General

Ink around all edges with distress ink, except the ones of the motorbike and the Tower of Pisa.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card and a 14 x 14 cm light blue card. Cut design paper with small checks into 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Fix two eyelets in the top right corner, 3 cm apart. Cut light blue card into 13.5 x 7 cm and 13.5 x 6 cm, striped design paper into 13.5 x 6.5 cm and design paper with big checks into 13.5 x 5.5 cm. Firstly adhere them to the plain coloured strips and then onto the design paper with small checks. Cut 7×8 cm jeans paper. Die cut the largest shield from kraft card. Die cut the man's heads from light blue and jeans paper.

From the jeans paper only the hat is used. Fix two small brads through the shield; attach the man's head with thin foam tape. Attach the hat with thin foam tape too. Die cut the motorbike and the Tower of Pisa from gold-coloured card. Die cut the large postage stamp from kraft card and the small one from light blue card. Stick a small Italian label to the postcard and stamp texts onto both die cut stamps. Tuck the Tower of Pisa under the postcard and adhere the elements, including the motorbike, to the card using foam tape. Tie a length of rope through the eyelets. Assemble the layers together onto the light blue square and then onto the single-fold kraft card.



General

Ink around all edges with distress ink, except the ones of the motorbike, the Big Ben and the Eiffel Tower.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold dark blue card and a 14 x 14 cm kraft card. Cut design paper with diamonds into 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Die cut four stamps from kraft card. Adhere jeans paper of 7.5 x 12 cm to the largest one and striped paper of 5.3 x 3.6 cm to the one but smallest. Die cut the motor bike, the Eiffel Tower and the Tower of Pisa from silver-coloured card; adhere the last two to the largest die cut stamp using thin foam tape. Die cut the shield from design paper with big checks





General

Ink around all edges with distress ink, except the ones of the Big Ben.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold beige card and a 14 x 14 cm dark blue square. Cut design paper with small checks into 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Cut a 7 x 10.5 cm strip from the map of London. Die cut the Big Ben from gold-coloured card and layer onto the map using thin foam tape. Die cut the photo camera from kraft card and choose a nice picture of the design paper to stick behind the lens. Tie a length of rope through the eye on the camera. Cut 6.5 x 9.5 cm kraft card and 6 x 9 cm jeans paper. Die cut the man's head out of the jeans paper; layer the paper onto the kraft card and fix

brads in the corners. Die cut the man's head from beige card too and stick it near the other head as shown, to create a shadow effect. Die cut the dark blue card and use adhesive pearls as hubcaps. Die cut the shield from kraft card and stamp the text. Fix two eyelets through the shield, 2.5 cm apart and tie a rope through them. Die cut a beige ticket and stamp the postage stamp. Cut off a strip and a piece of the photo strip. Layer the map onto design paper with small checks slantwise and adhere the other parts with foam tape. Tuck the photo strips and the ticket as shown. Firstly assemble the elements onto the dark blue card and then onto the beige base card. Add two buttons to complete.

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold night blue card and a 13.9 x 13.9 cm white square. Cut design paper of 13.6 x 13.6 cm and 5 x 14.5 cm. Die cut the note paper from design paper and the tabs from wine red and white card. Ink around the edges of the design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the shield from ice blue card and mat on wine red. Stamp the texts onto tabs and shield.

Stamp the postage stamps onto the card.

Sprinkle the text on the wine red tab with white embossing powder and melt with heat tool.

Die cut the motor bike, leave in the die and apply distress ink pumice stone and mahogany.

Die cut the gear. Add a button and tie a charm with scrappersfloss to complete.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold night blue card and a 13.9 x 13.9 cm white square. Cut design paper into 13.6 x 13.6 cm, 12 x 11.5 cm and a strip of 5 x 14.5 cm. Ink around the edges of the design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the tag and one postage stamp from kraft card and one postage stamp from white card. Stamp the texts and the Eiffel Tower with the Paris stamps. Tie a charm to the tag using scrappersfloss. Stamp the airmail text onto ice blue card and cut out. Stamp the round postage stamp onto night blue


card, sprinkle with white embossing powder, melt with heat tool and cut out.

Die cut the Eiffel Tower from white card and apply distress ink vintage photo. Die cut the shield from design paper, stamp the text onto it and mat on white card. Die cut the motor bike from ice blue card, leave in the die and apply pumice stone and faded jeans. Fix a brad into the front wheel.



Copy the pattern onto folded Christmas red card; place the left-hand side on the fold. Cut the pattern a bit smaller from white card and again smaller in two parts from different sheets of design paper. Lay the two design papers together and cover the seam with a 1.2 cm wide corn blue strip. Ink around the edges of the design paper using distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the tag from white card and stamp the map onto it. Use scrappersfloss to tie a charm to the tag. Die cut the Big Ben from kraft card and apply

distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the shield from design paper, stamp the text and mat on night blue card. Tuck the film strip behind the shield. Stamp the postage stamp onto the card. Die cut the banner from design paper, stamp the text; sprinkle with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool. Stamp the pocket watch onto corn blue card and cut out. Die cut the motor bike from Christmas red card, leave in the die and apply distress ink pumice stone. Fix a brad into the front wheel.

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold silver grey card and two squares: gravel 13.5 x 13.5 cm and purple 13 x 13 cm. Ink around the edges. Cut a 4 x 13.5 cm strip from gravel card. Wrap a ribbon around the card, securing the ends on the reverse side. Assemble the layers together on the base card. Die cut the church from gravel and silver grey



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold silver grey card and two squares: gravel 13.5 x 13.5 cm and purple 13 x 13 cm. Ink around the edges. Assemble the layers together on the base card. Cut two squares: silver grey 10.5 x 10.5 cm and curl 10 x 10 cm.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold silver grey card and two squares: gravel 13.5 x 13.5 cm and purple 13 x 13 cm. Ink around the edges. Cut a 4 x 13.5 cm strip from gravel card, adhere the ribbon across the card securing the ends on the reverse side. Cut two 10.5 x 10.5 cm: 1x from silver grey and 1x card. Cut the roofs of the church from silver grey card and mount on top of the white ones. Layer purple card/paper behind the windows of the church. Cut a 8.5 Ø circle from curl and silver grey card. Position the church, the circles and the picture on the base card. Make the picture 3D. Add a bow, leaves and flowers to complete.

Layer together and then in the centre of the card. Cut out the picture and make it 3D. Add a bow, a pigeon, leaves and flowers to finish.

General

Die cut the pinecones but leave them in the die and apply distress ink vintage photo or snow tex. Apply snow tex to the edges of all die cut shapes. Apply distress ink vintage photo to the deer. Stamp the postage stamps using Stazon ink black cherry. Tie bells to a length of rope.



Die cut the Go Kreate die from silver grey card and design paper, the size will be 14.25 x 14.25 cm. Cut an 11 x 11 cm square from design paper and mat on silver grey card. Cut a 12 x 7.25 cm rectangle from corrugated card and work with gesso. Cut out the picture and mat on silver grey card. Die cut four twigs (LRo286).

Use COL1330 to die cut:

1. two trees from olive grey card.

- 2. two deer from kraft card and a lantern post from mouse grey card.
- 3. two snowflakes from snow paper.
 Assemble on the card and adhere with 3D-glue.
 Create a nice bow of ribbon. Stamp the text with
 Stazon timber brown onto kraft card and cut into
 a banner. Stamp the postage stamps.




Die cut CR1223 5x from kraft card and 1x from design paper. Cut a 5.25 x 9.25 cm rectangle from all the layers for the window. Adhere together. Cut for the window from chipboard: for the sides two strips of 2 x 9.25 cm; for top and bottom two strips of 2 x 5.5 cm and for the back a 5.7 x 9.5 cm rectangle. Assemble the pieces in the shape of a box and adhere with strong glue. Attach behind the window. Layer design paper onto reverse side of frame. Cut out the picture and stick in frame. Layer strips of snow paper on the inside edges of the frame.

Use COL1330 to die cut:

- 1. six trees from moss green card.
- 2. two lantern posts from mouse grey card.
- 3. two deer from kraft card, two twigs from olive green and two pinecones (LRo286) from dark brown card.
- 4. two snowflakes from snow paper. Trim two of the trees and the lantern posts; place them in the window in front of the picture.

Assemble all elements together and adhere to the frame using 3D-glue. Create a bow of ribbon. Stamp the text onto kraft card and cut into a banner. Decorate the frame as shown. Cut the stand from chip board (see pattern). Decorate with design paper and attach to the reverse side of the frame.





Use the Nestabilities to die cut two rectangles from kraft card and design paper, the size will be 23.75 x 15 cm; fold in half. Cut 9 x 11.75 cm from design paper and mat on silver grey card. Die cut CR1248 (circle stitch) and CR1250 (border stitch) from kraft card. Layer CR1250 behind the rectangle. Attach pompom trim to the righthand side. Die cut a 9 cm Ø circle from design paper. Sprinkle the design paper with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool. Die cut LR0283 (horizon pinetrees) 2x from snow paper and 2x from moss green card. Cut out the moss green trees and mount on top of the white ones. Stick them to the circle overlapping and trim. Die cut COL1308 (birdhouse) from kraft card and snow

paper. Cut off the roof of the white birdhouse. Sprinkle the birdhouse with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool. Stamp the holly twig (EC0132) with olive green ink and apply red glitter glue. Die cut COL1311 (birds) 2x from kraft card. Colour the beak and paws with an orange pen and the eyes with a black one. Die cut three twigs from olive green, one pinecone from kraft card and two pinecones (LR0286) from dark brown card. Die cut two snowflakes (COL1330) from snow paper. Create a bow from ribbon. Assemble all elements together onto the card and adhere with 3D-glue. Stamp the postage stamps.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold blue card. Layer 14.5 x 14.5 cm (Country Home) and 12.5 x 12.5 cm checked paper on top. Cut out one half of a door and stick to the design paper at a slant. Cut a 3.5 x 4.5 cm strip from design paper Country Home. Die cut the apron (CR1246) from jeans design paper. Die cut eyelets from kraft card and thread a rope though. Adhere apron to the card. Die cut the shield and the tools from mirror card. Die cut/ emboss the hafts of the tools from kraft card and apply distress ink. Layer the hafts on top of the ones cut from mirror card. Die cut the shield from white card. Stamp Don onto it. Place the die on kraft card, trace with a gel pen and trim leaving a narrow border. Attach to the card with foam tape. Finish off the card with tools and the cup.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold beige card. Layer 14 x 14 cm jeans design paper onto 14.5 x 14.5 cm thin corrugated card, but first make an incision into

the top right corner of the striped design paper, roll it back and adhere. Adhere 12 x 12 cm jeans design paper. Cut a 6 x 14 cm strip from design paper with wood motif and one with parquet motif (Eline's Dollhouse) and layer to the card. Attach a torn off strip of corrugated card. Apply



Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold beige card. Mount the following papers on top: 14.5 x 14.5 cm kraft card, 14 x 14 cm jeans design paper, 12 x 12 cm tweed paper (PK9101) and 14 x 4.5 cm striped design paper (PK9099). Die cut/emboss the tree, the fence and the tools from kraft card. Apply distress ink or acrylic paint. Die cut the tools from mirror card and mount the hafts of craft card on top. Die acrylic paint to it and tie a rope around the card. Follow the instructions for card 1 regarding the shield, the tools and stamping the image. Assemble the elements together on the card and adhere as shown. Cut two 6 x 10 cm strips of striped design paper, make rolls and adhere. Stamp the texts onto 5.5 x o.9 cm and 5.5 x 1.5 cm pieces of paper and attach to the card. Finish off the card as shown.

cut/emboss the birdhouse and wheelbarrow from medium blue card. Apply distress ink. Cut a white 9 cm Ø circle and stamp Don and the background onto it (DDS3327 and DDS3333). Colour in the image. Layer a 9.3 cm Ø olive green circle behind. Finish off the card as shown.

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold moss green card and a 13 x 13 cm white card. Die cut both squares of CR1254 from design paper. Tie a rope around them. Die cut/emboss the shield, the tools and two man's heads from different colours of card. Stamp the text onto the shield. Apply green ink to the top parts of the shield and the brush. Assemble the elements of the card together as shown. Tie a charm to the rope.



Cut a 14 x 14 cm single-fold moss green card, a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white card and 13 x 13 cm design paper. Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser and curl a corner. Die cut/emboss the tools from different colours of card and stick them on a 6.7 x 10.2 cm piece of design paper. Use

brads to give the impression that they're hanging on hooks. Die cut/emboss a small shield from design paper. Stamp the texts and assemble all layers together on the base card. Add a piece of jute rope to complete.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold olive green card and a 7.5 x 11 cm strip. Cut a 13 x 13 cm white square and a 7 x 10.5 cm strip. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and a 6.5 x 10 cm strip. Die cut/emboss two white shields and mat on olive green. Die cut the man's head 1x from olive green, 1x from white and 1x from design paper. Die cut the hat and jacket from design paper, the shirt and

ribbon around the hat from white card and assemble the parts on the die cut green head. Cut a 1.5 x 10 cm white strip and stamp the texts. Assemble all layers of the card together on the base card. Add two buttons and a charm on a length of rope to complete.
