Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping ink: tuxedo black (Memento), Stamping paper: white, Card: green, kraft, red, white, Alcohol markers: Copics, Die cutting foam sheets: LR0022 (1 mm)

General instructions for stamping vague backgrounds:

When using the poinsettia and pinetrees in the background, stamp the 1st image onto scrap paper. The 2nd (or 3rd)) image will then give a vague, light grey impression. When colouring in the image with alcohol markers the outlines will be hardly visible or not at all.

Cut a 7 \times 17.5 cm rectangle from stamping paper. Stamp the scenery and colour in. Stamp the frozen window with transparent ink. Sprinkle white embossing powder on top and heat with heat gun till the powder melts.

Adhere the card to 7.5 x 18 cm kraft, 8 x 18.5 cm red and 8.5 x 19 cm green card and finally to a 10.5×21 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the amaryllis and pine branches from stamping paper and colour in with alcohol markers.

Die cut the shadow text from white card and the smaller one from snow paper. Adhere together.

Adhere all parts raised with foam to the card. Complete the card with a bow.



Extra for this card:

Craftables: CR1444 (Basic Hexagons), Stamp: TC0902 (Tiny's Poinsettia), TC0918 (Tiny's Art-Christmas Twigs) Die cut the hexagon with decorative border from kraft card. Adhere to red card and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border. Then adhere to green card and trim again.

Use a 14 x 12 cm white top-fold card. Adhere the hexagon at 1 cm down from the top.

Cut off the white card leaving a 1 cm border around the entire hexagon.

Place the hexagonal die with decorative border onto stamping paper. Draw along the inside in pencil and cut out this smaller hexagon. Stamp the background in black ink and colour in. Adhere this part to the card.

Stamp the poinsettia, cut out and colour in. Adhere it to the card with 3D-glue/foam.

Cut a 12.5 x 9.5 cm rectangle from stamping paper and stamp the scenery. Colour in with alcohol markers. Use a gel pen to draw white snowy accents. Stamp snowflakes with transparent ink onto the top half of the card. Sprinkle white embossing powder on top and heat with a heat gun till the powder melts. Then adhere the card to 13 x 10 cm kraft, to 13.5 x 10.5 cm red and 14 x 11 cm green card and finally to a 16 x 13 cm white single-fold card. Stamp the large Christmas tree, cut out and colour in with alcohol markers. Die cut the small text and colour in with red/pink alcohol markers. Die cut the shadow text from white card and adhere together. Adhere all parts with foam to the card with foam.

Cut a 9 x 9 cm square from stamping paper and colour in with blue alcohol markers. Use light blue ink to stamp the snowflakes. Apply glitter glue randomly.

Adhere the square to 9.5 x 9.5 cm kraft card, to 10 x 10 cm red and 10.5 x 10.5 cm green card and finally to a 12.5 x 12.5 cm

Die cut the parts of the poinsettia and pine branches from stamping paper. Colour in with alcohol markers and work the (Memento), black, Enamel dots: edges with gesso. Die cut a label. Stamp the text in black ink. Adhere all parts to the card with foam and add enamel dots.

Die cut the base for the box card 2x, 1x with the opening and 1x without. The closed part is the background.

Cut the background image from the decoupage sheet, making it 13.5 cm wide to fit the card.

Die cut the partition strips to adhere inside the box 2x. Cut a 13.5 x approx. 2 cm wavy strip of design paper for the first strip and adhere. Die cut large forest trees and adhere to the back of the strip. The trees are too long, but do not trim them yet! First die cut the fence, adhere together and then adhere to the strip.

Die cut the trees and heap of snow that belong to the box card set. Adhere them too.

Then adhere the first strip on the right-hand side inside the box card at 1.5 cm up from the bottom. Cut a 13.5 x approx. 3 cm wavy strip from snow paper and adhere too.

Die cut the deer, assemble and adhere to a separate piece of white card to make it sturdier. Now cut out the deer neatly and adhere to the wavy strip of snow.

Adhere this strip to the right-hand side inside the box too, at 0.5 cm up from the bottom.

Now adhere the sides of both parts of the box card together. At the same time adhering the partition strips on the left-hand

side. Fold the card flat and cut off the tree trunks along the bottom. Cut two 12.5 x 4 cm strips and adhere to the sides of the box card. Cut a 13.5 x approx. 2 cm wavy strip of design paper and adhere to the bottom of the front flap. Die cut the bird, adhere and place on the card. Die cut the berry sprig and garland with stars. Assemble and adhere as shown. Die cut a pink banner, stamp a text with transparent ink and work with embossing powder and a heat gun. Complete the card with adhesive pearls and rhinestones.

Cut a 21 x 9.3 cm blue card. Die cut the background with stars from pearl paper and adhere to design paper with white snowflakes and dots. Cut off the edges neatly. Cut/tear 9.3 x approx. 3 cm strip from checkered design paper. Die cut the hexagon from design paper and snow paper. Cut off the latter halfway in a wavy line. Die cut two trees from plain pink design paper. Die cut the deer and assemble. Die cut a pink banner, stamp a text with transparent ink and work with white embossing powder and a heat qun.

Adhere all parts to the card, the hexagon with 3D-foam tape.

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm blue top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 10 cm design paper. Cut/tear a 15 x approx. 3.5 cm strip from design paper.

Die cut a 10.5 cm \emptyset circle from plain light pink design paper and adhere with 3D-tape. Die cut the text circle from pearl paper and adhere to the pink one with 3D-tape.

Die cut the background image with a 9.2 cm Ø circular die and adhere. Die cut and adhere the tree and heap of snow. Die cut the bird, assemble and adhere.

Die cut a light pink banner, stamp the text with transparent ink and work with embossing powder and a heat gun.

Complete the card with adhesive pearls and rhinestones.

Die cut the amaryllis from white card, the stamens from metallic paper, the stem from light green card and adhere together.

Die cut two berry sprigs from metallic paper. Adhere the flower and sprigs to the card.

Cut a 4.5 x 12.5 cm vellum strip, lay it across the stem of the flower and adhere the ends to the back of the card.

Die cut the text from white card and metallic paper. Adhere together and then to the vellum.

Finally adhere this card to a 10.5×14.5 cm green single-fold card.

Use a 10.2×20.5 cm dark green single-fold card and adhere a 9.7×20.5 cm white card. Die cut a dark green background and adhere.

Die cut two dark green hexagons, cut one in half and adhere them to the card. Die cut a red amaryllis, stamens from metallic paper, a light green stem and adhere the flower together. Die cut red and green berry sprigs and leafy sprigs from metallic paper.

Die cut the numbers and stars from metallic paper and adhere all parts to the card as per example given.

Die cut a white background, adhere to a 9×20.5 cm dark green card and then to a 9.7×20.7 cm white single-fold card. Die cut a white hexagon and adhere to a slightly larger green one. Die cut the text from metallic paper and adhere. Die cut two red amaryllises, green leaves, hearts from metallic paper and adhere together. Die cut two green leafy sprigs and two from metallic paper. Die cut two red and two green berry sprigs.

Adhere all parts as per example given.

Draw the haunted house along the inner lines of the stencil onto anthracite card, and the roofs along the outer lines onto black card. Cut out. Work the edges of the house with distress ink black soot and make splashes with black and grey (water)paint. Adhere light yellow paper behind the windows and design paper with planks behind the door (PB7066).

Die cut the smallest circle (CR1597) from dark yellow card and work the edges with distress ink.

Stamp the images, cut out and colour in. Die cut the bare trees (LR056) from black card.

Use a single A5-card of stamping paper as the background of the card. Work it with distress ink black soot and the blue distress inks

Die cut a border (CR1583) and work with distress ink black soot and pumice stone. Adhere the layers together.

Stamp the text with Versamark ink and work with embossing powder.

Finish the card as shown.

Die cut the box card 2x from dark blue card. Die cut the window from the front panel.

Use 13.5 x 2.5 cm stamping paper for the back flap. Work it with distress ink black soot and the blue inks. Stamp the stars (EC0201) onto it with transparent VersaMark ink and work them with white embossing powder and the heat gun. Adhere to the dark blue base.

Die cut the tree trunk (CR1637) from dark brown card and the foliage from mint green. Die cut the hills from grey card and work the edges with distress ink black soot.

Die cut the smallest circle (CR1597) from dark yellow card and work the edges with distress ink fossilized amber.

Stamp the text. Stamp the images, cut out and colour in. Finish the card, use transparent sheet to adhere the bat.

Cut a 9.5×20.5 cm white single-fold card and a 9×20 cm rectangle from stamping paper. Work the latter with distress ink black soot and the blue inks.

Die cut the Slimline frame from light purple card and cut a 0.8×9.5 cm orange strip. Stamp the black text. Stamp the text on the orange strip with transparent VersaMark ink and work with white embossing powder and the heat gun.

Divide the shaker material on the background into three piles and adhere the purple frame, with 3 mm foam tape along the entire edge of each square, on top.

Stamp the images, die cut and colour in. Complete the card as per example given.

Cut off 10 cm on the short side of an A4-size white card. Fold the large part in half creating a Slimline top-fold card. Die cut the background from silver-coloured metallic paper and adhere to the front of the card.

Die cut the hexagon 2x from white card and adhere. The points in the centre are glued together. Decorate this with two die-cut white flowers (CR1444) as per example shown.

Use a smaller hexagonal die to cut out the pictures, stamp the text and adhere.

Complete the card with adhesive pearls.

Use a 10.5 x 14.8 cm brown single-fold card. Die cut the background from snow paper.

Die cut the largest hexagon from white card and the decorative border from platinum glitter paper. Use a hexagon to cut out the picture and stamp a text. Adhere these parts to the front of card. Die cut the flower (CR1444) from white card and platinum glitter card, die cut the berry sprigs from gold-coloured metallic paper. Position the flowers tufts on both sides of the hexagon and place an enamel dot in the hearts.
