Hint for attaching support strips: first paste the bottom. Fold the card open completely. Paste the top of the support strip. Always check to see if the card can still be opened and folded.

Cut a light blue strip 13.5 cm high x whole width of A4. Fold at 15.4 cm. The bottom is 14.3 cm high and 13.5 cm wide.

Cut 14 x 12 cm design paper for the 'back wall' of the card. Layer to Christmas red and trim leaving a narrow border. Layer to Christmas green and do the same.

Hinge: cut a light blue 11 x 2 cm strip. Make a valley fold at 1.5 cm. This 1.5 cm will be stuck to the light blue bottom. Stick design paper to the front of the strip. Now the hinge is sturdy and neatly finished off. Place the card in a 90° angle. Attach the hinge to the bottom, 4 cm from the right. Cut 2 x 5 cm design paper for the T-connection and fix this on both sides as per example. Check to see if the card can be opened and folded.

Use CR1224 to cut/emboss two trees: one from light blue and one from gravel card. Layer the light blue tree to the 'back wall' of the card.

Support strip for tree: cut an 11 x 1.5 cm light blue strip. Fold: at 1 cm a valley fold, at 1 cm a valley

fold, at 8 cm a valley fold, at 1 cm a valley fold. Fix as shown (see photo). Hint for pasting support strips: see top.

Support strip for LRO277: cut an 11.5 x 2 cm light blue strip. Fold: at 1 cm a valley fold, at 3 cm a valley fold, at 7 cm a valley fold, at 1.5 cm a valley fold. Paste as per example (see photo 2).

Cut LRO277: 1x from light blue (will come underneath), 1x from design paper (Santa in sleigh) and 1x with two stencils at the same time, from champagne (when cutting with two stencils at the same time the centre will open up).

Cut the fence from champagne and layer olive green behind.

Cut the flower pots 2x from light blue and 2x from champagne. Place them on each side behind the fence. Attach a 4.5 x 1.5 cm support strip at each side of the fence. Make a valley fold at 1 cm and again at 1 cm.

Cut triangle LRO278 from champagne. Place the stencil on glitter paper and trace the outline. Cut out. Layer the glitter paper behind the champagne.

Stick embroidery lace to the front of the back part.

Back part: layer 14.5 x 12.5 cm design paper to 15 x 13 cm Christmas red. Layer 4 x 13.5 cm light blue to 4.5 x 13.5 cm olive green. Stick the strip on both sides to the back part (lower half). Leave the centre open so that something can be tugged in.

Cut/emboss the fence from champagne and layer olive green behind.



Cut a 17.5 cm high and 13 cm wide silver grey card. Open up. Score (whole width) at 4 cm in from the bottom.

Make a 4 cm incision in to the fold. Fold the flaps inside.

Cut two 11.5 x 12.5 cm sheets from design paper for the inside of the card. Decorate the flaps with lace and paste to the sides. Leave the centre open. Front: layer 13 x 12.5 cm gold-coloured card and 12.5 x 12 cm design paper to the front of the card. Cut gold-coloured card in to 8.5 x 11.5 cm and glitter paper in to 8 x 11 cm. Layer the glitter paper to the gold-coloured paper.

Attach nylon lace to the bottom and top right corner of the glitter paper. Cut two small swirls from champagne and fix them to the right side of the glitter paper. Stick this complete layer to the

card. Attention: only paste the left side, the label will be tugged in.

Cut LRO276 2x from champagne. Layer the image behind. Layer gold-coloured card behind the small apertures at the top. Make the frame 2D. To neatly finish off the back with grey card cut out the point only (see first photo of the inside of the card).

Label: cut the point (LRO278) twice from champagne. Cut a silver grey 7 x 8 cm strip for the label. Place the curl pattern on it. Copy and cut to size.

Stick the silver grey strip to the champagne card. Stamp the text Warm Winter Wishes on to carnation white card and then cut out. Layer linen lace behind the right-hand side using with double-sided tape.



Cut a silver grey strip 16.5 high x whole width of A4. Fold from the left: at 3 cm a valley fold (later on fold this inside and paste at two sides), at 10.5 cm a valley fold (this fold will be on top), at 10.5 cm a valley fold (the design paper will come on top). The remaining piece is 5.7 cm (the glitter paper will come on top).

Inside: cut 10.2 x 16 cm creamy white. Layer 9.5 x 15.2 cm design paper on top. Stick 5.2 x 16 cm glitter paper on the bottom.

Attach linen lace to the front and finish this off with a narrow strip of gold-coloured card.

Front: cut 10 x 16 cm gold-coloured card. Layer 9.5 x 15.5 cm silver grey on top. Paste the lace to the bottom.

Cut four round arches and four points from champagne.

Layer a round arch to the picture at the top and bottom.

Layer a point behind each side of the picture.

Make the point 2D. Fix with 3D-glue.

Make the arch 2D. Fix with 3D-glue.

Stamp the text on to creamy white. Cut out with COL1325.

Finish the card off with leaves and roses.

NOSTALGIC CHRISTMAS Cling Stamps

Copy the pattern on to pearly white card and design paper, ink the edges and stick the layers together. Cut Petra's hearts 4x from mouse grey card, ink the embossed parts and embroider the holes. Stick two die-cut motifs to the front of the label and the other two to the reverse side (to finish it off neatly).

Cut the envelope from parchment paper and the label from design paper. Stamp the text and cut it out with Petra's ornament. Cut pearly white card in to 10 x 7 cm and stamp the postcard on to it. Cut off the edges with photo edge scissors,

ink the edges and stick this layer to design paper, trim leaving a 0.5 cm border.

Stamp and colour the snowman, cut out and shape him. Stick the snowman to the postcard with 3D-glue. Staple lengths of ribbon to the side of the postcard.

Layer a length of ribbon across the label and stick the label on top. Cut a holly branch and use tiny tempex balls as berries. Fill the bottle with artificial snow and hang the label around the bottle. Finish off the cork with ribbon and paper.



General
Apply ink to the edges and embossed parts. Embroider using running stitches.

Copy the pattern on to pearly white card, score the lines and paste the envelope together.

Apply ink to the edges of the cake doily. Cut Petra's ornament from design paper and pearly white card. Stamp the text. Cut the mail box from Christmas green card and the envelopes from design paper. Layer them together as shown.

Thread bells to a length of thread and stick to the envelope.

Cut a 13 x 13 cm card. Cut Petra's corners 2x from Christmas red card and cut the central part once from design paper. Cut 12.5 x 9 cm design paper.

Apply ink to the cake doily and cut out the centre. Cut a circle from design paper and layer it behind the doily. Stamp and colour the image and stick it to the card. Finish the card off with adhesive glitter and pearl stars.



Cut a 15 x 30 cm nut brown strip and score at 14.5 cm, 15.5 cm and 22.8 cm. Layer 0.5 cm smaller pieces of design paper to all parts.



For the tray: cut 10 x 15.2 cm nut brown card and

score at 1.2 cm, all the way around. Make one incision in each corner and paste the tray together. Cut from design paper four 1 x 7.5 cm strips and four 1 x 12.6 cm strips; stick them to the outsides and insides of the tray. Cut 12.5 x 7.5 cm from de-

sign paper and stick it to the bottom of the tray. Cut a piece out on the front. Cut Petra's corner 2x from nut brown card and cut the central part from carnation white card. Stick the layers together with the ends of strips of 1 x 5 cm in between (this will be the 'hinge'). Place the corner at the reverse side of the tray and fold the strips at the back downwards and paste them. Fix the button.

Cut Petra's ornament 2x from nut brown card and stick them together. Attach them partially to the easel. Cut the tab with text from design paper and the swirl from carnation white card. Stamp and colour Santa. Stick on the layers as shown.

Make a bunch with different flowers. Add the wooden letters and the adhesive pearls. Fill the tray with memo paper and a pencil or a pen.

Cut a fiesta red 15 x 15 cm single-fold card. Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white square and mount 14 x 14 cm design paper on top. Cut a 10.5 x 10.5 cm square from the centre. Layer white card behind the aperture and cut out the centre again, using a craft knife and a ruler, leaving a 0.5 cm border. Create a white card with clouds and layer on to the card. Cut two snow hills from snow paper and

layer on to the card too. Then mount the frame on top, using foam pads. Cut out the house and the other dies and attach in place as shown. Attach a text label, stamps stars and a snowflake of pearls to finish.



Creating clouds
First make your own paper clouds-template. Then take a piece of white card and using the template and a sponge with distress ink, dab clouds on to a white card.

out the shape leaving a 0.5 cm border. Create a white card with clouds and layer it on to the card. Cut out three snow hills and apply Aleene's true snow. Layer them on to the card using a few foam pads; make sure there will be enough space to adhere the houses. Attach the frame using thick foam pads. Cut out the houses and Christmas trees. Assemble the houses and apply Aleene's true snow. Place the houses and trees between the snow hills. Stamp a text and add a star of pearls to finish.



Cut a blue 15 x 16 cm single-fold card. Cut a white 14.5 x 15.5 cm square and mount 14 x 15 cm design paper on top. Use Creatable LR0242 to cut out the centre. Cut the red frame with a template and layer around the aperture. Create a white card with clouds and layer on to the card. Cut a few snow hills and apply Aleene's True Snow.

Mount them on to the card using foam pads. Cut out all parts of the house, the trees, the deer and the lamppost. Assemble the house and place it between the snow hills. Decorate the card with a label with a bow of ribbon tied to it with a length of linen rope.

LET IT SNOW

Christmas Village

Use the Go Kreate stencil and cut the largest size 2x from white card and the medium size 2x from design paper. Ink the edges and layer them together crosswise. Cut the straight oval from white card and design paper, ink the edges. First layer them together and then to the ornament. Attach the pearl ribbon around the oval.

Cut/emboss the mini village from pearly white card, ink the edges and layer nut brown behind. Cut the trees from green and the lampposts from brown card. Stick them on the oval as shown. Stamp the text. Punch a hole at the top and thread a rope, charm and ribbon through it. Finish the ornament off with pearl snow stars and snowflakes, drawn with a perlen pen.



Cut 15.5 x 11 cm night blue card, 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white and 14.5 x 10 cm design paper. Then cut 11.5 x 8 cm pearly white and 11 x 7.5 cm ice blue card. Layer them together. Sprinkle embossing powder on to the ice blue card and melt it with the heat tool. Stick this part together with the large snowflake to the card.

Cut the mini houses from Christmas red and the church from night blue card. Cut the roofs from snow paper too and layer them on the houses. Layer cream-coloured card behind the houses. Cut the trees from green and the lamppost from brown card. Tear strips from snow paper, approximately 7.5 cm wide, layer them to the card with

the houses and trees in between. Decorate with pompom ribbon.



Cut an 11 x 15,5 cm red rectangle, a 10,5 x 15 cm white one and a 10 x 14,5 cm one from design paper. Ink the edges and layer them together.

Cut from pearly white card an 8,5 x 11,5 cm rectangle and from ice blue an 8 x 11 cm one. Layer them together.

Stamp the background text and apply it with embossing enamel, melt it with a heat tool. Paste the text to the card on three sides only, leave the left side open for the tag.

Cut the house from night blue card. Layer to

Stamp the text. Cut a snowflake from snow paper and attach it to the top of the card with an adhesive pearl.

cream-coloured card and cut out. Cut the roof and snow border from glitter paper. Cut the trees from green and the lamppost from brown card. Layer cream-coloured card behind the lamp. Stick to the card as shown. Decorate with pompom ribbon.

Cut the tag and the banner, stamp the text, layer it on dark brown card and trim leaving a narrow border. Place the banner in the top left corner. Attach a charm and a length of rope to the tag and place it behind the image.

General

Apply distress ink vintage photo to the edges of the design paper and stormy sky to the skis, while the paper is still in the stencils.



Use the Go Kreate stencil to cut a square from fiesta red card and design paper. Layer a 13,5 x 4 cm strip of design paper across the square with a length of lace on top. Cut design paper into an 11,5 x 11,5 cm square and mat on fiesta red card. Cut a stamp and two stars from design paper. Cut a star from fiesta red and carnation white card. Stamp the text on to the star using Stazon ink. Cut Tiny's hearts from fiesta red card and mat on

design paper. Cut from carnation white card a 6,5 cm Ø circle, stamp the image with Stazon ink and colour it in with pencils. Cut two snowflakes from fiesta red card, four flowers from design paper and three ivy branches from moss green card. Stamp the post stamp using Stazon ink. Finish the card off with pearls, roses, rhinestones, snowtex and liquid appliqué.



Cut a 10 x 16 cm tag from fiesta red card and a 9,75 x 9,75 cm rectangle from design paper. Cut off the edges on one side. Cut a 9,75 x 15,75 cm rectangle from design paper and mat on fiesta red card. Cut the oval from design paper with the image of the snowman. Use the Go Kreate stencil to cut a flower from design paper. Cut Tiny's hearts from fiesta red and carnation white card. Layer the red circle behind the flower. Mat the carnation white circle on fiesta red card. Cut a 5,25 cm Ø circle from carnation white card. Cut

the church from carnation white card, leave the card in the stencil and apply distress ink weathered wood. Stamp the image with Stazon ink and cut out. Cut a snowflake and skis from carnation white card. Cut four flowers from fiesta red and two ivy branches from moss green card. Decorate the card with pearls, flower ribbon, paper roses and snowtex. Use a Nestability to cut a circle and stamp the text on to it. Make a hole and tie the circle to the tag with a rope. Tie two bells to the rope. Stamp the post stamps using Stazon ink.



Cut a folded and a single card from fiesta red card using the Go Kreate stencil. Use the same Go Kreate stencil two cut two pieces of design paper. Cut a narrow border from these two sheets, to get a visible red border after sticking the layers together. To make an easel card: fold one flap of the folded card in half and layer the single red card on top. For the top half: cut two flowers, two snowflakes and Tiny's hearts from fiesta red card. Cut two ivy branches from moss green card, the skis from carnation white and two flowers from design paper. Mat Tiny's hearts on design paper. Cut

a 6 cm Ø circle from carnation white card. Stamp and colour the image. Decorate the top with paper roses, pearls, snowtex and glitter glue. For the bottom half: cut a 9 x 6 cm and a 5 x 7,5 cm rectangle from design paper. Cut a 5,25 cm Ø circle from carnation white card. Stamp the text with Stazon ink. Cut a circle using a Nestability. Layer lengths of lace and ribbon across the card. Make a bow. Cut two snowflakes from fiesta red and an ivy branch from moss green card. Decorate the bottom half with paper roses, snowtex and pearls. Stamp the post stamps with Stazon ink.

Winterfun

Make an easel card: cut a dark blue 14 x 14 cm single-fold card and cut out a 13.5 cm Ø circle from the centre, make sure the circle falls over the score line to keep the card in one piece. Cut a circle from dark blue card. Fold one circle of the single-fold card down the centre and layer the dark blue circle on top.

Cut two light blue 13 cm Ø circles and two 12.5 cm Ø ones from design paper. Stick the layers together.



Cut a dark blue 14.5 x 14.5 cm card and three square cards: light blue 14 x 14 cm, cream 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper 13 x 13 cm. Ink the edges and stick them together.

Cut two rectangles: dark blue 9.5 x 12 cm and design paper 9 x 11 cm, and two strips: blue 5 x 14.5 cm and design paper 4.5 x 14.5 cm. Stick the strips



Cut four strips: dark blue 18 x 10.5 cm, light blue 17.5 x 10 cm, cream 17 x 9.5 cm and design paper 16.5 x 19 cm. Cut the top corners at a slant and stick the layers together. Cut design paper into a 16.5 x 5 cm strip and layer lace behind on both sides. Then mount it on top of the label. Cut/emboss the Craftables circle border with hearts from cream-coloured card and cut out the centre partially. Layer the circle on dark blue card and trim

Cut/emboss the Craftables hearts stencil from light blue and two snowflakes from dark blue card. Cut out the picture, layer it on light blue and then on dark blue card. Stamp the text on a piece of cream-coloured card, layer it on slightly larger dark blue card and then on the single-fold card. Finish the card off with a bow, lace, tulle, pearls, branches and a tuft of flowers.

together and attach lace underneath. Layer everything on the card. Layer the picture on larger cream-coloured card first, trim leaving a narrow border, and then on the card.

Finish the card off with skis, a snowflake, a branch, a bow and a tuft of flowers.

Cut the picture to size and stick it on the circle. Stick tulle under the circle and layer everything on the label. Stamp the text on cream-coloured card and trim leaving a narrow border. Layer the text on dark blue card, trim leaving a narrow border. Use a blue peg to attach the text to the card. Finish the card off with a bow, branches and a tuft of flowers.
