## Creatables

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### General

The sizes are given like this: first the height than the width. So 10 x 5 cm means: 10 cm high and 5 cm wide.

Frame the grape 1x from: army green, kraft and night blue card. Make them 3D (see photo). Apply Inka Gold platinum to the grape and distress ink aged mahogany.



Cut a 21 x 13.5 cm dark brown card. Open the card up. Score (whole width) at 5.5 cm from bottom. Make a 5.5 cm incision into the fold line. Fold both flaps inward. Flip the card over; the fold comes on top.

### Inside of card:

Cut 13.1 x 10.5 cm design paper and 13.5 x 5 cm gold-coloured card for the flap. Adhere ribbon with hearts to gold. Adhere both flaps (leave centre open).

### Front side of card:

Cut 13 x 15 cm from gold and adhere to dark brown card. Cut 12.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and 3 x 15.5 cm gold-coloured card. Layer ribbon onto

the gold. Die-cut/emboss frame LR0351 with outer and inner ring at the same time; the inner ring cuts out the centre. Distress with antique linen and fold in half. Don't paste it yet. Die-cut/emboss the glass from parchment paper. See general instructions for the grape. Die-cut/emboss frame LR0351 2x from ivory, 1x without and 1x using the inner ring at the same time. Distress with antique linen. Cut 11.2 x 13 cm dark brown card and layer behind the frame. Make picture 3D. Assemble the card. Die-cut/emboss the text from kraft and distress with walnut stain. Place the die (CR1325) onto dark brown. Trace the outline in pencil and cut out. Adhere kraft card to dark brown card.





Die-cut/emboss the bottle label 2x from kraft card. Cut out the centre of one label (front side). Emboss DF3416 from carnation white. Layer carnation white behind aperture of kraft label. Die-cut/emboss the leaves from kraft and adhere

(bottom right) behind carnation white. Adhere lace between the kraft parts. Die-cut/emboss the grapes (see general). Cut out the picture (EWK1237) and make 3D.



Cut a 19 x 14 cm dark brown single-fold card. Open the card up. Score (whole width) at 5 cm from the bottom. Make a 5 cm incision into the fold line. Fold both flaps inward. Adhere on both sides, leave centre open.

shown. Attach this part as one decoration to the card.

Front side of card:

Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and adhere to dark brown card. Layer lace to lower border of design paper. Die-cut/emboss frame LRO351 from ivory using the inner ring at the same time. The inner ring cuts out the centre. Distress with vintage photo. Die-cut/emboss frame LRO240 from ivory. Cut out the centre by hand. Distress with frayed burlap. Die-cut/emboss the grape 1x from: army green, kraft card and ivory. See general instructions. Distress the ivory with dusty concord and chipped sapphire. Adhere all layers as

Book:

Die-cut/emboss the book from three layers of ivory at the same time. Cut the sides of the top page in shape, if needed. Distress the pages with vintage photo, use a sponge and make circular movements over the ivory card. Distress the edges of the pages (top and sides) with aged mahogany. Use walnut stain to create a shadow effect. Die-cut/emboss the text from kraft card and distress with walnut stain. Attach to the card as shown. Die-cut/emboss the glass from white vellum and the flower from mauve. Make a loop from dark brown satin ribbon and finish off with a rose.

# Christmas

General

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. After using dies CR1326 up to CR1329 leave the paper in the die and apply distress ink vintage photo. Die-cut CR1326 up to CR1329 from two different card colours, the colours are mentioned in the text.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold kraft card. Cut design paper: 12.75 x 12.75 cm and 12 x 12 cm. Mat the big square on carnation white card. Work the small one with DF3415 (regency), sand down the paper lightly with sandpaper and adhere both squares to the card with foamtape. Die-cut DF3415 from Christmas red and the banner (CR1299) 2x from design paper. Cut 10.5 x 10.5 cm design paper and mat on carnation white. Die-cut

CR1332 (Basic Square) from kraft card. Cut out the picture. Die-cut the text from carnation and kraft and the pinecones from dark brown card. Die-cut the bird from LRO204 (Grass) and LRO205 (Fence) and the birdhouse from (LRO206 (Ivy) kraft card. Distress the die-cut/embossed motives with vintage photo. Colour the bill and paws of the bird with and the eyes. Make a bow and tie a charm to it. Finish off with snowtex.



Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm single-fold kraft card. Cut 12.75 x 12.75 cm design paper, mat on carnation white card. Cut a 12 x 12 cm carnation white square; work with DF3416 (Design Folder Marrakesh). Cut a 10 x 10 cm Christmas red square; layer onto the card with foamtape. Die-cut the banners (CR1299) 2x and a basic circle (CR1331) from design paper. Cut a basic circle from kraft card too. Cut out the picture. Die-cut: COL1363

(Jingle Bells) and CR1287 (Pinetrees) from olive green card; CR1288 (WinterVillage) from dark brown card; LRO122 (Poinsettia-straight) from Christmas red; CR1327 (Merry Christmas & a Happy New Year) from kraft card and Christmas red. Tie a charm to a length of rope. Finish off with snowtex and add a pearl to the heart of the flower.



Cut a 13.25 x 27 cm strip from kraft card; score at 14.75; 15.75 and 16.75 cm. Open the card up and adhere the border of the short side to the reverse side of the card, creating a card with a stand. Cut 12.5 x 14 cm design paper and mat on carnation white. Cut an 11.25 x 11.25 cm square from design paper and work with DF3416 (Design folder Marrakesh), sand down the paper lightly. Cut 8.5 x 12.4 cm design paper. Die-cut CR1332 (Basic

Circle) from Christmas red. Cut out the picture. Die-cut the text (CR1326) from Christmas red and kraft. Make a bow and tie a charm to it. Die-cut LRO122 (Poinsettia-straight) from Christmas red, LRO286 (Pinecones) from dark brown card, COL1363 (Jingle Bells) from olive green and LRO206 (Ivy) from moss green and kraft card. Finish off with snowtex and add a pearl to the heart of the flower.

## POP UP

# Pinetrees

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### General

Die-cut the pop-up blocks from the same card colours as the motives. Adhere the pop-up block behind the motives on the base of the card. Use a white pen to make dots on the back of the deer. Apply distress ink pumice stone to the edges of the design paper and the embossed parts of the die-cut motives, unless indicated otherwise. Work the motives with snowtex before adhering them to the card.



Cut a 22 x 11 cm strip from brown kraft card and score at 15.5 cm. Cut a 10.3 x 14.8 cm white rectangle (top half of card) and a 10.3 x 5.9 cm one (bottom half). Cut from design paper: a 10 x 14.5 cm rectangle (top half) and a 10 x 5.6 cm one (bottom half). Die-cut the oval from pearly white card, distress the embossed parts and the centre of design paper with old paper ink. Die-cut the house from pearly white card and brown kraft

card, layer the brown roof onto the white house; layer brown kraft card behind the windows. Die-cut the row of trees from olive green and the lantern poles from brown kraft card; layer daffodil yellow paper behind the glass. Die-cut trees from moss green card and a sled from kraft card. Tie a length of rope to the sled. Add a few stars to complete.



Cut a 22 x 11 cm moss green strip and score at 15.5 cm. Cut a 10.3 x 14.8 cm pearly white rectangle (top half of card) and a 10.3 x 5.9 cm one (bottom half). Cut from design paper: a 10 x 14.5 cm rectangle (top half) and a 10 x 5.6 cm one

(bottom half). Die-cut the church from brown kraft card and layer cream-coloured paper behind the windows. Die-cut the trees from snow paper, the deer from brown kraft and the text from olive green card. Add a few stars to complete.



Cut a 15 x 18 cm brick red strip and score at 11.5 cm. Cut from pearly white card: a 14.4 x 11 cm rectangle (top half of card) and a 14.4 x 5.9 cm one (bottom half). Cut from design paper: a 14.1 x 10.6 cm rectangle (top half) and a 13.8 x 10.3 cm one (bottom half). Die-cut the horizon with houses from brown card and layer daffodil yellow paper behind the windows. Die-cut the horizon

with trees from moss green card. Cut two strips from snow paper and adhere the horizon with trees between the layers. Die-cut the text from Christmas red and adhere to the snow border. Die-cut the trees from moss green and the deer from brown kraft card. Add a few stars to complete.

# Favourites

Cut a 15 x 15 cm silver grey single-fold card and single cards: 14.5 x 14.5 cm white, 14 x 14 cm brown design paper and 5.5 x 14 cm chequered green design paper. Ink the edges of the design paper and adhere the layers to the card. Die-cut/emboss the star and the text from white card; ink the paper while still in the die. Layer the picture behind the star. Die-cut green trees and adhere to

the card together with the star. Die-cut the deer from kraft card, ink them and make white dots on their backs. Adhere them to the card. Cut a white strip with a wavy line and adhere to the bottom of the card. Apply snow. Attach the text with foamtape. Add flowers, twigs, stars and a bow to complete.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm silver grey single-fold card and two single cards: white 14 x 14 cm and design paper 13.5 x 13.5 cm. First adhere the layers together with the lace and then onto the card. Die-cut/emboss the star and the text, ink while still in the

die. Adhere the star to snow paper and trim. Adhere the star to the card. Layer the picture onto a 8.5 cm Ø silver grey circle and then onto a 9 cm Ø white one. Attach the layers with foamtape. Add flowers, twigs, stars and a bow to complete.



Cut a 15 x 15 cm silver grey single-fold card and two single cards: white 14 x 14 cm and design paper 13.5 x 13.5 cm. First adhere the layers together and then onto the card. Die-cut/emboss the star and the text, ink while still in the die. Cut out the

small star in the centre of the big star. Layer the small star onto snow paper and trim. Layer the picture to the separate star and trim. Adhere the stars as shown. Attach the text with foamtape. Add flowers, twigs, stars and a bow to complete.

# Winter

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General instructions for pop-up card  
Die-cut the blocks from cardstock and adhere together. Adhere them behind the die-cut and stamped motives. Be sure to adhere a part to the top half of the card and one to the bottom half of the card. Create an extra 3D-effect by using smaller and bigger blocks. All parts should be linked together by pop-up blocks, so they all unfold when the card is opened. Ink all paper edges with distress ink.



Fold a sheet of kraft (PK9114) in half. Adhere to each half: carnation white card (14.5 x 14.5 cm) and design paper (14 x 14 cm). Die-cut the oval from stamping cardstock. Stamp the image with transparent ink; use a sponge to apply PanPastel in circular movements. Distress the rest of the

oval too. Die-cut the big pop-up block and adhere to the card; attach the oval. Die-cut the oval from night blue card, using the die of the inner ring too. Die-cut three small pop-up blocks and adhere two of them to the bottom of the oval. Cut one block in half lengthwise and adhere to the top of

the oval. Adhere the rest of the decoration. Finish off the top half of the card with a bow of jute rope and add a few stars to complete. Cut a 15 x 3 cm strip from kraft card and a 15 x 2 cm one from design paper for the bottom half of the card. Ad-



Cut a 20 x 12 cm night blue strip. Fold in half and place a little over half of the oval die. Die-cut the card. Die-cut the oval die once again. Layer the parts together till the fold line. Ink the sides using a white inkpad. Cut out the centre of the oval of design paper. Die-cut the large pinetrees 2x from kraft card and the small one from snow paper. Adhere the layers to the card. Stamp the images using transparent ink; apply PanPastel in

here together and onto the bottom half of the card and place the pinetrees on top. Make a floral arrangement with holly leaves, deer, pinecones and the half circle with stars.

circular movements, using a sponge. Repeat this for the text. Die-cut the small pop-up block 2x, adhere together and attach to the card with the image. This is not a real pop-up card, but it has a 3D-effect; it can be folded easily and put in an envelope. Make a floral arrangement with holly leaves, jingle bells and a paper flower. Add a few diamond gems and a bow of jute rope to finish.



Cut a 13 x 13 cm white single-fold card. Adhere to each half of the card: kraft card (12.5 x 12.5 cm) and design paper (12 x 12 cm). Die-cut Petra's Bells from pearly white card and adhere to the card halves with five small pop-up blocks (see general instructions). Stamp the image with transparent ink; apply PanPastel in circular move-

ments, using a sponge. Repeat this for the text. Adhere the image to the card. Die-cut the oval from night blue card and cut out a corner. Make a floral arrangement with holly leaves, skis and falling stars; place the text in between. Add a few stars and a diamond gems to complete.

# Birthday

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General

Apply distress ink to the edges of the card, design paper, pictures and die-cut shapes.



Cut a 15 x 29.5 cm blossom-coloured strip and score at 3, 6, 10, 14, 19, 24 and 26.5 cm; fold the zigzag card. First standing fold: cut a 4 x 15 cm strip from metallic pearl white card and die-cut the flower border. Cut a 1.5 x 15 cm strip from design paper; adhere to the card. Second standing fold: cut a 3.5 x 15 cm strip from metallic pearl white and 4.5 x 15 cm from design paper; die-cut the fine border from the design paper. Die-cut/emboss the text from metallic pearl white and adhere to the card. Third standing fold: cut a 4.5 x 15 cm metallic pearl white strip and 5.5 x 15 cm design paper. Die-cut the fine border from the design paper and adhere to the card.

Fourth standing fold: cut a 2 x 15 cm pearl white strip and a 3 x 15 cm one from design paper. Die-cut the fine border from the design paper and adhere to the card. Die-cut the oval from metallic pearl white card, trace onto design paper, and trim leaving a narrow border. Repeat with metallic pearl white and blossom-coloured card. Cut out the picture, adjust the size to the oval and adhere the oval together. Die-cut/emboss two swirls from metallic pearl white card. Adhere the oval and swirls to the third standing fold. Add a bow of tulle with a charm and diamond gems to complete.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm blossom-coloured single-fold card, a 14 x 14 cm metallic pearl white card and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper. Place the die with the fine border onto the design paper at a slant, stay 1 cm away from the edges. Run through the cutting machine to create a slit for the labels. Labels: cut two 7 x 10.5 cm rectangles from metallic pearl white card and cut off two corners

slantwise. Punch a hole in the top for a ribbon. Cut out the picture and adhere to the label. Cut out four butterflies from the decoupage sheet, layer two onto the card and two onto the labels and stamp a text next to it. Tie the ribbons to the labels. Die-cut/emboss the text from metallic pearl white card and adhere at a slant. Slide the labels into the slit.



Cut a single-fold card and a single metallic pearl white card of 14.8 cm wide and 15 cm high. Die-cut the flower border on each side of the single card. Cut 14.4 x 15 cm and 9 x 15 cm from design paper. Die-cut the Craftable circle from metallic pearl white card. Cut out the picture and adhere to the circle. Die-cut six Creadable flowers, curl

the petals using an embossing tool with a big tip. Layer them together two by two and add stamen through the hole. Die-cut olive green leaves and adhere to the card. Complete the card with a bow of tulle with a charm and add diamond gems.
