General instructions:

After die-cutting leave the crockery parts in the die and work with distress ink Victorian velvet. Die-cut the spoons from gold-coloured card. Die-cut the macarons from various colours and work with matching colours of distress ink. Die-cut the cookies from nut brown and recycled grey kraft, work with vintage photo. Die-cut the flowers (CR1323) twice from design paper and the leaves (CR1249) twice from moss green card. Make a bow with scrapper's floss and adhere an adhesive flat-backed pearl in the heart of the flower.

Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower set, smallest size), Craftables: CR1249 (Stitched square with flower), CR1403 (Punch-die - Cookies), Creatables: LR0462 (Tea for you/crockery), LR0463 (Tiered tray & Macarons), Die-cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: vintage photo, Victorian velvet, antique linen, seedless preserves, Inkpad: Archival jet black, Design paper: PK9135 (Fleurique), Papicolor card: Original aubergine (909), bright pink (912), purple (913), lilac (914), heather (922), light pink (923), cream (927), pearly white (930), nut brown (939), moss green (951) and spring green (952), Recycled kraft grey (322), Metallic gold (333), Adhesive pearls: JU0937 (light pink and pink), Scrapper's floss



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1390 (Basic shapes stitched passe-partout - Rectangle), CR1391 (Basic shapes-Ticket), CR1402 (Bendy card), Creatables: LR0341 (Cake & Cupcake), Design folder: DF3431 (Dots), Clear stamp: KJ1701 (Geniet, joepie), Enamel dots: PL4512 (baby pink)

How to make a Bendy card:

Cut 15.5 x 16 cm pearly white card.

Die-cut the bended parts from pearly white, shape them and then adhere to the sides of the square card using double sided tape. Layer 15 x 15.5 cm design paper onto the square. Die-cut the bended parts also from design paper and cut them a little smaller, then adhere to the white ones. Make a vertical incision in the bended parts. Place the bended strips on top of each other and insert the ends into the incisions. The base card is finished now.

Cut 14 x 9 cm design paper. Die-cut the ticket 2x and the rectangular passe-partout 1x from design paper. Emboss the motif into 7.5 x 12 cm pearly white card. Die-cut the crockery from pearly white, light pink and bright pink card. Adhere the light pink crockery parts overlapping onto the bright pink ones and the pearly white parts onto the light pink ones. Die-cut the tiered tray from heather card and the macarons and cookies from various colours. Die-cut the cupcake from pearly white and recycled grey kraft;

finish off with an enamel dot. Stamp the text onto design paper and cut into two labels. Finish off with a flowers tuft.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1352 (Basic shapes-Label), CR1391 (Basic shapes-Ticket), Design folder: DF3431 (Dots), Clear stamp: KJ1708 (Coffee & Tea) Cut a 16.25 x 12.25 cm pearly white top-fold card.

Cut design paper into 15.75×11.75 cm and 15×11 cm. Mat the large one onto light pink card. Die-cut the ticket 2x and the label 1x from design paper. Cut a 10.5×12.25 cm pearly white rectangle and emboss the motif. Stamp the text onto 17.5×6 cm vellum, fold it around the 15×11 cm square and adhere to the reverse side. Die-cut the crockery set from light and bright pink card and adhere overlapping. Die-cut the tiered tray from heather card. Die-cut the macarons and cookies. Finish off with a flower tuft and adhesive flat-backed pearls.



14.5 × 14.5 cm

Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1238 (Tea cup with spoon), CR1390 (Basic shapes stitched passe-partout - Rectangle), Design folder: DF3432 (Sweet Hearts), Clear stamp: KJ1710 (Coffee & Tea), Vellum

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white top-fold card. Cut design paper into 13.75 x 13.75 cm and 13 x 13 cm, mat the large one on light pink card. Emboss the motif onto 12.25 x 12.25 cm pearly white card.

Layer rolled up rope partially behind 9.25 x 13.25 cm design paper. Stamp the text onto 8.5×12.75 cm vellum and layer a pearly white passe-partout on top using 3D-tape/glue. Die-cut the crockery from pearly white, light pink and heather and the spoon from gold-coloured card. Finish off with a flower tuft.

Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1403 (Punch die-Cookies), Creatables: LR0403 (Tiny's Ferns), LR0462 (Tea for you), Design paper: PK9135 (Fleurique), Papicolor card: Metallic 330 (pearlwhite), Card: green, brown, Decoration paper: silver



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0463 (Tiered tray and Macarons, LR0464 (Tiny's Bow), Decoupage sheet: VK9556 (Tea for you-1), Card: pink and yellow, Lace, Paper flowers: Rose buds RB2240 (bright pink) and RB2243 (dark lavender), Daisies RB2251 (light pink), RB2254 (light lavender) and RB2255 (dark lavender), Pearl pen

Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1404 (Basic shapes-Classic Square), Stamp: KJ17008 (Every day is a coffee day), Decoupage sheet: VK9557 (Tea for you-2), Paper flowers: Rose buds RB2239 (light pink) and RB2241 (light pink), Daisies RB2251 (light pink), RB2252 (bright pink) and cm, 18.5 cm and 26 cm. Adhere the last narrow border to the reverse side of the card. Cut a 14×16 cm strip from design paper.

Cut a 27 x 16.5 cm white strip and score folds at 14.5 cm, 16.5

Die-cut/emboss the bow from 13 x 13 cm white card. Stamp the text onto it. Die-cut the bow also from white card and adhere with 3D-tape/glue. Adhere all layers to the card with a length of lace. Cut out the pictures. Die-cut the tiered tray from Metallic card and the cookies from various card colours. Adhere them to the card.

Finish off with flowers and dots made with a pearl pen.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm single-fold card and layer $14.5 \times 14.5 \text{ cm}$ on top. Stamp the text onto a white oval, layer onto blue design paper and trim leaving a narrow border.

Die-cut the largest square from white and the next size from design paper. Die-cut the smallest one together with the one with the straight edge from white card. Layer the picture behind the last one. Adhere the layers to the card with the text in between. Die-cut/emboss the cups/saucers from white card and design paper. Cut out the cups of design paper and layer onto the white ones. Make an incision in the cup for the spoon. Finish off with flowers and a bow.



RB2253 (medium pink)

Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1354 (Punch-die-Butterflies), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0987 (Felicitaties), Distress ink: spun sugar and worn lipstick, Inkpad: Dye ink (Memento) and pigment ink (various kinds) and black, Stamp master: LR0009, Stamping paper: white, Design paper: PK9135 (Fleurique), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Kraft grey (322), Lace: white

Stamp master: check out the YouTube channel of Marianne Design for the video with the Stamp master.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0464 (Tiny's Bow), Layered stamps (3D): TC0855 (Tiny's Rose), Adhesive flat-backed pearls: light pink



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1404 (Basic shapes-Classic Square), Layered stamps (3D): TC0854 (Tiny's Hydrangea), Adhesive flatbacked pearls: white Cut 11.7 x 7.4 cm stamping paper. First stamp the text and then the roses and leaves. Stamp two more leaves onto stamping paper. Cut out and adhere with 3D-glue. Adhere the stamping paper to 12 x 7.7 cm design paper. Cut 12.6 x 8.3 cm pearly white card and 13.2 x 8.9 cm kraft. Adhere the layers to a 14 x 9.7 cm white single-fold card. Die-cut/emboss the bow 2x from pearly white card. Work with distress ink and cut out. Adhere with 3D-glue. Finish off with butterflies and pearls.

Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and adhere to 14 x 14 cm pearly white card. Adhere 13.5 x 6.5 cm design paper along the bottom half of the card and finish off with lace. Then adhere the layers to a 15 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card. Die-cut the classic square from kraft and cut out the centre using a die. Trace the square onto stamping paper and cut out. First stamp the text and then the hydrangeas and leaves. Stamp a hydrangea and some leaves onto a separate piece of paper, cut out and adhere to the card with 3D-glue. Finish off with butterfly and pearls.

Cut 13 x 13 cm, 9.5×9.5 cm and 13 x 3.5 cm design paper and layer together. Die-cut a classic square from stamping paper and stamp the tulips with the Stamp master. Die-cut a small square from the centre. Layer both squares onto design paper and trim leaving a narrow border. Then layer the small square onto kraft and the large one onto pearly white card. Cut a 1 cm wide strip from design paper. Cut both ends into a point and adhere to the large square. Adhere the large square on the left-hand side of the card and cut off in line with the card. Adhere the layers first onto 13.5 x 13.5 cm kraft and then onto a 14.5 x 14.5 cm single-fold card. Adhere the small square. Use the Stamp master to stamp three more tulips and adhere with 3D-glue. Finish off with a butterfly, text and adhesive pearls.

Cut a 9 x 11 cm rectangle from stamping paper. Stamp the flowers and adhere to 9.3 x 11.3 cm design paper. Stamp the text onto 9 x 2.2 cm stamping paper. First layer it to 9.3 x 2.5 cm design paper and then to the large rectangle. Cut 9.9 x 11.9 cm pearly white and 10.5 x 12,5 cm kraft. Adhere all layers to a 11.7 x 13.7 cm white single-fold card. Die-cut/emboss the bow 2x from pearly white. Work the embossed parts with distress ink and cut out. Adhere with 3D-glue. Finish off with butterflies and pearls.

14.5 × 14.5 cm

Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1427 (Eline's Farm set), COL1428 (Eline's Duck family), COL1429 (Eline's Chicken family), Die-cut and embossing machine, Stamps: PL1523 (Flowers), Inkpad: Memento tuxedo black, Versa Color old rose (57), Design paper: PK9131 (Celebrations), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft: grey (322) and brown (323), Original raven black (901), cream (927), daffodil yellow (928), pearly white (930), mustard yellow (948), Enamel dots: PL4512 (baby pink), Thin jute rope, White gel pen

Extra needed for this card: Decoupage sheet: AK0066 (Eline's backgrounds-Meadow), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), used for the wheelbarrow's wheel, Papicolor card: Recycled

kraft orange (325) and night blue (326), Original red (918) and christmas red (943)

Cut kraft into a 21×10.5 cm base card and layer 20.5×10 cm pearly white on top. Cut 14×9.5 cm design paper in half diagonally. Adhere these halves to the ends of the card. That the centre is not covered is no problem, the scenery will be layered on top slantwise.

Die-cut the farm, fences, chicklets and wheelbarrow and adhere. Finish off the card as shown.

red (943) and army green (954)

Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1330 (Anja's Flower border), CR1395 (Seed pocket and Garden tools), used for the sunflower, CR1402 (Bendy card), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft green (328), Original light pink (923), blossom (934), christmas Cut kraft into a 15 x 15 cm top-fold card.

Die-cut the two bended parts of the card from pearly white. Trace the inside of the dies onto army green and recycled green kraft, cut out and adhere. Fold the two bended parts outward. Cut a 14.5×14.5 cm pearly white card and layer 14×14 cm blue design paper on top. Die-cut the farm, the sun and the horse and adhere to the blue design paper. Fold the first bended part inward.

Die-cut the cow and the two fences and adhere. Then fold the second bended card inward.

Die-cut the flowers, ducks and decorative border and adhere. Die-cut two decorative borders from recycled brown kraft and adhere. Finish off the card.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1330 (Anja's Flower border), CR1353 (Label XL & labels XS), CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitched border-Squares), CR1402 (Bendy card), used for the sun, Decoupage sheet: AK0066 (Eline's backgrounds-Meadow),

Papicolor card: Recycled kraft green (328), Original light pink (923) and baby blue (956), Mica

Cut kraft into a 15 x 15 cm top-fold card and layer 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white on top. Die-cut the square with stitched border from the centre. Close the opening with mica. Cut 14 x 14 cm design paper. Trace (on the reverse side) the square template, cut out and adhere. Cut two pieces of 6.5×2.5 cm from design paper and adhere halfway on both sides. Die-cut the decorative border from baby blue and adhere. Cut the picture of the decoupage sheet into a 9.2 x 9.2 cm square and adhere inside. Die-cut the fence and sun and adhere to the inside as well. Die-cut the tea cup, ducks and cat and adhere. Finish off the card.
