CREATABLES

Beach

By Astrid Schipper
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Cut a 15 x 15 cm grey single-fold card and two squares: 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 14 x 14 cm. Ink the edges and adhere together. Die-cut/emboss the frame from white card and ink the shape while still in the die. Layer the picture behind the aperture and then adhere the frame to the card. Attach netting material. Die-cut the waves from

two grey strips of 6 cm high and one grey strip of 4 cm high; round off the edges. Die-cut/emboss the lighthouse from white card and ink while still in the die, layer blue card behind. Adhere the lighthouse and waves to the card. Stamp the fish, cut out and adhere between the waves. Finish off as shown.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm grey card and two squares: 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 14 x 14 cm. Ink the edges and adhere together. Die-cut/emboss the oval from white card and ink while still in the die. Layer the picture behind the aperture and adhere the circle to the card. Add some netting material. Die-cut/emboss the bucket from blue card and the spade

and beach chair (2x) from kraft card; ink while still in the die. Die-cut the spade from black card too and work the blade with Inka gold. Then layer the blade onto the brown spade. Cut the centre from one of the beach chairs and layer onto the complete chair using 3D-glue. Add a blue cushion. Adhere all items to the card. Finish off as shown.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm grey single-fold card and two squares: 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 14 x 14 cm. Ink the edges and adhere together. Die-cut/emboss the oval from white card and ink the shape while still in the die. Layer the picture behind the aperture and then adhere the oval together with jute ribbon onto the card. Add netting material. Die-cut/emboss the bucket from blue card and the

spade and ice cones from kraft card; ink them while still in the die. Die-cut the spade from black card too and work the blade with Inka gold, then layer the blade onto the brown spade. Die-cut the shell and ice (2x) from white card. Adhere the ice creams together. Adhere all items onto the card. Finish off as shown.

DECOUPAGE

Vintage Beach

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Cut mouse grey card into a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card, a 12 x 12 cm square and a 4.5 x 12 cm strip. Score the front of the single-fold card at 7.5 cm and fold back. The design paper measures 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 4 x 11.5 cm. Die-cut the required shapes from gravel and mouse grey card. Ink the edges of all layers with distress ink walnut stain. Stamp an image into the centre of the oval. Layer

the oval to mouse grey card and trim leaving a narrow border. Layer the picture behind the other oval. Layer this one onto mouse grey card too and trim leaving a narrow border. Mount all layers onto the card as shown. Attach the bow of ribbon and lace with a brad and the flowers with 3D-glue. Finish off with ice rhinestone.



Cut kraft card into a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card and a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square. The design paper measures 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 13 x 13 cm. Die-cut the required shapes from gravel card. Ink the edges of all layers with distress ink walnut stain. Cut out the centre of the oval and layer a picture

behind. Then adhere to kraft card and trim leaving a narrow border. Mount all layers onto the card as shown. Attach the bow of ribbon and lace with a brad and the flowers with 3D-glue.



Cut mouse grey card into a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card, a 10 x 12.5 cm rectangle and a 15 x 5.5 cm strip. The design paper measures 14.5 x 14.5 cm, 9.5 x 12 cm and 15 x 5 cm. Die-cut the required shapes from gravel and mouse grey card. Ink the edges of all layers with distress ink walnut stain. Layer the picture and die-cut shape onto mouse grey card and trim leaving a narrow

border. Mount all layers onto the card as shown. Attach a bow of ribbon and lace with a brad and the flowers with 3D-glu. Finish off with ice rhinestone.

Memorable Moments

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Vandaag was gezellig
 Divide the photos over the page, cut small photos to size using COL1389. The partitions can be decorated with design cards or punched-out borders. Fill the remaining pockets with cards from the set. Stamp the arrows and texts and write the journaling. Make splashes using Distress Ink chipped sapphire and Dylusions spray ink, leave to dry. Slip a tab with camera and a stamped notepad page behind the photo. Add stars and flat-backed pearls to the page randomly.

Dagje IKEA
 Divide the photos over the pages, cut smaller photos to size using COL1389. Fill the remaining pockets with coordinating cards from the set. Die-cut tabs for journaling and slip in behind cards. Stamp, die-cut and write texts. Create splashes using Distress Ink and Dylusions spray ink. Die-cut arrows and hearts and adhere to the page randomly. Finish off with sequins.



Mr & Mrs
 Slip the large photos into the pockets. Use COL1389 to die-cut the small photo. Slip cards into the other pockets. Die-cut the arrows, card with tab, letters and hearts. Stamp the texts and write the journaling. Finish off with diamond gems.

Lekker Buiten
 Divide the photos over the page. Use COL1389 to die-cut small photos. Fill the remaining pockets with cards from the set. Stamp the text. Die-cut the polaroid and date numbers and adhere to the photo. Die-cut the arrows, camera and hearts and adhere. Finish off with diamond gems.

CRAFTABLES

Family

To start with: what is needed for pocket scrapbooking? First of all you will need a ring binder album for pocket pages measuring 31.5 x 31.5 cm. Pocket pages are available with different pocket sizes. Which album and which pages to buy depends on the kind of photos you are planning to work with and the quantity. So before you start consider the possibilities and make a plan.
 How do like the photos to be printed? If the colours in your photos do not coordinate with the project cards you like to use, you might consider printing them (or have them printed) in black and white. There are pockets of 10 x 15 cm en 10 x 7.5 cm. With the aid of the computer program Picasa

a collage of two horizontal or two vertical photos can be made. These can be printed in the size 10 x 15 cm. When cut in half these photos each measure 10 x 7.5 cm. Collages with more photos can also be made to obtain smaller photos, which can be used to adhere to a photo or layered behind a film strip.
 For the scrapbook pages described here the theme 'emotions' has been used. This is the basis to make a memorable album with photos and cards.
 The Collectables, like for instance the film frame and polaroid create pretty shapes to decorate your pages with. The Collectables with basic shapes are very helpful for cutting photos to

size. And don't forget the stamps with texts and sentiments. A text written with a waterproof pen, entrance tickets and/or receipts are also interesting keepsakes to use. To keep things together tacky glue and double-sided tape can be used, but also a stapler, washi tape and even a

sewing machine to stitch papers together. Photos can also be divided over two or more pockets to make them stand out. Shift your photos, decorative papers and texts over the page to make the lay-out that suits your own photos and purpose best.

CLEAR STAMPS

Sweet Baby

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Select a few pretty photos and slip into pockets. The photos can be die-cut to size using COL1389, to make them fit into smaller pockets. Choose coordinating cards and slip into the pockets too. Keep shifting photos and cards until you are happy with the lay-out. Then start decorating



Cut a 13 x 13 cm white square and mount 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper on top. Stamp a border along the bottom. Use COL1388 to die-cut a polaroid from white card and staple it to the card. Stamp a text into the polaroid's aperture. Cut flags from three different design papers and staple them to a length of jute rope. Make a bow



Cut a 13 x 13 cm kraft card and mount 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper on top. Stamp a border along the top and bottom of the card. Tear a piece of design paper and adhere to the card. Select a project card with a suitable text, fold the edges in a decorative way and adhere. Use COL1389 to die-cut a shape

them. Write or type a text onto the cards. Use COL1389 to die-cut shapes from cork and adhere near photos and texts. Stamp suitable texts onto card, cut out and adhere or staple near photos and texts. Use CR1321 to die-cut a border. Finish off with washi-tape.

in the ends. Adhere the garland to the card. Use COL1389 to die-cut a few shapes from cork and adhere to the card. Make decorative stitches with a sewing machine in the right-hand top corner. Then adhere all layers onto a single-fold 13.5 x 13.5 cm kraft card.

from kraft card, stamp a text and adhere behind the card. Decorate with a piece of paper tape. Use CR1323 to die-cut a shape from cork and add flowers. Tie a length of jute rope around the card. Adhere all layers onto a single-fold 13.5 x 13.5 cm white card.

COLLECTABLES

Kids & Cards

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Pocket 1: Project card with text 'mooiste van de hele wereld', adhere the art work text 'Genieten'.
Pocket 2: Select a photo and cut a 1.5 x 6 cm strip from a project card and adhere. Use PL1506 (family) to stamp a circle onto yellow paper and cut out. Use CR1323 to stamp a flower from cork and adhere with the flower to the paper strip.
Pocket 3: Select the project card with green border. Cut out the text 'Hoe leuk is dit!' and adhere. Use COL1389 to die-cut an arrow and the exclamation mark and adhere. There is space left to write something.
Pockets 4 and 5: Die-cut two photos using

COL1389 (project card).

Pocket 6: Select the project card with flags and adhere the art work text 'Kiekeboe!'.

Pocket 7: Select a photo and use the dotted paper of a project card to make a 1.5 x 6 cm strip. Stamp PL1506 in blue ink. Use CR1323 to die-cut two flowers and adhere together with the strip.

Pocket 8: Select a project card with a green border with flowers and the card with the text 'Joepie de Poepie!'. Cut the text into a 4.5 x 10 cm rectangle. Draw a white line a few mm in from the edge and adhere the rectangle.



Cut a 13,5 x 13,5 cm white single-fold card. Cut a 12 x 12 cm square and 7 x 13,5 cm rectangle from design paper. Draw lines along the edges of the rectangle. Use CR1389 to die-cut a project card from black card. Use COL1388 to die-cut a polaroid from design paper, draw lines along the edges using a fineliner and adhere to the pink

project card with a flower border and cut to size. Use COL1389 (the project card) to die-cut just the text 'Kan 't zelluf'. Use COL1389 to die-cut the camera and exclamation mark. Attach the layers to the card and stamp a text using PL1506.



Cut a 10,5 x 15 cm white single-fold card, a 3,5 x 15 cm black strip and a 3,3 x 15 cm strip from design paper. Cut a 1,5 x 15 cm strip from the project card with white dots and adhere along the black strip. Cut the circle with the text 'Hotel Mama' from the project card and adhere. Use PL1506 to stamp the hearts with text onto the card twice.

Use COL1388 to die-cut the small polaroid from black card and adhere to cork, cut to size and draw a white line along the edge. Attach to the card as shown. Die-cut the camera and arrow using COL1389 and adhere. Use CR1323 to die-cut flowers from cork and design paper and adhere in the corners.
