Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1436 (Rectangle doily), Creatables: LR0509 (Tiny's Butterflies), LR0521 (Tiny's Butterfly set), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1006 (Birthday poems-Dutch), Inkpad: black, Distress ink, Design paper: PK9155 (Weathered Wood), Card in various colours, Ribbon



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1354 (Punch die-Butterflies), Craftables CR1331 or Circle cutter, Decoupage sheet: MB0173, Adhesive flatbacked pearls Cut a 14 x 14 cm blue single-fold card, yellow card 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 13.5 x 6.5 cm and design paper 13 x 13 cm and 13 x 6 cm.

Cut the front flap of the blue card in half lengthwise. Cut out the picture and die cut/hand cut a yellow and blue circle each one slightly bigger, see photo.

Die cut/emboss the templates. Thread a ribbon through the rectangle.

Highlight the embossed parts of the flower with distress ink. Stamp the text and position all parts on the card as shown.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1423 (Picket fence), Craftables: CR1355 (Grass border), Decoupage sheet Tiny: IT592, Adhesive stones Cut a 14.5×14.5 cm white single-fold card, green card 14×14 cm, pink card 13.5×13.5 cm and design paper 13×13 cm. Die cut/emboss all dies. Thread a ribbon through the rectangle. Highlight the embossed parts of the flower with distress ink. Stamp a text onto a scrap of white card, tear off the edges and wipe them with distress ink. Position all parts on the card as shown.

Materials used for both cards:

Collectables: COL1451 (Mini village), Craftables: CR1332 (Basic shapes-Square), CR1435 (Punch-die, Keys), Creatables: LR0522 (Sign post), LR0523 (Keyring), LR0524 (Horizon-Wood), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1004 (Dream house), Inkpad: Versafine onyx black, Distress ink: pumice stone, Decoupage sheet: MB0173 (Mattie's Cottages), Design paper pad: PK9155 (Weathered Wood), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930), cerise (933), light pink (923), army green (954) and olive green (945), Recycled kraft grey (322) and black (324), Metallic steel (332), Glitter card: CA3127 (silver)



Cut 19.5 x 14.5 cm cerise card and score at 2.5 en 5 cm and mount 14.1 x 14.1 cm pearly white and 13.9×13.9 cm design paper on to the square.

Cut three strips: cerise 14.5×7 cm, pearly white 14.1×6.4 cm and 13.9×6.3 cm design paper. Layer together and then on adhereto the first narrow flap of the card.

Die cut the sign post from metallic steel and pearly white. Work the sign with distress ink pumice stone and stamp a text.

Cut out the image and adhere to a die cut white square.

Die cut the row of trees from army green and adhere along the bottom of the card and flap. Die cut the keys (big and small) from silver card and the key hanger from light pink and pearly white. Assemble and stamp a text.

Die cut the houses from pearly white and the roofs once again from grey kraft and cerise card, work with distress ink pumice stone. Layer black paper behind the houses. Finish off with black lampposts and olive green trees.





Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1383 (Villagedecoration set 2), COL1423 (Picket fence), Craftables: CR1303 (Topiary set), CR1355 (Grass), CR1396 (Vines), CR1437 (Build-a-house), Creatables: LR0371 (Oval & Pop-up blocks), LR0378 (Fir), LR0407 (Petra's Beautiful border), LR0505 (Bridal bouquet), LR0524 (Horizon-Wood), Clear stamps: pumice stone, picket fence, Inkpad: Versafine onyx black, Design paper pad: PK9155 (Weathered Wood), Papicolor card: Original: pearly white (930), light pink (923), heather (922), cloud grey (929), army green (954) and olive green (945), Recycled kraft night blue (326), Metallic ivory (331), steel (332), red lacquer (337), Glitter card: CA3127 (silver), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white)

Cut 16 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and die cut/emboss the beautiful border along the top.

Cut 24.5 x 15 cm blue kraft, trace the outline of the border and cut off. Score at 8.5 cm in from the bottom.

Cut 13 x 14 cm design paper, die cut the bottom edge of the beautiful border along the top.

For the lying part of the card cut 8 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 7.5 x 14 cm design paper.

Die cut the firs and trees from olive green and adhere raised with foam tape to the standing part of the card. Die cut the row with trees from army green, cut to size and adhere using pop-up blocks.

Die cut the house from design paper, the roof parts and chimney from pearly white and roof tiles from metallic red lacquer. Work the chimney with distress ink pumice stone. Assemble the house. Die cut the windows, layer lace behind and adhere to cloud grey card. Die cut the shutters, flower boxes and door from blue kraft, work the door with distress ink picket fence. Die cut the steps from metallic steel. Glue the parts in position.

Decorate the door with an army green wreath with pearls and the flower boxes with green twigs from the vines and flowers from the bridal bouquet. Add a pearl to the flowers. Die cut the rain-pipe and lamppost from silver card and layer

Adhere the house to the card using large pop-up blocks. Die cut two flower pots from heather card and army green boxwood, adhere with pop-up blocks.

metallic ivory behind the lamp.

Die cut the fence from pearly white and work with distress ink pumice stone. Glue army green grass, a car from metallic steel and a black cat in front. Adhere the fences with pop-up blocks. Finish off by stamping a text and adhering a few pearls.

Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1435: (Punch die-Keys), Creatables: LR0522 (Sign post), LR0523 (Key ring), LR0524 (Horizon-Wood), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1004 (Dream house), Inkpad: Versafine onyx black, Design paper: PK9155 (Weathered Wood), Card: various colours, Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), CA3127 (silver), Rope, White gel pen

General instructions:

Highlight the embossed parts with distress ink.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1348 (Wooden planks), CR1351 (Heart), CR1433 (Card box), Collectables: COL1333 (Home sweet home), COL1443 (Karin's bird, heart and tag)

Die cut the card box 2x from grey kraft and the complementary parts from design paper, decorate the box. Die cut the bars and decorate with design paper.

Die cut from various card colours and design paper: wooden planks (3x narrow, 1x wide), nails, keys (silver and black), sign post, house, trees, heart, big key and small hearts.

Stamp the text in black ink on the sign post and wide wooden plank.

Finish off the card box as shown.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1390 (Basic shapes with stitches-Rectangle), CR1418 (Punch die-Cars), Collectables: COL1451 (Mini village), Design folder: DF3434 (Clouds), Design paper pad: PK9149 (Do what you love)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm black top-fold card, white card 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 9 x 13.5 cm and design paper 13 x 13 cm, 5 x 14 cm and 8.5×13 cm. Work the white rectangle with the design folder. Die cut a rectangular frame from design paper, the horizon with trees from kraft and layer behind the frame. Die cut from various card colours and design paper: sign post, key ring, keys (silver and black), houses, trees and cars. Stamp a text in black ink to the sign post and key hanger. Finish off the card as per example.

Materials used for all cards:

Shadow paper or Watercolour paper: white, Inkpad: Versafine onyx black, Shadow painting liner, Shadow paint: Delft blue, Brush



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: PP2801 (Tulips), PP2802 (Windmill-frame used), Cord: dark blue 1 mm thick Cut Shadow paper into a 10.5×10.5 cm single-fold card and a 10.5×10.5 cm square. Stamp in waterproof black ink the frame on to the card and the tulips on to a scrap of Shadow paper, set aside to dry. Use Shadow painting liner to trace the black lines of the stamped tulips, set aside to dry.

Colour in the tulips with Delft blue Shadow paint; a little water can be used to dilute the paint/reduce the intensity of the colour. Use a brush or spray to make the 10.5 x 10.5 cm card wet. Apply a little Shadow paint onto one half of the card with a brush and carefully let it run to the other half of the card. Set aside to dry. Cut away the paper within the frame, leaving a narrow white border. Cut out the tulips with a narrow white border and adhere with foam tape inside the card.

Wrap dark blue cord around the front flap and tie the ends at the front.



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: PP2806 (Sailing boat), PP2805 (Dutch rooster-frame used)

Cut Shadow paper into a 11 x 11 cm single-fold card and two 10 x 10 cm squares, one 11 x 11 cm square and one 9 x 9 cm. Stamp the frame in waterproof black ink onto the 10 x 10 cm squares, set aside to dry. Stamp the ship onto a scrap of Shadow paper, set aside to dry. Use Shadow painting liner to trace the black lines of the frames and ship and set aside to dry. Colour in the two frames with Delft blue Shadow paint, a little water can be used to dilute the paint/reduce the intensity of the colour. Set aside to dry. Colour in the ship in the same way and set aside to dry. Use a brush or spray to make the 9 x 9 cm card wet. Apply a little Shadow paint onto one half of the card with a brush and carefully let it run to the other half of the card. Set aside to dry. Cut out the ship with a narrow white border. Cut away the circle of one of the coloured frames, but leave a narrow white border. Second frame: cut away the circle and the inner square, but leave a narrow white border near the corner ornaments and the square frame. Adhere the two frames together with foam tape, the frame without the circle on top. Adhere the ship with foam tape to the coloured 9 x 9 cm square. Then adhere the two frames with foam tape to the card with the

Then adhere the two frames with foam tape to the card with the ship and finally onto the single-fold card.



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: PP2804 (Dutch Canal houses), PP2802 (Windmill-frame used), Card: dark blue Cut Shadow paper into a 11.5 x 11.5 cm single-fold card and squares of 10 x 10 cm, 9.5 x 9.5 cm and 9 x 9 cm. Stamp the frame in waterproof ink onto the 9.5 x 9.5 cm square, set aside to dry. Stamp the canal houses to a scrap of Shadow paper and set aside to dry. Use the Shadow painting liner to trace the black lines of the frames and the houses, set aside to dry. Colour in the canal houses with Delft blue Shadow paint, a little water can be used to dilute the paint/reduce the intensity of the colour. Set aside to dry. Use a brush or spray to make the 9 x 9 cm card wet. Apply a little Shadow paint onto one half of the card with a brush and carefully let it run to the other half of the card. Set aside to dry. Use a brush or spray to make the 10 x 10 cm card wet. Apply a little Shadow paint to the card with a brush, creating a hardly diluted dark blue colour and set aside to dry. Cut away the centre of the top card, leaving a narrow white border. Cut out the canal houses with a narrow white border. Adhere to the coloured 9 x 9 cm square using foam tape. Adhere the frame with foam tape to the card with the canal houses and then to a 10 x 10 cm dark blue card using doublesided tape. Finish off by adhering the dark blue to the singlefold card using double-sided tape.

Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower set), COL1449 (Alphabet XXL), COL1450 (Eline's Hippo), Craftables: CR1245 (Tiny's Swirls & Leaves 3), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: pumice stone, Inkpad: Stampin' pad Hello Honey, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Clear stamps: CS1005 (Birthday poems-Dutch), Design paper pad: PK7054 (Crafty Patterns), Papicolor card: Original raven black (901), silver grey (902), light pink (923), pearly white (930) and mouse grey (944), Recycled kraft grey (322), Scrapper's floss, Sharpie pen white

General instructions

Die cut the flower 2x from design paper and the leaves (CR1245) from silver grey card.

Make a bow from scrapper's floss. Add an adhesive pearl in the heart of the flower.

Die cut the hippo from mouse grey, pearly white, raven black and light pink card and design paper, work the hind legs with distress ink pumice stone. Draw dots in the eyes with a sharpie pen.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1390 (Basic shapes with stitches-Rectangle), Mica/transparent foil, Shaker material (sequins) Cut a 15.25×12.25 cm top-fold card from kraft card. Cut 14.25×11 cm pearly white, die cut the letters and layer mica behind the die cut word. Adhere 3D-tape around the mica. Cut 14.75×11.75 cm silver grey card and 7×13.5 cm design paper. Adhere the white rectangle, leave a small gap and add the shaker material.

Die cut and assemble the hippo. Die cut a pearly white rectangle and stamp the text.

Die cut the flower tuft.

Finish off with adhesive pearls and sequins.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1391 (Basic shapes-Ticket)

Cut a 13.25×13.25 cm top-fold card from kraft and mount silver grey on top.

Die cut a ticket from pearly white and design paper. Die cut the letters from design paper and kraft card. Adhere slightly overlapping.

Stamp the text and cut into a label. Cut the same size from design paper.

Die cut the hippos and the flower tuft.

Position all parts on the card and finish off with adhesive pearls.

Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1436 (Ribbon Doily), CR1353 (Label XL & Labels XS), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps CS1005 (Baptism and Communion-Dutch), Inkpads: Archival jet black, Versamark, Embossing powder: clear, Heattool, Copic markers in various colours, Design paper: PB7054 (Crafty Patterns), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Photos, Ribbon



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1430 (Succulentround), CR1432 (Herbs & Leaves), Embroidery thread, Beads, Sequins, Wool felt

Cut a pearly white 14.5×14.5 cm single-fold card and mount 14×14 cm design paper on top.

Die cut the labels from design paper and the flowers and two small labels from wool felt.

Die cut the twigs and rectangle from white card. Colour them in with Copic markers.

Stamp texts and ornaments and work them with clear embossing powder and a heat tool.

Thread ribbon though the rectangle.

Assemble the felt flowers with a few embroidery stitches. Position all parts on the card as shown, using 3D-glue and foam tape to create 3D effects.



Extra needed for this card: Collectables: COL1448 (Eline's Koala & baby), COL1421 (Eline's Baby essentials), Bells: JU0941

Cut a pearly white 14.5×14.5 cm single-fold card and mount 14×14 cm design paper on top.

Die cut a label from design paper. Die cut the other parts from white card and colour in with Copic markers.

Stamp texts onto the labels, work them with clear embossing powder and the heat tool.

Colour in the rattle and the teat, then apply Versamark ink and work with clear embossing powder and a heat tool.

Thread ribbon through the rectangle. Assemble the koala mama and baby.

Position all parts on the card as shown, using 3D-glue and foam tape to create 3D-effects.
