DON & DAISY

Clear Stamps

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General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser and distress ink vintage photo.

Draw a border of clouds, cut out and lay on the image; using a sponge and distress ink tampon a sky.

Stamp the image using Archival jet black. Use the kraft paper from Pretty Papers bloc PK9109.



Cut kraft card to 27 x 11.5 cm, score at 18 cm. Cut design paper to 17.25 x 10.75 cm, mat on pearly white card. Cut design paper to 16 x 10 cm and 6 x 9.5 cm. Work the small rectangle with DF3402 (Dutch Dots), sand down with sand paper. Die-cut COL1314 (Tab with Text) from design paper, punch a hole and set an eyelet. Tie on a charm using a length of rope. Die-cut COL1359 (Smartphone) from kraft card, pearly white card and design paper. Stamp the text using the Stazon inkpad. Die-cut DF3408 (Stars) from kraft card.

Die-cut LRO335 (Horizons Trees) from moss green card and design paper, LRO356 (Tiny's Butterflies) from design paper and LRO230 (Seashells) from pearly white card; work them with distress ink vintage photo. Stamp the image and colour in, then mat onto kraft card. Stamp ECo144 (Eline's Beach House) using the Hero Arts inkpad on the border of the image. Stamp the text using the Stazon inkpad onto kraft card and cut out two banners.

Decorate the butterfly with an adhesive flat-backed pearl.



Use an A4-size sheet of kraft card, score at 14, 15.5 and 17 cm. Fold the card and adhere the border of the short side to the back of the card. Cut design paper to 12.75 x 13.75 cm, mat on pearly white card. Cut pearly white card to 12 x 12 cm, work with DF3408 (Stars). Cut design paper to 10.5 x 12 cm. Die-cut LRO354 (Horizons Big City) from kraft card and LRO355 (Horizons Trees) from moss green card. Stamp the image

onto a 7.25 x 10 cm rectangle and colour in. Die-cut COL1330 (Football) from pearly white and kraft card. Work the ball with distress ink vintage photo. Stamp the text onto pearly white card using the Stazon inkpad and cut out a banner, mat on kraft card. Die-cut DF3408 (Stars) from kraft card. Using the Hero Arts inkpad stamp the postage stamps onto the card, and the flags onto pearly white card, cut them out.



Use an A4-size of kraft card and score at 17, 18.5 and 20 cm. Cut off the corners on one short side at a slant. Fold the card and adhere the border of the short side to the back of the card. Cut pearly white card to 13 x 16.5 cm and design paper to 12.75 x 8.25 cm and 12.75 x 9.5 cm. Cut off the top corners at a slant of the pearly white card and of one rectangle of design paper. Cut design paper to a 13.5 x 5.5 cm strip. Die-cut LRO353 (Horizons Village) from kraft card, LRO355 (Horizons Trees) from moss green card and design paper and CR1248 (Circle and Flower Stitch) from kraft card. Stamp the image onto a 9.25 cm Ø white circle; colour in the image. Die-cut LRO358 (Little Lamb)

twice from pearly white card; work with distress ink black soot and pumice stone. Die-cut LRO205 (Fence) from kraft card and LRO204 (Grass) twice from moss green card. Work the fence with distress ink vintage photo and the grass with distress ink peeled paint.

Die-cut CR1272 (Daisy and Leaves) from moss green, pearly white and mustard yellow card and LRO356 (Tiny's Butterflies) from pearly white card and design paper. Stamp the text using the Stazon inkpad. Punch a hole in the top of the card, tie on a length of ribbon and a charm. Decorate the butterfly and flowers with an adhesive flat-backed pearl.

CARDTOPPERS

On Holiday

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Cut nut brown card to 14 x 14 cm, pearly white to 13.5 x 13.5 cm and design paper to 13 x 13 cm. Adhere the layers together. Stamp them with nautic images. Cut pearly white card to 10 x 10 cm. Cut the image out of the decoupage sheet. Adhere the layers together and then onto the card. Tear two 14 cm wide strips from nut brown and position along the bottom of the card. Die-cut the shells and lighthouse from pearly white; work with vintage photo. Adhere to

the card with a piece of gauze. Die-cut the smartphone from sea green card and work with vintage photo. Attach the picture from the decoupage sheet behind and adhere to the card with foam pads. Die-cut the seagull from pearly white card; adhere to the telephone. Die-cut the anchor from silver foil, place in between the shells. Finish off the card with the text 'Footsteps in the sand'.



Cut nut brown card to 14.5 x 14.5 cm, pearly white to 14 x 14 cm and design paper to 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Adhere the layers together. Cut a scrap of card into the shape of a cloud; use it to colour a sky at the top of the card with PanPastel. Die-cut the row of houses from mouse grey and adhere to the card. Cut pearly white to 11 x 11 cm; layer onto the card using 3D-foamtape. Work the top with PanPastel. Layer sea green and design paper

on the bottom half of the card. Die-cut the row of houses from mouse grey and position onto the card creating a continuing row of houses. Cut the picture out of the decoupage sheet and adhere. Die-cut the fence from nut brown and the lam from felt. Adhere on the left-hand side of the card. Finish off the card with flowers and adhesive flat-backed pearls.



Cut nut brown card to 12.5 x 16 cm, pearly white to 12 x 15.5 cm and design paper to 11.5 x 15 cm. Adhere the layers together. Die-cut the houses of the big city from nut brown card and adhere to the top of the card. Decorate with a length of rope. Die-cut the row of trees from sea green and adhere on the left-hand side of the card

under the row of houses. Cut the picture out of the decoupage sheet, mat onto nut brown card and fix a brad at the top. Cut pearly white card to a square matching the size of the picture and work with the design folder. Adhere to the card as shown. Stamp the text. Finish off the card with rope, staples and brads.

DESIGNABLES

Sympathy

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Cut pearly white card to 10.5 x 13.5 cm and work with Designables DS0916. Layer the rectangle to an 11 x 14 cm mouse grey card and then onto a 12 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Cut design paper to 9 x 3.5 cm. Adhere to the card with a grey tag, as shown. Using LR0352 die-cut and emboss the flowers four times from pearly white card. Work with distress ink and make them 3D.

Adhere the flowers to the card. Die-cut the words 'With Sympathy' from mouse grey and pearly white card. Work them with distress ink pumpice stone. Cut off the word 'With' and adhere the pearly white word 'Sympathy' onto the mouse grey card and then onto the basic card. Finish off the card with a bow and strass flower.



Cut pearly white card to 13.5 x 9 cm and emboss with Designables DS0916. Adhere to 14 x 9.5 cm kraft card and then onto a 10.5 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold. Cut design paper to 2.5 x 10.5 cm and 2 x 15 cm. Adhere to the card, together with the tags. Cut the picture out of the

decoupage sheet and adhere.

Die-cut the text 'Heel veel sterkte' from kraft card. Work with distress ink vintage photo distress ink. Cut the text into separate words and adhere as shown. Finish off the card with a flower pearl and white bow.



Cut pearly white card to 14 x 10.5 cm and emboss/cut with Designables DS0913. Adhere to a 14.5 x 10.5 cm mouse grey card and then onto a 15.5 x 10.5 cm single-fold card. Cut design paper to 14 x 4 cm and 14 x 1.5 cm strips and adhere to the card. Cut/emboss LR0352 four times from pearly white

card. Work with various colours of distress ink and then make them 3D. Adhere to the card. Finish off the card with a bow, tag and butterfly.

CONDOLENCE

Decoupage

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General instructions:

- Die-cut the Callas flower from a light-coloured card. With the card still in the die, dab the motif with distress ink antique linen and the blending foam sponge; work the pistil with distress ink mustard seed. Then take the paper from the die and work the bottom of the calyx with shabby shutters and mowed lawn. Work the flower itself with a little antique linen.

Work:

- all leaves with shabby shutters and mowed lawn
- the edges of the design paper with dusty concord
- the jeans blue card with dusty concord

Finish off the cards with lines, drawn with a Gelly Roll pen.



Use a white single-fold card, standard size. Cut design paper to 5 x 15 cm, ink around the edges. Die-cut the Border Stitch along jeans blue card and layer behind the design paper. Mount the layers onto the card.

Cut the image out of the decoupage sheet and adhere using foam pads. Add a pearl flower to complete.



Cut a cream-coloured top-fold card. Layer a 1.5 x 13 cm blue purple strip with a ribbon across the width of the card. Layer 10.5 x 10.5 cm design paper and onto an 11.5 x 11.5 cm jeans blue card. Die-cut the Circle and Flower Stitch and

attach the image from the decoupage sheet. Finish off the card with a bow, adhesive flat-backed pearls and a pearl flower.



Cut a cream-coloured top-fold card. Cut design paper to 9.5 x 15 cm and adhere to the card. Cut the picture out of the decoupage sheet. Die-cut the flowers and leaves and work according to the general instructions. Adhere them to the card

in a pretty arrangement with the picture, using both foam pads and double-sided tape. Stamp the sentiment in the top right-hand corner. Finish off the card with a butterfly and a pearl flower.

New Home

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General instructions:

Ink around the edges of the design paper using distress ink.

Leave the die-cut shape in the die after embossing and apply distress ink.

Give the white houses a roof of kraft card and attach kraft card behind the apertures of the windows and doors; attach white card behind the windows and doors of the kraft houses.



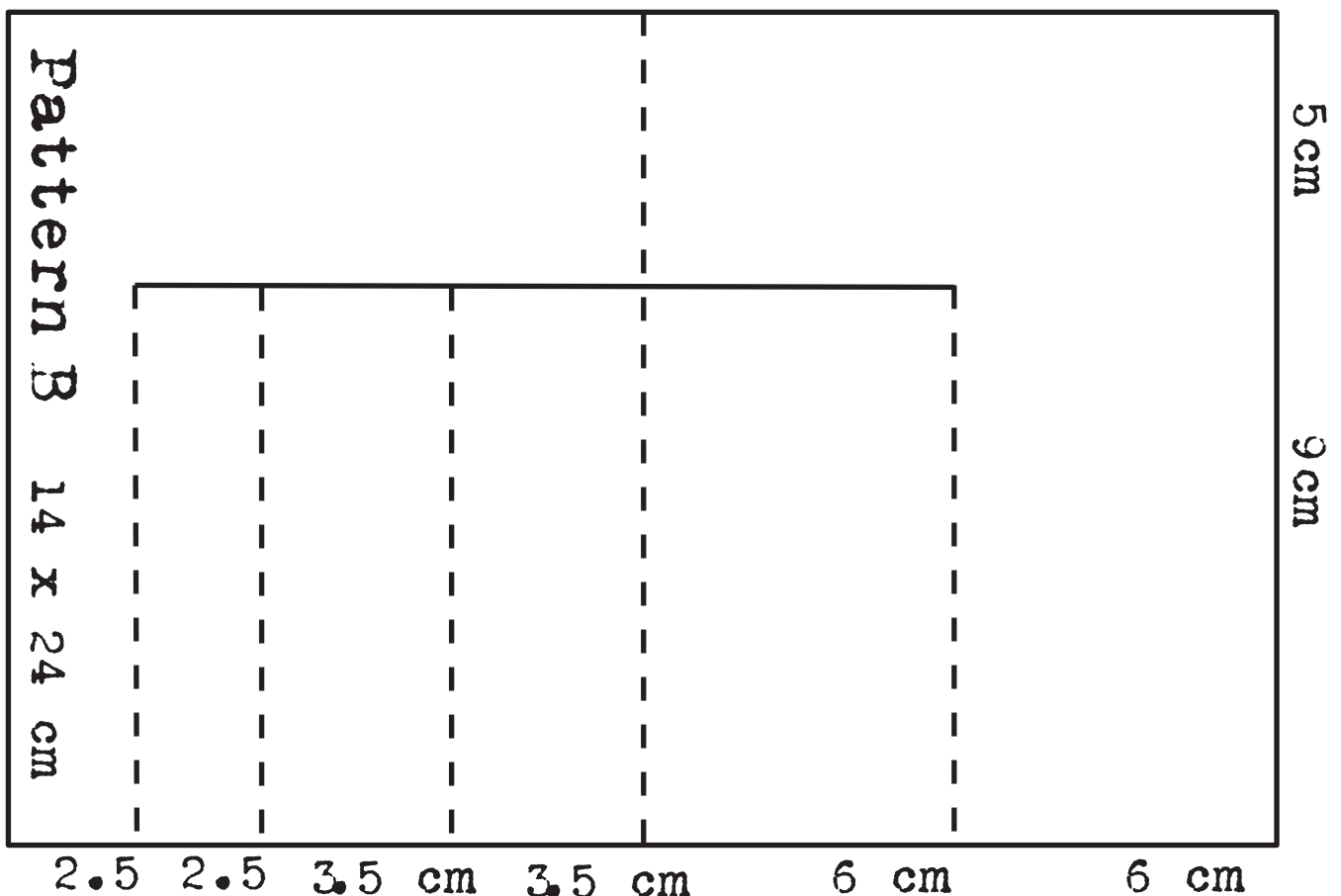
Cut a 15.5 cm Ø circle from kraft card. Measure on the centre line 9.1 cm in from the left-hand side and from that point 2 cm upwards and 4.5 cm downwards and cut in this line. Now score the steps on the right-hand side. Score the first line at the top of the cutting line (so at 2 cm up from the centre line), then at 3 cm, at 5.3 cm and at 6.5 cm. The lowest scoring line is at the same level as the lowest point of the cutting line. Fold the card and trim off any excess paper near the steps in line with the round shape of the card. Cut a 15.2 cm pearly white circle and cut in half. Cut out the part on the right-hand side: measure 8.7 cm in from the left-hand side and 4.4 cm

down from the top. Cut design paper to a 14.9 cm Ø circle and cut in half. Cut out the part on the right-hand side: measure 8.4 cm in from the left-hand side and 4.4 cm down from the top. Cut pearly white card to a 1.8 x 5.6 cm strip for the top step and 2 x 5 cm for the bottom step, on the right-hand side cut it off in line with the round shape of the card. Cut design paper to a 1.5 x 5.3 cm strip for the highest step and 1.7 x 4.7 for the lowest step. Die-cut the houses, trees, car, lantern pole, fence and cat and adhere to the card. Finish off the card with a flower and butterfly of pearls.



Cut blue card to a 14 x 24 cm strip. Score and cut the lines as per pattern B. Cut pearly white card to 13.7 x 11.7 cm and cut off a part on the right: measure 4.7 cm in from the left-hand side and 2.2 cm up from the bottom. Cut pearly white card to 3.3 x 8.7 cm and 5.7 x 8.7 cm strips for the steps. Cut design paper to 11.4 x 13.4 cm and cut off a

part on the right-hand side: measure 4.4 cm in from the left-hand side and 1.9 cm up from the bottom. Cut design paper to 3 x 8.4 cm and 5.4 x 8.4 cm strips for the steps. Die-cut the houses, trees, car, cat and text and adhere all layers to the card. Finish off the card with a butterfly of pearls.

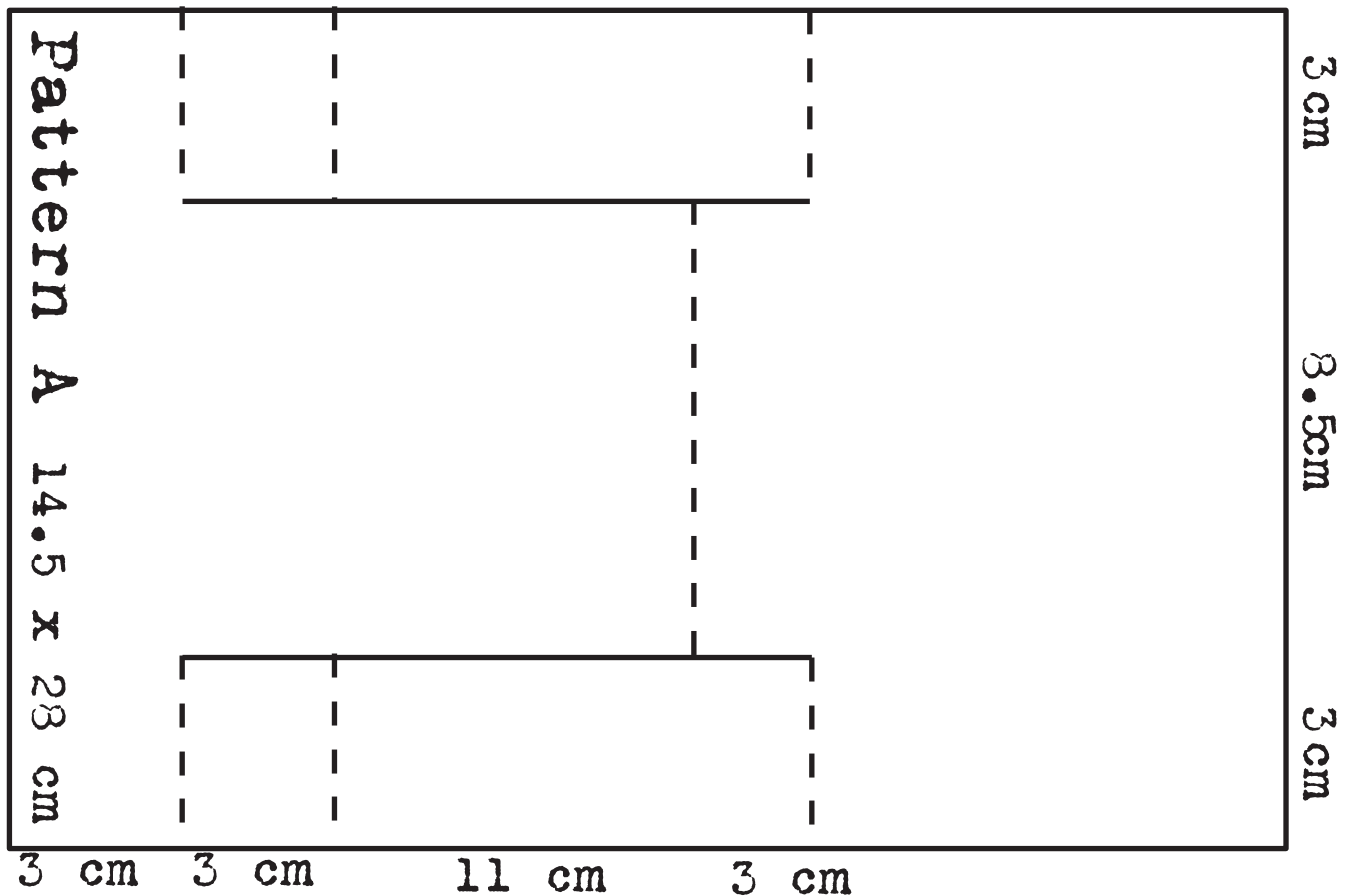




Cut kraft card to a 14 x 26 cm strip and score lines at 3 – 6 – 10.5 – 15 and 20.5 cm. Cut kraft card to an 11.5 x 14 cm card and adhere to the last folding line. Cut pearly white card to 2.6 x 13.6 cm, 4.1 x 13.6 cm and 11.2 x 13.6 cm.

Cut design paper to 2.3 x 13.3 cm, 3.8 x 13.3 cm and 10.9 x 13.3 cm. Die-cut the houses, trees, cars, fence, cat, lantern pole and text and adhere all layers to the card.

Finish off the card with a butterfly of pearls.



SILHOUETTE

Butterflies

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Cut the packet of milk as per the pattern from brown recycled kraft card and score the border. Using Versamerk ink stamp the image of the flower stamp on each side of the packet, cover the adjacent sides with a piece of paper. Sprinkle embossing powder over the image and melt with the heattool. Repeat this on all sides.

Stamp a butterfly above the flower border and work with embossing powder too. Close the sides and bottom using double-sided tape. Die-cut two butterflies, adhere together and finish them off with adhesive flat-backed pearls. Close the top with double-sided tape and add a ribbon to complete.



Cut a 10.5 x 14.8 cm white single-fold card. Stamp the border in black ink and colour in with Derwent colour-pencils. Stamp a butterfly and colour in too. Die-cut the letters from grass green

card and adhere to the card as per example.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm carnation white single-fold card. Layer 13.2 x 13.2 cm black card and 13 x 13 cm design paper on top. Use a black inkpad to stamp few butterflies onto the design paper. Cut carnation white to 13 x 5.5 cm, black to 13 x 5 cm and design paper to 13 x 4.8 cm. Adhere the layers together and tie tulle around. Position the

layers on the bottom half of the card. Die-cut a butterfly from design paper and carnation white card and place them near the bow using 3D-glue. Die-cut the text and work with distress ink. Trim off the word 'Vlinders' and adhere to the card. Finish off the card with glitter stones.
