The Collection #58

General instructions:

Read the measurements as follows: the sizes in cm are indicated as: first you see the height and then the width. So 10 x 5 cm means 10 cm high and 5 cm wide.



Materials:

Creatables: LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), LR0488 (Petra's Christmas border), LR0491 (Tiny's Decorated Christmas tree), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear text stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Kerstdagen), Distress ink: weathered wood,

Memento ink: cottage ivy, rhubarb stalk, Decoupage sheet Tiny: IT598 (Christmas trees), Design paper bloc: PK9151 (Royal Christmas), Papicolor card: Original: silver grey (902), lavender (921), pearly white (930), Christmas red (943), light grey (957) and Metallic: platinum (335), botanic (336), Snow paper: CA3104, Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Vellum, Enamel dots: PL4511 (cold as ice), PL4510 (gold and silver), Glitter glue, Flat-backed pearls: CA3132 (white), Satin ribbon: VV1012 narrow stars 6 mm (white)



1. Cut a 21 x 15 cm pearly white strip (a little bigger than needed). Adhere the stencil with low tack tape at the top and die cut/emboss with the machine. Turn the paper.



2. *Tip*: to measure the position for the pattern at the opposite side: place the picture on the pearly white against the embossed pattern. Adhere the stencil to the right-hand side next to the picture using low tack tape and die cut/emboss the border with the machine. Cut off the top above the embossed pattern in a straight line. Cut off the bottom edge at 1 cm down from the embossed pattern.



3. Cut a 14.4 x 9.5 cm strip from silver-coloured card. Adhere the picture to silver 2 cm down from the top. See photo 5.



4a. Cut a 21 x 13.8 cm pearly white strip for the lower border. Attach the stencil (see photo 1) to the top using low tack tape and die cut/emboss the border with the machine. Cut a 2 cm high strip from design paper with stars. Stamp the text in black ink. Place the strip on pearly white and cut to size.

4b. Score and fold the bottom next to the design paper with stars. Make another fold after 1 cm. The height of the lower border (measured in the centre of the tip) is 6.5 cm. Sizes: 6.5 cm (lower border), 1 cm fold, 1 cm fold, 14.4 cm.



4c. To prevent the lower border from falling forward secure it with ribbon (see photo). Mount the design paper with stars on top.



5. Die cut/emboss the Christmas border for the top as per example from pearly white and Christmas red. Adhere together. Then mount on top of silver (see photo 7).



6. Cut 14.4 x 13.7 cm from red design paper (PK9151) and adhere to pearly white (see x in the photo).



7. Adhere the part with the picture to to red design paper. Die cut/emboss the trees from silver grey and botanic.



8. Cut a 17.5 x 29 cm lavender strip. Fold and unfold again. Make a 2 cm incision into both ends of the fold. Score the card front at 2 cm in from both sides, fold inside and adhere. Cut 13.8 x 16.7 cm design paper with stars for the back.



9. Adhere the part with trees to the front of lavender. Fold the ribbon around the card front and adhere at the back. Die cut/emboss the poinsettia from vellum, light grey card, snow paper and two leaves from platinum.

Materialen used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1325 (Banners and Christmas sentiments), COL1441 (Karin's Pins & Bows Giftwrapping), Craftables: CR1335 (Punch die-Snowflakes), Die cut and embossing machine, Inkpad: VersaMark, Distress ink: peeled paint, Embossing powder: WOW! Primary chartreuse regular WH10R, Design paper bloc: PK9151 (Royal Christmas), Papicolor card: Recycled green kraft (328), Original: pearly white (930), pine green (950), light grey (957), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), CA3104 (snow paper), CA3121 (gold), Flat-backed pearls: CA3133 (off-white), Heat tool, Thin jute rope, White feathers, White lace



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1332 (Basic shapes-Square), CR1378 (Tiny's Pine branch), CR1379 (Tiny's Ornaments-Icicle and Bauble), CR1381 (Tiny's Ornaments-Church and Owl), CR1382

(Tiny's Ornaments-Star and Bell), Decoupage sheet: IT598 (Tiny's Christmas tree), Vellum, Flat-backed pearls: JU0392 (clear)

Cut a 27.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white strip and score folds at 5.5 cm, 7 cm, 20.5 cm and 22 cm. Cut a 12.5 x 4.5 cm rectangle in the side flaps to create a 0.5 cm wide frame. Layer vellum behind. Cut a 13 x 13 cm light grey card and 12.5 x 12.5 cm and 13.5 x 4.5 cm design paper. Die cut the decorative square from white and a solid $(8.7 \times 8.7 \text{ cm})$ one from gold paper. Die cut the image. Die cut the pine brances from pine green and recycled green kraft, work with distress ink. Layer on the card with lace behind the gold. Die cut the Christmas ornaments from gold paper and snow paper and adhere with a rope. Complete the card.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1334 (Basic shapes-Rectangle), CR1378 (Tiny's Pine branch), Creatables: LR0490 (Tiny's Christmas tree with stars), LR0489 (Tiny's Deer head),

Distress ink: pumice stone, Decoupage sheet: IT597 (Tiny's Christmas baubles), Black pen



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circle), CR1378 (Tiny's Pine branch), CR1384 (Christmas decorations), Creatables: LR0492 (Tiny's Christmas tree-Wood), Distress ink: pumice stone, Decoupage sheet: IT597 (Tiny's Christmas baubles)



Extra needed for this card: Collectables: COL1315 (Tab with Dutch text), Craftables: CR1332 (Basic shapes-Square), CR1380 (Tiny's Ornaments-Birds), CR1387 (Wreath), CR1423 (Open star fold), Creatables: LR0491 (Tiny's decorated Christmas tree), Decoupage: IT598 (Tiny's

Christmas trees), Glitter glue: gold (Stickles), Black pen

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white single-fold card, 14.5 x 10 cm light grey and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper and adhere with lace. Cut a 15 x 5 cm strip from design paper.

Die cut the decorative rectangle from white and layer with 10.7 \times 6.7 cm design paper.

Die cut the picture, cut to measure and adhere.

Die cut the pine branches from pine green and recycled green kraft, work with ink.


Die cut the Christmas tree from white and gold and adhere overlapping.

Die cut the deer head and work with ink. Finish off the card.

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white top-fold card. Cut 14 x 9.5 cm and 15 x 7 cm from design paper and adhere with lace. Die cut the decorative circle from white and a smaller one from design paper. Use an even smaller one to die cut the picture. Die cut the twigs from pine green and recycled green kraft, work with ink.

Die cut the Christmas tree from white and work with ink. Adhere the layers to the card and finish off.

Trace the pattern onto pearly white card and cut out. Mark the centre of the part with the glue strips (so at 6,75 cm) in pencil and die cut the open star fold (CR1423), fold and assemble the card. Cut 13×13 cm light grey and 12.5×12.5 cm and 13×3.5 cm design paper. Cut out the hexagon in the centre and layer to the card with lace along the bottom. Now fold the tips of the star to the sides. Die cut the wreath from pine green card and recycled green kraft, layer to the circular border. Fold over the tips and add a few leaves. Die cut the Christmas tree, work with ink and glitter glue and adhere with a feather behind. Die cut the bird from gold and layer a feather behind its tail. Finish off the card. Cut 13×13 cm white for the sliding card and layer on top: 12.5×12.5 cm light grey with a tab, 12×12 cm design paper, a white die cut decorative square and a picture.

Materials used for both cards:

Clear stamps: HT1627 (Haunted Mansion), Stamping paper, Inkpad: Stazon jet black, Masking paper, Distress ink: chipped sapphire, wilted violet, spiced marmalade, black soot, ground espresso, Blending tool, Card: purple and black, Water colour paint



Extra needed for this card: Heat tool, Frantage: shabby white Cut 10 x 10 cm stamping paper, stamp the border along the bottom using black Stazon ink. Stamp the border on masking paper as well and cut out. Adhere the cut out parts onto the stamped images on the original card to cover them.

Use the blending tool and distress ink (chipped sapphire, spiced marmalade and wilted violet) to colour in the background. Use a new sponge for each colour. Let the colours blend in.

Carefully sprinkle a few droplets of water on the background and heat from beneath with a heat tool; the water will react with the ink. Use black Stazon ink to stamp a few branches along the sides and a some bats. Sprinkle frantage on the background and heat from beneath with the heat tool. Colour in the bottom of the card with distress ink ground espresso and apply distress ink black soot to the edges.

Remove the masking paper from the card and colour in the image with watercolour paint.

Cut a 10.5 \times 10.5 cm purple square and a 13 \times 13 cm black single-fold card. Adhere the layers to the card.



Extra needed for this card: Clear stamps: HT1626 (Happy Halloween), MM1604 (Texture

Grid), Craftables: CR1422 (Spiderweb), Die cut and embossing machine Cut 10 x 13 cm stamping paper, stamp the border along the bottom and the witch at the top using black Stazon ink. Stamp the border and the witch on masking paper as well and cut out. Adhere the cut out parts onto the stamps images on the original card to cover them.

Use the blending tool and distress ink (chipped sapphire, spiced marmalade and wilted violet) to colour in the background. Use a new sponge for each colour. Let the colours blend in.

Use black Stazon ink to stamp a branches along the side, bats and a text. Use the mixed media stamps to create structure on the background. Colour the bottom of the card with distress ink ground espresso and apply black soot to the edges.

Remove the masking paper from the card and colour in the images with water colour paint. Cut a 10.5×13.5 cm purple square and an 11×14 cm black single-fold card. Adhere the layers to the card. Die cut two spider webs and adhere them too.

Materials used for this card:

Stamp master: LR0009, Stamping paper: white, Layered stamps: TC0862 (Tiny's Holly), Clear text stamps: CS0991 (Fijne kerstdagen), Inkpad: black, Distress ink: vintage photo, Memento ink: bamboo leaves, dandelion, lady bug, love letter, new sprout, northern pine, rich cocoa, rhubarb stalk, Design paper: PK9151(Royal Christmas), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Flat-backed pearls: CA3132 (white)

General instructions:

Apply distress ink to the edges of the card/paper any way you like.



Extra needed for this card: Layered stamps: TC0859 (Tiny's Poinsettia) Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper on a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Mount 14 x 14 cm, 7 x 13 cm and 14 x 5 cm design paper on top. Stamp the poinsettia on stamping paper and cut into an 11 x 5 cm rectangle. Cut off protruding parts and adhere to 11.5 x 5.5 cm design paper. Stamp the text and holly leaves. Finish off with adhesive pearls.



Extra needed for this card: Layered stamps: TC0860 (Tiny's Amaryllis)

Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper on 14 x 14 design paper and then on a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Mount 7 x 10.5 cm, 7.5 x 13 cm and 15 x 3 cm design paper on top. Stamp the amaryllis on 9 x 7.5 cm stamping paper and adhere to 9.5 x 8 cm design paper. Stamp the text on a white 9 x 1.5 cm strip. Stamp a holly leaf. Finish off with adhesive pearls.



Extra needed for this card: Layered stamps: TC0861 (Tiny's Hellebore) Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper on 14 x 14 cm design paper and then on a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Mount 10 x 8 cm, 4.5 x 13.5 cm and 9 x 7.5 cm design paper on top. Stamp the hellebore on 10 x 7.5 cm stamping paper and adhere to 10.5 x 8 cm design paper. Stamp the text and cut into separate parts. Stamp a holly leaf. Finish off with adhesive pearls.
