CRAFTABLES

Winterworld

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card and layer 14 x 14 cm design paper on top. Cut 4.5 x 15 cm and 7 x 15 cm strips of white snow with wavy tops. Adhere the high strip onto the card along the bottom and sides only, to fit a label. Decorate the top with a snow pen. Die-cut the trees from green card, the deer from kraft card and fence from brown card. Adhere the low strip of

snow and the trees onto the card. Decorate with a snow pen. Adhere the deer and the fence onto the card. Label: die-cut/emboss the corner from white kraft card and cut a 9.5 x 7.7 cm rectangle. Attach a length of lace to both sides and adhere the corner at the top. Adhere the picture. Finish off the card by adding a bow, charm and snow flake.



Cut two 15 x 18.5 cm white strips, score folds at 1.5 cm and 3.5 cm, and cut a 15 x 7.5 cm strip. Layer 14 x 14 cm and 14 x 6.5 cm design paper onto the card. Die-cut the oval from white card, layer the picture behind and then adhere onto the card. Layer the other picture onto the flap. Cut 3 x 15 cm and 6.5 x 15 cm strips of white snow with wavy tops and for the flap 4 x 7.5 cm and 2.5 x 7.5 cm. Adhere the high strips and decorate the edges with a snow pen. Die-cut the village from white,

green and kraft card. Cut out the white and green parts and adhere onto the village of kraft card. Layer brown card behind the village and adhere onto the card. Die-cut the fence from brown card, the deer from kraft card and the trees from green card. Adhere the trees with the strips of snow onto the card and decorate the edges of the snow with a snow pen. Adhere the deer onto the card. Finish off the card by adding a bow, charm and snow flake.



Cut a 14.8 x 16 cm white rectangle and 13.8 x 15 cm design paper. For the card stand cut a 7.5 x 15 cm strip and score folds at 5 and 10 cm; cut off both sides of the bottom at a slant. Attach to the reverse side of the card. Layer the design paper onto the card front. Die-cut/emboss the corner and rectangle from white card and cut out the centre. Layer onto the card and attach the pic-

ture. Die-cut the trees from green card and the deer from kraft card. Cut 2.5 x 15 cm and 4.5 x 15 cm strips of white snow with wavy tops. Adhere the trees behind the high strip and the deer behind the low one. Attach to the card. Make a snowy edge with a snow pen. Finish off the card by adding a bow and a charm.

CREATABLES

Anja's Circle

Die-cut the largest die of the circle set from mouse grey card and the smaller one from design paper. Score mouse grey card of 14 x 26 cm at 14-18.5 and 21 cm. Layer 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 13.5 x 4.5 cm on top. Apply distress ink all around. Trace the shape of the die onto a picture of your choice and cut it out. Use the long die of LR0273, die-cut a shape with the bottom half of the die, and fold it

forward to use it as a 'clip' to keep the card front in place. Assemble the card as per example; add pearls and the banner with text. Finish off the back with icicles. Tie a bow of tulle and attach. Apply distress ink onto the small die-cut shape when still in the die after embossing, to avoid messy edges.



Die-cut the two largest templates of Anja's circle set from pearly white card and die-cut the smaller one twice. Cut out the centre from one of the small shapes and die-cut the banner. Apply distress ink onto the small shapes when they are still in the die, apply ink all around the large one. Die-cut the ivy from snow paper and the corners from

silver metallic. Trace the shape of the die onto the picture and then cut it out. Adhere the picture onto the plain shape. Mount the layers onto the card as shown; attach the die-cut top shape with foamtape. Bend the corners a bit. Stamp the banner and attach.



Cut from pearly white card: the two largest dies of Anja's circle set; all circles of the Snow Globe; five icicles; the banner and the swirls. Cut the skis from mouse grey and the fairy from blossom-coloured card. Place the circles of the Snow Globe, well divided over a large picture of the decoupage sheet and secure with masking tape. Make sure they are matching well and cut out; you will get four rings and the centre. Layer these circles onto the borders of the white ones and apply distress ink all around. Adhere the circles together with

foamtape. Cut 14 x 30.5 cm white card and score at 7-14-19-21 and 23 cm. Paste the parts between 19 and 21 cm together. Adhere the design paper, stick the two circles together and attach to the centre of the easel card. Add icicles to the bottom layer. Assemble the card as per example. Decorate the fairy's dress with glitter glue. The sleigh has been placed into a small layer of silicon glue, it can be folded, but first let it dry well. You might like to add artificial snow.

ELINE'S Winter

Cut an 11.5 x 13 cm single-fold card from recycled brown kraft card. First layer 11.5 x 10 cm and 11.5 x 2.5 cm design paper on top and then a strip of corrugated card with on the right-hand side a tab in between. Cut 7.5 x 15 cm design paper, sand down the edges and adhere to the centre. Die-cut/ink the letters 'Christmas', adhere onto the

card with foamtape and stamp the text. Die-cut the circles and attach them to the card. Die-cut the tiny white clock from silver-coloured die-cut foil and tie with sewing thread and a bell around the neck of the reindeer. Die-cut/work the leaves with ink and attach. Finish off the card with a heart and make dots with a Sharpie pen.



Take a sheet from the kraft bloc and fold in half. Layer 13 x 13 cm design paper on top. Cut 12 x 12 cm design paper, work the edges with gesso and adhere onto card as a pocket, leave the top open. Stamp the text and draw a line with a Sharpie pen. Die-cut the label from off-white card, tie silk ribbon through it and place in pocket. Die-cut a circular border from design paper by using two different sizes of Nestability circles at the same time. Die-cut the off-white scalloped border in the same way. Die-cut a circle from transparent sheet, layer between the two circular borders. Draw in pencil a circle slightly larger than the aperture in the card, attach foamtape all around (see photo). A second layer can be used to create more depth. Be sure to completely seal off the edge so that snow can't fall through. Sprinkle

enough snow into the aperture and close the window. Die-cut the Polar bear, ink its snout. String a bell onto sewing thread and use tape to attach the thread to the back of the hat. Die-cut leaves and work with Maya Gold and gesso. Die-cut the star from snow paper –the flower in the centre is part of the hat die- and a dot from silver-coloured die-cut foil. Make dots with a glue pen and sprinkle confetti on top.





Cut a 15 x 15 cm off-white single-fold card. Cut 9.5 x 14.5 cm pink card, punch a border and layer onto the card. Cut 8 x 14 cm and 8 x 6 cm from design paper, adhere the small sheet centrally at the top of the larger sheet. Punch out a semi circle through the top of both layers. Adhere the two layers onto the card as a pocket, leave the top open. Add corrugated card and a tab to the card. Die-cut a Nestability circle from design paper, the scalped circle from kraft card and

the doily from white paper. Adhere together and onto the card. Die-cut/ink the hedgehog, attach to the card. Die-cut the label, string the silk ribbon and the bells through with scrappers floss and stamp the text. Die-cut/work the leaves with Maya Gold and paint frosted mint, adhere to card and label. Die-cut/ink the feet and attach to the card. Make dots with the Sharpie pen and add adhesive pearls. Finish off the card as shown.

CLEAR STAMPS Birds

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold kraft card. Cut 13 x 13 cm white card and layer 12.5 x 12.5 cm and 9 x 11 cm design paper on top. Stitch a border with the sewing machine. Then adhere 12.5 x 6 cm design paper. Stitch another border with the sewing machine. Tie a tassel to a label using silk ribbon. Attach paper tape to the other label and tie a length of jute rope around it. Add the labels to

the card. Cut 7 x 9 cm design paper and attach to the label partially. Stitch the border again. Stamp the branch onto the card. Stamp the bird and the leaves onto different scraps of design paper, cut out and attach with foamtape. Stamp a text balloon onto paper and stamp the text inside, attach with foamtape. Adhere the layers onto a single-fold card.



Cut an 18 cm Ø circle from kraft card and fold in half. Tear design paper into the right size and stitch onto the card fancifully using a sewing machine. Tie a tassel to a label using silk ribbon and attach the label to the card. Die-cut LR0185 from kraft card and adhere. Staple the ribbon onto the

card. Attach ribbon with roses to the card. Cut two birds from the decoupage sheet and layer onto the card with foamtape. Cut out the wings a second time and attach with foamtape. Stamp the text balloon onto paper and stamp the text inside. Adhere with foamtape.



Cut an 11 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card. Adhere 10 x 14 cm design paper onto 10.5 x 14.5 cm white card. Add the bag. Attach 10.5 x 5 cm design paper. Lay black thread onto the card in a fanciful way. Stamp the Christmas trees onto the label. Tie silk ribbon to the label and adhere onto the

card. Stamp the horse onto design paper, cut out and adhere with foamtape. Stamp the text balloon onto design paper and stamp the text inside, adhere with foamtape. Adhere all layers onto the single-fold card.

CHRISTMAS Celebrate

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm carnation white single-fold card and layer 11 x 11 cm design paper on top. Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper onto 14 x 14 cm design paper. Use COL1362 to cut out a circle. Make the white circular border by die-cutting the two largest dies of COL1362 at the same time. Ad-

here the border onto the card using thick foamtape. Cut out a circle from carnation white card and stamp a text. Ink the edges and attach with foamtape. Die cut the presents, flags and star and fix with foamtape.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm spring green single-fold card, and layer 11 x 11 cm design paper on top. Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper onto 14 x 14 cm white card. Cut out in the centre a 9.5 x 9.5 cm square, layer yellow card behind and cut out the square a little smaller; use a knife and ruler to make the

0.5 cm border. Attach the frame using foamtape. Die-cut/emboss the tree, flags and presents; work with ink and adhere with foamtape. Stamp a text randomly. Use COL1309 to die-cut Christmas baubles from snow paper and attach.



Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper, distress the edges, and adhere onto 14 x 14 cm white card. Stitch a zigzag line with the sewing machine. Cut out the star and layer mica behind. Attach thick foamtape to the back of the star, add shaker card material

and cover with design paper. Adhere all layers onto the card. Die-cut the presents, work with ink, stamp a few texts and adhere to the card with foamtape.

PAPER TAPE

Clean & Simple

Cut a 12.5 x 16.5 cm Christmas red rectangle and a 12 x 16 cm nut brown one. Use a tracing wheel to make a border and adhere the layers together. Make three banners from paper tape and attach to the card. Cut a 6.5 x 10 cm tag from design

paper, cut the corners slantwise, work with the tracing wheel and mat on Christmas red. Punch a hole into the tag and tie a ribbon and charm through it. Adhere to the card, raised with foamtape.



Cut a 12.5 x 16 cm pearly white rectangle and an 11.5 x 15 cm nut brown one. Adhere them together. Draw a running stitch with a fineliner. Cut three circles: pearly white 9.5 cm Ø, nut brown 9 cm Ø and 6.5 cm Ø. Die-cut the snowflake from pearly white. Adhere all layers together as shown

and attach them to the card. Cut a 1.5 x 11.5 cm pearly white strip; adhere onto the card. Add paper tape. Finish off the card with a bow of kitchen rope and make three presents from paper tape and attach to the circle using kitchen rope.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm moss green square and a 12 x 12 cm carnation white one. Emboss the carnation white one with a Design Folder. Adhere the layers together. Attach paper tape in two colours to the left- and right-hand side. Draw running stitches with a fineliner. Cut 9 x 9 cm nut brown and 8.5 x 8.5 cm carnation white card; adhere together.

Cut 6.5 x 7.5 cm nut brown; work with paper tape and stamp a text. Layer to the square. Make a bow with kitchen rope and a charm. Adhere to the card, raised with foamtape. Die-cut the word 'Christmas' using raven black card. Attach to the card as shown.
