The Collection #5 hen Fun

Cut a purple 5 x 15 cm single-fold card. Cut from design paper a 14 x 14 cm square and layer it onto a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white square. Use the sewing machine and make backstitches along the borders. Cut from design paper a 15.5 x 5.5 cm rectangle and layer it onto 14.5 x 6 cm kraft card. Make backstitches along these borders too. Cut a decorative border from kraft card, ink the embossed parts and stick the border behind the rectangle. Place a length of ribbon onto the rectangle and stick the ends to the reverse side of the card using tacky tape. Cut a paper doily in half. Layer the doily and the rectangle onto the square. Then mount the layers onto the single-fold card. Cut the apron from pearly white and corn flower blue card and ink the edges. Finish the apron off and stick it to the card. Cut a wooden spoon and put it in the pocket of the apron. Finish the card off with a bow, flowers and a text.



Cut from kraft card a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card. Cut from pearly white card a 14.5 x 14.5 cm square and stick it to the single-fold card. Cut design paper into 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 13.5 x 6 cm and turquoise card into 14 x 14 cm. Stick the layers together as per example and make backstitches with the sewing machine. Then layer it onto the single-fold card. Cut/emboss a brown border, ink

the embossed parts and stick it to the card. Cut out the picture, mat it on lilac card and then layer it onto the card using 3D-foam tape. Cut out the pot holder and kitchen glove from pearly white and lilac card and ink the embossed parts. Make bows from twine and fix them to the card. Stamp a text onto the card. Finish the card off with paper flowers and a bow made of twine.




Cut from corn flower blue card a 12.5 x 20.5 cm strip. Cut from design paper a 12 x 14 cm and 12 x 6 cm rectangle and stick them to the corn blue card. Use the sewing machine to make back-stitches along the borders. Cut out a brown border, work it with distress ink and stick it to the design paper. Then layer it all onto the bag of kraft card. Cut out the apron and put its parts together. Attach a length of elastic white ribbon

along the bottom using double-sided tape. Make the straps of the apron from satin ribbon and attach the apron to the bag; fix the straps with 3D-foam tape. Cut the whisk, wooden spoon and text label. Stamp a text on the label and attach the items to the bag. Stick two roses near the text. Finish the bag off with a bow made of twine and attach it, together with a charm, to the handle.

Cut a 26 x 6.5 cm strip from blue card; score folds at 8 cm, 10.5 cm and 12.5 cm. Cut 7.5 x 6 cm and 13 x 6 cm design paper. Layer this onto the blue strip in such a way that it will be visible when the strip is in the transparent bag. Cut out the parts of the pie from felt, layer them together and finish the pie off with beads and embroidery stitches. Stamp the circle onto a piece of white card and stick it to the felt circle. Decorate the circle with a button and small beads. Attach the pie and the text circle to the bag and fill it with sweets. Fold the top of the bag over twice. Punch two holes in the top and tie a ribbon through them.







For the recipe booklet cut blue card into four 15.8 x 12.5 cm rectangles. Cut four holes for the binding rings into both top corners. Cut from design paper four 14.8 x 10.5 cm rectangles and three 14.8 x 3 cm strips. Stick only the sides of the design paper the card so that recipes can be pushed in between. Stamp letters and make a text to stick onto the strips. Cut out the parts of the pie Trace the pattern of the gift box onto card and fold/paste the box together. To decorate the box cut design paper into 12.5 x 12.5 cm. Cut a 3 x 12.5 cm strip from design paper and stick it to the square; embroider zigzag stitches along the edges of the strip. Cut out the parts of the pie from felt, stick them together and finish the pie off with beads, sequins and embroidery stitches. Stamp the circle onto a piece of white card, and then

from felt, stick them together and finish the pie off with beads, sequins and embroidery stitches. Stamp the circle onto a piece of lilac card, then stick it onto the felt circle and decorate with embroidery stitches. Stick the layers to the booklet and attach the roses with 3D-glue. Bind the booklet together and tie ribbon through the rings.

layer it onto the felt circle. Decorate the circle with a button and small beads. Cut the heart from red design paper and the heart on top from blue design paper. Stick them together and tie an organza ribbon through them. Stamp the text. Attach all parts to the box as shown. Attach the roses with 3D-glue.

General

Apply distress ink vintage photo to the edges of the design paper.



Cut 15.2 \times 21.4 cm white card; score down the centre and fold it into a single-fold card. Cut design paper into 14.8 \times 10.2 cm and layer onto the card. Use design paper with another motif and cut a 4 \times 14.8 cm strip. Stick it to the card at 1 cm from the bottom edge. Accentuate the strip by sticking music tape across the top and bottom edges. Cut out the vintage picture and use 3D-foam tape

to attach it to the card. Cut the Collectable from white card and stamp the image onto it. Layer the die-cut circle onto the card. Mount the stamped image on top using 3D-foam tape. Finish the circle off with roses and a bow. Decorate the card with two buttons. Finally pierce two holes along the border of the card and make backstitches.



Cut 15.1 x 21.5 cm white card; score down the centre and fold it into a single-fold landscape card. Ink the edges with distress ink. Cut a 14 x 7 cm rectangle from design paper. Ink these edges too and stick it to the card at 1 cm up from the bottom edge. Layer a small visible strip of another motif behind the top of the strip. Stick a 1.5 cm high strip of red design paper across the centre of

the card. Cut the girl out of design paper and fix her to the card using 3D-foamtape. Layer a yellow ribbon across the top of the card. Then layer dotted paper tape on top. Cut a scalloped circle from kraft card and ink the edges. Stamp the image. Attach the circle to the card using 3D-foamtape. Finish the card off with five roses, and two butterflies, cut from paper tape.



Cut 15.1 x 21.5 cm white card; score down the centre and fold it into a single-fold card. Cut design paper into a 14.5 x 7 cm rectangle. Ink the edges and stick this piece of paper onto the left-hand side of the card at 1 cm in from the edge. Decorate it with a strip of paper tape. Draw back-stitches along the edges of the design paper using a black pen. Use CR1202 to cut a frame from red design paper and ink the edges. Stick the frame

in the centre of the card. Cut the three girls out of design paper and use 3D-foam tape to attach them to the card. Use the Collectables to cut a straight oval from design paper and a scalloped oval from kraft card. Stamp the image onto kraft card and attach it to the larger straight circle. Stick all layers onto the card. Finish the card off with roses and a bow.

General

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser.

Work the various parts with coffee- and/or sepia-coloured ink.

Stamp the images and texts with black ink onto smooth stamping card.



Cut from red design paper a 13 \times 13 cm square and layer it onto: a dark brown 13.5 \times 13.5 cm square, a 14 \times 14 cm cerise-coloured square and a white 14.5 \times 14.5 cm single-fold card. Cut from design paper a 8 \times 12.5 cm rectangle, an 8.5 \times 8.5 cm square and a 14.5 \times 2.5 cm strip. Stick all layers to the card as

per example. Stamp the girls twice, once onto the white square for the card and once onto a scrap of smooth white card. Colour in the second image, cut out and attach it to the first image using 3D-glue. Finish the card off with ribbon, branches, flowers, leaves, adhesive pearls and texts.



Cut from dark brown card a 15 x 22.5 cm rectangle, score folds at 6 cm and 16.5 cm. Cut from design paper four 13.5 x 4.5 cm rectangles and mat them on respectively a carnation white 14 x 5 cm rectangle and a 14.5 x 5.5 cm cerise-coloured one. Attach on both side flaps ribbon of 22 cm. Then layer the narrow strip onto the card. Cut from design paper a 13.5 x 9 cm rectangle and mat it on a carnation white 14 x 9.5 cm rectangle and a 14.5 x 10 cm cerise-coloured one. Stick the

rectangle to the inner side of the card, right in the centre. Cut from design paper a 14.5 x 2 cm strip and attach it to the central part of the card as per example. Stamp the image twice, once onto the white strip for the card and once onto a scrap of smooth white card. Colour in the second image, cut out and attach it to the first image using 3D-glue. Finish the card off with ribbon, branches, flowers, leaves, adhesive pearls and texts.



Cut from dark brown card an 18 x12 cm rectangle; score folds at 8.9 and 9.2 cm. Fold the card into a booklet. Cut from design paper three 7.4 x 10.5 cm rectangles. First mat them on cerise-coloured 7.9 x 11 cm rectangles and then onto carnation white 8.4 x 11.5 cm rectangles. Attach to the front and right-hand inner side two ribbons of 25 cm length. Then stick the rectangles to the front and the two inner sides. Cut from design paper

a 5.5 x 6.5 cm rectangle. Stick them to the front of the card. Cut from design paper three 7.5 x 1 cm strips and stick them to the centre of all the pasted sides. Stamp the image twice, once onto the white strip for the card and once onto a scrap of smooth white card. Colour in the second image, cut out and attach it to the first image using 3D-glue. Finish the card off with ribbon, branches, flowers, leaves, adhesive pearls and texts.

General

Distress the edges of the design paper and card using distress ink walnut stain.

Stamped images with a broken top layer of melted embossing powder:

Stamp an image with Stazon ink. Work the image with Versamark ink. Sprinkle ultra thick embossing powder onto the image and heat it with a heat tool. Repeat this process twice. Then place the card in the freezer. After half an hour remove it from the freezer and make cracks in the top layer by bending the card a little.



Use the Go Kreate stencil to cut a single-fold and a single card from mouse grey card, and a single one and a smaller size from design paper. The fold

of the card is on top. Stamp the texts with Stazon ink. Use the Nestabilities to cut a scalloped oval from mouse grey card and a straight oval from

pearly white card. Stamp the vintage stamps onto pearly white card using Stazon ink. Work the image as described in General. Finally work the image with distress ink and layer it onto the scalloped oval. Stick bandage, ribbon and lace

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Cut from mouse grey card a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold card. Cut from design paper a 13.75 x 13.75 cm and an 11.75 x 11.75 cm square; mat both on carnation white card. Cut a border from carnation white card and stick it behind the small square. Cut from design paper a 10 x 10 cm square. Layer bandage behind the square. Cut from mouse grey card two 8.5 cm Ø circles. Cut from the centre of one circle a smaller circle to get a 7 cm Ø aperture. Layer a piece of transparent foil behind the aperture and cut it to size. Stick foam blocks



Cut from mouse grey card a 15 cm Ø double and a single circle. Cut from carnation white card a 14.75 cm Ø single circle and from design paper a 14.75 cm Ø single one. Stamp the vintage stamp with Stazon ink onto pearly white card. Cut out the image and mat it on mouse grey card. Work the image as described in General. Cut from design paper a 10.25 x 10.25 cm square and mat it on mouse grey card. Stamp the text with Stazon ink. Cut from mouse grey card a label and three

under the oval. Attach a pearl ribbon around the oval. Make a bow. Cut from moss green card four leaves, from carnation white card two swirls and from design paper two roses. Stamp the post stamp with Stazon ink.

to the oval, neatly next to each other. Stamp the vintage stamp onto pearly white card using Stazon ink and cut out. Stick it to the other circle. Put glitter powder in the aperture and place the image. Stick the layers to the card and decorate with ribbon and lace. Make a bow and tie a charm. Cut from mouse grey card two leaves and from carnation white card a swirl. Cut from design paper two roses. Finish the card off as per example with stamps, feathers, roses and a pearl swirl.

leaves, from carnation white card a swirl and a post stamp and from design paper two roses. Tie a length of ribbon and a charm with twine to the label. Stamp the text onto the post stamp. Cut from design paper a 12 x 7.5 cm rectangle. Stick a piece of lace under the stamped image. Finish the card off as per example with roses, a pearl swirl, a text ribbon and a feather.

General

Decorate the edges of all the pieces of card with Hero Arts wet-cement ink.



Cut a green 15 x 15 cm single-fold card and two squares: caramel 14.5 x 14.5 cm and yellow flowers design paper 14 x 14 cm. Stick them together. Cut four cards: brick red 12.5 x 9.5 cm, green design paper 12 x 9 cm, caramel card 10.5 x 10.5 cm and red design paper 10 x 10 cm. First stick the layers together and then onto the card. Cut/

emboss the stencil from champagne and green card, stick them together and then onto the card. Attach a piece of lace to the card. Cut the picture from design paper and attach it to the card using 3D-glue. Finish the card off with a bow, charm, swirl and roses.



Cut two 14 x 12.7 cm rectangles from champagne card and cut/emboss the stencil at the top. Cut two green strips: 14.5 x 13.2 cm and 29 x 13.2 cm; score folds on the last strip at 7.25 and 14.5 cm. Layer the champagne cards on the green strips and trim the top leaving a narrow border. Cut five strips: caramel 8.6 x 12.2 cm (2x), red design paper 8.1 x 11.7 cm and 8.1 x 3.5 cm and green design paper with image at 8.1 x 11.7 cm. Trace the central part of the Creatable onto the small red

strip of design paper and cut out. Layer the diecut ornament on top. Stick all layers together, including the lace and attach it to the card. Cut two ornaments from caramel card. Cut out the text, layer it on caramel card and trim leaving a narrow border. Stick the ornaments to the text and then onto the card. Finish the card off with a bow, charm, swirl and roses.



Cut a 10 x 19.5 cm rectangle from green card and score folds at 3 cm, 4.5 cm, 15 cm and 16.5 cm.
Cut a 9.1 x 15 cm strip from champagne card. Cut/emboss the stencil at both sides of the strips and embroider the borders. Stick the strips together only along the edges and leave the top open to be able to insert the label. Cut two strips: red design paper 8.5 x 10 cm and yellow/green design paper 3 x 10 cm. Layer the strips onto the card and fix the lace diagonally. Cut the picture out of design paper (6.3 x 7.5 cm) and layer it onto a larger

piece of card. Cut/emboss the narrow border from champagne card and stick it to the side of the picture. Cut out the apertures. Layer everything to the card. Finish the card off with a bow, charm, swirl and roses. Label: Cut an 11 x 9.2 cm green strip, cut/emboss a border and embroider the border. Cut two strips: yellow/green design paper 8.2 x 8.7 cm and red design paper 4 x 8. cm. Cut out the text and layer it to a larger champagne circle.
