

# The Collection #110



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## Materials used for both cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp Master: LR0029, Distress Ink: milled lavender, bundled sage, Stamping ink: Versamark transparent, Embossing powder: white (WoW), Pretty Paper design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PB7060 (Eline's Honeymoon), Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Vellum, Velvet card: white, Watercolor paper: white, 3D-foam, Blending tool, Flat-backed adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Glitter glue: platinum (Stickles), Heat gun



**Extra for this card:**  
Creatables: LR0749 (Tekst Veel Liefs), Stamp+die set: TC0890 (Tiny's Flowers Lily), Glitter glue: platinum (WoW)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card from white velvet and adhere 14.5 x 14.5 cm green design paper.  
Create a background on 13 x 13 cm white watercolor card using distress ink bundled sage and a blending tool. Adhere to 13.5 cm x 13.5 cm soft glitter paper.  
Use Versamark ink to stamp a few lilies onto watercolor paper, sprinkle white embossing powder on top and use the heat gun. Colour in the lilies with a blending tool and distress ink.  
Clean the white embossed parts with a clean cloth or tissue paper.  
Die cut the lilies with the stencil.  
Die cut the shadow of the text from vellum and the text 3x from white velvet card and 1x from platinum soft glitter paper.  
Adhere the white texts together, then adhere the vellum shadow and on top the platinum soft glitter text.  
Adhere all parts to the card and use 3D-foam for the lilies.  
Complete the card with adhesive pearls and glitter glue on the stamens of the lilies.



**Extra for this card:**  
Stamp+die sets: TC0892 (Tiny's Flowers Dahlia), KJ1727 (Karin's Ik denk aan jou), Embossing powder: platinum (WoW)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card from white velvet and adhere 14.5 x 14.5 cm green design paper.  
Use Versamark ink to stamp a few dahlias onto 13 x 13 cm watercolor card, sprinkle white embossing powder on top and melt it with a heat gun.  
Colour in the dahlias with a blending tool and distress ink.  
Clean the white embossed parts with a clean cloth or tissue paper.  
Adhere the card to 13.5 x 13.5 cm soft glitter paper and then to the card with 3D-foam.  
Stamp the text with Versamark ink onto vellum, sprinkle platinum embossing powder on top and use the heat gun.  
Die cut the text using the stencil.  
Complete the card with adhesive pearls.

Collectables: COL1505 (Eline's Bees), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper pads: PB7056 (Eline's Summer picnic-A5), PK9174 (Springtime-A4, double-sided), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original: pale pink (923), pearly white (930), pale blue (964), Card: blue, mustard yellow, dark brown, Vellum, Craft tape (double-sided): LR0014, Enamel dots: PL4520 (Snowflakes), Flower Shaping set: LR0020, coloured pencils: pink, Rhinestones: CA3136 (silver), pale orange



**Extra for this card:**

Collectables: COL1504 (Flowers by Marleen, leaves used), Craftables: CR1579 (Art Texture Honeycomb), Creatables: LR0738 (Branch), LR0750 (Tekst Van Harte), Craft stencil: PS8118 (Beehive by Marleen), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Pretty Papers design paper A4-bloc, double-sided: PK9172 (Frozen Winter, plain brown used), Papicolor card Recycled kraft: brown (323)

Draw the outline of the beehive onto pearly white card, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut them out.

Take the one for the back and score a horizontal line at 5 cm down from the top. Adhere this part to the front panel. The beehive/card can now stand upright.

Use the innerlines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of (design)paper.

Don't forget to turn over the stencil to avoid drawing a mirror image.

Start with the opening of the beehive. Draw it onto brown recycled card, cut out and adhere.

Draw the other parts too, cut out and adhere with 3D-tape.

Die cut the twig and leaves. Adhere as per example given.

Cut/tear an 11 x approximately 2 cm plain green strip and adhere along the bottom of the beehive.

Cut/tear an 11 x approximately 1 cm green strip too, but now use the printed side. Adhere with 3D-tape to the plain strip.

Die cut the letters from blue and adhere.

Die cut the different bees, assemble and adhere. Place a white dot in their eyes and colour the cheeks with a pink coloured pencil.

Die cut the different flowers, assemble and adhere.

Complete the beehive with rhinestones and enamel dots.

Craftables: CR1544 (Square Backgrounds by Marleen), CR1579 (Art Texture Honeycomb), Creatables: LR0748 (Daisy), LR0750 (Tekst Van Harte), Decoupage sheet Eline's Backgrounds: AK0089 (Flower garden), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold)

Cut a white 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card and adhere 13 x 13 cm kraft, 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and a 13.5 x 6 cm strip of design paper.

Die cut a gold-coloured honeycomb and adhere.

Die cut the image with the one but smallest of the square backgrounds and adhere.

Die cut the daisy, assemble and adhere.

Die cut the text from pale pink and adhere.

Die cut the bee, assemble and adhere. Place a white dot in its eyes and colour the cheeks with a pink coloured pencil.

Die cut the flowers, assemble and use to decorate the card.

Complete the card with rhinestones and enamel dots.

Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline Frames), Creatables: LR0749 (Tekst Liefs), Decoupage sheet Eline's Backgrounds: AK0089

(Flower Garden), Papicolor card Original: pine green (950)

Cut a 21 x 10 cm pearly white Slimline card.

Die cut the largest Slimline frame from kraft and the smaller one from the decoupage sheet. Adhere together and to the card.

Die cut the text from pale pink and adhere.

Die cut the flower from white and pale yellow. Assemble and adhere with 3D-tape.

Die cut the different bees, assemble and adhere.

Place a white dot in their eyes and colour the cheeks with a pink coloured pencil.

Die cut different flowers, assemble and adhere.

Complete the card with rhinestones and enamel dots.



**Extra for this card:**

Collectables: COL1466 (Eline's Butterflies), Creatables: LR0748 (Daisy), LR0749 (Tekst Liefs), Papicolor card Original: pine green (950)

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 10 cm kraft and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper.

Die cut the daisy 3x. Adhere the first one to the card, cut the stem to size and adhere too. Then adhere the second and third one with 3D-tape. Adhere their stems too.

Die cut the text from blue and adhere.

Die cut the butterflies, assemble and adhere.

Die cut the different bees, assemble and adhere. Place a white dot in their eyes and colour the cheeks with a pink coloured pencil. Give one of the bees a blue flower with an enamel dot. Complete the card with rhinestones.

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**Materials used for both cards:**

Creatables: LR0746 (Anja's Butterfly XL), LR0747 (Anja's Butterfly set), Die cut and embossing machine, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0200 (Pigeons), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PB7060 (Eline's Honeymoon), Card: white

**General instructions butterflies:**

When using two layers for the butterfly, cut off part of the hindwings of the top layer.



**Extra for this card:**

Creatables: LR0752 (Anja's Slimline Border), LR0750 (Tekst Van Harte), LR0732 (Anja's Pyramid, ornament used), Enamel dots: PL4520 (snowflakes), Circle cutter

Cut a 21 x 10 cm white top-fold card. Die cut the wavy border along the front flap and the open border along the back flap. Make sure the stencils are lying straight and the one for the back flap will be facing upwards after die cutting is done. Adhere the stencils with craft tape and run through the machine.

Cut a 21 x 10 cm top-fold card from design paper as well. Die cut and emboss along the front flap only. Fold the design paper around the white card and adhere with a bit of glue near the fold on the front flap only. Use a circle cutter to cut a picture into 7 cm Ø and a similar circle from white card. Adhere together. Die cut and emboss the ornament from plain design paper and adhere to the picture. Die cut the text 1x from white card and 1x from plain design paper, adhere together slightly overlapping. Die cut the butterflies 1x from white card and 1x from plain design paper as well. Adhere together and complete the card with adhesive stones.



**Extra for this card:**

Creatables: LR0751 (Anja's Slimline Top Corner), LR0749 (Tekst Liefs), LR0731 (Anja's Moon), Enamel dots: PL4517 (pink)

Cut a white 21 x 10 cm single-fold card with the fold on the left. Firstly, die cut the checkered pattern into the right-hand inside flap of the card and then die cut the pattern into the front flap. Die cut two 9.5 cm wide strips of design paper and cut the arc at the top using the stencil. Repeat this at the back, now using the stencil with three arcs. Draw and cut the bottoms to size and adhere. Use the stencil to die cut the moon and picture. Adhere together and then onto the card, raised with 3D-glue/foam tape. Die cut the text 1x from white card and 1x from plain design paper, adhere together, slightly overlapping. Die cut the butterflies and adhere. Complete the card with hearts, adhesive pearls and a text. Adhere a large butterfly to the back of the card to finish it off neatly.

**Materials used for both cards:**

Craftables: CR1579 (Art Texture Honeycomb), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft stencil: PS8116 (Tiny's Honeycomb), Mask stencil: PS8117 (Tiny's Morning Dew), Distress Oxide Ink (Ranger): antique linen, spun sugar, tattered rose, Copic Markers (alcohol), Stamp Master Advanced: LR0029, Stamping ink: Watermark, Embossing powder: white, Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Card: salmon, Masking paper, Stamping paper: white, Craft sheet A4: LR0040, Heat tool, Material to apply ink (daubers, sponges, etc.)

**General instructions:**

Use watermark ink and the stamp master to stamp the flowers to stamping paper. Sprinkle white embossing powder on top and heat with a heat tool till the powder melts. Then colour in the flowers with Copic markers.

Stamp the flowers on to masking paper. Cut them out and position on top of the coloured flowers. Apply three colours of distress oxide ink to the craft sheet. Spray with water and press the stamping paper into the ink. Set aside to dry.

Use masks and distress oxide inks to create different shapes. Set aside to dry again. Remove the masking paper from the flowers.

Die cut the shadow of the text from pearly white card. Colour the stamping paper with Copic markers. Die cut the smaller text from this paper. Adhere together and to the card.



**Extra for this card:**

Stamp+dies set: TC0891 (Tiny's Flowers Tea Rose), Creatables: LR0750 (Tekst Van Harte), Die cutting foam sheets: LR0022 (1 mm), Papicolor card: light pink (923)

Cut a 13.5 x 9 cm rectangle from stamping paper. Stamp one rose onto it (see general instructions) and colour it in. Colour the stamping paper too. Die cut the honeycomb from pearly white card. Colour 9.5 x 6 cm stamping paper using distress oxide inks spun sugar and tattered rose. Set aside to dry and die cut another honeycomb. Adhere different pieces of the white honeycomb to the stamping paper. Fill up some of the openings with die-cut parts from coloured stamping paper. Cut the sides of the honeycombs in line with the stamping paper.

Firstly, adhere the card to 14 x 9.5 cm pink card, then to a 14.5 x 10 cm salmon coloured rectangle and finally to a 15.5 x 11 cm pearly white single-fold card.

Stamp a rose onto stamping paper. Colour in and cut out. Adhere the rose to the card with foam tape.

Complete the card with a text.



**Extra for this card:**

Stamp+dies set: TC0893 (Tiny's Flowers Anemone), Text stamp by Karin Joan: KJ1721 (Gefeliciteerd), Pretty Paper design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PB7060 (Eline's Honeymoon)

Cut 17.5 x 8 cm stamping paper. Stamp two anemones (see general instructions). Colour them in and then colour the stamping paper. Colour 9.5 x 6 cm stamping paper with distress oxide ink tattered rose and set aside to dry. Then die cut the honeycomb from this paper. Adhere different pieces of coloured honeycomb to the stamping paper. Fill up some openings with the same-coloured paper. Cut the sides of the honeycombs in line with the stamping paper.

Firstly, adhere the card to 18 x 8.5 cm salmon-coloured card, then to 18.5 x 9 cm plain design paper and finally to a 19.5 x 10 cm pearly white card.

Complete the card with a text.

**Materials used for both cards:**

Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers dessinpapier A5-bloc: PK9167 (French Antiques), Embroidery needle, Craft tape

**General instructions embroidery:**

Adhere the beginning and end of the embroidery thread to the back of the card with a piece of cellotape. Embroider with six strands.



**Extra for his card:**

Craftables: CR1577 (Stitching die Lavender), Creatables: LR0749 (Tekst Liefs), Embroidery thread Stafil: middle turquoise (187), light violet (094), Pretty Papers design paper A5-pad: PK9167 (French Antiques), Watercolor paper, Ribbon

**Tip:**

Creating a singlefold card with two 15 x 21 cm sheets of design paper. Cut off 0.5 cm along the long side of the paper, the sheet will then measure 14.5 x 21 cm. Score at 14.5 cm and fold. Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm from another sheet of design paper and adhere it on or under the folded border. When adhered on top you will see the other print at the back. When adhered underneath, however, and after adhering the white card you will not see it.

Cut 14.5 x 11 cm watercolor paper. Place the border stencil against the edge, tape with craft tape and run through the machine. Then lay the embroidery stencil exactly on the die-cut border, tape it and run through the machine.

Die cut the border also from 14.5 x 8 cm design paper. Embroider the lavender with light purple and the twigs and leaves with blue green. Die cut the word and its shadow from two lilac tints and adhere.

Follow the Tip on how to make a single-fold card from two sheets of design paper. Adhere the embroidery on top at 2 cm from the fold.

Adhere the die-cut lilac strip well visible underneath. Complete the twigs with a bow of ribbon.



**Extra for this card:**

Collectables: COL1455 (Eline's Craft Dates), Craftables: CR1578 (Stitching die Daisies), Embroidery thread Stafil: baby pink (032), rose (062), light green (216), Text stamps: CS1077 (Stikselteksten), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Stamping ink: stone grey, Embroidery needle, Cellophane bag 15 x 15 cm

Cut off a 14.5 cm strip from the long side of an A4-sheet of watercolor paper.

Place the border stencil against the edge, tape it and run through the machine.

Then place the embroidery border exactly against the die-cut edge, tape and run through the machine.

Embroider the flowers with two pink tints and the leaves with light green, matching the design paper.

Score at 6.5 cm in from the die-cut edge and fold over. Cut the card 14,5 x 14.5 cm to fit in the 15 x 15 cm cellophane bag.

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm square from design paper of your choice. Die cut embroidery cards from scraps of watercolor paper and stamp the pattern of an embroidered heart. Wrap embroidery thread around.

Cut off a piece of the packaging of the pearls and adhere with double-sided tape to a die-cut rectangle.

The stamps set includes stamps of embroidery needles, use them to decorate the design paper.

Die cut a small pair of scissors from silver-coloured card and a bigger pair from dark grey.

Adhere the embroidery cards and strip with pearls with double-sided foam tape and put in the bag.

Decorate with scissors and more texts.
