VICTORIAN VINTAGE Clear Stamps

Cut an 11 x 15.5 cm light blue single-fold card; cut off the top corners at a slant. Cut 10.5 x 15 cm and 11 x 6 cm from azure blue card and 10 x 14.5 cm and 11 x 5.5 cm from design paper. Stamp the image onto stamping card and tear off the edges. Apply ink to the edges and layer onto azure blue card. Tear off the azure blue edges too. Apply ink

to the edges of all the sheets of card and paper. Stick them to the label as shown. Punch a hole in the top and attach a bow and charm. Attach the flowers with a droplet of 3D-kit and finish off with ice rhinestones.



Cut a 15 x 19 cm strip from white card; score at 15.5 cm. Punch the top and bottom with a corner punch. Cut 14.5 x 15 cm and 6 x 15 cm from azure blue card and 14 x 14.5 cm and 5.5 x 15 cm from design paper. Stamp the image onto stamping card. Apply ink to the edges of all the sheets

of card and paper. Layer them onto the card as shown. Fix the bow of lace and the seaming with a brad. Attach the flowers with a droplet of 3D-kit and finish off with hearts.



Cut 15 x 23.5 cm light blue card; score at 7.5 and 8.5 cm. Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 7 x 14.5 cm from azure blue card and 14 x 14 cm and 6.5 x 14 cm from design paper. Cut the Craftables from gravel card and apply ink to the edges. Stamp the image

onto stamping card. Stick all layers to the card as shown. Fix the bow of lace and the seaming with a brad. Attach the flowers with a droplet of 3D-kit and finish off with hearts.

CRAFTABLES Swirls & Girls

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold card from kraft card and cut three squares: blue 14 x 14 cm, white 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper 13 x 13 cm. Cut a 14.5 x 12 cm strip from kraft card and tear off two opposite edges. Work the light-coloured parts with Hero Arts shadow ink and the remaining ones with white ink. Stamp the text onto the strip of kraft card and cut the oval away from the

centre. Use the same die to cut out the image. Cut an oval from blue card; layer it behind the passe-partout and stick the image inside. Cut the swirls from white card. Stamp the post card onto a piece of white card and distress the edges. Stick the card together and finish it off with a ribbon leaves, flowers and stamps.



Cut a 28.5 x 14.5 cm strip from kraft card and score at 7 and 14 cm. Cut five squares: kraft card 14.5 x 14.5 cm, blue 14 x 14 cm (2x), white 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper 13 x 13 cm. Cut two 6 x 13 cm strips from kraft card and a 5.5 x 13 cm light-coloured strip. Work the light-coloured parts with Hero Arts shadow ink and the remaining parts with white ink. Stamp the text onto the blue squares and cut the swirls from white card. Copy the shape of the swirl onto a blue square and onto the squares of design paper and cut them out. Stick the swirls to these squares. Stick

the layers together and to the card. Stick a piece of lace, the kraft card stamp and the image to the card. Cut the pigeon and the book from kraft card. Cut the book from white card and cut it out along the outer embossing lines. Cut the book from design paper too and cut it out along the inner embossing lines. Stick the book together; apply the glue for the top pages in the centre only. Stick the pigeon and the book to the card. Finish the card off with a bow, branches and flowers.



In The Collection #4 unfortunately a wrong list of materials was placed next to the 3e card by Astrid Schipper. To avoid any misunderstanding here is the photo again with the proper list of materials and the description of the card.

Craftables: CR1239 (passe-partout round), CR1245 (Tiny's swirls & leaves), Nestabilities: grand label one, Clear stamps: CS0860, Ink pads: Hero Arts shadow ink wet cement, Brilliance white, Pretty Papers bloc: PK9092 (Victorian fashion), Ecoupage sheet: VK9528 (Victorian vintage 2), Papicolor card: carnation white (03), turquoise (32), Kraft card, Charm: JU0890, Lace, Tulle, Flowers

Cut the medium size label from kraft card and score a line down the centre. Apply ink to the edges and stamp the text using white ink. Cut the one but smallest label from carnation white card and trace the outer edge of the die on to turquoise card and the inner edge on to design paper. Cut out and apply ink to the edges. Cut the swirl from carnation white card. Stick the layers



together with the swirl in between; attach to the card as per example. Cut the passe-partout circle from kraft card and cut a circle from turquoise card. Use the die to cut out the picture, stick them together and then on to the card with a piece of lace. Now attach the swirl completely. Finish the card off with a bunch of flowers and a bow with charm.

ELINE'S BUITENHUIS

Maritiem

General:

Apply distress ink vintage photo to the edges of the design paper.



Stamp the text onto the canvas using Stazon ink. Cut a 16 x 16 cm square from kraft card and a 15 x 15 cm one from design paper. Mat this square on dark blue card. Cut a 10.5 cm Ø circle from design paper. Cut a 5 x 5 cm square from design paper, cut the tab from design paper too. Stamp the text with Stazon ink. Cut a 7 x 13.5 cm tag from kraft card, stamp the tag. Make a hole in the top and thread ribbon and rope through it. Layer a piece of jute behind the tag. Cut the house and the sailing boat from white card. Apply distress ink vin-

tage to the house and the boat and pumice stone to the sails, while they are still in the stencil. Cut the house to size as per example. Mat the house on dark blue card. Stamp the numbers on the door of the house and stick a charm on the door. Cut the flags to size. Fill the bottle with sand. Stamp the text and stick it to the bottle. Thread a few shells onto a piece of rope. Stamp a coin and cut it out. Finish the canvas off with stamps and decorate it with roses and lace.



Cut a 12 x 16.5 cm white single-fold card. Cut an 11.25 x 15.75 cm dark blue rectangle and mat it on kraft card. Cut 11 x 7 cm and 11 x 12.75 cm rectangles from design paper. Cut out a corner from design paper. Layer it onto the seam of the design paper; stick a piece of lace and flower ribbon underneath it. Stamp the borders and numbers with Stazon ink. Cut a stamp from white card and mat it on kraft card. Draw a border with clouds on a piece of scrap paper and cut it out. Lay the clouds

onto the stamp and sponge the edges with distress ink stormy sky. Stamp the boat and the text. Punch a hole in the top of the stamp. Cut an anchor from foil; the shells and sea star from white card. Apply distress ink rusty hinge and old paper ink to the shells and sea star. Stick the fishes to the ends of a piece of rope; tie this rope with the anchor to the stamp. Stick all layers to the card with a piece of jute sticking out from underneath.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card. Cut a 13.75 x 13.75 cm dark blue square and mat it on kraft card. Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square from design paper. Cut an 8 x 10 cm rectangle from design paper and mat it on dark blue card. Cut a 10 x 11.5 cm map from design paper. Cut a 9.25 x 8 cm rectangle from embroidery linen and mat it on white card. Stamp the images with Stazon ink. Tie a few shells to a piece of yarn. Cut a shell, sea stars and

the light house from white card. Cut the anchor from foil and a tab from design paper. Apply distress ink pumice stone to the light house, rusty hinge ink to the sea stars and old paper ink to the shells. Stick a strass stone to the light house. Stamp the shell on design paper and cut it out. Fill a small bottle with sand, stamp the text and cut it out. Decorate the card with flower ribbon. Stamp the coins and borders. Finish off with roses.

BEAUTIFUL Butterflies

Cut a 12.5 x 16 cm daffodil yellow single-fold card with the fold on top. Cut a 12 x 15.5 cm turquoise rectangle and a 12 x 15.5 cm one from design paper. Apply ink to the edged and stick them together. Cut a flower border from design paper and layer it to the bottom of the card. Cut a 10.2 cm Ø daffodil yellow circle and a 9.5 cm Ø tur-

quoise one. Cut the butterfly from turquoise card. Stick the circles together and then on to the card. Stamp the butterfly within the circle. Cut and stamp the butterfly from design paper and stick it to the card, raised with 3D-glue. Fold its wings in shape. Cut leaves and attach them to the card together with the roses.



Fold daffodil yellow A4-size card in half. Place the Creatable just a little over the edge and cut it out. Fold the top part. Cut another daffodil yellow circle. Layer it to the folded part. Cut three circles: turquoise 10.2 cm Ø, azure blue 9.5 cm Ø and design paper 8.8 cm Ø. Stick the circles together and then on to the card. Repeat this for the lying card. Cut the butterflies from design paper. Cut the swirls and layer them with the flower ribbon to the top circle. Place the Collectable butterfly

just over the edge of a folded azure blue strip and cut it out. Then fold the top part of the butterfly over. Cut and stamp the butterfly from daffodil yellow card once again and attach it to the folded part. Attach this to the lying card. Stick two strass stones under the butterfly to make it stay upright.



Cut a 14.5 x 30.5 cm white strip; score and fold at 14.5 and 16 cm. Use the card with the fold on top. Score the front of the card in to a square at 1.6 and 3.2 cm in from the edges. Cut the folds in from corner to corner and fold it into a shallow box. Cut an 11 x 11 cm white square and stick it on the bottom. Cut 10.5 x 10.5 cm design paper and stick it on to the white square. Cut 1.3 cm wide daffodil yellow strips. Stamp them with

the border stamp and layer them on the raised borders. Cut the butterflies from white card and vellum. Stamp them and work them with embossing powder and the heat tool. Finish the card off with flowers and branches. Attach the butterfly with a spring between the flowers. Finish the inner part of the card off with a 13.5 x 13.5 cm turquoise square, an 11.5 x 11.5 cm daffodil one and a stamped butterfly.

Mini-Snoesjes

Half carousel

Cut the carousel twice from design paper, score the two sides and make a diagonal score line. Copy the paper and cut two white single-fold cards or use Grand Nestabilities Labels One and cut it out a few times. Layer wall paper (design paper) to the walls of the living room, don't forget to stick the ends of a ribbon between the first and last wall, so the house can be closed. Cut the furniture and the clock for both living rooms. Cut two flower baskets and use them for newspapers and for the cat. Stick everything to the walls. Cut two carpets to size and lay them on the floor. Punch two cats and stick them to the walls together with a few charms. Stick the walls to the supports of the floor. Cut three white supports and stick them to the front and back. Cut



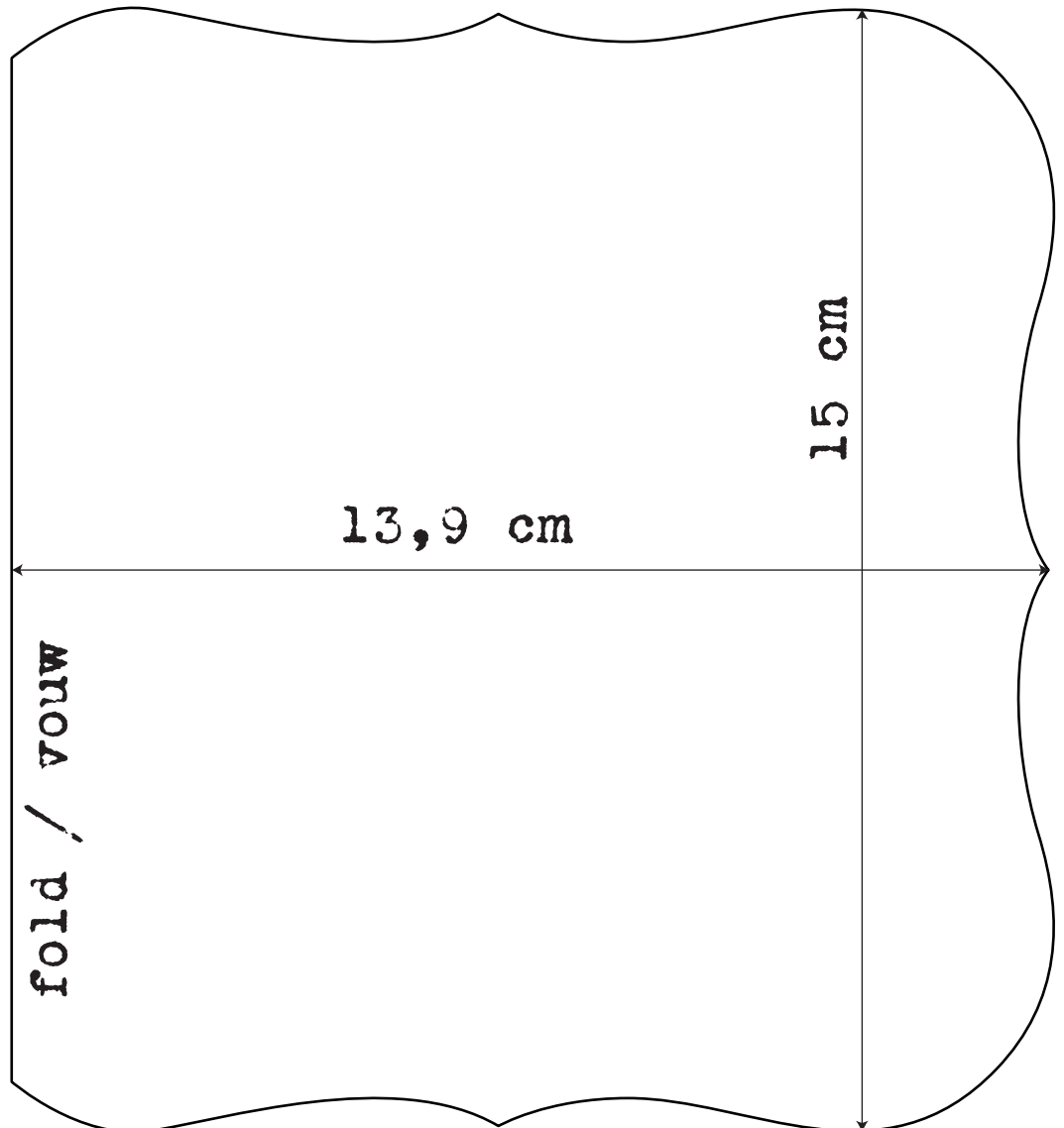
Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card and stick design paper to the front. Cut the furniture from white card and apply distressinkt. Stick the mini-

the Scandinavian house and the grass and attach them to the front with some mini-Snoesjes.

Quarter carousel

Cut the carousel from design paper, score the two sides and make a diagonal score line. Cut a square single-fold card 14 cm high and 13 cm wide and layer design paper on all sides; don't forget to stick the ends of a ribbon between the first and last wall, so the house can be closed. Cut the English cottage from brown and carnation white card. Attach it to the card together with mini-Snoesjes and grass cut from green card. Cut the furniture and place it in the room. Stick mini-Snoesjes within the frames. Cut the carpet and lay it on the floor. Stick the walls to the upright borders of the floor.

Snoesje within the frame. Punch a cat and stick it to the wall together with a few charms.



Eline's Buitenhuis

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card from kraft card, 14 x 14 cm white card and 13 x 13 cm design paper. Stick the layers together. Cut two rectangles from design paper and mat them on white card. Distress the edges with a distresser or a pair of scissors. Layer the rectangles onto the card and stick the lamp to the largest one. Cut the lamp shade

from felt and stick this to the paper lamp shade, decorate it with lace and a pearl. Finish the card off with lace, ribbon, a label and metal corners painted salmon.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white single-fold card and 13 x 13 cm kraft card. Cut a piece of design paper and use it as wall paper and cut a piece of the parquet motif to make the floor. Cut a piece of carpet too. Stamp the frame and the cupboard. Cut an opening into the doors of the cupboard, use pearls as door knobs. Cut the lamp stand from kraft card.

Cut the lamp shade from carnation white card and from felt. Stick them together. Cut the chair from kraft card and the seat from felt as well. Layer design paper behind the frame and hang it on the wall. Embroider a border around the card and add beads.



Cut a 15 x 30 cm strip from kraft card; fold in half. Fold the front panel in half again and cut off the top half of this small strip at 8 cm down from the top edge. Paste the lower half along the bottom and the side turning it into a pocket. Layer smaller pieces of design paper and white card to the kraft card. The pocket will have two punched bor-

ders, and a tag will be placed in to it. Tie a charm to a piece of ribbon and rope. Make a pretty composition of the furniture. Cut six triangles from design paper and mat them on kraft card. String them and attach them to the card.
