## Horses

### Materials cover #24:

Craftables: CR1296 (Horseshoe), CR1297 (Horse), Design Folder Extra: DF3410 (Diamonds), Clear stamps: CS0883 (Happy Birthday-Congratulations), Inkpads: Archival Ink (jet black), Color Box (frost white), distress ink (walnut stain), Paint: rusty paper Viva Decor, Pretty Papers blocs: PK9109 (Kraft), PK91419 (Baroque), Papicolor card: raven black (901), pearly white (930), dark brown (938), Kraft card, Charm, Eyelets and eyelet setter, Thin rope

Cut kraft card into a 14 x 14 cm single-fold card, white card into 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper into 13 x 13 cm. Cut a white 12 x 12 cm square and emboss it with the Design Folder and an

Cut kraft card into a 14 x 14 cm single-fold card, white card into 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper into 13 x 13 cm. Die-cut and emboss a mouse grey door and work with distress ink. Then cut the top half in along the doorpost, so that it can be opened. Die-cut a white horse's head and work with distress ink. Cut dark brown card into a 5.3 x 5.3 cm square and stick it behind the open door

Cut white card into a 14 x 14 cm single-fold card and design paper into 13 x 13 cm. Cut a 12 x 12 cm white square and emboss with the Design Folder and embossing machine and trim the edges, if needed. Die-cut and emboss the big horseshoe from silver card and two glasses from white card,

Cut kraft card into a 10.5 x 21 cm top-fold card. Cut a 10 x 20.5 cm white card and 9.5 x 20 cm design paper. Die-cut and emboss a tree from kraft and green card. Work the green one with distress ink. Cut off the leaves of the kraft tree and layer the bare tree onto the green one. Diecut and emboss 4x the fence from kraft card and 4x the grass from green card and work with distress ink. Die-cut and emboss the carriage from embossing machine.
Tear the edges and ink
them with distress ink.
Die-cut the diamonds
from kraft card, work
a few with distress
ink and attach to the
square randomly. Diecut the small horseshoe



2x from brown card, layer them together and work with rusty paper paint. Die-cut and emboss the black horse and work with white ink. Stamp the text in black onto a scrap of kraft card. Cut a 2.7 x 14 cm strip from design paper. Layer everything together as shown and finish off with a bow made of rope and add a charm.

with the horse's head in between. Die-cut and emboss 2x dark green ivy branches, 2x olive green boots, 2x grass from grass green card, 2x hinges from silver (cut off the curls) 1x white bricks, 1x red bucket and 1x a spade from kraft and silver card. Work these parts with inkpads and layer together as shown. Finish off the card with a rolled up piece of rope and a bow with charm.

apply glitter glue to the bubbles. Adhere wide lace across the design paper. Stick the parts to the card. Attach a pretty bow of tulle and a few flowers to the foot of the glasses. Stamp the text onto a scrap of white card and attach to the card with a small bow of lace.

silver card and the horse from brown. Work the horse with a white inkpad. Layer the lace as a curtain behind the carriage. Attach a length of black cord or thread to the nose of the horse and the front of the carriage. Cut a semi circle of 18 x 7 cm from white card. Mount all parts onto the card and finish off with a bow of tulle and add a charm.







# Cats & Dogs

Cut kraft card into an 11.5 x 11.5 cm top-fold card. Cut an 11 x 11 cm blue square and a 10.5 x 10.5 cm white one. Stamp the mouse in the left-hand top corner and the text in the bottom right-hand corner. Using a fineliner draw a line along the white square at 5 mm in from the edge. You could use a

ruler. Cut narrow strips of 1 and 1.5 cm from design paper, kraft and blue card and make a pretty composition. Braid the strips before attaching them. Die-cut the cat and mount onto the braided part.



Fold kraft card into a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold card. Cut pink card into a 13 x 13 cm square and Baroque design paper into 12.5 x 12.5 cm. Cut kraft card into 13 x 6.5 cm, pink into 12 x 6 and design paper into 11 x 5.5 cm. Decorate the bottom edge with pompom trim. Layer the sheets of paper together. Die-cut the letters L.O.V.E from pink and string them with a double black thread.

Draw the dots with a fineliner. Fix the garland to the top of the card. Die-cut the dogs from black Crafts Cardboard and the scarves and bones from pink and kraft card. Adhere the dogs and add the scarves and wobbly eyes. Adhere the bones along the bottom. Finish off the card with hearts and use a label maker to make the texts.



Cut kraft card into a 12.5 x 12.5 cm single-fold card. Cut red card into a 12 x 12 cm square and design paper into two 11.5 x 5.5 cm strips. The paper bloc contains sheets with the same dogs. Apply ink to the edges and layer the paper together. Die-cut a blue circle of approximately  $8.5 \text{ cm } \emptyset$ . Die-cut the dogs from white and dark grey and the scarf and bones from design paper. Adhere the circle but leave an opening on the right-hand side for the label. Make a composition of the cord and dogs and attach. Add wobbly eyes to the dogs and the scarves. One dog gives the bone to the other one. Using a fineliner draw the noses. Label size: 4.5 x 8 cm. Cut off the edges slantwise and punch a hole in the middle. Using a fineliner draw a line along the edges. Stamp a text onto the label and decorate it with ribbons.

#### Label

Cut kraft card into a 7 x 13 cm label and red card into a 7 x 13 cm one. Cut off the corners, layer them together and punch a hole into it. Cut design paper into a 6 x 10 cm rectangle. Apply dark blue ink to the edges of the rectangle and the label of kraft card. Cut the pictures of the dogs from design paper and mat on red or blue; trim leaving a narrow coloured edge. Die-cut the dog from black paper and add a scarf and wobbly eye; adhere between the red part of the label and the design paper. Mount the pictures onto the card using 3D-tape. Decorate the label with cord and ribbon. Die-cut a few more bones and stick them to the red/white cord. Finish off by drawing dots or stripes onto the bones.

## Creatables

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card and two single cards: pearly white 14.5 x 14.5 cm and blue design paper 14 x 14 cm. Cut two strips: blue 14 x 3.5 cm and red 14 x 3.5 cm. Ink all parts with distress ink walnut stain. First layer the design paper onto the white card and then layer both onto the kraft card. Cut two circles: white Ø 8.5 cm and daffodil yellow Ø 10 cm. Emboss the white circle with the Design Folder in an embossing machine.

Adhere the circles to the card with the 3D-picture in the centre. Die-cut/emboss the cake and pot holders from white card and work with distress ink fired brick, broken china and mustard seed. Adhere the items to the card using 3D-tape and a piece of cheese cloth. Finish off the card with flowers, twigs and a bow with charm.



Cut kraft card into 18.5 x 10.5 cm and cut off two corners slantwise. Cut design paper into a 5 cm Ø circle, layer across the top, punch a hole and thread a length of tulle through and tie a ribbon around it. Cut two strips: white 14.5 x 10 cm and red design paper 14 x 9.5 cm. Emboss the design folder onto white card and tear off a corner. Lay-

er it onto blue design paper and tear off a smaller corner. Die-cut the motifs from blue design paper and adhere. Layer all parts together. Adhere the picture with a piece of cheese cloth to the label and make the picture 3D. Finish off the label with the Hurrah garland and a bunch of flowers.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card and two single cards: pearly white 14.5 x 14.5 cm and red design paper 14 x 14 cm. Cut 14 x 7 cm design paper. Adhere the design paper to the white card and then both together with a piece of lace onto the kraft card. Stamp the Snoesje onto a white 10 cm  $\emptyset$  circle, colour in the image with Panpastel.

Adhere the image with a piece of cheese cloth onto the card. Die-cut the cupcakes from white and brown card and attach with 3D-glue. Die-cut the whisk from silver card and the wooden spoon from kraft card. Finish off the card with flowers, twigs and a bow with charm.

# Let's Party!

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card. Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and mat on white. Adhere to the card. Die-cut CR1254 from design paper and white card. Cut the white shape in half diagonally and layer behind the design paper as shown. Adhere the layers with foamtape. Stamp

the image and colour it in with distress ink. Cut out and adhere with foamtape. Die-cut the balloons; stamp the ropes onto white card and cut them out. Finish off the card with texts.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm purple single-fold card. Cut a 12 x 12 cm pearly white square, work it with the Design Folder in an embossing machine. Adhere to the card. Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square from design paper and mat on white. Using LRo310 cut out a shape and adhere the frame with foamtape to the card. Draw stitching lines along the edge.

Die-cut the garland, flowers and leaves and adhere them to the card. Cut out the picture and adhere it too. Stamp the text, trim and mat on purple card. Finish off the card by adding a few rhinestones and adhesive flat-backed pearls.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm green single-fold card. Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm from design paper and mat on white. Adhere it to the card using foamtape. Use the Molotow marker to draw white lines along the edge. Cut kraft card into a 10.5 x 7 cm rectangle and work with the Design Folder in an em-

bossing machine. Adhere it to the card and layer die-cut circles behind two corners. Mount the 3D-picture onto the card. Die-cut the letters and balloons and adhere. Finish off the card by stamping the ropes for the balloons.

# Snoesjes

### **General instructions**

Work the edges of the papers with a paper distresser and ink around them with brown ink. Stamp the texts in black ink. Die-cut the green shapes from moss green paper, work with distress ink to make them look a shade darker.



Cut a 11.5 x 17 cm rectangle from design paper. Cut off the top corners slantwise. Cut the following parts from design paper: strips measuring 11.5 x 2 cm and 17 x 4 cm, rectangles measuring 7.5 x 9 cm and 11.5 x 6.5 cm. Adhere them to the label of design paper as shown. Then adhere to 12 x

17.5 cm kraft and 12.5 x 18 cm pearly white card. Cut off the corners again. Finish off the card with stamped and coloured Snoesjes, die-cut shapes, adhesive flat-backed pearls, ribbon and a stamped text.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square from design paper and adhere to 14 x 14 cm kraft card. Cut an 8.5 cm  $\emptyset$  circle from the centre. Layer 10 x 10 cm design paper behind the circle with the white side facing the front panel. Then divide the visible white circle into 11 equal parts, cut them in and curl the paper to the front. Add ivy branches and fold the

design paper wedges over and adhere them to the card front. Layer a Snoesjes Cardtopper behind the aperture. Die-cut the scalloped Design Folder from white card and layer behind the card. Finally adhere the layers to a 14 x 14 cm white single-fold card. Finish off with die-cut shapes, a text, lace and adhesive flat-backed pearls.



Cut an 11.5 x 17.5 cm rectangle from design paper. First adhere it to 12 x 18 cm pearly white card and then onto a 12.5 x 18.5 cm single-fold kraft card. Cut an 11.5 x 10 cm rectangle from design paper, adhere to 12 x 1.5 0 cm pearly white and then onto 12.5 x 11 cm kraft card. Adhere it to the card front, but only apply glue on the left, right and

bottom. Die-cut a 9 x 13 cm label from design paper and adhere to 9.5 x 13.5 cm kraft card. Die-cut a picture in a 6 cm Ø circular shape. Adhere onto a 6.5 cm Ø brown circle. Layer yellow roof tiles behind, made with the Design Folder. Finish off the card with die-cut shapes, adhesive flat-backed pearls, ribbon and a text.

# For the boys

Cut kraft card into a 14.5 x 14.5 cm top-fold card. Cut design paper into a 12.5 x 12.5 cm square and mat on moss green and then on carnation white card. Die-cut the grid 4x from dark brown and adhere together. Stamp and colour an image, round off the top corners, mat on dark brown and round off the corners again. Die-cut 4x grass from moss green and attach to the card using foampads. Die-

cut the footballs from pearly white, work with distress ink and attach between the grass using foampads. Die-cut the letters from mustard yellow and thread them with twine. Tie the ends to the grid and adhere using foampads.



Cut a 12 x 15 cm top-fold card from kraft card. Cut 10.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and mat on carnation white. Cut  $8.5 \times 12.5$  cm design paper and mat on night blue. Die-cut the grid 2x from kraft card and adhere to the top and bottom. Adhere jute ribbon to one side. Emboss the Design Folder from craft card and cut into a  $6 \times 9$  cm label. Die-cut the grid

from design paper too and layer onto the label. Using CR1299 die-cut a carnation white label, stamp a text and adhere with jute twine to the kraft label. Die-cut an image and mat on a night blue die-cut circle. Adhere to the card using foampads. Finish off by adding a few die-cut diamonds to the side of the image.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm top-fold card from kraft card. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and mat on carnation white and then dark brown. Emboss the Design Folder from ochre yellow card and cut into 12 x 4.5 cm, mat on dark brown. Die-cut a circle from dark brown and die-cut a smaller circle from its centre, creating a circular frame. Use CR1299 to die-cut a label from kraft card. Die-cut the grid from dark brown and adhere part of it to the label. Thread jute twine through a button and

attach to the label. Cut out an image and mat on brick red. Adhere the label and the circle behind the image. Stamp a text onto kraft card, punch into a circle and mat on dark brown. Die-cut the letters from brick red and thread with jute twine. Attach them to the card using foampads. Tie the ends of the rope to the circle and adhere. Finish off with a text.
