Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1617 (Mini Slimline 2 Squares), CR1623 (Slimline Tulip/Flower), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps+dies set: EC0200 (Eline's Little Critters), Text stamps: CS1128 (Lentegroetjes), Stamping ink Memento: tuxedo black, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9183 (Sweet Flowers), Stamping paper, Alcohol markers, Foam tape pads (1 mm thick), Gel pen: white

General instructions:

For all cards the front and back of the Pretty Papers design paper was used.



Extra needed for this card:

Distress oxide ink: mowed lawn, kitsch flamingo, broken china, Enamel dots: PL4516 (Floral Hearts), Foam tape (3 mm thick), Mica: CA3187, Shaker material, Strong glue, like Tacky Glue Cut a 14.5 x 7.2 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the flowers, leaves and mini-Slimline parts from coloured paper.

Cut two 5.5×2 cm strips from floral paper. Work the blue background, flowers and leaves with distress oxide ink in matching colours.

Stamp the text on to the background, use the light orange window to position the stamp.

Adhere the floral strips to the back of the windows. Use strong glue to fix 12.5×5.5 cm of mica to the back of the light orange window and flower strips.

Choose shaker materials, e.g. sequins, and place on the blue background.

Use foam tape to adhere the window with mica carefully to the background. Make sure there are no gaps between the pieces of foam tape, to prevent shaker materials falling out.

Stamp and colour the snails and cut out.

Complete the card.

Craftables: CR1583 (Slimline Grass-Horizon-Clouds), Creatables: LR0748 (Daisy), Distress oxide ink: mowed lawn, kitsch flamingo, broken china, dried marigold Cut a 4.5 x 7.2 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the tulips, stems, grass and mini-Slimline parts from coloured paper.

Cut off the grass, 5.8 cm wide.

Work the blue background, flowers, stems and grass with distress oxide ink in matching colours.

Cut a green-white floral strip of approximately 1.7 cm high.

Stamp and colour the bees and cut out.

Stamp the text and complete the card.

General instructions:

Colour the cheeks of the insects with a pink-coloured pencil and place a white dot in their eyes with a gel pen.

Extra needed for this kaart: Craftables: CR1519 (Mailbox by Marleen), CR1542 (Potted Plants by Marleen), Text stamps: EC0188 (Eline's Animals), Stamping ink Memento: MD404 (angel pink), Florence card: 002 (raffia), Soft glitter paper: CA3143 (gold), Mini ink Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card from white velvet card. Adhere 12 x 12 cm design paper and 11.2 x 11.2 cm plain blue. Cut/tear a 13.5 x approx. 2.5 cm green strip and adhere along the bottom. Die cut the pilar box from plain pink paper, work with ink and the mini ink blending tool and then adhere with 3D-tape to plain light pink paper. Trim along the edges. Die cut a green plant and three snails and envelopes from different colours. Die cut different flowers. Put them all together and to the card. Die cut a banner from light pink, stamp a text and adhere with

hotel 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut them out. Take the one in mirror image (back flap of card) and score a horizontal line at 8 cm down from the top and fold over. Adhere this glue strip to the back of the front flap. The card can stand upright now. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them on the back of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over, to avoid drawing a mirror image. Cut out and adhere. Tip: hole punches can be used to cut out small circles. Die cut the insects and put together. Die cut different flowers and leaves. Die cut a banner and stamp a text.

Cut a 21 x 10 single-fold Slimline card from white velvet card. Die cut the largest size Slimline frame from blue paper and the smaller one from blue design paper. Adhere to the card. Die cut the same die from plain green paper and adhere along the bottom. Die cut the flowerpots from kraft and adhere. Die cut the windows from white card and adhere mica to the back. Die cut curtains from design paper, adhere to blue paper and position the windows on top. Trim along the edges and position the windows on the pots. Die cut the door from different colours, adhere together and to the largest pot. Die cut twigs, leaves, flowers, chimney and lantern to decorate the flowerpot house.

Die cut two snails and two ladybugs from different colours, put together and adhere.

Die cut a light pink banner, stamp a text and adhere. Complete the card with pearls and rhinestones.

VersaMark transparent, Embossing powder: Stampendous white EP100, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9183 (Sweet Flowers), Florence card: 043 (air), 093 (hazelnut), 094 (bear), 099 (kraft light), 101 (off-white), Velvet card: white, Metallic paper: CA3174 (light pink), Enamel dots: PL4517 (two pink), Heat tool, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Rhinestones: CA3156 (light pink)

Cut a 13×13 cm light blue card, 12.5×12.5 cm design paper and a 13.5×4.5 cm strip of design paper too, adhere to the card. Die cut the largest basic circle from orange and adhere with 3D-tape.

Die cut the text circle from white and adhere to the orange one with 3D-tape.

Die cut the smaller circle from green and adhere to the white one. Die cut the box from design paper and the box with the separate ribbon from metallic paper. Cut off the ribbons and adhere as per example given, using 3D-tape. Then adhere to the green circle. Die cut the bonbons, put together and adhere.

Complete the card with enamel dots, pearls and rhinestones.

Collectables: COL1504 (Flowers by Marleen, leaves used), Creatables: LR0697 (Flowers), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps: CS1129 (Koekjes en Snoepjes), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9183 (Sweet Flowers), Card: dark brown, Velvet card: white



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1551 (Big Tag), Creatables: LR0803 (Teapot & Glass, mug used), LR0804 (Cookie Jar), Distress ink: walnut stain, Stamping ink: Inkon3 blackout hybrid detail

ink, Kraft card: light and dark, Rhinestones: CA3154 (bronze), Wax cord

Use a white velvet top-fold card. Place the top of the largest tag just above the fold and die cut the tag. Die cut the rectangle from design paper and adhere to 9.5 x 12.5 cm plain design paper. Die cut the cookie jar from floral design paper and the lid from a plain colour. Stamp the text.

Die cut the cookies from dark-coloured kraft and the round wafers from light-coloured kraft. Work with distress ink walnut stain. Die cut the mug from design paper, place a dark brown scrap as 'coffee' inside. Position the cookies as shown.

Die cut the flower and leaves from plain design paper and complete the flower with a rhinestone.

Die cut a reinforcement strip and tie cord through the hole.

ink, Card: apple green, light-coloured kraft, brown in different shades, Metallic paper: CA3172 (silver), Mica A4: CA3187, Rhinestones: CA3156 (light pink), Wax cord

Cut a 19.5 x 14.5 cm apple green strip and score at 2.5 and 5 cm. Adhere 13.7 x 13.7 cm white velvet card and 13.2 x 13.2 cm design paper. Cut 6.5×14.5 cm apple green paper, 5.7×13.7 cm velvet card and 5.3×13.2 cm design paper. Adhere together and to the first small flap of the card.

Die cut the bar of chocolate from dark brown card, silver metallic and design paper. Stamp the text on to the wrapping and adhere together. Die cut the tea pot from design paper. Die cut the tea glass from mica and light-coloured kraft card, the tea label from design paper and let it hang from the pot with wax cord. Die cut the chocolates from different shades of brown card, white velvet card and plain design paper. Adhere together. Die cut the flowers and leaves from plain design paper and add a rhinestone to the hearts of the flowers.

Complete the card with a text label.

Materials:

Collectables: COL1528 (Chocolates by Marleen), Craft stencil: PS8142 (Bonbon Box), Creatables: LR0763 (Small Circle Arches), LR0764 (Small Circle Lace), Die cut and

embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1129 (Koekjes en snoepjes), Stamping ink Archival: black, Stamp master: LR0029, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9183 (Sweet Flowers), Card: different brown colours, white, Ribbons: JU0950 and JU0951

Cut two pink cards: 11.3×15.6 cm and 11.3×16.6 cm. Score a 1 cm fold on the largest card and adhere this glue strip to the back of the other card.

Die cut the base of the layout from white velvet card and the layout/framework 6x from white velvet card and 1x from pink design paper. Adhere the six white layouts together and onto the white base. Die cut the squares and rectangles from design paper. Die cut the chocolates from different shades of brown card, design paper, white velvet card, pink glitter paper and snow paper. Adhere together. Adhere the chocolates raised with foam tape.

Cut 9.6 x 3.8 cm mica and adhere on to the six white layouts. Then adhere the pink layout on top.

Die cut the flowers and leaves from plain design paper, complete the flowers with a rhinestone.

Die cut a label, stamp a text with transparent ink and work with embossing powder and a heat tool.

Complete the card with die-cut hearts.

Place the craft stencil on the back of design paper and draw the outline in pencil.

Cut out, score the four lines and fold the box together.

For example, a tea bag and a bonbon fit in it.

Die cut the labels from the plain back of the design paper. Stamp texts onto white paper, cut out and adhere to the labels.

Decorate some of the labels with a paper bonbon and tie to the box with a ribbon.

Craftables: CR1623 (Slimline Tulip/Flower), Creatables: LR0801 (Tulips), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1128 (Lentegroetjes), Stamping ink: black, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9183 (Sweet Flowers), Card: green, white



Extra needed for this card:

Decoupage sheet Mattie's Minis: MB0209 (Bouquets), Distress ink: tumbled glass, Card: kraft, Rope Take the die with holes and die cut from two different design papers. Cut one of them down to 19.5×5 cm. Cut a 10.1×1 cm strip of design paper. Adhere the layers together and then to kraft card. Trim leaving a 2.5 mm border.

Adhere to a 21 x 9.8 cm white single-fold card.

Cut out two pictures. Adhere to kraft card and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border.

Stamp the text with black ink on to a white scrap. Cut out, adhere to design paper and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border.

Work the edges with distress ink tumbled glass.

Die cut the leaves and stems from green card and the flowers from white card. Complete the bunch of tulips with a bow.



Extra needed for this card:
Decoupage sheet Hetty's Minis:
HK1711 (Snoesjes Zomer),
Distress ink: peeled paint,
tattered rose, Rocailles

Die cut both rectangular dies from design paper. Die cut the largest flower 2x from the smallest rectangle. Adhere together. Die cut the smaller flower 2x and adhere the pictures behind. Then adhere the layers to a 9.8 x 21 cm white single-fold card. Stamp the text in black, adhere to green card and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border.

Die cut the smallest flower 8x from white card. Crumple the flowers and use them to make four flowers. Add rocailles to the hearts. Die cut the smallest flowers 4x from green card as well. Work with distress ink peeled paint. Then adhere the flowers.

Die cut the separate flowers and the leaves and stems of the tulips from green card, colour the edges with distress ink peeled paint. Die cut tulips from design paper and add a touch of distress ink tattered rose. Complete the card.

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Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0694 (Vases), LR0801 (Tulips), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1053 (Tegeltjeswijsheden), Distress ink: ground espresso, mowed grass, rusty hinge, Stamping ink: blue, Card: green, kraft, white



Extra needed for this card: Lace ribbon

Cut an 8.5×8 cm card from design paper and an 8.5×2.5 cm strip. Adhere to 8.5×13 cm design paper. Position the lace and adhere to a 9×13.5 cm kraft card. Work the edges with distress ink rusty hinge and ground espresso. Then adhere to a 10.5×15 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the two vases from design paper.

Die cut the smallest vase from white card and colour the embossed parts with blue stamping ink.

Die cut the tulip stems and leaves from green card. Colour with distress ink mowed grass.

Die cut the flowers from white card and pink and red design paper. Stamp the text in blue onto white card. Cut out and adhere to kraft card. Trim on three sides leaving a 2.5 mm white border. Adhere to the card.

Creatables: LR0494 (Horizon Amsterdam), LR0804 (Cookie Jar), Die cutting foam sheets: LR0022 (1 mm), Distress ink: gathered twigs, lumberjack plaid, vintage photo, Mica A4: CA3184

Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper card and a 12.5 x 3 cm design paper strip. Adhere to 13 x 13 cm design paper and then to a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the biscuit tin from white card. Cut out a window and adhere mica behind. Die cut the canal side houses from design paper and adhere to the tin. Cut off the sides neatly. Die cut the lid from different design papers and adhere.

Die cut/emboss the biscuits from kraft card. Colour the embossed parts of the spiced biscuits with distress ink gathered twigs. Die cut the treacle waffles 2x. Colour them with distress ink rusty hinge and vintage photo and the edges with ground espresso. Adhere together with 1 mm thick foam tape.

Die cut the vase from design paper. Die cut the tulip stems and leaves from green card. Colour them with distress ink mowed grass. Die cut the flowers from design paper. Add a touch of distress ink tattered rose and lumberjack plaid.

Die cut the tile from white card and colour the embossed parts with blue ink. Stamp the text in blue. Die cut the square from design paper and adhere the tile.
