CRAFTABLES

Country garden

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Cut a 14.8 x 14.8 cm pink single-fold card and three squares: silver grey 14 x 14 cm, design paper with pink stripe 13.5 x 13.5 cm and green design paper 10 x 10 cm. Ink all part with distressinkt walnut stain. Layer the parts together with the tabs in between. Die cut/emboss the Craftable from

pearly white card and layer the picture behind the passe-partout. Adhere all parts to the card. Die cut the birdhouse from corrugated card and layer dark brown card behind the aperture. Adhere to the card with the bird and grass. Finish off the card.



Cut a 14.8 x 14.8 cm pink single-fold card and two squares: silver grey 14 x 14 cm and design paper with pink stripe 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Cut a 15.5 x 6.5 cm card from green design paper, cut off the top corners slantwise. Ink all parts with walnut stain and adhere together. Die cut/emboss the oval from

pearly white card and layer the picture behind. Die cut/emboss the box tree, watering can, wheelbarrow, birds and bench. Where more colours are visible cut out twice, cut off the parts needed and adhere together. Finish off the card.



Cut a 24.8 x 14.8 cm pink strip and score folds at 7.4 cm and 14.8 cm. Cut four squares: silver grey 9.2 x 14 cm and 6.6 x 14 cm, design paper with pink stripe 6.1 x 13.5 cm and green design paper 8.7 x 13.5 cm. Ink all parts with distress ink walnut stain. Fold the (easel) card and adhere parts together. Die cut/emboss the Craftable from pink card. Layer the picture behind the passe-partout and then mat on white

card. Adhere to the card. Die cut/emboss the small Craftables from white and pink card. Layer the picture behind the passe-partout, stick the shapes together and then onto the card. Die cut/emboss the box tree, watering can, bench, birds. Where more colours are visible cut out twice and cut off the parts needed and adhere together. Finish off the card.

FLOWERS

Clear Stamps

Fold 15.5 x 14 cm white cardstock in half. Score and cut according to pattern. Cut design paper 3 mm smaller at all sides and adhere. Layer 1.5 x 11.5 cm white cardstock on front panel, but first wrap blue ribbon around it. Stamp on white cardstock using pink ink, sprinkle embossing powder on top

and melt with heat tool. Cut out picture and layer on die-cut circle. Stamp again using black ink and only colour in the lilies. Cut out and adhere onto pink stamped image using 3D-kit. Use CR1203 to make flowers. Decorate card with flowers, leaves and a tag with stamped text.



Cut a 15.5 x 11 cm white single-fold card. Cut 10.5 x 15 cm red design paper and 10 x 14.5 cm kraft card. Stamp the flower with coloured ink onto a kraft card rectangle, cut a little bit smaller and sprinkle with embossing powder. Melt powder with heat-

tool. Cut a white strip with CR1250. Cut to the size of the kraft card and layer all parts onto the front of the card. Decorate the strip with flower ribbon, red paper roses, bows, die-cut swirls and ivy. Make the flowers yourself.

Cut a 14 x 14 cm white single-fold card. Fold the front panel in half again and adhere a 14 x 14 cm white square to it. Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm green square and 13 x 13 cm design paper. Cut a 3.5 x 13.5 cm white strip and wrap wide white ribbon around it. Adhere to front panel. Die-cut the shape from white cardstock and stamp the image with pink ink. Sprinkle transparent embossing powder onto it and melt with heattool. Repeat with another piece of white cardboard and cut off the image. Colour in the flowers and adhere

using 3D-kit. Decorate with handmade flowers and leaves. Colour the edges of the petals with a marker. Cut 13.5 x 7.5 cm green card and 13 x 7 cm design paper. Layer to the inside of the card and decorate with a label with text and the same flowers as the front panel. Stick an organza bow and a cord between the flowers. Add adhesive pearls for the finishing touch.

NOIR & BLANC Fashion

General

After die cutting LRO291 (pump), LRO293 (oval frame) and LRO294 (rose) leave them in the die and apply pan pastel to the visible paper parts; fix the colour with fixing spray.

Work around the edges of the design paper with distress ink vintage photo.



Cut a 13.25 x 15.25 cm white single-fold card and 12.75 x 14.75 cm kraft card. Cut design paper into 12 x 14.25 cm and 9.5 x 12 cm and mat together on black card. Stick to card and layer lace across. Die cut oval LRO293 and work with black pan pastel. Die cut LRO163 twice from white, LRO292 from black and LRO271 from kraft card. Die cut the

rolled rose from kraft card, make the rose and add an adhesive pearl to its heart. Adhere the rose, adhesive pearls and tulle to the mannequin. Make a bow of ribbon and tie a charm to it with rope. Stamp the text with stone gray ink. Finish off the card.



Cut a 16 x 12.5 cm white top-fold card and 15.5 x 12 cm kraft card. Cut design paper into 15 x 11.5 cm and 12.5 x 10 cm, mat both on black card. Die cut LRO293 from kraft card. Work the oval with black pan pastel. Stamp CS0864 onto the centre of the oval using stone gray ink. Die cut LRO294 and LRO291 four times from black and white card.

Work the black roses and pumps with black pan pastel. Adhere the black roses and pumps overlapping on top of the white ones. Use 3D-glue for the pumps. Tie a charm with black rope to one rose. Stamp the text with stone gray ink. Finish off the card.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card and 14 x 14 cm kraft card. Cut design paper into 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 11.25 x 11.25 cm; mat each one on black card. Layer lace across the card. Die cut LRO293 from kraft card and black card. Work the oval with white pan pastel. Stamp the card and oval with stone gray ink. Die cut LRO294 2x

from black and 2x from white card. Work the black rose with white pan pastel. Die cut LRO163 twice from white card and LRO271 twice from kraft card. Work the leaves with black pan pastel. Adhere the black roses overlapping on top of the white ones, using 3D-glue. Make a double bow of ribbon, tie a charm to it. Finish off the card.

VINTAGE STYLE

Cut a 15.5 x 15.5 cm nut brown single-fold card and three squares: black 15 x 15 cm, pearly white 14.5 x 14.5 cm and design paper 14 x 14 cm. Use embroidery thread to stitch a border along the design paper and adhere all layers together. Add lace and rope as shown. Die cut the oval from nut brown card and design paper. Layer together and then



Cut a 15 x 15 cm black single-fold card and two squares: pearly white 14.5 x 14.5 cm and nut brown 14 x 14 cm. Adhere together. Cut four 6 x 6 cm squares from design paper and stick to the card. Die cut the circle from pearly white and nut brown. Stamp the text onto the nut brown



Cut a 12 x 16.5 cm nut brown single-fold card, an 11.5 x 16 cm pearly white rectangle and an 11 x 15.5 cm one from design paper. Adhere together. Die cut the heart from pearly white card and adhere to card, work with pan pastel. Die cut the cats from black and nut brown card. Adhere together

onto the card. Die cut the birds from black and white card, adhere to the oval almost overlapping, a narrow white border is visible on the left. Die cut the swirls from nut brown and white card and the leaves from black card. Adhere to the card and complete with paper roses and ribbon.

circle. Adhere the circles together and then onto the card using 3D-kit/foampads. Die cut the roses from pearly white and adhere to the circle. Stamp the text onto two pieces of card and attach with rope. Complete the card with a butterfly.

almost overlapping, creating a shadow effect. Die cut the border of grass and the lantern post from nut brown card. Adhere to the card together with the flower ribbon. Draw a horizon and birds. Stamp the text onto a white strip. Stick to the card and decorate with two wooden hearts.

Fifties

Die cut a silver grey base card with the Go Kreate die. Cut 4.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and mat on white card. Stick ribbon to the strip. Use the Nestabilities to die cut a circle from design paper with image and mat on design paper and then on white card. Die cut/emboss an oval frame from white card and work with distress ink. Die cut

mannequins from design paper and attach parts of them onto nut brown die-cut mannequins. Adhere the mannequins with foampads. Tie a charm around a mannequin. Die cut leaves from white and silver grey, adhere paper roses. Cut a text from a design paper image and adhere with foam pads.



Cut a 12 x 15 cm silver grey top fold card. Cut 10.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and mat on white. Tie organza ribbon around the top right corner and attach a rope with a charm. Cut design paper with children into 3.5 x 15 cm and mat on white. Die cut/emboss a silver grey oval frame, work with distress ink. Die cut an oval frame from design paper with children and attach to centre of silver

grey frame. Cut out the children and attach with foampads as shown. Die cut/emboss the pumps from silver grey, work with distress ink. Tie rope through the pumps and attach with foampads. Use the round Nestability die to cut the image from design paper and mat on a silver grey die-cut scalloped Nestability. Mount all layers onto the card.



Cut a 12 x 15 cm top-fold card from kraft card. Cut 10.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and mat on white. Cut a slanting strip from design paper and mat on brick red. Die cut/emboss an oval frame and work with distress ink. Adhere at a slant. Tie ribbon around the side, tie together with flowers in be-

tween. Die cut/emboss pumps from white, work with distress ink and attach to brick red as shown. Decorate with adhesive pearls. Die cut swirls from brick red. Cut out the image with text from design paper and stick between the swirls.

PRETTY IN PINK Rose Garden

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm purple single-fold card, 13.9 x 13.9 cm white card and 13.6 x 13.6 cm design paper. Ink around the edges of the design paper with distress ink. Die cut two corners, two small roses and a heart from white card, leave the shapes in the die and apply pink pastel ink. Die cut the ornament from white card and work with

glacier ice ink. Layer design paper behind the corners, the ornament and the heart and stamp the text onto the heart. Die cut the roses also from sea green card, leave in the die and work with bundled sage. Cut off the rose buds, stick to flower stems and decorate with swirls and a bow. Cut out the picture and make 3D.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm purple single-fold card and a 13.9 x 13.9 cm white square. Cut two 6.8 x 13.6 cm rectangles from design paper (the top part from the top and the bottom part from the bottom). Together they will form a 13.6 x 13.6 cm square. Cut 4.5 x 14.5 cm design paper. Ink around the edges of the design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the largest die of the heart from white card, the smaller one from design paper.

Stick the design paper hearts onto the purple card and trim leaving a narrow border. Cut out the picture and butterflies and make them 3D. Die cut two roses, leave in die and work with pink pastel ink. Die cut them from sea green card too and work with distress ink bundled sage. Cut off the rose buds, stick to the flower stems and decorate with swirls and a bow.



Die cut the Go Kreate die from pale pink card: place the die just over the folded top line of the card to create a single-fold card. Die cut the die from a single sheet of design paper and adhere to the single-fold card. Cut 10 x 10 cm and 9.7 x 9.7 cm from white card and a 3 x 13.5 cm strip from design paper. Cut off the sides of the strip along the card. Ink around the design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Die cut the border from

white card, leave the shape in the die and work with glacier ice ink. Stick lace to the bottom of the strip. Cut out the picture and make 3D. Die cut the rose from white card (work with pink pastel ink) and sea green card (work with bundled sage). Cut off the rose bud and stick to the flower stem. Stamp the text. Finish off the card.
