

# The Collection #102

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## Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline Frames), Die cutting and embossing machine, Mask stencils: PS8094 (School of Fish), PS8095 (Tiny's Beach), Text stamps: CS1024 (Strand), Stamps+dies set: TC0883 (Tiny's Beach), Stamping ink: Archival jet black, Distress inks: black soot, bundled sage, festive berries, peeled paint, salty ocean, spiced marmalade, tea dye, vintage photo, weathered wood, Watercolour card, Masking paper, Self-adhesive flat-backed pearls: CA3133 (off-white), Tuft of reindeer moss, Scrapper's floss: light blue



Die cut the Slimline card and the matching rectangle from watercolour card. Work the rectangle from bottom to top with the following distress inks.

- stencil PS9058: the beach with tea dye, and the fishing net with tea dye and a little bundled sage,
- stencil PS9084 (school of fish): bundled sage and a little salty ocean.

Ink the edges with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut and emboss two frames.

Stamp a flying seagull, use an extra image as a mask and ink the background with the blending foam sponge with the paper still in the die, mask the seagull, to keep it white. Stamp the text.

Stamp and die cut the other seagull, the mooring pole and the rope.

Work the pole and the rope with the paper still in the stencil, with distress ink vintage photo

and black soot. Colour in the seagull with distress ink and a water brush.

Adhere the parts to the card, use foam tape for the seagull.

Complete the card with a tuft of reindeer moss and adhesive pearls.



Cut a 13 x 13 cm background from watercolour card, work with mask stencil Tiny's beach and distress ink tea dye and a blending foam sponge. Ink the edges with distress ink vintage photo.

Die cut and emboss four postage stamp frames (CR1537) and three matching rectangles.

Stamp two flying seagulls and a lighthouse onto the rectangles. Colour in the lighthouse with green ink and a water brush. Mask the seagulls and lighthouse and work the backgrounds with a blending foam sponge and distress ink salty ocean and a touch of bundled sage, and the beach with tea dye.

Work the fourth frame with the paper still in the die, with distress ink tea dye, salty ocean and mask stencil Tiny's beach.

Adhere the frames as per example given and stamp the text.

Stamp and die cut the standing seagull and the rope with distress ink.

Adhere with a tuft of reindeer moss and a bow of rope.

Complete the card with adhesive pearls.

**Materials used for both cards:**

Craftables: CR1510 (Labels), Creatables: LR0716 (Anja's Elegant oval), LR0471 (Seashells), Die cutting and embossing machine



**Extra needed for this card:**

Creatables: LR0703 (Anja's Hydrangea), Text stamps: CS1065, Stamping ink: Memento MD708 (olive grove) and Versa Magic GD-76 (malted mauve), Decoupage sheet: MB0194 (Oval field bouquets), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7060 (Honeymoon), Card: light salmon and white, Glitter card: CA3145 (bronze), Vellum, Glitter gloss: 888N (Nuvo), Adhesive stones: CA3154 (bronze), Wax cord

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm salmon-coloured single-fold card with the fold on the left-hand side.

Score a diagonal fold from the bottom left to top right corner of the front flap and fold one half back.

Cut 14 x 14 cm and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper, cut the smallest one in half diagonally and adhere.

Die cut and emboss the largest oval from salmon-coloured card, the next size from glitter card and the picture with the oval with stitches. Adhere together.

Die cut a white and salmon-coloured label, adhere together partially overlapping and attach the cord. Stamp the text.

Die cut flowers from vellum and apply a touch of malted mauve stamping ink.

Die cut the berries and twigs from white card and work with green ink. Then cut off the berries and adhere to the green twigs.

Complete the card with a touch of glitter gloss on the petals and leaves and adhere stones.



**Extra needed for this card:**

Craftables: CR1535 (Fishing net), Creatables: LR0536 (Seahorse), LR0693 (Anja's circle XS, twig used), Text stamps: CS1007, Stamping ink: Memento MD902 (gray flannel), decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0195 (Oval beach), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9162 (Ocean adventure), Card: blue, white and scraps for the shells/twigs and fishing net, Glitter card: CA3144 (platinum), Coconut hair, Adhesive stones: CA3158 (mint), Wax cord

Cut a white 11.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold card and four 11 x 13 cm squares from design paper.

Die cut and emboss the largest oval 2x from glitter card, the smaller one 2x from blue and use the smallest oval to cut out the picture. Adhere together.

Die cut and stamp the label and attach the cord. Die cut the shells, seahorse and twigs and adhere.

For the back of the card: die cut fishing nets, shells and twigs. Adhere and complete the card with adhesive stones.



### Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1554 (Steering wheel), Die cutting and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1007 (Beach sentiments), Stamping ink  
Inkon3: blackout hybrid detail ink, Distress ink: scattered straw, chipped sapphire, walnut stain, picket fence, Pretty Papers design  
paper-bloc: PK9162 (Ocean adventure), Card: kraft, navy blue, white, light blue, Paper distresser

### General instructions

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. Work all motifs die cut/embossed from dark card with distress ink  
picket fence, the kraft motifs with walnut stain and the light blue ones with chipped sapphire. Work the sailor cap with distress ink  
scattered straw and chipped sapphire, and the lifebuoy with aged mahogany.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0541 (Palm trees), LR0601 (Seashell border), LR0602 (Seashell pins), LR0718 (Hammock), Decoupage sheet: IT611 (Tiny's Lighthouses), Card: green, brown, light brown kraft, red, Metallic card: CA3127 (silver)

Cut a dark blue top-fold card. Die cut the border of shells from kraft and adhere behind the top of a 14.5 x 14.5 cm kraft card. Cut 14 x 14 cm design paper. Adhere the layers to the card and stamp a text.

Die cut the motifs from different colours of card and design paper and work them with distress inks.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1511 (Monocular), CR1537 (Slimline frames), CR1552 (Art texture scales), Creatables: LR0471 (Anja's Shell), LR0660

(Coral set), LR0717 (Surfboard & flippers), Distress ink: aged mahogany, Decoupage sheet: VK9589 (Lighthouses), Card: two shades of green, dark grey, cornflower blue, Shaker window 5 cm Ø: LR0032, Shaker material

Cut a 21 x 10 cm top-fold card from kraft card. Die cut the Slimline frames from cornflower blue and design paper. Die cut the monocular from dark blue card together with the circle die to create an aperture. Cut out the image with a wide margin. Place the shaker window with the convex side on the workface, adhere double-sided tape on the edge and put shaker material into the window. Adhere the picture face down to the window. Then adhere double-sided tape to the circle of the monocular and adhere around the window. Die cut the coral from two shades of green card. Die cut the shells, adhere to white card and cut out neatly. Die cut the binoculars from dark grey and the sailor cap from white card.

Die cut the fishing net from kraft, the surfboard from design paper and kraft and the flippers from dark blue, the nautical rope and lifebuoy from white card.

Stamp the texts onto design paper.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1410 (Tiny's Lighthouse), Creatables: LR0471 (Anja's Shell), LR0660 (Coral set), LR0719 (Classic beach chair), Decoupage sheet: EWK1258 (Seabreeze 1), Card: red, light green

Cut a 15 x 15 cm red top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 14.5 cm white card and 14 x 14 cm design paper.

Die cut the steering wheel from kraft and layer the picture behind.

Die cut the lighthouse from red, the coral from light green, the nautical rope from white and the shells from white and light blue card.

Die cut the beach chair from white card and design paper.

Die cut the sailor cap from white and the binoculars from dark blue. Stamp the text onto a piece of design paper.

Adhere all parts to the card as per example given.

### Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1433 (Eline's Seagull & friends), COL1468 (Sealife by Marleen), COL1497 (Eline's Seaside COL1497), Craftables: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Die cutting and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1007 (Beach), Stamping ink Archival: jet black, Pretty Papers design paper-pads: PB7058 (A4 and double-sided), (Eline's Babies-Little miracles, plain colours pink and turquoise used), PK9163 (Sea sparkle by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original raven black (901), carnation white (903), pearly white (930) and taupe (961), Card: light and dark orange, Acryl stamping block, Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Rhinestones: CA3154 (bronze), CA3157 (light blue), brown, Gel pen: white, Coloured pencil: light blue, Wax cord: light blue



### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1432 (Eline's Seals), COL1496 (Eline's Pelican), Craftables: CR1374 (Box card), CR1535 (Art texture mesh), Decoupage sheet: AK0077 (Eline's Holiday backgrounds), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft brown (323)

Die cut the solid back of the box card from pearly white card and the front with aperture from kraft.

Die cut the narrow strip to glue inside the box card 2x from pearly white card and lay aside.

Cut 14.5 x 13 cm design paper with sand motif. Cutting the decorative top: draw along the top of the stencil and cut off a little smaller. Adhere the design paper to the inside on the solid part of the back of the card. Cut the background image into 14.5 x 9.2 cm and adhere too. Die cut the boat and lighthouse, assemble and adhere to the background.

Cut/tear 15 x approx. 3.5 cm pearly white card and adhere to one of the white strips. Die cut three beach houses, assemble and adhere to the strip too. Then adhere the strip to each side inside the box card near the background at approx. 3 cm up from the bottom. Cut/tear 15 x ca. 2.5 cm design paper with sand motif and adhere to the other white strip. Die cut the seal, assemble and adhere to the strip. Then adhere the strip to each side inside the box card, in front of the other one, at approx. 2 cm up from the bottom. Now adhere the two parts of the card together. Cut/tear 15 x approx. 2.5 cm sand-coloured design paper (the back cover of the Paper Pad can be used) and adhere. Die cut the mooring pool and seagull, assemble and adhere as per example given. Die cut the pelican and assemble on a piece of white card. Then cut out neatly around the pelican and adhere to the frame of the box card.

Colour the cheeks of all the animals a little pink and place a white dot in their eyes.

Die cut the fishing net from pearly white.

Decorate the front of the card with die-cut banners with text, an anchor, star fish and shells.

Complete the card with rhinestones.



### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1430 (Eline's Whale), COL1431 (Eline's Tropical fish), Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline frames), Craft stencil: PS8093 (Paper boat),

Decoupage sheet: AK0067 (Eline's Backgrounds - Ocean)

Cut a 21 x 10 cm top-fold card from kraft.

Die cut the largest Slimline frame from pearly white card and use the smaller one to die cut the image from the decoupage sheet. Adhere to the card.

Draw the outline of the boat stencil onto pearly white card. Use the inner lines of the stencil for decorations. Draw them onto the back of design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing in mirror image.

Adhere the cut-outs to the boat and position the boat on the card.

Die cut the whale, crab and fish, assemble and adhere.

Colour the cheeks of the whale and fish a little pink and place a white dot in the eyes of all the animals.

Die cut the anchor, star fish and shells. Die cut the banner and a 4.5 x 1.3 cm strip of design paper, stamp the texts and adhere.

Tie wax cord and the anchor through the hole of the banner.

Complete the card with rhinestones.



**Extra needed for this card:**  
Collectables: COL1496 (Eline's Pelican), Craftables: CR1507 (Card stand-Extra), Creatables: LR0719 (Beach chair), Craft stencil: PS8092 (Message in a bottle by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft brown (323)

Draw the outline of the bottle onto pearly white card.

Use the inner lines of the stencil for decorations. Draw them onto the back of design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing in mirror image.

Use the stencil to draw dunes onto design paper and carnation white card and water onto plain turquoise design paper. Cut out/tear and adhere.

Die cut the lighthouse, beach house, mooring pole, pelican and seagull. Adhere together and to the card.

Colour the cheeks of the pelican and seagull a little pink and place a white dot in their eyes.

Die cut the anchor and tie it around the bottle with light blue wax cord.

Die cut star fish and shells and a banner, stamp a text and adhere.

Complete the card with rhinestones.

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### Materials used for the photo album and card:

Collectables: COL1388 (Photo frames), COL1498 (Insta camera), Craftables: CR1364 (Punch die-Fish), CR1552 (Art texture-Scales), CR1553 (Punch die-Boats), Creatables: LR0541 (Palm Trees), LR0717 (Surfboard & flippers), Die cutting and embossing machine, Mask stencils: PS8094 (School of Fish), PS8095 (Tiny's Beach), Stamping paper: white, Distress oxide ink: black soot, chipped sapphire, festive berries, ground espresso, rustic wilderness, scattered straw, tumbled glass, twisted citron, worn lipstick, Papicolor card: Original black (901) and pearly white (930), Recycled kraft grey (322), Craft sheet, Gauze bandage, Heat gun, Material to apply ink: daubers, sponges etc.

### General instructions:

Apply the distress ink onto the stamping paper with rotating movements, then spray with water. Set aside to dry.

Use the stencils of the fish to create sand ridges onto the paper.

Die cut all loose parts from stamping paper and colour in with different colours of distress oxide inks.

### Techniques for the photo frames:

Colour the photo frames with distress oxide ink scattered straw. Spray with water and set aside to dry.

1. Colour part of the fishing net die with distress oxide ink ground espresso and spray with water. Set aside to dry. Then lay the photo frame on top and press it down, the die will make an imprint on the paper.

2. Create sand ridges onto the photo frame with distress oxide ink ground espresso.

Colour the edges with distress oxide ink scattered straw.



### Extra needed for this photo booklet:

Shaker window: LR0032 (Small circle), Shaker material: fish, boats, rocailles, Photos



Die cut the largest die of the cameras 3x from stamping paper. Colour the front of two cameras and the back of one camera with distress oxide ink tumbled glass and scattered straw. Create sand ridges with ground espresso. Trace the outline of the largest die 3x in pencil onto kraft card and cut out. Trace the die 2x onto pearly white card as well and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border. Cut from kraft a 2 x 6 cm strip and score a fold at 1 cm. Fold over and assemble the booklet. Cut the fold in line with the shape of the booklet. Die cut the camera 2x from stamping paper. Colour one camera with distress oxide ink worn lipstick, festive berries and chipped sapphire. Cut several parts out of the other camera and colour in. Die cut and emboss smaller parts from black card. Leave the flashlight white, but wipe distress ink black soot along the edge. Build up the camera in 3D.

Adhere a shaker window in the centre, place shaker material into it and cover with a photo, face down.

Complete the booklet with boats, the camera, flippers, photos, gauze bandage, palm trees, surf boards and fishing nets.



### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0718 (Hammock)

Cut 13 x 13 cm stamping paper and colour in with distress oxide ink tumbled glass and scattered straw.

Create sand ridges with distress oxide ink ground espresso.

Adhere to 13.5 x 13.5 cm kraft and then to a 14.5 x 14.5

cm pearly white single-fold card. Die cut a large photo from

stamping paper, work with technique 1. Die cut palm trees, a hammock and a boat. Colour them in with distress oxide inks. Colour 7 x 7 cm stamping paper with distress oxide ink tumbled glass and scattered straw.

Die cut the camera 2x from stamping paper and colour one of them with distress ink worn lipstick. Cut several parts out of the other camera and colour them in.

Die cut and emboss smaller parts from black card.

Keep the flashlight white but wipe distress oxide ink black soot along the edges. Build up the camera in 3D.

Complete the card with flippers, gauze bandage and a fishing net.
