Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0777 (Tiny's Snowy Village), LR0778 (Tiny's Snowy Signpost & Fence), Die cut and embossing machine, Card: kraft, dark brown, dark green, ochre, Velvet card: white, Pearl paper: CA3166, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9172 (Frozen Winter), Snowtex

Tip:

- The plain colour of the back of the design paper matches the printed front perfectly. It's ideal for die cutting.
- Work the trees and green twigs with Snowtex.
- Layer ochre yellow card behind the doors and windows of the houses.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1478 (Poinsettia by Marleen), CR1579 (Basic Circles by Marleen), CR1600 (Let it Snow Circle by Marleen), CR1604 (Slimline Forest Horizons), Creatables: LR0675 (Holly Leaves), LR0767 (Scalloped Squares), LR0769 (Berry Branch), Decoupage

sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0205 (Winter Landscape), Snow paper: CA3104 (qlitter), Nuvo dream drops: cloud

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm top-fold card from kraft and adhere a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square from velvet card. Die cut the large scallop square from green design paper and the text circle from white velvet card. Die cut the picture and green circle with the basic circle stencils and adhere together. Die cut the poinsettia from light green design paper and pearl paper, the berries from light green design paper and pearl paper and the twigs from dark green card. Work the berries with nuvo drops. Die cut and emboss the signpost from kraft and snow paper. Die cut the Slimline forest horizons from dark green card and a few trees and the house from dark green and snow paper. Arrange all parts on the card as shown.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline Frames), CR1584 (Slimline 3 Circles), CR1600 (Let it Snow circle by Marleen), CR1604

(Slimline Forest Horizons), CR1606 (Forest Critters), Distress ink: rusty hinge, Card: dark blue, Fineliner: black

Take a dark blue A4-sheet and cut off 10 cm on the short side. Fold the larger part in half for the Slimline card.

Die cut the largest Slimline stencil from pearl paper and the smallest one from design paper. Die cut forest trees from dark green card and layers of snow from white velvet card. Adhere together, no need to trim to size.

Die cut the card with the Slimline stencil with stitches and then adhere. Die cut the houses from dark blue design paper, the signpost from kraft and the fences from dark brown. Use white velvet card to die cut and emboss all snowy parts.

Die cut the birds from kraft, colour their beaks with distress ink rusty hinge and draw their eyes and legs with a black pen. Die cut the text from light blue design paper.

Arrange all parts on the card.

Creatables: LR0779 (Anja's Poinsettia), LR0780 (Anja's Fancy Frame), LR0550 (Tiny's Larix), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft stencil: PS8131 (Anja's Triangle Card), Stamping ink Memento: MD-805 (toffee crunch), Decoupage sheet: MB0204 (Ice Skating), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9172 (Frozen Winter), Card scraps: dark green, dark red, kraft, Pearl paper: CA3166 (white), Rhinestones: CA3162 (smokey grey)





Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1507 (Text Banners), Text stamps: CS1068 (Winter), Stamping ink: Versa Magic: GD-058 (Hint of Pesto), Memento: MD-901 (London Foq) Draw the triangle card onto pearl paper, score the line and fold. Draw and cut design paper to size and adhere. Die cut the round frame 2x from pearl paper. Cut plain-coloured design paper to size fitting behind the frame. Adhere both frames with the design paper in between. Die cut the picture with the next frame size and adhere. Die cut the larix twig from kraft, work the cones with stamping ink toffee crunch.

Die cut the large leaves and the stamens of the poinsettia 2x from dark green, and the poinsettia 2x from dark red. Shape the leaves with your fingers. Die cut the largest banner from design paper and stamp the text with stamping ink London fog. Fold the banner as per example given. Adhere together and adhere the round frame, poinsettia and larix cones raised with 3D-glue. Die cut a twig from kraft and work the needles with stamping ink Hint of Pesto. Complete the card with rhinestones.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0773 (Fijne Kerst), Scrap of card: yellow Draw the triangle card onto pearl card, score the line and fold. Draw and cut design paper to size and adhere.

Die cut the largest round frame and the next size together, 1x from pearl paper and 1x from design paper. Use the frame to draw around the picture and cut out. Adhere the frames together with the picture in between.

Die cut the large leaves of the poinsettia, 2x from dark green and 2x from dark red; the poinsettia 2x from dark red and the stamens 1x from red and 1x from yellow. Shape the leaves with your fingers. Arrange them nicely and adhere.

Die cut the twig 1x from kraft and 1x from dark green card. Cut off the needles of the dark green one and adhere to the twig of kraft. Die cut the text from pearl paper and kraft and adhere slightly overlapping. Die cut and emboss the larix twigs from kraft and work the larix cones with stamping ink toffee crunch, adhere the longest twig to the reverse side of the card. Adhere the frame, poinsettia and text raised with 3D-glue. Complete the card with rhinestones.

Materials:

Craftables: CR1606 (Forest Critters), Creatables: LR0772 (Forest XL), LR0773 (Fijne Kerst), Die cut and embossing machine, Mask stencil: PS8012 (Snowflakes), Distress ink (Ranger): black soot, chipped sapphire, crackling campfire, faded jeans, forest moss, gathered twigs, mermaid lagoon, mowed lawn, mustard seed, rustic wilderness, rusty hinge, stormy sky, vintage photo, Card: white, kraft, Stamping paper: white, Gesso: white, Texture paste: Dutch Doobadoo 870.000.001

Cut 9 x 19.5 cm stamping paper. Use the mask stencil and texture paste to apply snow. Let it dry. Colour the stamping paper with blue shades of distress ink.

Die cut and emboss the trees from kraft. Colour them with distress ink gathered twigs. Then work them with white gesso. Tear white card to create a snowy landscape. Adhere the snow and trees to the coloured stamping paper and then adhere to a 9.5 \times 20 cm kraft card. Work the edges with distress ink gathered twigs and white gesso. Then adhere the layers to a 10.5 \times 21 cm pearly white single-fold card.

Die cut the animals and twig from stamping paper and colour them in with distress ink:

Green twig: forest moss, mowed lawn, rustic wilderness Squirrel: black soot, rusty hinge, vintage photo, Rabbit: black soot, gathered twigs, vintage photo

Blackbird: black soot, gathered twigs

Blue tit: black soot, mermaid lagoon, mustard seed Robin: black soot, crackling campfire, mustard seed

Turtledove: black soot, gathered twigs

Owl: black soot

Die cut the large text from kraft. Work the edges with distress ink gathered twigs and white gesso. Die cut the small text from white card. Adhere together. Complete the card by adhering the text and animals with 3D-qlue.

Craftables: CR1483 (Trees by Marleen), CR1601 (Bears by Marleen), CR1602 (Pine Trees by Marleen), Die cut and embossing machine, Florence card: 096 (black), 099 (kraft), Velvet card: white, Kraft: light brown, Pearl paper: CA3166 (white), Gel pen: white, Colouring pencil: pink

General instructions:

- Die cut different trees and place them in the landscape.
- Die cut the bears and assemble. Colour their cheeks with a pink colouring pencil and place a dot in the eyes and on the noses with a white gel pen.
- Complete the card with rhinestones.

Creatables: LR0493 (Horizon Snowy Mountains), Florence card: 047 (water), Paper sets: PB7063 (Hoera een jongetje), PB7064 (Hoera een meisje), Rhinestones: CA3154 (bronze), CA3163 (ice blue), Card: light grey Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm white top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 10 cm blue card and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper with stars.

Die cut the mountain and the snow. Adhere together and to the

Tear/cut a 3 x 15 cm strip of design paper and adhere.

Place the bears in the landscape.

Choose a text and adhere to plain paper, trim leaving a narrow border and adhere.

card: 030 (poppy), 093 (hazelnut), 101 (off-white), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PB7059 (Eline's Autumn Whispers), Rhinestones: CA3154 (bronze), CA3159 (red)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white top-fold card. Adhere 14.5 x 14.5 cm plain dark brown paper, 14 x 14 cm light grey design paper and 11 x 11 cm brown design paper. Draw the mountain of the craft stencil onto kraft and the snow onto pearl paper, cut out and adhere together.

Tear/cut a 4.5 x 15 cm strip of light plain red paper and one of 3 x 15 cm from design paper with leaves.

Adhere the light red strip, then the mountain and on top the strip of design paper with leaves.

Place the bears in the scenery.

Die cut a set of mushrooms, assemble and adhere. Die cut leaves and adhere. Die cut a banner from plain light orange paper, stamp a text and adhere.

Craftables: CR1600 (Let it Snow), CR1605 (Text Labels), Craft stencils: PS8045 (Mountains by Marleen), PS8074 (Bell Jar by Marleen), Text stamps: CS1105 (Kerst), Stamping ink Archival: jet black, Metallic paper-A4: CA3172 (silver), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, doublesided: PK9172 (Frozen Winter), Rhinestones: CA3136 (silver), CA3163 (ice blue), Hole punching pliers, Hemp cord: naturel

Draw the outlines of the bell jar onto white velvet card 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut out.

Take the mirrored jar (back panel of the card), score a horizontal line at 5 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this strip to the front panel. The card can now stand up straight. Should it be a bit wobbly, cut a straight line at the bottom of the back panel. Use the inner lines of the stencil for decoration purposes. Draw them onto the back of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over, to avoid drawing in mirror image. Cut all parts

Draw the mountain onto kraft and the snow onto pearl paper, cut out and adhere together.

Start with adhering the sky to the bell jar, then the mountain and the hills.

Die cut the words from white card and adhere as shown.

Place the bears in the landscape.

Die cut a set of mushrooms, assemble and adhere.

Add white die-cut snowflakes.

Die cut a banner from plain green paper, stamp a text, punch a hole and tie with hemp cord.

Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1516 (Eline's Hedgehog), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PB7059 (Eline's Autumn Whispers), Card: brown, grey, light brown, light grey, orange, red, white, black, kraft and greyish kraft, Stamping ink Versafine: onyx black

Tip: For many plain colours the back of the double-sided design paper has been used. These colours match perfectly with the printed front.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1474 (Eline's Fox, scarf used), Craftables: CR1574 (Chain of Snowflakes), CR1604 (Slimline Forest Horizons), Art stamps-texts: MM1631 (Hallo Herfst), Enamel dots: PL4520 (snowflakes)

Cut an 11 x 13.5 cm white top-fold card.

Cut a 5 x 6.5 cm strip from plain design paper and a 7 x 9 cm and a 4 x 11 cm one from printed design paper.

Die cut the shapes needed from different papers.

Stamp a black text onto the card.

Complete the card as per example given.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1551 (Big Tag), Creatables: LR0763 (Small Circle Arches), LR0772 (Forest XL), LR0775 (Autumn Leaves), Text stamps: CS1104 (Herfst), Decoupage sheet: AK7080 (Eline's Animals Autumn), Die cut the largest label from white card and the large rectangle from orange design paper. Cut a 3×4 cm strip and a 4×10 cm one from design paper and adhere.

Cut the picture into 8×9 cm and adhere to 8.5×9.5 cm white card and then to 9×10 cm kraft.

Die cut the shapes needed from different colours of paper.

Die cut trees and trim to fit the label.

Stamp a text to the white circle.

Tie a piece of jute and the small label with rope to the large label.

Complete the card.

Jute

Cut a 15 x 15 cm top-fold card from greyish kraft. Adhere 14 x 14 cm red design paper to 14.5 x 14.5 cm white card. Cut a 1.5 x 15 cm strip from plain design paper and a 3 x 15 cm one from printed design paper, adhere to the bottom of the card. Then cut a 3.5 x 6.5 cm strip from plain design paper and a 3.5 x 7.5 cm one from printed design paper and adhere to the card. Cut the image into 9.3×14.3 cm, adhere to 9.8×14.8 cm white card and then to 10.3×15.3 cm greyish kraft. Die cut the shapes needed from different colours of paper. Die cut a small white rectangle, stamp the text and adhere to slightly larger greyish kraft. Complete the card as per example given.

Materials used for both cards:

Collectables: COL1507 (Text Banners), Craftables CR1594 (Punch die Alphabet), Stamps+dies sets: TC0885 (Tiny's Fall Leaves), TC0866 (Tiny's Mushrooms), Die cut and embossing machine, Mask stencil: PS8117 (Tiny's Morning Dew), Stamping ink: Archival jet black, Distress ink: candid apple, forest moss, gathered twigs, hickory smoke, peeled paint, rusty hinge, tattered, rose, tea dye, uncharted mariner, vintage photo en wild honey, Watercolour paper, Craft tape: LR0010 (non-permanent), Foam tape/-blocks



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline Frames), Stamps & dies sets: CS1106 (Gnome & Lantern), CS1108 (Sitting Gnome), Card: kraft and red brown Die cut the smaller Slimline stencil from watercolour paper and stamp the mushrooms on the left-hand side. Stamp a mask too, cut out and stick to the image. Cover the stitched border all around with non-permanent craft tape and work the card with distress ink. Place the mask stencil on top and work with distress ink. Splash a few droplets of water. Remove the masks and colour in the mushrooms with distress ink. Stamp two gnomes, three mushrooms, a hedgehog, several leaves and acorns onto watercolour paper and colour them in with distress ink. Work a scrap of watercolour paper with distress ink and die cut the letters. Adhere to a small white banner. Arrange all parts on the card. Die cut the larger Slimline stencil from kraft and cut a 9.7 x 21 cm single-fold red-brown card. Adhere together.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1538 (Slimline Banners), Stamps+dies sets: CS1106 (Gnome & Lantern), CS1107 (Gnome & Cane), CS1108 (Sitting Gnome), Card: green and kraft, Rope Cut the smaller Slimline banner rectangle from watercolour paper and stamp the border with leaves 2x next to one another. Stamp two masks too, cut out and stick to the images temporarily.

Cover the scallops all around with non-permanent craft tape and work the banner with distress ink.

Place the mask stencil on top and work it with distress ink and splash a few droplets of water onto it.

Remove the masks, colour in the leaves with the same colours as used for the background.

Stamp the gnomes, mushrooms and various leaves onto watercolour paper, die cut and colour in.

Arrange on the card and adhere.

Die cut a small white banner.

Work a scrap of watercolour paper with distress ink and die cut the letters.

Adhere the banner and a double bow of rope to the card. Die cut the larger Slimline stencil from green card and cut a 9.7 x 21 cm single-fold kraft card. Adhere together.
