## Materiales used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0480 (Tiny's Grape vines), LR0481 (Wine bottle \& Glass), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0994 (Carpe Diem), Distress ink: peeled paint, walnut stain, Memento tuxedo black, Design paper: PK9108 (Garden Party), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322) and green (328), Original army green (954), Vellum, Glitter stones, Hemp cord, Pearls: CA3133 (off-white), White gel pen

Craftables: CR1334 (Basic
shapes-Rectangle), Distress ink: antique linen, Decoupage sheet: EWK1251 (Chardonnay), Papicolor card Original: carnation white (903), pearly white (930), light green (947), Glitter paper: CA3120 (bronze)

Extra needed for this card:
Craftables: CR1404 (Basic shapes-classic square), Creatables: LR0367 (Bottle label), Inkpad: Versa Color 17 violette, Decoupage sheet: EWK1251 (Chardonnay), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft black (324), Original: pearly white (930), Christmas red (943), Gel pen: black

Cut a $15 \times 10.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ top-fold card from recycled grey kraft and layer $14.5 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ carnation white on top.
Cut $14 \times 9.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper, work the edges and adhere. Cut 15 $\times 3 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper and adhere.
Die-cut the decotratieve rectangle from pearly white and adhere using 3D-tape.
Cut $11 \times 7 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper and adhere. Cut out the picture and adhere. Layer glitter paper behind the wine glass.
Add grape vines, the wine glass, a text and adhesive stones to finish.

Cut a $13.5 \times 13.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ top-fold card from recycled grey craft and layer $13 \times 13 \mathrm{~cm}$ carnation white and $12.5 \times 12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper on top. Copy the window onto the design paper and cut out. Die-cut the arch from carnation white, work with ink and adhere around the aperture. Cut $12.5 \times 12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ recycled grey kraft and lay behind the window, but don't glue yet. Take blue card, lay behind the window too and glue to the grey kraft. Die-cut the landscape Horizon Cypresses from pine green card and recycled green kraft and adhere to the blue card, creating a landscape you like. Layer Christmas red card behind the wine glasses. Die-cut the wine bottle from pine green. Then adhere 3D-tape along the edges of the separate card and layer the landscape behind the window. Add grape vines, a wicker bottle, wine glasses, a text and several adhesive stone to finish.

Die-cut the bottle label from kraft. First cut out the top half, move the die down as far as possible, then cut out the bottom half. The label used is 10 cm long.
Cut $9.5 \times 5.3 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper, round off the corners and adhere. Die-cut the basic classic square from pearly white and design paper, adhere together and then onto the card.
Cut out the pictures and adhere. Die-cut the wine glass and wine bottle, work with ink and adhere as shown.
Layer Christmas red paper behind the wine glass.
Add grape vines, a text and adhesive stones to finish.

## Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: C0L1435 (Village deco-set Cars, Caravan), C0L1436 (Village deco-set 4 (Bicycle, etc.),
Craftables: CR1418 (Punch die-Cars), Die-cut and embossing machine, Inkpad: Versafine onyx black, Ribbon, Rope, Gel pen: white

## General instructions:

Work the embossed parts of the die-cut shapes with distress ink.


Extra needed for this card:
Collectables: COL1327
(House), COL1329 (Houses), COL1383 (Trees and Fence), Creatables: LR0472 (Flower), Decoupage sheet: IT596 (Tiny's Background-Landscapes), Clear stamps: CS0994 Carpe Diem

Cut a $14.8 \times 14.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ white square and layer $7.5 \times 14.3 \mathrm{~cm}$ light blue on top. Cut out the picture $7.2 \times 14 \mathrm{~cm}$ and adhere onto a $7.5 \times 14.3 \mathrm{~cm}$ green rectangle and then glue partially over the bottom half of the picture. Die-cut the bendy card from white card. Trace the inside of the die for the sides in pencil onto green card and cut out. Cut $2.5 \times 11.5$ en $2.5 \times 14 \mathrm{~cm}$ grey/ brown strips and tear a little off the top. Stamp a text onto kraft and make a banner.
Die-cut the shapes you like to use from various card colours and adhere.

Cut the box card $2 x$ from kraft. Cut off the sides from one box card. Use a rectangle with stitches to cut out the centre, turning the box card into a frame. Cut a $10 \times 14,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ rectangle and two $4.5 \times 11.1 \mathrm{~cm}$ strips from white card. Emboss the clouds. Die-cut two partition strips from kraft and attach $2.5 \times 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ dark grey strips. Adhere to card front.
Cut one $2.5 \times 14,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ strip and two $2.5 \times 4.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ strips from dark grey card. Die-cut the shapes you like to use from various card colours and adhere.

## Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: C0L1358 (Eline's Typewriter), Craftables: CR1416 (Brush Alphabet), CR1417 (Punch die-Letters), Design folders: DF3437 (ABC Moonflower), DF3438 (Trendy Hearts), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0992 (Background-Typewriter), CS0993 (Post voor jou), CS0995 (Postage set), Inkpad: black, Decoration paper: CA3135 (silver), Papicolor card: pearly white (03), raven black (02), Circle cutter, Corner punch, Cork: JU0948, Enamel stickers: PL4503, Rope, Templates: CA3110 (Party Numbers-small), CA3111 (Party Numbers-large)


Cut a $13.5 \times 13.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ white single-fold card and layer $13 \times 13 \mathrm{~cm}$ black card on top.
Stamp the background onto $12.5 \times 12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ white card and adhere.
Cut circles of different sizes from design paper and cork and adhere in a playful way.
Die-cut the typewriter from scraps of card, adhere together and then adhere to the card using 3D-foam pads.
Stamp a text onto the paper in the typewriter. Stamp images onto the small circles.
Die-cut black letters and adhere the text to a strip of paper. Punch a hole and thread a length of rope through it.
Finish off the card with an enamel sticker.


Cut an $11 \times 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ white single-fold card and design paper of the same size, round off the corners and adhere together. Cut $4 \times 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper, round off two corners and adhere. Trace the small numbers onto silver-coloured card, cut out and emboss the letters. Adhere using 3D-foam pads. Die-cut the text from black card and adhere to the number.
Die-cut the typewriter from scraps of card, adhere together and then onto the card using 3D-foam pads. Stamp a text onto the white paper in the typewriter. Stamp a text onto a narrow strip of white card too. Punch a hole and tie a length of rope through. Finish off the card with an enamel sticker.

Cut an $11 \times 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ white single-fold card and design paper of the same size. Round off the corners and adhere together. Trace a large number onto silver-coloured paper, cut out and emboss the hearts. Adhere using 3D-foam pads. Die-cut black letters, adhere to a strip of design paper, mat on black and adhere using 3D-foam pads. Die-cut the typewriter from scraps of card, adhere together and then to the card using 3D-foam pads. Die-cut a text from black card and adhere to the paper in the typewriter.
Cut circles of different sizes from design paper and adhere in a playful way.
Punch a hole into a circle and thread a rope through.

## Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: LR0437 (Petra's Twigs set, LR0438 (Petra's Larch), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Kerstdagen), Papicolor card Metallic: pearl white (330), Original olive green, Design paper bloc: PK9139 (Country Christmas), Gesso, Ribbon: JU0924 (tulle), white statin, Flat-backed pearls


Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), LR0485 (Anja's Marquee), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0169
(Country villages)

## Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0484 (Anja's Ornament), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0168 (Christmas Flowers)

Cut a $15 \times 15 \mathrm{~cm}$ white single-fold card and layer $14.5 \times 14.5$ cm red design paper on top. Die-cut the stencils $2 x$ from white card and cut out one of them. Die-cut two stencils at the same time from design paper and layer the picture behind. Adhere the white shape to the card with glue and the cut-out one raised with 3D-kit/foamtape.
Stamp the text onto a white strip and cut out a V-shape at both sides. Die-cut the poinsettia from white card ( $2 x$ the large one and $1 x$ the small one). Die-cut the twigs set from olive green and work with gesso. Adhere all layers to the card and finish off with a bow and flat-backed pearls.

Cut a $30 \times 17.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ white strip and score folds at $14.5 \mathrm{~cm}, 17$ $\mathrm{cm}, 19.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ and 29 cm . Adhere the last strip to the back of the card to assemble. Layer $14 \times 17 \mathrm{~cm}$ design paper on top. Die-cut the large plain stencil from red design paper and the decorated ones from white card. Adhere the large ones together. Cut the small border in half and layer behind the large border. Cut out the picture and mat on red design paper. Adhere to the card raised with 3D-glue. Stamp the text onto a white oval, layer the corner behind and adhere to a larger red oval.
Die-cut the twigs set from olive green and work with gesso. Adhere all layer to the card and finish off with a bow and flatbacked pearls.
