### Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9192 (Christmas at Home), Cardstock A4-pad (250 grs): PK9193 (Christmas at Home), Cardstock A5-pad Metallics (275 grs): PK9194 (Christmas at Home), Card: white and black



### Extra for this card:

Craftables: CR1660 (Fijne Feestdagen Vierkant by Marleen – ice crystals used), Creatables: LR0724 (Lantern), LR0769 (Berry Branches), LR0815 (Tropical Flower set), LR0871 (Open Christmas Bauble), LR0872 (Sleigh), LR0873 (Set of

Pinetrees), Decoupage sheet: HK1715 (Winter Snoesjes City), Soft glitter paper: CA3142 (silver), Pearl paper: CA3166 (white), Stickers: CA3169 (Kerst), Enamel dots: PL4526 (light blue glitter)

Cut a 15 x 7.5 cm white top-fold card and mount 14.5 x 7 cm dark green paper and 14 x 6.5 cm design paper on top.

Stick 11 x 11 cm design paper, 11.5 x 11.5 cm dark green onto a 12.5 x 2.5 cm white card.

Die cut the shapes needed from different card/paper colours.

Stick gold-coloured paper behind the lantern.

Die cut the image with the smooth die of the bauble set and stick onto a 7.5 cm Ø white circle.

Die cut a 3.5 cm Ø white circle and mount a text sticker on top.

Complete the card.

(Kerstgroetjes by Marleen), Enamel dots: PL4526 (light blue glitter)

Cut a 20.3 x 13.5 cm white strip and score a line at 6.8 cm from the left-hand side. Fold the flap forward. Stick 13 x 13 cm dark green and 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper onto the inside of the card.

Stick a 13.5 x 2 cm strip of design paper onto the inside of the card as per example given. Stick 13 x 6.3 cm dark green and 12.5 x 5.8 cm design paper onto the flap.

Die cut a 3.5 cm Ø white circle and mount a text sticker on top.

Die cut the shapes needed from plain card and design paper.

Stick the image onto an 8.7 x 8.7 cm white square and stick half of this square onto the flap.

Complete the card.

Die cut the bauble from shiny gold-coloured and ochre card and cut out the centre. Die cut the image and stick to the bauble.

Die cut the shapes needed from plain, glitter and metallic paper.

Die cut the text (white and dark green) and bow (mint green) twice and stick together slightly overlapping.

Complete the card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card.

Die cut the circles from the front of the card, creating a slanted flap.

Stick 14.5 x 14.5 cm plain green paper and 14 x 14 cm design paper onto the inside of the card.

Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm dark green paper and die cut the circles as well. Then stick this triangle behind the white circles, a few millimeters overlapping. Fill the open circles on the front with stickers.

Die cut three white circles and mount a text and ice crystal stickers on top.

Die cut the shapes needed from different plain paper colours.

Complete the card.

**Materials used for both cards:**

Craftables: CR1606 (Punch die – Forest Critters), CR1667 (Sticker Circles), Creatables: LR0873 (Set of Pinetrees), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: walnut stain, rusty hinge, Decoupage sheet: VK9614 (Winter Forest), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9192 (Christmas at Home), Cardstock A4-pad (250 grs): PK9193 (Christmas at Home), Card: white, Stickers: CA3194 (Kerstgroetjes by Marleen), Snowtex, Pen: black

**General instructions:**

Work the trees, fence and bottom of the sleigh with snowtex.

Work the birds with distress ink walnut stain and rusty hinge. Draw a black dot for the eyes of the birds and rabbits.

Cut a 15.2 x 15.2 cm green top-fold card and mount

14.4 x 14.4 cm white card and 14 x 14 cm design paper on top.

Die cut the Christmas bauble from green metallic card and stick onto design paper. Cut out the picture and stick onto the circle.

Decorate the bauble with green trees and metallic stars.

Die cut the other shapes needed. Stick the sticker onto the circle.

Die cut the text 2x and stick together slightly overlapping.

Cut a 14.7 x 17.6 cm turquoise single-fold card and mount three rectangles on top: 13.9 x 17 cm white card and 13.5 x 16.6 cm and 12 x 15.5 cm design paper.

Die cut the Christmas bauble from design paper and turquoise card and stick the picture in between.

Die the other parts needed.

Die cut the poinsettia, sticker circle and rabbits from white card and complete the card.

### Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Card: white, green, ochre, brown, kraft, Stamping paper: white



#### Extra for this card:

Craftables: CR1664 (Tiny's Maple Leaf – Circle), CR1667 (Sticker Circles), Creatables: LR0767 (Scallop Squares), LR0770 (Mushroom XL), LR0775 (Autumn Leaves), Shakables: LR0051 (Welcome Fall), Sticker sheets: CA3189

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card. Mount three squares on top: 14.5 x 14.5 cm red, 14 x 14 cm white and 13.5 x 13.5 cm green. Die cut the maple leaf from 11 x 11 cm design paper. Stick a transparent sheet behind it and foam tape along the borders. Sprinkle Shakables into it and cover with an 11.5 x 11.5 green card. Work a sheet of stamping paper with different colours of distress ink and then die cut the leaves. Die cut the other shapes needed and complete the card as per example given.

Cut a 21 x 10 cm white Slimline single-fold card and mount 20.5 x 9.5 design paper on top. Work a sheet of stamping paper with different colours of distress ink and then die cut the leaves. Die cut the other shapes needed. Attach a shaker window behind the circle in the centre, sprinkle Shakables into it and cover with the background. Position the stickers onto the die-cut circles and complete the card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm ivory-coloured single-fold card. Mount three squares on top: 14.5 x 14.5 cm green, 14 x 14 cm brown and 13.5 x 13.5 cm ivory. Die cut the background with fall leaves 1x from green and 1x from ochre design paper. Lay them on top of each other and turn the bottom one a quarter and stick together. Cut the picture a little smaller and stick to a slightly larger brown square. Die cut the chestnuts and acorns from brown card and kraft, cut off the cupule of scales/ovals and stick to the acorns/chestnuts. Stamp the text onto an ivory-coloured rectangle and stick to a slightly larger brown one. Complete the card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card from kraft and mount three squares on top: 14.5 x 14.5 cm yellow, 14 x 14 cm ivory and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper. Work a sheet of stamping paper with different colours of distress ink and then die cut the wreath and leaves. Stamp the text onto a yellow rectangle. Die cut the other shapes needed and complete the card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card and mount 14.5 x 14.5 cm brown and 14 x 14 cm white paper on top.  
Die cut the background with fall leaves 1x from brown and 1x from green card. Lay them on top of each other, turn the bottom one a quarter and then stick together.  
Work a sheet of stamping paper with different colours of distress ink and then die cut the maple leaf.  
Stamp the gnome and squirrel onto stamping paper and colour them in. Stick all parts together.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card and mount four squares on top: 14.5 x 14.5 cm green, 14 x 14 cm design paper, 12.5 x 12.5 cm green and 12 x 12 cm design paper.  
Stamp the gnome and hedgehog onto stamping paper and colour them in.  
Cut out the image with a distressed square (CR1375) and die cut larger squares from green card and design paper.  
Work a sheet of stamping paper with different colours of distress ink and then die cut the leaves.  
Stick the card together as per example given.

**Materials used for all cards:**

Craftables: CR1667 (Sticker Circles), Die cut and embossing machine, Cardstock A4-pad (250 grs): PK9193 (Christmas at Home), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Card: ochre, cognac, brown, black, Gel pen: white

**General instructions:**

Use the craft stencil to draw around the outline of the number in pencil. Then cut out.  
Die cut the giraffe from ochre, brown, cognac and black card and die cut a green twig. Draw the accents on the animals with a white gel pen. Stick animal or text stickers onto die-cut sticker circles.

Die cut the largest scalloped square and stick a 12.4 x 12.4 cm white top-fold card behind it to let the card stand.  
Die cut the square with dotted border from 11.25 x 11.25 cm white card.  
Work 10.5 x 10.5 cm watercolor paper with distress oxide tumbled glass and create sunrays by dabbing ink through the mask stencil.  
Die cut a light green grass border (CR1583).  
Die cut two giraffes. Die cut a tree (CR1637) from brown card and three different green colours.  
Die cut the snail from grey kraft and salmon, white and black card.  
Die cut the flower from pink and green card.  
Complete the card as per the example given.

Die cut the Slimline frame from white card and from the decoupage sheet.

Die cut the giraffe. Die cut three meerkats from brown and black card and brown and grey kraft. Die cut six tufts of grass.

Complete the card as per the example given.

Die cut the Slimline tag from white card, the rectangle from watercolor paper and the reinforcement strip from grey card. Work the watercolor paper with distress oxide ink tumbled glass and create sunrays by dabbing ink through the mask stencil.

Die cut two nut brown fences. Die cut the rectangle of the Slimline tags from light green card and die cut the grass border.

Die cut the giraffe. Die cut the meerkat from brown card and brown and grey kraft.

Die cut the lion from different brown colours. Die cut a text label and stamp a text. Die cut two light green tufts of grass.

Tie a piece of rope through the tag.
