CRAFTABLES

## At the beach

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Cut a 14.5 x 20.5 cm night blue strip and cut a 6.5 x 3 cm strip from the top right-hand corner. Score at 0.5 cm, 1.75 cm, 3 cm, 17.5 cm, 18.75 cm and 20 cm. Cut two squares: 14 x 14 cm kraft card and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and layer together. Adhere the image, boat, text and sand castle to the card. Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm night blue card and die cut the Nautic stencil at 5 cm from the bottom in the centre of the square. Die cut the seagulls

from the right-hand top corner. Cut out a square from the card at 2 cm from the top and sides and at 3 cm from the bottom. Adhere these two parts of the card together. Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm kraft square and cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm from the centre; adhere the frame to the card with blue-white rope as shown. Complete the card with a bow and charm.



Cut a 14.5 x 20.5 cm dark blue strip and score at 6 cm. Die cut and score the shells from the centre of the folded part. Cut two squares: 14 x 14 cm kraft card and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper with flower. Cut a 14.5 x 4.5 cm strip from design paper. Adhere the layers together and stamp the border,

boat and text. Layer jute around the layers and adhere to the card. Die cut the mooring post with seagulls and cut out the image. Layer the image to the card at a slant and finish off with a bow and charm.



Cut a 22 x 14 cm night blue strip and score at 8.2 cm. Cut a 30.5 x 13.5 cm dark blue strip and score at 3 cm, 9 cm and 17 cm. Die cut the waves in the centre between the scoring lines. Cut two squares: kraft 13 x 13 cm and design paper 12.5 x 12.5 cm and also a 12.5 x 5 cm strip from design paper. Ink the parts and adhere together. Stamp the borders and layer jute and lace around the card. First adhere to the dark blue card and then to the night blue one. Cut out the image, mat on dark blue and then adhere to the card. Die cut the sand

castle, the feet, seagulls, bucket and spade. Work the last two with Inka gold silver. Cut a 2.5 x 13.5 cm strip from kraft card and layer to the card. Stamp the text and attach all parts to the card. Finish off the card with a bow and charm. Cut a 14 x 7.5 cm strip of card, score at 5 cm and 9 cm and adhere the central part to the reverse side of the card to support it.

# In the sand

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## General instructions

Die cutting Craftables Silver Collection: draw a pencil line as indicated in the description of the card. Place the stencil on the pencil line. There are two grooves on the sides of the stencils; align them with the pencil line and attach with removable tape (e.g. paper tape).

Score the pencil lines after die cutting. Erase them and fold the card.

Work the edges of the paper with a paper distresser.

Cut out the images and mat on pearly white.

After die cutting CR1278, CR1279 and LRO230 leave the card in the stencils and apply distress ink vintage photo (starfish with rusty hinge).

Place bandage behind the shells.



Cut a 13.25 x 13.25 cm single-top-fold card from recycled kraft card. Cut a 12.5 x 21 cm pearly white rectangle. Draw a pencil line at 15 cm, die cut CR1275 (folding dies nautic). Die cut CR1275 a second time from royal silver and recycled kraft card. Cut out the steering wheel and anchor. Fix a brad into the steering wheel. Cut 12.25 x 13 cm and 12.25 x 3 cm from design paper. Stamp the

text. Cut out the image. Die cut CR1276 (folding dies wave) from pearly white card and cut out the wave. Die cut CR1278 (sandcastle set) and CR1279 (ocean set) from recycled kraft, royal silver, pearly white and iris blue card. Colour the birds. Adhere to the card with 3D-glue.



Cut a 15.5 x 12.25 cm single-top-fold card from recycled kraft card. Cut a 15 x 15.5 cm pearly white card. Draw a pencil line at 3.5 cm. Die cut CR1277 (folding dies seagulls) according to the general instructions. Die cut the stencil twice from pearly white card, cut out the birds and colour their bills and eyes. Cut rectangles from design paper: 14.75 x 10 cm, 14.75 x 3.5 cm and 14.75 x 2 cm. Cut out the image. Die cut CR1276 (folding dies wave),

CR1279 (boat) and LRO230 (shells) from pearly white card. Cut out the waves and the sails, colour the flag red. Die cut CR1279 (ocean set) and CR1278 (sandcastle set) from recycled kraft card. Die cut CR1278 (spade) from royal silver card. Adhere to the card with foamtape or 3D-glue. Stamp the text and border with Stazon and inkpad cup o'joe. Tie a charm to the length of rope.



Cut a 12 x 21 cm rectangle from pearly white card. Draw a pencil line at 3 cm, 6 cm, 9 cm and 12 cm. Die cut 2x CR1276 (folding dies wave) according to the general instructions (place the dies on the 3 cm and 9 cm line). Cut a 12.5 x 14.25 cm single-top-fold card from recycled kraft card and two 12.5 x 6 cm rectangles, score both at 3 cm. Adhere the strips under the folds with the waves to make the paper stronger. Cut rectangles from design paper: 2x 11.75 x 2 cm, 1x 11.74 x 14 cm, 1x 11.75 x

4 cm and 1x 11.75 x 2.5 cm. Stamp the text on an 11.75 x 11.75 cm strip of recycled kraft card. Cut out the image. Use COL1315 (tab with text) to cut a map from design paper, thread yarn through the holes and tie a charm. Die cut CR1278 (sandcastle set) and CR1279 (ocean set) from recycled kraft card and royal silver card. Colour the birds. Attach to the card with 3D-glue. Stamp the text.

# Garden Party

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## General instructions

- The measurements of the cards are written like this: you will first see the height in cm and then the width, so 10 x 5 cm means 10 cm high and 5 cm wide.
- Attach lace with double-sided tape.

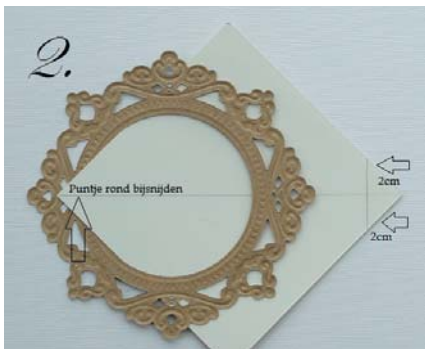


Photo 1/1a:

Cut a 14 x 29.7 cm (whole width of A4 sheet) light yellow strip; fold into a top-fold card. The front and back of the card are 11 cm high; fold the remaining centimeters inside.

### Top of card:

Make a 9 cm incision into the centre of the card, the remaining fold on left and right will be 2.5 cm. Make a 7 cm deep cut in the centre of the card. Fold down the two corners slantingly.

There will be a triangular opening now. Fold on each side the slanting part in half. Cut 10.5 x 13.5 cm dotted design paper; layer behind light yellow using low tacky tape. Place on light box and trace the slanting cutting lines in pencil.

If you are not using a light box then draw the lines on the front. Cut out the triangle from the centre of the dotted design paper. Cut an 8 x 13.5 cm caramel card and attach to light yellow on the inside. Decorate the flap with a ribbon and attach to sides. Leave centre open.



Photo 1a + 2:

Use a sheet of flowered design paper.

Cut out a 10 x 10 cm square from the top left-hand corner of flowered design paper. Lay aside the rest of the paper; you will need it later on. Die cut a circle from kraft card; use two stencils (frame and ring) at the same time. Secure with low tack tape to prevent sliding. The ring will cut out the centre.

Place the corner of the square into the circle; cut off the corner in a round shape. Cut off the opposite corner, 2 cm from the point, in a straight line. Finish off the back neatly with light yellow card. Insert this part into the card.



Photo 3:

Lay the dotted design paper and the rest of the flower design on your cutting mat as per example. Pay attention to the arrows!



Cut off the corners on two sides at 14 cm. Fold the point of the flower design upwards at 4.6 cm from the corner. Adhere to the front of the card as per example. Attach the ribbon.

Photo 4:

Die cut the label 1x from kraft and 1x from light yellow card. Stamp the text onto light yellow. Assemble the label as per example; shape it a little and adhere with 3D-glu.

Die cut two roses from champagne and work with Inka Gold.



Photo 1:

Die cut and emboss the rectangle 2x from light yellow and 2x from champagne.

Cut out the centre (by hand) from champagne and work the border with Inka Gold-Alt Silber.

Attach the border to light yellow using 3D-glu.

Die cut the next border size 1x from flowered design paper and 1x from kraft card.

Adhere to centre of light yellow as per example.

Attach the buttons, leave to dry.

Die cut LR0319 2x from kraft and 1x from mango; work mango with Inka Gold Aprikot.

Adhere mango to kraft using 3D-glu; leave to dry.



Photo 2:

Cut a 21 x 26 cm caramel strip.

Fold from the left: 6.5 cm valley fold, 13 cm valley fold; 6.5 cm will remain.

Score the whole width at 7 cm from the bottom.

Make 2x a 1 cm incision at the bottom of both folds.

Cut off a 1 cm straight strip along the bottom as per example.

Fold the corners at each side upwards diagonally.

Adhere the two door panels to the flaps on the front of the card; leave to dry.

Photo 3:

Fold the lower 7 cm backwards and attach to the sides. Leave the centre open to create a pocket.

Back of card:

Add lace to both sides and decorate the flap with design paper.

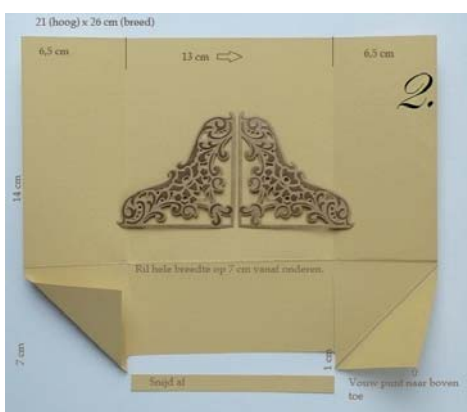
Flaps front bottom:

Use 3D-kit to adhere caramel to the bottom corners.

Press down well and leave to dry (you could place a book on top). Die cut the large triangle 2x from kraft card.

Lay the two triangles onto chequered green design paper.

Trace the outline and cut out. Layer behind kraft card.



Inside:

Adhere 13.7 x 12.5 cm chequered green design paper.

Stamp the girl onto smooth card.

Adhere the image to caramel and trim leaving a narrow border.

Attach the point on top.

Die cut leaves/flowers from champagne and work with Inka Gold Alt-Silber.

Cut a 21 x 29 cm sea green strip; fold in half and fold open again. Score the whole width at 6 cm from the bottom. Make a 6 cm incision into the lowest part of the fold.

Cut 2x: 13.5 x 14.1 cm kraft card and for the flaps 5.7 x 14 cm green design paper. Stamp the butterflies with CS0863; leave to dry. Attach lace to the green design paper. Fold the flaps inside and adhere to sides. Leave the centre open.

Cut for the front of the card:  
yellow/brown design paper 14.5 x 14 cm  
green design paper 14 x 13 cm  
light yellow card 14 x 7.5 cm  
design paper with roses 13.5 x 7 cm.

Die cut two circles from kraft card. First only with the large frame; the centre is closed. Die cut the circle once again, now with two stencils (frame and ring) at the same time. Attach with low tack tape to prevent sliding.

The ring will cut out the centre.

Adhere design paper with flowers to the centre of the closed circle.

Attach the decorative border with 3D-glue; leave to dry.

Die cut four large corners from kraft card.

Lay them down as shown and stick double sided tape on the back.

Adhere to the card as shown.

Make a pretty collage of roses and silk flowers.

Stamp the leaves with Cling stamps TC0830.

Cut them out and attach with 3D-glue.

# Cosy Cards

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Die cut all stencils from kraft card, the large corner of LR0320 2x; apply ink to the embossed parts and the edges. Stamp the image onto carnation white card and mat on kraft card. Cut a 7 cm high and 13.5 cm wide single-top-fold card. Mark a dot in pencil on the bottom at 6 and 7.5 cm and on



Cut 14 x 30 cm pearly white card and score at 14 cm. Cut 13.5 x 21.5 cm kraft card and score at 13.5 cm. Cut 13 x 13 cm design paper. Die cut the stencils from pearly white card and apply distress ink when the shapes are still in the stencils. Place the round stencil on kraft card and trim leaving a narrow border. Die cut the narrow stencils from kraft card. Use a Versafine inkpad to stamp the girl in the centre of the round die-cut shape. Take



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold kraft card. Adhere design paper to the front. Die cut all stencils from kraft card and apply distress ink when the shapes are still in the stencils. Die cut the round stencil 2x and cut out one centre. Adhere the two round stencils together with 3D-glue. Cut 11 x 7.5 cm kraft card and score the long side at 5 cm and 6

the sides at 6 cm. Cut out the corners from dot to dot. Attach the two large die-cut corners to the corners. Place the rectangular stencil on design paper and cut out the centre. Adhere all layers to the card as per example and finish off.

18 x 8 cm kraft card and score at 9 cm. Adhere the round shape to one side; the fold should be in the centre. Cut off the rest creating a tag. Attach the small rectangular shape with text. Adhere the design paper to 13.5 x 21.5 cm kraft card. Fold the flap upwards and stick the sides together. Stick the 'crown' to kraft card, trim leaving a narrow border. Complete the card and insert the tag.

cm. Attach one part to the left-hand lower part of the card, sticking out 1 cm and layer 4.5 x 7 cm design paper to the front. Stick the two smaller rectangles in contrasting colours to the long card. Use a Versafine inkpad to stamp the image and mat on kraft card. Adhere the image as shown. Complete the card and stamp a text on the inside.

# Call me!

Cut a 10.5 x 15.5 cm kraft card. Mount 10 x 15 cm music paper on top. Cut a 5 x 14 cm strip from design paper. Adhere to card. Lay black thread across the card in a decorative way. Die cut COL1359 (smartphone) from black card. Stamp a text onto design paper. Stick the parts together using 3D-foam. Attach the smartphone. Die cut

COL1315 (tab with text) from design paper and stamp a text. Stick the small tab partially behind the smartphone. Tie jute rope around the card. Thread twine through a button and attach to the bow. Attach the layers to an 11 x 16 cm black single-fold card.



Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm kraft card. Work with modelling paste and a template. Adhere to a 13 x 13 cm white card. Tear a piece of book paper and adhere. Tie ribbon and jute rope to two labels and stick behind the book paper. Cut 10 x 10 cm design paper and fold the corners as shown. Attach to the card. Die cut COL1358 (typewriter) from

black, white and kraft card. Stamp the text onto the paper and adhere the layers together. Attach the typewriter with 3D-foam. Staple the kitchen rope to the card in a decorative way. Attach a paperclip. Stick the layers to a 13.5 x 13.5 cm green single-fold card.



Cut a 10 x 15 cm white card. Punch the corners with a corner punch. Stick paper tape across the card horizontally and vertically. Die cut COL1358 (typewriter) from black, white and kraft card.

Stamp the text to the paper and adhere the layers together. Stamp the text in the corner of the card. Attach the card to an 11 x 16 cm white single-fold card.



Cut a 13 x 17 cm nut brown rectangle, a 12.5 x 16.5 cm pearly white one and 12 x 12 cm and 12 x 4 cm from design paper. Adhere together. Die cut the text 'hoera' from pearly white card and attach to the card as shown. Stamp the text 'hiep hiep'.



Cut a 13 x 17.5 cm nut brown rectangle and 10.5 x 15.5 cm design paper. Die cut the tab from the note paper. Stick together. Die cut the word 'Birthday' from purple card and stick to the card. Die cut the parts of the typewriter from purple,



Cut a 15 x 15 cm nut brown card, a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white one, a 14 x 14 cm purple one and 13 x 13 cm from design paper. Adhere together. Cut a 9 x 7.5 cm rectangle from design paper. Mark both short sides at 5 cm from the top and cut out toward the centre of the bottom, creating a pocket. Cut 9 x 1.5 cm design paper; layer it along the top of the pocket. Fix two brads as shown and draw

Die cut the circles from pearly white card and design paper. Adhere to the card using foamtape or 3D-glue. Die cut the parts of the typewriter from pearly white, black and silver card, adhere together and then onto the circles.

black and white card. Mount on top of the card using foam tape or 3D-glue. Complete the card with deco tape and postage stamps.

stitching lines. Attach the pocket to the card, but leave the top open. Die cut the parts of the smartphone from silver and black card and from design paper. Layer them together and put into the pocket. Complete the card with deco tape and stamps.
