Vintage Labels

General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. Then work the edges of the design paper, card and pictures with distress ink vintage photo and snow tex.

Die-cut LR0286 (Tiny's Pine Cones) from recycled kraft card, olive green and dark brown card.

Die-cut CR1287 (Tiny's Pine Trees) from olive green card, CR1289 (Tiny's Deer) from recycled kraft card, LR0206 (Ivy) from moss green and LR0122 (Poinsettia) from blossom card.

Work CR1289 (Tiny's Deer), LR0286 (Tiny's Pine Cones), LR0122 (Poinsettia) and LR0206 (Ivy) after die-cutting with distress ink. The deer, pine cones and poinsettia with distress ink vintage photo, the ivy leave with forest moss.



Cut an 11.75 x 18 cm single-folded card from recycled kraft card. Cut 10.75 x 17 cm from design paper, mat on blossom and then on carnation white card. Cut out the picture, mat on recycled kraft card and layer onto the centre of the card. Die-cut LR0335 (Tiny's Nostalgic Label) from carnation white card, cut out the centre and attach to blossom card. Trim along the edges and layer

onto the card using foamtape. Die-cut the small label of LR0335 from carnation white card, layer onto blossom and trim around the edges. Die-cut as per the general instructions: LR0286, CR1287, CR1289 and LR0206. Stamp the text onto design paper using Stazon ink, cut into a banner. Make a bow of lace (JU0921).



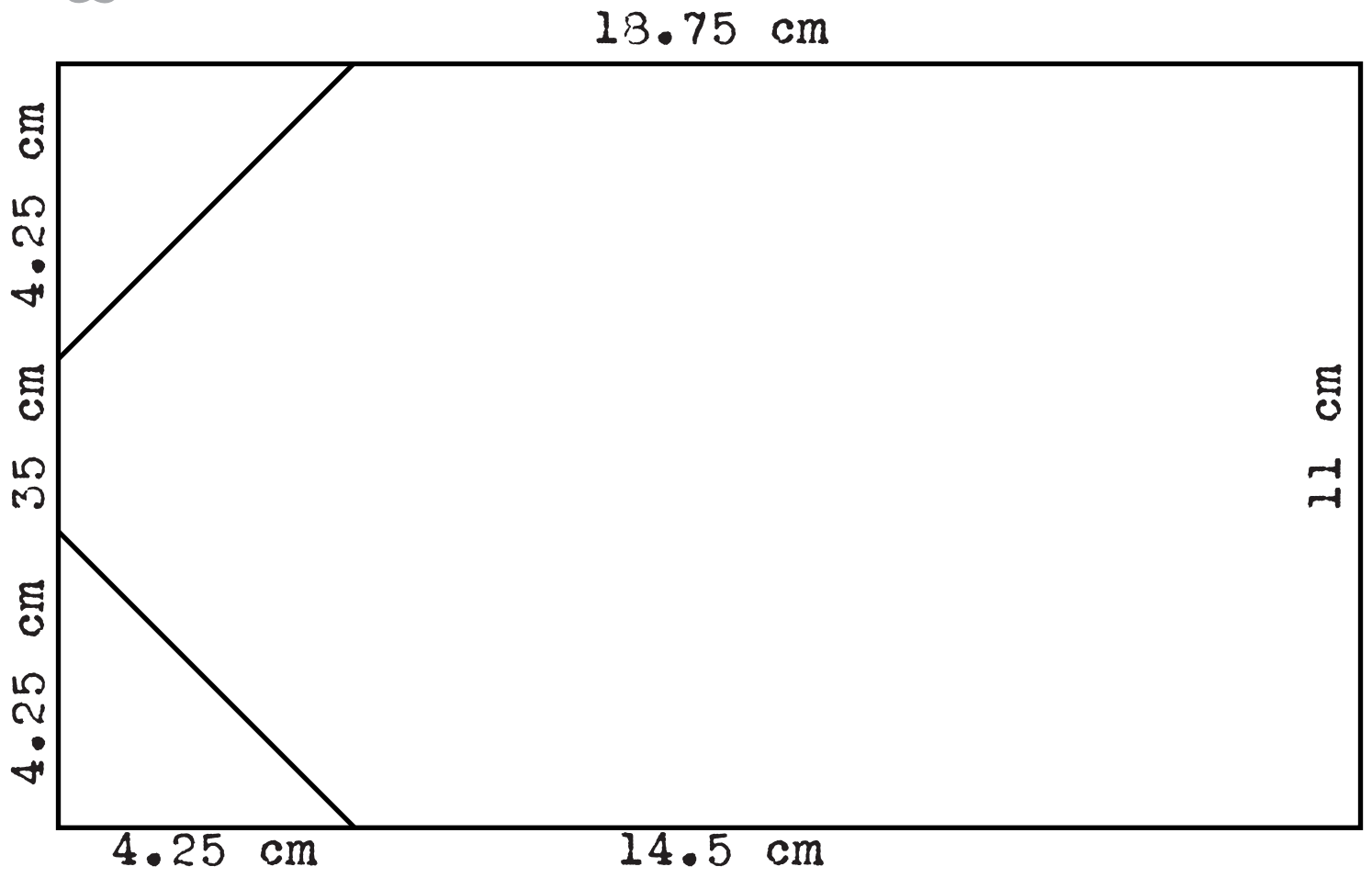
Copy pattern 1 onto recycled kraft card and design paper and cut out. Cut out the label drawn onto design paper 0.75 cm smaller. First mat on ice blue card and then on carnation white. Cut out the picture. Die-cut the small label from LR0334 (Tiny's Vintage Label) from carnation white card and layer behind the image. Then layer both in the centre of the large label. Die-cut LR0334 from carnation white card; cut out

the centre and attach using foamtape. Die-cut as per the general instructions: LR0286, CR1287, CR1289, LR0206 and LR0122. Die-cut the sled (LR0178) from recycled kraft card. Work the sled with distress ink vintage photo and Viva Decor inka gold silver. Stamp the text onto design paper using Stazon ink and trim into a banner. Make a bow of lace (JU0915).



Cut a 15 x 29 cm rectangle from recycled kraft card. Copy the pattern, cut out, score and fold as per the instructions for the pattern. Copy the front panel of the card onto design paper. Cut off 0.5 cm on all sides; mat on carnation white. Cut out the picture, work with embossing enamel and the heat tool; mat on carnation white and then on recycled kraft card. Adhere the picture to the centre. Attach a length of lace across the bottom of the card. Die-cut LR0334 (Tiny's Vintage Label)

from Papifleur card, cut out the centre and attach using foamtape. Die-cut as per the general instructions: LR0286, CR1287, CR1289 and LR0122. Die-cut the small label from LR0334 from carnation white card. Die-cut LR0336 (Tiny's Gloves) from recycled kraft card and design paper. Stamp the text onto design paper using Stazon ink, trim into a banner. Finish off the card with adhesive flat-backed pearls.

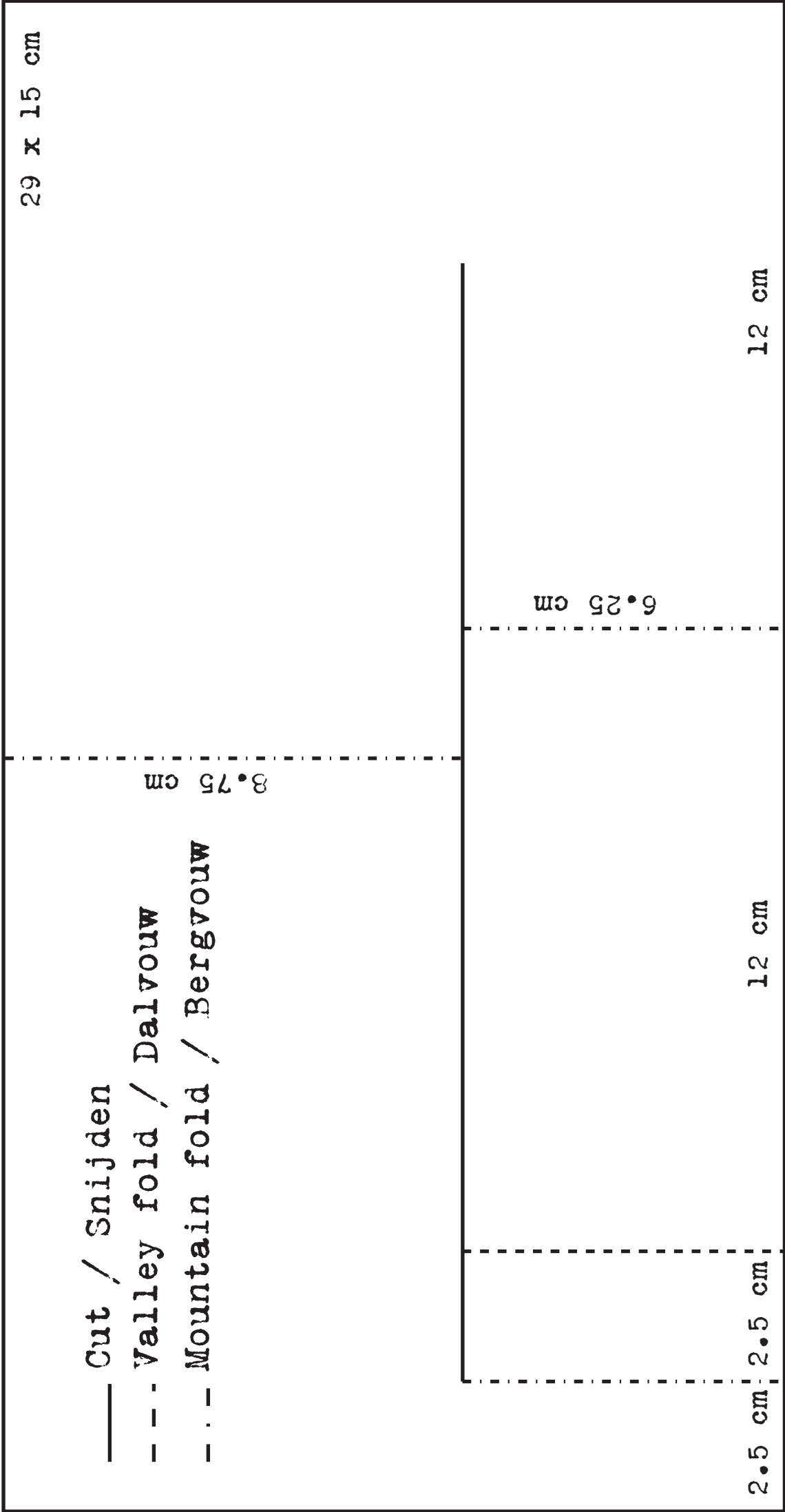

Winter cards

Cut an 18 x 24.3 cm blue strip and score at 7 cm and 17.3 cm. Die-cut the label from white card. Ink all parts with distress ink. Adhere the label to the centre of the card and trim the top leaving a narrow border. Cut off the sides at a slant. Die-cut the shape from design paper and adhere. Cut two 13 x 5 cm strips of design paper and cut the top into shape. Die-cut four trees and two pine twigs

from moss green and work with gesso. Attach the trees to the side flaps, cut the snow borders from white card and attach. Create a snow border with the snow pen. Die-cut the deer from kraft card and attach. Layer the picture with the sled, twigs and poinsettia to the card. Finish off the card by adding stars, a bow, a label and a text.



Cut two blue strips: 18 x 12 cm and 6 x 12 cm. Cut two white strips: 17 x 11 cm and 5 x 11 cm and two strips from design paper: (green and blue) 15 x 10.5 cm and 4.5 x 10.5 cm. Tear the green design paper in half and ink all parts with distress ink. Layer them together. Attach the ribbon with lace in between and leave the top of the small strip

open for the label. Die-cut the large label from white card and the small one from blue. Stamp the text onto the small label and adhere with the twigs and poinsettia. Die-cut the shape from blue design paper and attach to the label with the picture, cheese cloth and twigs with bells. Thread tulle with ribbon through the label.



Die-cut the label and gloves from white card. Work all parts with distress ink. Adhere the label to blue card and trim leaving a narrow border. Die-cut the shape and gloves from design paper. Layer the shape in the centre of the label and attach the gloves as shown. Finish off with a pearl border. Cut out the picture and layer to the card

together with cheese cloth. Adhere the gloves, twigs and poinsettia. Die-cut the small label from blue card and stamp the text onto white card. Copy the outlines of the shape and cut out. Layer the parts together and then onto the label. Finish off with tulle, ribbon and pearl stars.

Wedding & Christmas

Cut 26 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and score and fold at 13 cm. Wipe the edges of 12.5 x 14 cm design paper with distress ink and adhere to the card. Die-cut two large gates and one fence from pearly white card. Apply distress ink when after embossing still in the die. Die-cut the wedding rings and wipe distress ink around the edges. Layer the parts onto the card as shown and add

the largest picture of the wedding cake behind the fence. Attach the second layer of the gate and the rings with 3D-glue. Make two small bows from tulle and stick them to the ribbon. Then adhere them to the columns of the gate. Cut out the bridal couple and make them 3D. One of the gate doors remains closed. Embellish the wedding bells with glitters and add adhesive stones to the rings.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm red single-fold card. Cut off the top of the front layer making the bottom half 10 cm high. Attach 5.5 x 14 cm design paper. Die-cut the gate and fence from pearly white card and apply distress ink. Die-cut the fence from fiesta red too and remove the moveable part. Attach this part (without the fence) in the centre of the card front. Measure 6 cm from the bottom and draw a pencil line across the card front. Cut along the pencil line and around the fence.

Adhere 14 x 14 cm design paper onto the back panel. Attach the die-cut shapes as per example; the white doors open through the red gate. Layer the picture behind the fence doors and decorate further with stars from the Design Folder, hiding the small line; trim the tree trunk. Die-cut the tree and mistletoe from green card and the flower from red. Finish off the card by adding flowers and a bow.



Cut an ice blue 30.5 x 13.5 cm strip and score at 12, 14 and 26 cm. Cut the last part at a slant from the top left corner to the bottom right corner, creating a point. Cut two times 11.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white card and emboss in the Design Folder. Wipe a sponge with distress ink lightly over the bricks, creating a light shade. Die-cut from nut brown card two gates and one fence and wipe with distress ink, directly after embossing with the paper still in the die. Layer the gate and fence to the card front, cut out the centre of the gate

creating an aperture. Layer the second gate onto the back panel of the card and adhere the picture of Don & Daisy kissing under the mistletoe. Die-cut from moss green card the Christmas tree and mistletoe and from fiesta red: the bells, lamps of the lantern, the flower and the brick of the Design Folder. Adhere the Christmas tree in such a way that it can be folded to fit into an envelope. Layer the parts onto the card as shown and add small red bows. Attach the red bricks to the wall. Finish off with the fiddler.

Cute Bears

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold card and layer 14 x 14 cm design paper on top. Die-cut the square (CR1254) from azure blue and white card and from design paper. To make the white line: cut the white square in half diagonally and layer it behind the design paper covering the apertures. Then adhere the square to the card at a slant, using foamtape. Die-cut all part for the bear and

the flags garland and assemble. Draw stitching lines on the bear using a white marker. Adhere the layers to the card. Stamp the texts and die-cut them with LR0322. Make a flower using COL1323. Adhere it to the card with an ivy twig. Finish off the card by adding a bow of twine and a charm. Attach with foamtape.



Make a base card using the Spellbinder's stencil and die-cut a frame from design paper. Layer white card behind, worked with the Design Folder and blue distress ink. Layer the frame to the card using foamtape. Die-cut the parts for the

bear and assemble. Draw stitching lines on the bear using a white marker. Stamp a text and die-cut. Make a flower from mulberry paper. Adhere the layers to the card as shown.



Die-cut the largest Go-Kreate stencil from design paper. Layer onto cerise card and trim leaving a 0.5 cm border. Fold in half. Die-cut a circle, work with the Design Folder and a sponge with ink. Layer it to an azure blue circle and then onto the

folded card. Die-cut the parts of the bear and assemble. Die-cut the fence, bird and ivy twig. Make a pink flower. Adhere the layers to the card. Stamp a text and cut it out. Finish off the card as shown.

Paper & Pencils

Cut design paper to fit the notepad and adhere. Cut a label from design paper, mat on kraft card and adhere. Stamp a text onto the label and add the sticker of the apple. Die-cut COL1375 (Quill

Pen & Ink) from different colours of card and layer onto the notepad using 3D-foam blocks. Tie kitchen rope around the notepad. Decorate a pencil with paper tape.



Cut 13 x 13 cm white card and layer 12.5 x 12.5 cm kraft card and book paper on top. Cut 10.5 x 6 cm and 10.5 x 7 cm design paper and adhere. Fold over the corners frolicsomenly. Stamp images randomly. Attach paper tape to the label and tie kitchen rope around it. Adhere the label to the card. Cut an image from the design paper and

attach to the label using 3D-foam blocks. Die-cut COL1375 from different colours of card and attach with 3D-foam blocks. Stamp a text onto a circle and mat on kraft card. Attach the text with 3D-foam blocks. Then adhere the layers to a 13.5 x 13.5 cm red single-fold card.



Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm kraft card. Work it with modeling paste and a template. Layer it onto 13 x 13 cm white card. Tear a piece of book paper and adhere. Cut 10 x 10 cm design paper, fold the corners frolicsomely and adhere. Die-cut COL1374 (Abacus) from kraft card, red and white card and design paper, assemble the parts. Stamp a few sums onto design paper using VersaMark ink.

Sprinkle embossing powder onto the stamped images and melt with the heat tool. Attach the abacus with 3D-foam blocks. Staple kitchen rope to the card frolicsomely. Stamp a text and attach with 3D-foam blocks. Add a paperclip to a corner. Then adhere the layers to a 13.5 x 13.5 cm red single-fold card.

CLEAR STAMPS

General instructions:

Ink around the edges of the design paper using distress ink pumice stone.

Work the die-cut shapes of kraft card with distress ink vintage photo, the figures of light-coloured paper with pumice stone and the black ones with picket fence.

Stamp the sums, alphabet and texts onto black card using Versamark watermark ink and work with white embossing powder.



Cut brown kraft card into a 12 x 15.2 cm single-fold card and black kraft card into an 11.4 x 14.6 cm rectangle. Cut an 11.1 x 14.3 cm rectangle from design paper; work the edges with a paper distresser. Die cut the school slate from kraft card

and the centre from black card. Stamp the alphabet onto the slate and the pencils onto grey kraft card. Cut them out. Die-cut the quill pen from pearly white and royal silver card. Cut out the image. Stamp the ink line near the quill pen.



Cut black kraft card into a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold card and white kraft card into a 13.9 x 13.9 cm single square. Cut a 13.6 x 13.6 cm square from design paper. Die-cut the circle from pearly white, the ink pot from black kraft card, the lid

from pearly white and the quill pen from white kraft card and royal silver. Cut the round image, the map and the tag from design paper. Stamp the texts and the inkblot. Finish off the card by adding lace.



The outside: cut 15 x 24.5 cm brown kraft card and score at 11.8 cm, 12.6 cm and 13.6 cm. Draw a horizontal pencil line at 5 and 10 cm between the 12.6 and 13.6 cm scoring lines and make an incisions of 1 cm for the pencil. Adhere lace in the centre and around the outside to tie the booklet together.

the map onto it and paste on the outside and bottom only. Die-cut the slate border from kraft card and the slate from black card. Stamp the map onto the slate. Tie a piece of rope through the slate's border.

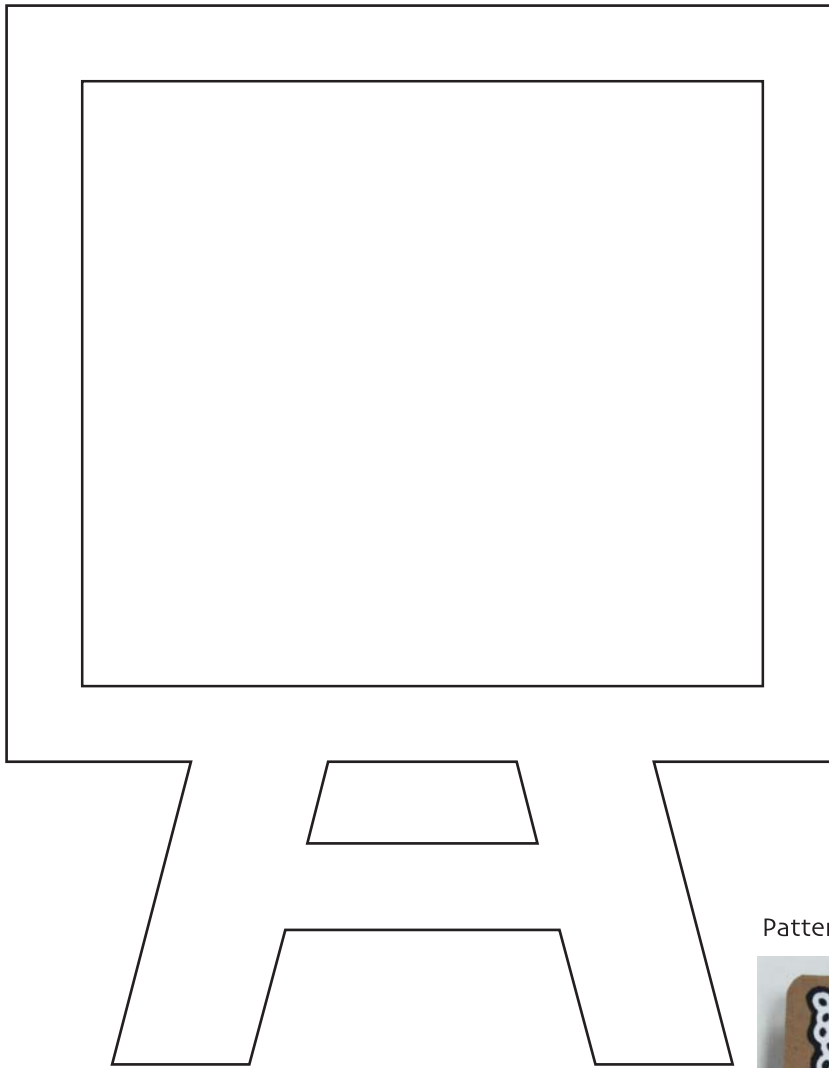
Front cover: cut 10.2 x 14.4 cm black kraft card and 9.7 x 14 cm design paper. Die-cut the abacus border from kraft card, the school slate from black card and all the beads from grass green, fiesta red, daffodil yellow, pearly white and iris blue, and the crayons from pearly white. Stamp the text onto black card, the flag onto kraft card, fiesta red and iris blue, the pencils onto fiesta red and iris blue and the pencil sharpener onto royal silver. Cut them out.

The inside: right-hand side: adhere the notepad to the right-hand side, as far as possible to right edge to make it possible to closed the booklet. Cut 10.5 x 14.8 cm black kraft card and 10 x 14.3 cm design paper; work the edges of the design paper with the paper distresser. Adhere it to the cover of the notepad. Cut a tag and dip pen out of design paper, stamp the ink doodle and attach the letters. Die-cut the inkpot from black kraft card, the lid from pearly white and the quill pen from pearly white and royal silver. Stamp the inkblot.

The inside, left-hand side: cut 10.2 x 14.4 cm from black kraft card and 9.7 x 14 cm from design paper. Cut 5.7 x 10.2 cm from design paper, stamp

The back cover:

Cut 11 x 14.4 cm from kraft card and 10.5 x 13.9 cm from design paper.
