Cover card

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Materials:

Craftables: CR1279 (Ocean set), CR1363 (Punch die, Shells and Starfish), CR1364 (Punch die, Fish and Seahorses), CR1366 (Thank you), Creatables: LR0416 (Tiny's Tall Ship), LR0418 (Ropes), Clear stamps: TC0839, Inkpad: Versafine, Distressink: brushed corduroy, pumice stone, Design paper: PK9133 (Nautical), Papicolor card: Metallic 330 (pearl white) en Recycled kraft (grey), Dark blue card, Moss and broken shells

Cut a 22 x 14 cm blue strip and fold at 9 cm. Cut two single cards: white 12 x 13 cm and design paper 11.5 x 12.5 cm. Work the white card and design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Adhere to the card. Die-cut two pop-up blocks of the largest size from blue card and adhere to the back and the bottom. Cut a 9 x 14 cm strip from design paper and adhere to the card. Stamp the sea 2x onto design paper and cut off along the top. Adhere one part against the pop-up blocks. Score the other part somewhere in the centre and cut off the bottom. Adhere this part to the bottom card, leaving some distance between this part and the first one, so the ship can be placed in between the waves. Die-cut the tall ship 2x, cut off a few sails and adhere to the complete ship using 3D-glue. Work the ship with distress ink brushed corduroy. Adhere the tall ship and the mooring post between the two layers of sea. Finish off with a text and shells.

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General: When in this shaker card foamtape is used, apply glue as well for a stronger bonding.



Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1364 (Fish and Seahorses), CR1366 (Thank you), Creatables: LR0417 (Porthole and Steering wheel), LR0418 (Ropes), Die-cut and embossing machine, embossing mat, Inkpad: Memento summer sky, Distress ink: vintage photo, weathered wood, spiced marmalade, dried marigold, shabby shutters, mustard seed, Design paper: PK9133 (Nautical),

PK9114 (Kraft), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), metallic (334), pearl white (330), Corrugated card, Transparent sheet (mica), Blue paint, Blending tool, Deco paint: blue, Foamtape: 2 mm and 6 mm, Jute, Gems: JU0955 (metal), Sponge, White gelpen, black pen

Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white single-fold card, 13.5 x 13.5 cm corrugated card, 13 x 13 cm design paper and 8 x 10 cm jute. Cut an 8 cm Ø circle from mica and design paper. Work the corrugated card with a droplet of blue deco paint and a dry sponge by wiping paint on random places. Tear the edges of the square design paper randomly. Adhere the design paper, jute and circle to the single-fold card. Avoid adhering the torn edges! Use a little water to moisten the torn edges on the white side and curl them forward. Set aside to dry. Die-cut and emboss the porthole from metallic. Work the accents with the blending tool and distress ink weathered wood, with the paper still in the die. Clean the die with a damp cloth. Die-cut and emboss the ropes and the anchor from kraft and work with distress ink vintage photo, with the paper still in the die. Die-cut the text from pearly white card. Die-cut and emboss the fish from pearl white (330) card. Remove the fish and seahorses from the die and work with the blending tool, various colours of distress ink and the Memento inkpad. Draw eyes and accents with a black pen and place white dots in the eyes. Set aside to dry. Adhere fish and seahorses to the round design paper, using 0.2 mm foampads and glue. Place a few smaller fish in the centre as shaker material. Adhere 0.6 mm foamtape and glue all around one side of the mica, making sure there are no gaps in between. Adhere the other side of the mica behind the porthole. Apply glue to the other side of the foamtape and mount the porthole on top of the round design paper with the fish. Set aside to dry. Then adhere all layers to the base card. Finish the card off.

Cut a pearly white 14 x 10.5 cm single-fold card. Cut 13.5 x 10 cm corrugated card and 13 x 2.5 cm and 13 x 7 cm (2x) design paper. Cut from one of the rectangles a window at 1 cm in from the edges. Cut 13 x 7 cm mica. Stamp the fishing net in black ink onto the mica. Adhere foamtape (0.6 mm) along the borders on the reverse side. Work with distress ink and adhere the fish and seahorses, as per the instructions of shaker card 1. Cut out the picture and adhere ropes around the borders. Adhere all layers to the card. Finish off with a gem.

Follow the instructions for card above. Cut also 2.5 x 10 cm corrugated card, 2 x 10 cm design paper and 5 x 9.5 cm jute. Die-cut the charter from kraft. Make a few creases and work these and the edges with distress ink vintage photo. Stamp the letters in black ink. Attach (with glue for stronger bonding) foam pads behind the charter. Adhere all layers to the card. Finish off with gems.

Follow the instructions for the first shaker card. Die-cut a tag from kraft and stamp the text in black ink. Thread a length of rope through the tag and adhere to the card. Stamp the fishing net onto kraft and cut out along the rope. Adhere all layers onto the card. Finish off with gems.

Creatables: LR0418 (Ropes), Clear stamps: TC0839, Inkpad: Versafine, Distressinkt: pumice stone, Design paper: PK9133 (Nautical), Papicolor card: Metallic 330 (pearl white) en Recycled kraft (grey), Dark blue card, Moss and broken shells

Cut a 13.5 x 20.5 cm blue strip and two single cards: white 13 x 12.5 cm and design paper 12 x 11.5 cm. Work the design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Cut a 10.5 x 7.5 cm aperture from the centre. Die-cut and emboss two white borders and adhere with the white card to the blue strip. Cut out the aperture again leaving a narrow blue border. Cut for the back of the card a 13.5 x 18 cm blue strip and score folds at 1 cm, 2.25 cm, 3.5 cm, 14.5 cm, 15.75 cm and 17 cm. Glue the picture in the centre and then adhere the strip behind the aperture in the base card. Stamp the fishing net from kraft, cut out and adhere a piece behind the aperture. Die-cut the ropes, mooring post and steering wheel from kraft and adhere to the card with the fish, seahorses, anchor and the moss. Die-cut the text from blue card and mat on white. Punch a hole, tie rope through it and adhere the text to the card with foamtape.

Creatables: LR0417 (Porthole and Steering wheel), LR0419 (Charter), Clear stamps: CS0858, Decoupage sheet: Matties mooiste MB0150, Ribbon: JU0949

Cut a 14 x 17 cm blue strip. Die-cut the border from white card and adhere to the blue strip together with a 13 x 12 cm white rectangle. Cut 12.5 x 11.5 cm design paper, work with distress ink and adhere to the card. Mat the picture on blue card and adhere. Die-cut the rope from kraft and adhere. Stamp the fishing net from kraft, cut it out and place a piece in the top right-hand corner. Die-cut and emboss the charter from white card and ink with distress ink pumice stone. Stamp the text and adhere it with the steering wheel, bottle, rope and moss to the card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm blue single-fold card and two single cards: white 14 x 14 cm and striped design paper 13.5 x 13.5 cm. Cut a 6.5 x 13.5 cm strip of design paper too. Work the white card and design paper with distress ink pumice stone. Adhere the layers together. Adhere ribbon and rope across the card. Die-cut and emboss the porthole and steering wheel from dark brown card and work with Inka gold copper. Layer the picture behind the porthole and then adhere to the card using foamtape. Die-cut the charter from white card and work with distress ink pumice stone. Stamp the text. Stamp the fishing net onto kraft and cut out. Die-cut the rope and adhere to the card together with the fishing net, charter and steering wheel. Finish off with seagulls and shells.

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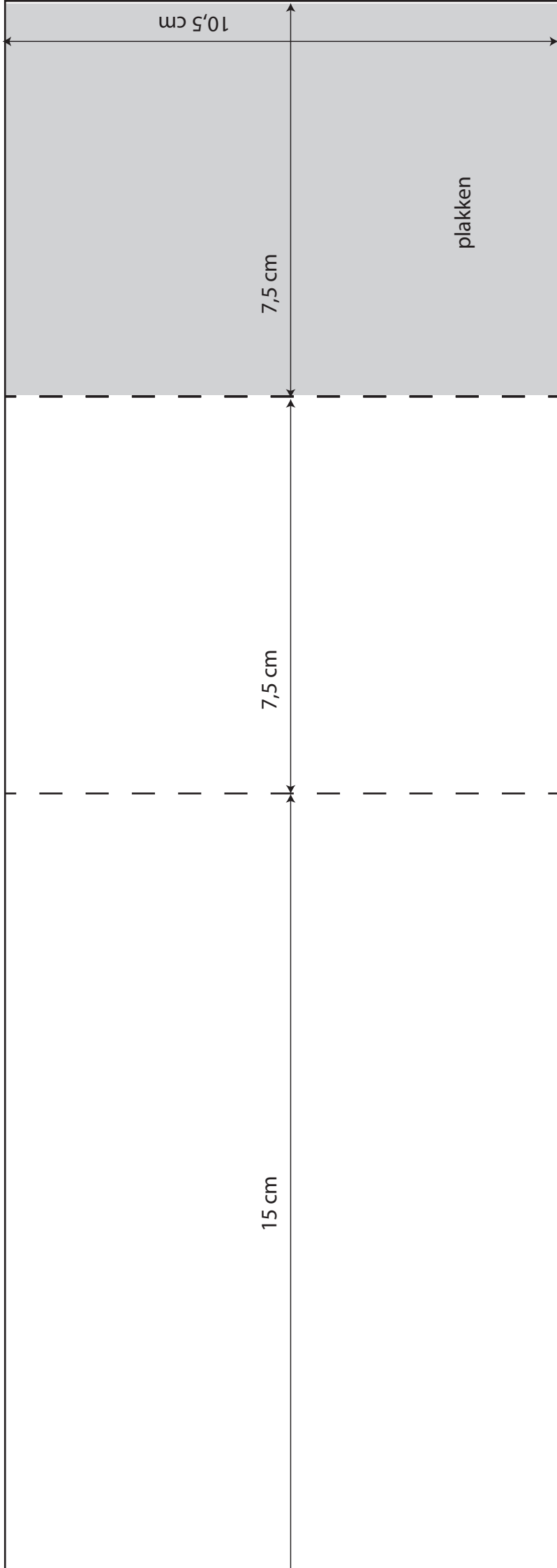
Materials:

Craftables: CR1279 (Tiny's Ocean set), CR1363 (Punch die-Shells and Starfish), PL1516 (Algemeen-used for banner), Creatables: LR0371 (Oval and Pop-up blocks), LR0416 (Tiny's Tall Ship), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: EC0144 (Eline's Beach House), TC0838 (Tiny's Surf), Inkpad: Memento tuxedo black, Distress ink: antique linen, pumice stone, walnut stain, Design paper: PK9133 (Nautical), Papicolor card: Recycled

kraft grey (322) and Original pearly white (930), Rope: JU0949 (Maritime), Gems: JU0955 (metal), Snowpen

Trace the pattern of the card onto white card and cut out. Cut 10 x 14.5 cm sand-coloured design paper and adhere to the bottom of the card. Fold the other half of the bottom over the sand-coloured paper into an easel. Top part of the card: stamp the waves 3x onto design paper and work them with distress ink and a snowpen. First wave: cut off along the top and bottom. Layer sand-coloured paper behind and adhere to the first part of the card. Second wave: cut off along the top, cut off the bottom at 4.5 cm. Adhere to the second part of the card. Third wave: cut off along the top, cut off the bottom in a straight line at 5.5 cm. Cut 10 x 14.5 cm striped design paper, attach the third wave and adhere onto the card. Die-cut the boat, banner, mooring post, seagull and shells from white card and kraft. Work them with distress ink and then adhere to the card. Adhere a pop-up block behind the mooring post. Finish the card off.

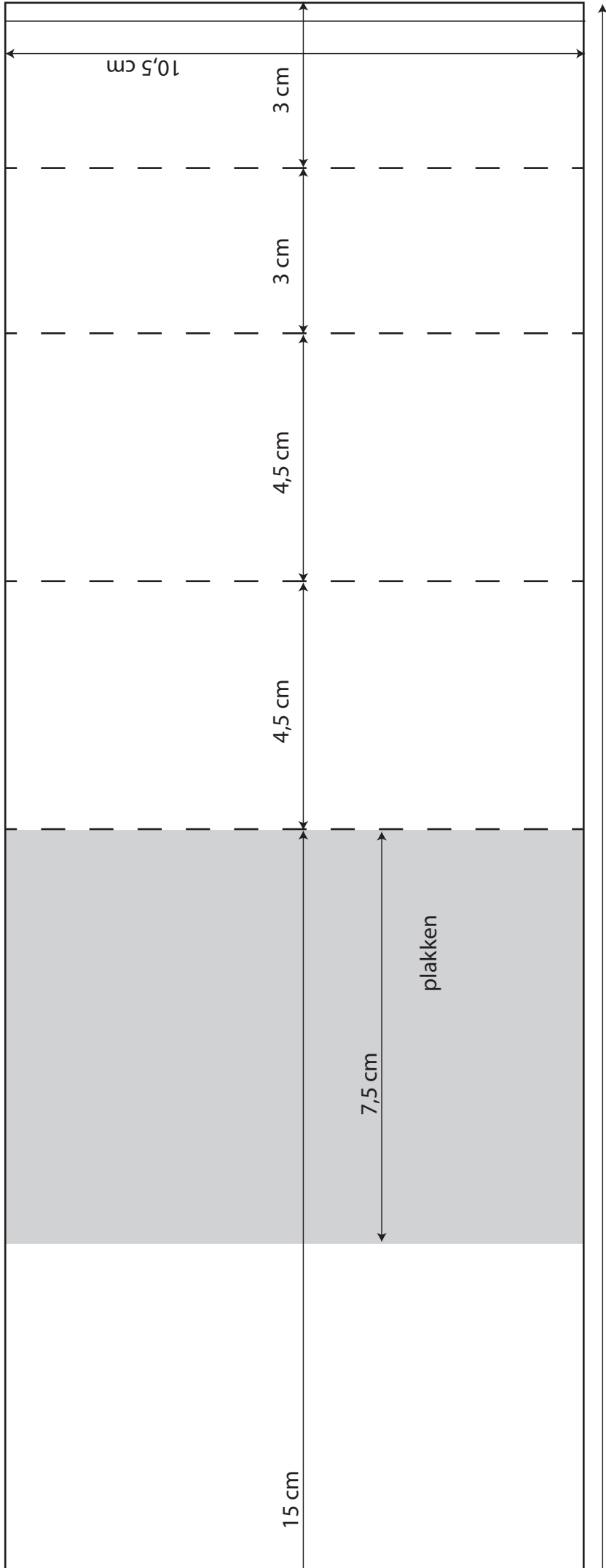

Materials for both cards:

Craftables: CR1350 (Circle),
Creatables: LR0380 (Knitting),
Design folders extra: DF3427
(Cross-stitches) and DF3418
(Knitting), Die-cut and embossing
machine, Decoupage: VK9544
(Beary Cute), Kraft card: PK9109,
Papicolor card: carnation white
(903), brick red (935), blue
(955), Cocktail sticks, Enamel
stickers: PL4503 (black and
white), Glue: Aleene's tacky glue,
Ribbons: JU0950

Cut a 12.5 x 1.5 cm carnation white card and emboss the knitting pattern. Then cut into a 12 x 12 cm square. Die-cut and emboss hearts in three colours. Die-cut the knitting pattern in the same colours. Remove the die carefully, most of the knitting stitches will remain in the die, they can be pressed out easily. Place a bit of glue on a piece of scrap paper and use a cocktail stick to apply the glue onto the white embossed stitches. Lay the coloured stitches on top and press down with a clean cocktail stick. Die-cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm brick red square and fold a kraft card. Cut out the picture and mat of kraft. Adhere all layers to the card and finish off with enamel dots.

Tip:

First cut out the cards from coloured A4-sheets. Then die-cut the hearts and stitches from the rest of the paper.

Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm carnation white card and emboss the cross-stitch pattern. Then cut into a 12 x 12 cm square. Die-cut and emboss the hearts. Die-cut the circle from kraft. Cut out the picture and layer onto the kraft circle. Die-cut the cross-stitches in three colours. Remove the die carefully, most cross-stitches will remain in the die, they can be pressed out easily. Make a pattern in the corners using all three colours. Place a bit of glue on a piece of scrap paper and use a cocktail stick to apply the glue onto the white embossed stitches. Place the coloured stitches on top and press down with a clean cocktail stick. Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm brick red square and a 13.5 x 13.5 cm blue single-fold card. Adhere all layers to the card and add a blue bow to the hearts.



By Boukje van der Weit
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General:

- Ink around the edges of the design paper with distress ink walnut stain.
- Cut in the flowers (COL1316) between the petals and then roll each petal around a tooth pick to shape them.
- Work the leaves (LR0398) met Inka Gold green/yellow.
- Die-cut the spoons (CR1237, CR1238) from card layered with metal tape and shape them with an embossing tool.

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white top-fold card. Cut 14 x 9.5 cm design paper and mat on kraft and then adhere against the fold with a small folded ribbon sticking out on the left. Adhere a corrugated strip along the top of the card. Adhere paper tape at 3 cm in from the left. Die-cut the giftcard (LR0420) from design paper and a frame from carnation white card to layer behind. Die-cut a charter (LR0419) from pearly white and work with distress ink vintage photo. Make dots with the perlenpen. Die-cut the text from dark brown card. Adhere a flower, leaves and spoon to the bottom left corner. Finish off the top with a flower and leaves. Add a gem to the hearts of the flowers.

Materials:

Collectables: COL1319 (Tiny's Butterfly-3), Creatables: LR0317 (Petra's Circle-Crown), LR0398 (Build a rose), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamp: PL1524 (Verjaardag), Inkpads: Archival jet black, Distressink black soot, bundled sage, dusty concord, scattered straw, shaded lilac, tumbled glass, walnut stain, Design paper: PK9113 (Flower

Garden), Card: white, Watercolour paper, Bells: purple, Sweet lace: JU0934 (Tiara), Mini-mister, Paper flowers: RB2238 (Rose bud, white), RB2244 (Rose, white), RB2256 (Carnation, white), Perlenpen: eisweiss, Tacky Glue, Rope, Tulle: light blue

Cut a 10.5 x 25.2 cm white strip and score at 6.3 cm and 19 cm, fold the flaps forward. Cut design paper into two 5 x 9 cm rectangles, mat on kraft and adhere to the folded flaps. Take 50 cm of ribbon and layer horizontally across the centre of the flap on the left and onto half of the reverse side of the card. Let the ribbon on the right-hand side hang loose, to make it easy to open the card. Thread both ends of the ribbon through a wooden bead and tie a knot in the ends. Die-cut design paper into a carnation white giftcard (LR0420) and a frame. Stamp the text and adhere to the flap on the left. Decorate with a flower, leaves, a spoon and the V-shapes (DF3407); make dots with the perlenpen. Die-cut design paper into a giftcard and frame for the inside and adhere. Stamp the text and hearts and decorate with a flower, leaves and V-shapes. Close the card by pushing the bead towards the card.

Cut a 13 x 13 cm white single-fold card. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and ink around the edges with distress ink walnut stain. Die-cut and emboss the circle border and the straight circle, work the straight circle with distress ink tumbled glass and bundled sage. Make splashes with shaded lilac. Stamp, die-cut and emboss the butterfly from watercolour paper and colour in with distress ink walnut stain, black soot, bundled sage, tumbled glass en scattered straw. Adhere to the card with foamtape. Colour the flowers with a mini-mister: mix distress ink with water and spray it onto the flowers. Set aside to dry or use a heat tool. Die-cut the leaves and colour with bundled sage and tumbled glass. Make a bow of lace and tulle, tie to the flowers using rope with bells. Adhere the bow, flowers and leaves to the card with foamtape and tacky glue. Stamp the text and make dots with the perlenpen.

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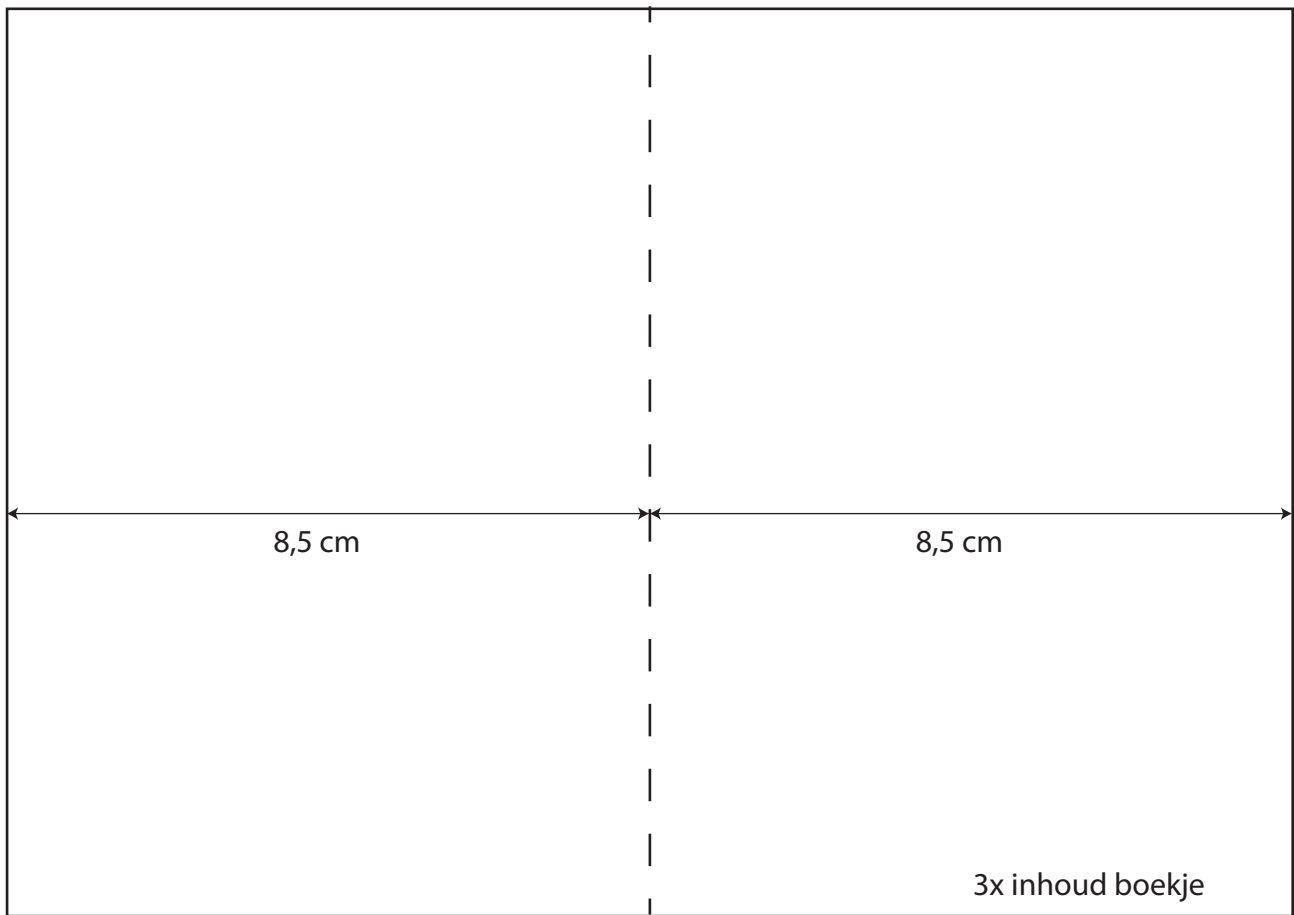

Craftables: CR1351 (Basic Hearts-Dankjewel), Creatables: LR0420 (Giftcard), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0972 (Tegoedbon), Inkpad: Memento tuxedo black, Design paper: PB7047 (Eline's Peach & Mint), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Parchment paper, Silver-coloured card, Enamel stickers: PL4504 (pink and mint green), Ribbon: JU0951 (Victorian Christmas)

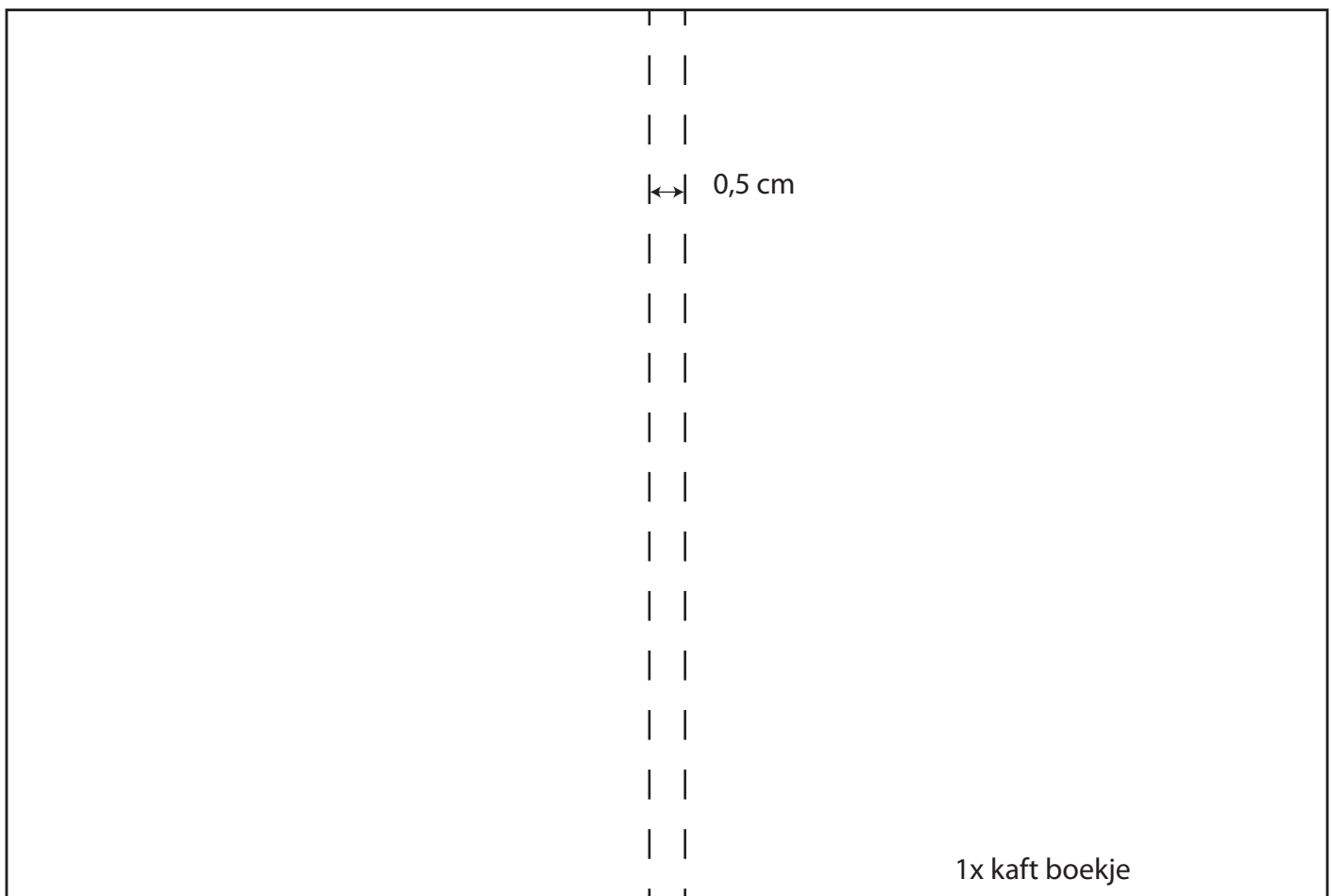


Trace the pattern of the cover onto white card and cut out. Adhere design paper onto the cover. Trace the pattern of the page 3x onto white card and cut out. Adhere the pages together and then inside the cover. Adhere 11.5 x 8 cm design paper to the pages and a white decorative frame. The gift cards will later on be glued on top. Die-cut the giftcards from silver-coloured card. Cut and tear smaller design paper and adhere. You might like to use the inner edge of the die. Stamp the text and finish off with two enamel stickers. Die-cut a heart from parchment paper and a smaller one from design paper. Adhere them to the front of the booklet with one end of a ribbon underneath. Tie the ribbon into a bow to close the booklet.
