Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1538 (Eline's Butterfly Family), COL1539 (Bleeding Hearts by Marleen), Creatables: LR0851 (Scallop Borders), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9186 (Early Spring), Card: brown, green, greyish kraft, white and black

General instructions:

For most plain colours the reverse side of the design paper is used.

(Eline's Backgrounds Early Spring), Jute and rope

Die cut the large circle of the lay-out set 2x from white card. Score a line halfway one of the circles and cut off a small straight piece on the bottom (to make the card stand up straight). Adhere the top half of the circle to the back of the complete circle. Cut a 3.5×16 cm strip of design paper. Cut a 3×16 cm lilac strip and die cut a scalloped border.

Die cut the scalloped circle from yellow and the other two circles from white card and the background sheet. Die cut a semi-circle that fits the background sheet, cut off the top in a wavy line and adhere. Die cut a white label and tie jute and rope to it. Die cut fitting design paper and adhere the label behind the yellow circle. Die cut the shapes needed from different paper colours. Complete the card as per the example given.

Collectables: COL1525 (Eline's Ladybugs), COL1527 (Flowerpot House by Marleen), Craftables: CR1597 (Basic Circles by Marleen), Creatables: LR0849 (Happy Daisy), Easter/spring stickers by Marleen): CA3192 Cut a 10×21 cm white top-fold card. Cut 9.5 x 20.5 cm plain design paper and adhere 9×20 cm patterned design paper. Cut a 3×10 strip of design paper as well.

Cut a 1.5 x 10 cm white strip and work with the stitches die. Die cut a white scalloped circle and a smaller one from design paper. Adhere together and cut in half. Use only the right half. Die cut a white 3 cm Ø and a 4 cm Ø circle and adhere a text sticker. Die cut the shapes needed from different colours of plain paper.

Complete the card as per the example given.

Clovers), CR1647 (Elegant Tag), CR1648 (Fence by Marleen), Decoupage sheet: AK0092 (Eline's Backgrounds Early Spring), Rhinestones: CA3158 (mint), Ribbon and rope Cut a 21 x 10 cm white top-fold card, 20 x 10 cm design paper and two 5×6 cm strips.

Cut a white 11×20.5 cm rectangle and die cut a scalloped border on one side. Adhere a 9×20 cm background.

Die cut a white label and tie ribbon and rope to it. Die cut fitting design paper and adhere the label behind the card with the background. Die cut the shapes needed from different plain

Cut a 3 x 5 cm purple scalloped strip. Adhere a text ticket to a white 4 cm Ø circle. Complete the card as per the example given.

Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1646 (Punch die-XL Eggs), Creatables: LR0850 (Bunnies), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9186 (Early Spring), Card: brown, kraft, white, black, Metallic paper: CA3171 (gold), Coloured pencils: grey and pink, Cotton pads, Craft tape, double-sided: LR0014, Enamel dots: PL4529 (duotone lavender), PL4530 (yellow glitter), Hemp cord: white, Rhinestones: CA3154 (bronze), Stickers by Marleen: CA3192 (Easter/Spring)

General instructions:

- Making a standing card with a craft stencil:
 - Draw the shape of the craft stencil (Easter eggs or letter 'P') 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out. Take the shape in mirror image (the back part) and score a line a few centimeters* down from the top and fold it over. Adhere the folded top to the back of the other card.
- *4 cm down on the large Easter egg and 2 cm down on the letter 'P.
- Die cut the bunnies from kraft and black card, and their tails from a cotton pad. Adhere together and colour their cheeks a little with a pink pencil.
- Die cut small Easter eggs from gold-coloured and orange paper.
- Complete the card with enamel dots and rhinestones.



Extra for this card:

Craftables: CR1648 (Fence by Marleen), Creatables: LR0839 (Layout Circles by Marleen) Cut 14 x 14 cm design paper with flowers. Die cut the lay-out circles in a 14 x 14 cm mint green square. Adhere the layers to a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white top-fold card. Fill the open circles with stickers.

Adhere two text stickers to white 3 cm Ø circles (LR0839). Place a bow of hemp cord behind the yellow sticker and adhere with 3D-tape.

Die cut a brown fence and make a pretty arrangement with the bunnies and Easter eggs.



Extra for this card:

Craftables: CR1648 (Fence by Marleen), Craft stencil: PS8155 (Easter Egg Cottage by Marleen), Push pins: CA3151 (gold), Rhinestones: CA3164 (lilac) Draw along the outermost lines of the craft stencil to copy the shape of the Easter eggs onto pearly white card and cut out. Draw the large Easter egg a second time, cut out and adhere to the first one with 3D-tape.

Use the inner lines of the craft stencil to draw shapes for decorating the card. Draw the shapes onto the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing a mirror image. Cut all parts out and adhere to the card. Draw the door on yellow paper, insert a push pin as a doorknob and adhere to the card.

Windows frames: draw the thick lines onto white card and cut

Curtains: draw them onto the back of design paper, cut out and adhere, together with the window frames, onto plain light yellow paper. Cut off the excess paper neatly and adhere to the card.

Bow: draw the outermost lines onto plain lilac paper and the innerlines onto the reverse side of design paper. Cut out and adhere to the card with 3D-tape.

Die cut a brown fence and and make a pretty arrangement with the bunnies and eggs.

Adhere a bow of hemp cord and a text sticker to the card with 3D-tape.

Draw along the outermost lines of the craft stencil to copy the shape of the letter 'P' onto pearly white card and cut out.

Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate the card. Draw around them on the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing a mirror image. Cut all parts out and adhere to the card. Die cut two scalloped borders from different colours of design paper. Adhere to the card and trim to fit the card.

Die cut the plant with the bleeding hearts from different colours, adhere together and to the card. Adhere the yellow sticker with flowers. Adhere a text sticker and a bow of hemp cord to the card with 3D-tape.

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm white top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 10 cm purple paper and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper. Die cut a white text circle and a 9.2 cm Ø lilac one. Adhere the text circle with 3D-tape to a 10.5 cm Ø mint green circle. Then adhere the lilac one with glue/double-sided tape to the text circle. Die cut the parts for the label from different kinds of paper and adhere together. Die cut a 3 cm Ø purple circle and adhere a sticker with chicks. Die cut Easter eggs from metallic paper and plain design paper, adhere together and to the label. Thread ribbon and lace through the opening and secure with a bow of hemp cord. Turn the text circle over so the back is facing up. Place the label in the centre and mark its position in pencil. Adhere 3D-tape on three sides except the top and adhere the text circle to the card. Now slide the label behind.

Die cut a 0.8 cm border with the Craftable 'Shakables Egg' and adhere this border overlapping the Shakables window Egg. Place shaker material in a pile on design paper. Fix tape to the border of the shaker window and adhere the window over the shaker material. Cut off the excess paper neatly. Then adhere the Easter egg to the text circle.

Craftables: CR1539 (Punch die-Lucky), CR1605 (Text Labels), Creatables: LR0747 (Anja's Butterfly set), LR0848 (Circle Layout-M), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1128 (Lentegroetjes), Stamping ink Inkon3: blackout hybrid detail ink, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9186 (Early Spring), Card: black, red and white velvet card, Circle cutter, Nuvo dream drops: cloud, Pen: white

General instructions for the circular cards:

- Card: use a circle cutter to cut two 13.5 cm Ø cards. Score a line in one circle at 2.5 cm down from the top and cut off a small piece on the bottom (the card can stand up straight now). Adhere this card to the reverse side of the other card.
- Lay-out: die cut the largest circle from design paper and adhere to the card.
 Die cut the lay-out 4x from white (velvet)card and 1x from the decoupage sheet. Adhere the lay-outs together (the larger white parts are not being used) and adhere to the card. Then fill the open areas with the die-cut images of the decoupage sheet.

Creatables: LR0846 (Tiny's Crocus XL), Distress ink: milled lavender, dusty concord, rusty hinge, Decoupage sheet: EWK1297 (Country Flowers XL), Card: green Cut the two circles for the card and the lay-outs from white velvet card. Follow the general instructions.

Die cut the purple crocuses (the two largest ones) from plain design paper and work them with distress ink dusty concord. Die cut the small crocuses from white velvet card, work one with pumice stone and the other with milled lavender.

Die cut the pistil from white velvet card and work with rusty hinge. Die cut the stems from light green card.

Die cut butterflies from white velvet card and decorate with rhinestones.

Stamp the text onto the label of design paper and complete the card with lady bugs.

Creatables: LR0846 (Tiny's Crocus XL), Distress ink: dusty concord, rusty hinge, dried marigold, hickory smoke, forest moss, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0214 (Spring Garden XL), Card: purple Cut the two circles from lilac card and the lay-outs from white card. Follow the general instructions.

Die cut the purple crocus from plain design paper, work with distress ink dusty concord. Die cut the pistil from white velvet card and work with rusty hinge. Die cut the white crocus from white velvet card and work with pumice stone. Die cut the yellow crocus from white velvet card and work with dried marigold. Die cut the stems from plain design paper and work with forest moss. Die cut the butterfly from white velvet card and decorate with rhinestones. Stamp the text onto the label of design paper and complete the card with lady bugs.

Craftables: CR1551 (Big Tag), Creatables: LR0693 (Anja's Circle XS), LR0847 (Tiny's Daffodil XL), Distress ink: dried marigold, rusty hinge, rustic wilderness, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0213 (Flower Bulbs), Card: light green, Metallic paper: CA3171 (gold), Vellum, Hemp cord Fold a white velvet sheet into a top-fold card. Place the top of the largest tag die just above the card and die cut. Die cut a rectangle from patterned design paper and adhere to 9.5×12.5 cm plain design paper. Die cut the reinforcement strip and the eyelets of the tag from design paper and tie hemp cord through. Die cut the circle from white velvet card, adhere to plain design paper and trim along the edges. Cut out the image (8.5 cm 0) with a circle cutter and adhere. Die cut the daffodils from white velvet card, work the calyces with distress ink dried marigold and rusty hinge. Place a gold-coloured pistil on the largest daffodil. Die cut the stems from light green card and work with distress ink rustic wilderness. Tie hemp cord around the stems. Die cut the butterfly from white velvet card and vellum. Work the vellum with distress ink dried marigold. Adhere the bodies together and decorate with rhinestones.

Stamp the text on to the label of design paper and complete the card with ladybugs.

General instructions:

Stamp the flower stems with Archival stamping ink jet black or leaf green. Mat the watercolour paper on the plain side of the design paper. Stamp the texts in black.

Decorate the card with different colours of rhinestones.

Cut a 7.5 x 15 cm white single-fold card and adhere design paper of the same size.

Die cut a Slimline mini frame from watercolour paper. Stamp the ropes with Altenew lilac, the vase with Archival cornflower blue, the tulips with Archival saffron and the poppy with Altenew volcano lake. Colour the vase and the flowers in with watercolour paint and distress ink. Stamp the splatter with Altenew soft lilac.

Cut an 8.5 x 12.25 cm white single-fold card and adhere design paper of the same size.

Die cut a scalloped rectangle from watercolour paper. Stamp the tulip with Archival saffron and Altenew lavender fields, colour the flowers, leaves and sky in with watercolour paint.

Cut an 11 x 4 cm vellum strip and adhere to wide double-sided tape. Die cut a scalloped border along one side and stamp a text.

Die cut a mini frame from watercolour paper. Stamp the vase, tulip and hemlock with Archival jet black. Stamp the stains and splatter as per the example given with different colours of Altenew ink.

Stamp the hemlock and freesia with Archival leaf green and Altenew lavender fields, colour in the flowers and the sky. Cut a 10.25 x 3.5 cm white strip and die cut a scalloped border along one long side. Stamp the text.

Stamp the freesia with Archival jet black and the ropes and stains as per example given with different Altenew ink colours.
