Materials, used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1343 (Christmas bells), CR1424 (Lantern), Die-cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Kerstdagen), Distress ink: forest moss, gathered twigs, pine needles, Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930) and light green (947), Recycled kraft grey (322), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Gesso: white

General instructions:

Ink the edges of the paper with distress ink gathered twigs.

Die cut the holly leaves from light green card and highlight the embossed areas with distress ink forest moss, gathered twigs and pine needles. Apply gesso to the edges.



Extra needed for this card: Card: blue, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white) Trace the pattern on to a 29 \times 14.5 cm pearly white strip, score and fold in to a card.

Cut rectangles from design paper: 7.5 x 12.5 cm, 3 x 10 cm and 3 x 0.5 cm. Adhere to blue card, measuring: 8 x 13 cm, 3.5 x 10.5 cm and 3.5 x 1 cm and then to kraft card: 8.5 x 13.5 cm, 4 x 11 cm and 4 x 1.5 cm.

Adhere the layers to the card and finish off as per example.



Extra needed for this card: Collectables: COL1363 (Jingle bells), Craftables: CR1425 (Advent candles), Card: pink, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white) Adhere 13 x 8.5 cm design paper to 13.5×9 cm pink card and then to 14 x 9.5 cm kraft. Cut 4 x 7.5 cm design paper. Die cut the perforated part of the lantern 2x from pearly white card. Adhere to 5 x 1.5 cm kraft and cut off the sides in a straight line.

Adhere all layers to a 15×10.5 cm white single-fold card. Adhere 6.5×5.5 cm pearly white to 7×6 cm pink card and mount on top of the card using 3D-silicone glue. Finish off as per example.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1426 (Candles set), Adhesive pearls: brown Adhere the following layers to a 15×15 cm pearly white card: design paper of 12.5×6 cm, 12.5×12.5 cm and 13×13 cm plus kraft card of 13.5×13.5 cm.

Die cut the lantern 2x from kraft card. Use part of the top as a bowl for the candles. Glue the perforated part as a border in the centre of the card.

Adhere 6.5 x 9.5 cm white card to 7 x 10 cm design paper and attach to the card using 3D-silicone glue. Finish off as per example.

Materials:

Craftables: CR1252 (Skis and Snowflake), Creatables: LR0474 (Kim's Buddies), LR0493 (Horizon Snowy mountains), LR0497 (Snowflakes corner), LR0498 (Snowflakes border), LR0499 (Kim's Buddies winter), LR0500 (Moon), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear text

stamps: CS0991 (Fijne kerstdagen), Distress ink: pumice stone, Inkpad: VersaMark, Embossing powder: Stampendous White EP100, Design paper bloc: PK9142 (Après-Ski), Papicolor card: raven black (901), light pink (923), salmon pink (925), pearly white (930), nut brown (939), Christmas red (943), blue (955), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Snow paper: CA3104, Thin jute rope, namel dots: PL4512 (baby pink), White gel pen

Cut a 13.5×22 cm pearly white strip and score/fold at 8.5 cm in from the left-hand side. Cut a 13×21 cm blue strip and score/fold at 8 cm in from the left-hand side.

Die cut the snowflakes corner from snow paper and the snowflakes border at the right-hand side into the blue card. Adhere together with the snowflakes corner slantwise in between.

Cut a 13 x 8 cm blue card. Cut 12.5 x 7.5 cm design paper and work the edges with a distress tool.

Die cut the moon from silver. Die cut the mountains from white and work with ink. Die cut the snow of the mountain from snow paper. Adhere the layers to the card as per example. Mount a snow strip (snow paper) on top using 3D-glue.

Die cut the dolly from raven black, light pink, salmon pink, nut brown, Christmas red and design paper. Assemble and glue in position. Colour the cheeks with the pink pencil and finish off with a white gel pen. Complete the card.

Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0495 (Santa is coming), LR0500 (Moon), LR0444 (Horizon-Forest), Clear stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Kerstdagen), Inkpads: Archival jet black, Hero Arts dandelion, Distress ink: peacock feathers, chipped sapphire, black soot,

Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), raven black (901), Snow paper: CA3104, Stamping paper, Enamel dots: PL4511 (Cold as Ice), Wax cord Cut an 11×15.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and layer 10.5×15 cm design paper on top. Make a pretty background on stamping paper using distress ink, starting with peacock feathers, then chipped sapphire and finally black soot. Die cut a row of trees from snow paper, make the row longer by adding another die cut tree. Tear a strip from snow paper.

Die cut/emboss the moon from stamping paper and work with yellow ink. Die cut Santa and his sleigh from raven black and adhere in front of the moon. Stamp a text and cut into a label. Tie wax cord through. Finish off with star shaped enamel dots.

Materials used for the Sinterklaas cards:

Craftables: CR1353 (Labels XL & XS), CR1374 (Box card, tree used), Creatables: LR0446 (Sinterklaas), Die cut and embossing machine, Inkpad: Archival jet black, Design paper: PK9151 (Royal Christmas), Papicolor card: Original carnation white (903), dark brown (938) and red (918), Recycled kraft brown (323), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Jute rope



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1390 (Basic shapes with stitches-Rectangle), Creatables: LR0494 (Horizon-Amsterdam), LR0496 (Sint and Piet), Clear stamps: CS0982 (5 December), Papicolor card: mocha (953),

Christmas red (943), raven black (901)

Cut a 10.5×15 cm mocha top-fold card and adhere 10×14.5 cm and 9×13.5 cm brown kraft. Die cut a mocha frame, using two dies at the same time and stamp the text three times along the top. Die cut the row of houses twice from Christmas red, once from black and once from mocha. Adhere two differently coloured rows of houses overlapping. Then adhere overlapping behind the frame. Adhere the layers to 7.5×12 cm design paper. Die cut dark brown trees. Die cut a mitre and staff from gold and red. Adhere the staff between the trees. Die cut a label from design paper and carnation white, stamp a text and tie jute rope through. Die cut Sinterklaas and the Black Peters from raven black.



Extra needed for this card: Collectables: COL1362 (Snow globe), Distress ink: vintage photo, Clear stamps: CS0981 (Sinterklaas), Decoupage sheet: HK1701 (Sinterklaas) Cut a 11×15 cm top-fold card from brown kraft and adhere 9.5 x 14 cm and 9 x 13.5 cm design paper.

Die-cut a picture. Die cut a frame from design paper using two dies at the same time. Adhere the picture.

Die cut a carnation white label and stamp a text. Die cut the label from brown kraft too and tie jute rope through both. Adhere partially behind the picture.

Die cut two dark brown trees. Die cut/emboss a carnation white letter S and work with distress ink. Tie jute rope around. Die cut the staff and mitre from gold and red card.

Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0244 (Holly branches), LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: walnut stain, Decoupage Tiny: IT599, Design paper bloc: PK9142 (Après-Ski), Papicolor card: Brilliant gravel (161), Adhesive stones, Brad, Lace, Silk lace: JU0914 (white)



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0498 (Border-

Snowflakes), Papicolor card: 942 (celeste) Cut a 15 x 5 cm celeste single-fold card. Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and 13.5 x 13.5 cm glitter paper. Die cut the border of snowflakes from 13 x 13 cm gravel card. Adhere the picture. Die cut the other parts from glitter paper and celeste card. Ink the edges of the die cut and hand cut paper with distress ink walnut stain. Adhere all layers together as shown. Use 3D silicone glue for the poinsettia. Make a bow from lace and silk lace and adhere with a brad. Finish off with adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0493 (Horizon-Snowy mountains), Papicolor card: Original blue (956), Snow paper

Cut a 15 x 15 cm light blue single-fold card and a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square. Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm and 13 x 13 cm design paper. Die cut the shapes needed from gravel and light blue card. Ink the edges of the die cut and hand cut paper with distress ink walnut stain. Adhere the picture to light blue card and trim leaving a narrow border. Then adhere all layers to the card as shown.

Make a bow of lace and silk lace and secure with a brad. Adhere the poinsettia with 3D silicone glue and finish off with adhesive stones.

Materials used for all cards:

Design paper bloc: PK9142 (Après-Ski), Clear stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Feestdagen), HT1612 (Hetty's Happy Penguins), HT1613 (Hetty's Polar ice), Copic Markers, Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Hempcord, Sequins



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0493 (Snowy Mountain), LR0497 (Snowflake Corner), Papicolor card: lavender (921) Cut a 14 x 17 lavender single-fold card and mount 13.5 x 16.5 cm white card and 13 x 16 cm design paper on top. Adhere 6 x 14 cm design paper to a 6.5×14 cm white strip. Stamp the penguins, iceberg, igloo, floe and signpost, colour in with Copic markers. Cut a 9.5×14.5 cm white card and die cut/ emboss snowflakes in the corner. Die cut/emboss the icebergs from lavender card and the snow from white. Stamp the text on a white strip and mat on lavender. Cut off the card along the icebergs, layer the die cut snowy mountains behind and adhere to a 8.5×14 cm white card. Finish off as per example.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0941 (Snowflake Border), Papicolor card: night blue (941) Cut a 15 x 15 cm night blue single-fold card and mount a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white card and 14 x 14 cm design paper on top. Adhere 12 x 12 cm design paper to a 12.5 x 12.5 cm blue card. Cut 13 x 13 cm stamping paper and die cut/emboss the snowflakes border twice. Stamp the icebergs, penguins and igloo and colour in with Copic

markers. Then adhere to a 13.5 x 13.5 cm blue card. Adhere all layers to the card as per example and add die cut snowflakes to complete.
