Materialen used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Design paper pad: PK9148 (Boho Summer), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft white (321), Original: raven black (901) and pearly white (930), Vellum, Stickers Project NL: PL4505 (Zon, zee, strand)



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1456 (Eline's Flamingo), Craftables: CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitches-Square), CR1375 (Basic shapes-distressed Square), Creatables: LR0478 (Hibiscus & Tropical leaves), LR0541 (Palm trees), LR0543 (Beach bag), Decoupage sheet: AK0070 (Eline's Tropical backgrounds), Design paper pad: PK9127 (Watercolor), Papicolor card:

Recycled kraft brown (323), Original salmon pink (925), blossom (934), pinetree green (950) and baby pink (959), Diamond gems: JU0938 (light blue & blue)

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm top-fold card from white kraft.

Cut 14.5 x 10 cm blossom card and lay aside. Cut 14×9.5 cm design paper and mount onto the blossom card. Cut a 16.5×7.5 cm strip from vellum, score and fold at 1 cm and 15.5 cm. Fold around the pink card and glue the narrow strip. Adhere the layers to the card.

Die cut a pearly white square with stitches and adhere with 3D-tape. Die cut the background picture with a smaller size distressed square.

Die cut two monstera leaves from dark green and adhere partially behind the picture.

Die cut the tall palm tree and adhere.

Die cut the bag and small palm tree and adhere with 3D-tape. Die cut the flamingo and adhere.

Finish off the card with a text sticker and adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1455 (Eline's Lion/Tiger), Craftables: CR1443 (Lantern set), Creatables: LR0478 (Hibiscus & Tropical leaves), Decoupage sheet: AK0071 (Eline's Savanne

backgrounds), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original: carnation white (903), caramel (926), nut brown (939), mocha (953), army green (954) and taupe (961), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Diamond gems: JU0392 (clear)



Cut 20.5 \times 10 cm army green card and lay aside. Cut 20 \times 9.5 cm design paper and adhere to the army green. Cut out the picture at 19 \times 8.5 cm and adhere to the design paper.

Cut a 12 x 3 cm vellum strip, score and fold at 1 cm and 11 cm and wrap around the army green card, design paper and picture. Adhere the layers to the card.

Die cut the lions, the leaves and lanterns and adhere. Finish off the card with a text sticker and diamond gems.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1457 (Eline's Toucan), Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circle), CR1360 (Basic shapes with stitches-Circle), CR1443 (Lantern set), Creatables: LR0478 (Hibiscus & Tropical leaves), Design folder: DF3449 (Tropical leaves), Decoupage sheet: AK0070 (Eline's Tropical backgrounds),

Papicolor card: Recycled kraft: grey (322), orange (325) and green (328), Original: light pink (923), cream (927), cerise (933), mango (940), light green (947), pinetree green (950), army green (954) and baby pink (959), Diamond gems: JU0937 (light pink & pink)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm top-fold card from white kraft and mount 14 x 14 cm light green card and 13 x 13 cm design paper on top. Emboss 12.5 x 12.5 cm vellum with the design folder and adhere (apply glue in the centre only so that it doesn't show). Die cut the circle with stitches from pearly white card and adhere with 3D-tape. Die cut the picture with a smaller size circle without stitches and adhere.

Die cut the monstera leaves and adhere.

Die cut the bird and adhere without the legs, lay those aside. Die cut the twig, leaves and lantern set and adhere. Then adhere the legs under the body and on top of the twig.

Die cut the hibiscus and adhere.

Finish off the card with a text sticker and diamond gems.

Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: LR0437 (Petra's Twigs set), LR0539 (Petra's Amaryllis), LR0540 (Petra's Botanical circle), Design folder: DF3450 (Pine), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: peeled paint, barn door, Decoupage sheet: VK9566 (Christmas Birds), Papicolor card: Original olive green (945) and army green (954), Shiny pearls: green D106, Marabou feather: mix forest 2908, Brad


General instructions:

The dimensions are indicated like this: first you will see the height and then the width. So when it says 10 x 5 cm, this means the paper is 10 cm high and 5 cm wide. Lace is adhered with double-sided tape.



Extra needed for this card:

Distress ink: weathered wood, pumice stone, Victorian velvet, Papicolor card: Original: black (901), blossom (934), baby blue (956) and taupe (961), Metallic gold (338), Brilliant gravel (161) and champagne (163), Shiny pearls: green D106, Lace/Ribbon: German lace DK3006 pink 60 mm, K1058 white lace polyester 25 mm, VV1011 satin ribbon taupe 10 mm, Marabou feather: white, Stamens



Cut 13×13 cm taupe and baby blue, emboss the pattern and fold them into triangles.

Indicate the centre in pencil onto baby blue and position the two folded triangles on each side.

For the bottom cut a 5.7×14 cm black strip and a 5.3×13.6 cm taupe one. Adhere together.

Take a long piece of pink lace. Adhere at the right-hand side behind the black strip.

Position the black strip on the card as per example and adhere with 3D-glue. Leave the centre open.

Wrap the pink lace around the card on the left-hand side and fix at the back. Cut to size.



Cut two 1.8 x 14 cm taupe strips. Adhere one at the front and one at the back in the centre of the pink lace.

Take a long piece of taupe ribbon. Adhere as per example at the front and back of the two narrow taupe strips. Use the long ribbon to close the card with a pretty bow on the right-hand side.

Die cut/emboss the botanical circle from olive green and army green card.

Position the picture in the centre and adhere to olive green using 3D-glue. Set aside to dry. Push the lowest olive green point behind the black strip and adhere as per example in the centre of the card onto the two triangles.

Die cut/emboss the amaryllis from army green, champagne and blossom card, and the alder cones from gold-coloured paper. Assemble as per example. Set aside to dry.

Die cut/emboss from gravel card 2x the large flower and 1x the small star/flower. Shape the flower. Punch a hole into the centre for the stamens.


Finish off the card with pearls and a pretty bow.






Extra needed for this card:

Distress ink: barn door, Ink pad Memento: northern pine, Papicolor card: Original: silver grey (902), fiesta red (918), olive green (945) and army green (954), Metallic red lacquer (337), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Vellum: white, Bells: JU0931 (silvergold), Embroidery lace: K1084 white 10 mm, Shiny pearls: red D110, green D106, Nylon lace: K1093 ivory white 20 mm, Gloss VV1002 gold 1 mm



Cut the following squares: silver grey 14 x 14 cm (this will be placed under the vellum, so does not need to be embossed) and 13 x 13 cm (will be folded into a triangle and adhered at the reverse side), vellum 13.5 x 13.5 cm, pearly white 13 x 13 cm (will be folded into a triangle). Emboss the squares with the design folder.



Die cut/emboss the botanical circle (LR0540) from olive green, army green and gold card. Adhere the picture in the centre behind army green and then position on the olive green using 3D-glue.

Set aside to dry. Then adhere centrally onto the pearly white triangle. Measure well.

Die cut/emboss the amaryllis from army green and fiesta red, the twig from gold card. Assemble as per example. Set aside to dry.

Adhere the vellum centrally to silver grey. Die cut/emboss a small star/flower from pearly white. Fix in the top right corner using a brad.

Adhere silver grey to the front of the card.

Adhere the pearly white triangle at the bottom, behind the front flap.

Fold the front part up. Adhere the gold-coloured circle to the vellum as per example. Measure well.


Cut a 5 x 2 cm pearly white strip and fold as follows: at 1 cm valley fold, 0.5 cm mountain fold, 2 cm mountain fold, 0.5 cm valley-fold. 1 cm remains, adhere this strip in the centre as per example. Apply glue. Fold the pearly white triangle up and press again it.

Fold the 13 x 13 cm silver grey square into a triangle. Position it on the reverse side of the card as per example. The other tip will be on the table. Finish off the tip with adhesive pearls.

Materials used for both cards:

Collectables: COL1362 (Snow globe-circles used), Craftables: CR1431 (Succulent-pointed leaf), CR1435 (Punch die-Keys), Creatables: LR0388 (Flower Doily), LR0537 (Anja's Long borders), LR0538 (Anja's Corners), LR0542 (Suitcase), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: vintage photo, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0176 (Brocante), Design paper pad: PK9157 (Soft pastels), Adhesive pearls, Rope

General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper and the embossed parts with an ink pad/distress ink.



Extra needed for this card:

Ink pad Versa Magic: ocean depth, Papicolor card Original: blue (955), Kraft, Doily, Flower foam, Heat tool, Stamens Cut a 10.5 x 20 cm single-fold kraft card.

Cut 10 \times 19.5 cm design paper and blue card. Die cut the long border and the corners into the blue rectangle. Cut the paper to size, cutting off the edges around the corners.

Cut a 3 \times 18 cm strip from design paper. Adhere the layers together.

Glue the picture to kraft card and trim leaving a narrow border. Colour the doily with ink and cut in half, position on each side of the picture. Tie rope around the picture.

Die cut two suitcases from design paper.

Die cut the succulent from flower foam, colour in with ink. Heat the flower with a heat tool and shape the petals. Assemble. Punch a few leaves too.

Adhere all parts to the card and finish off.



Extra needed for this card:

Papicolor card Original: blossom (934) and carnation white (903), Kraft, Paper flowers, Punch: butterfly, Small lock Cut a 10.5 x 21 cm single-fold card from blossom card.

Die cut the corner into 9.5×20 cm design paper and adhere the strip to 10×20.5 cm carnation white card.

Die cut the long border from carnation white card and adhere to the design paper. Die cut the flower doily from carnation white card, cut off a piece and adhere along the edge.

Die cut a circle from blossom card and use the same die to die cut the picture from the decoupage sheet. Adhere overlapping. Tie rope around the card and add a flower with a key.

Die cut the suitcases from kraft card.

Adhere all layers to the card and finish off with a flower and a small lock.

Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: picket fence, Design paper pad: PK9157 (Soft pastel), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), olive green (945), Paper distresser

General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser.





Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circles), Creatables: LR0541 (Palm trees), LR0542 (Suitcase), LR0543 (Beach baq), LR0477 (Flip-flops & Sun glasses), Design folder: DF3449 (Tropical leaves), Clear stamps Project-NL: PL1514 (Zon, zee, strand), Distress ink: vintage photo, Ink pad Versafine: onyx black, Decoupage sheet: EWK1260 (Tropical Dreams), Design paper pad: PK9148 (Boho summer), Papicolor card: Original silver grey (902) and

dark brown (938), Recycled brown kraft (323), Glitter card: CA3127 (silver)

Die cut the following parts and adhere together as per example:

- a 28 x 14 cm olive green strip, score at 7 and 14 cm.
- two 6.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white strips and two 6 x 13 cm ones from design paper.
- 13.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white card and 13 x 13 cm design paper.
- a 28 x 4.5 cm olive green strip, score at 14 and 21 cm.
- pearly white card: 13.5 x 4 cm and twice 6.5 x 4 cm.
- design paper: 13 x 3.5 cm and twice 6 x 3.5 cm. Adhere the strip along the bottom of the card at 3.5 cm in from the edge.

Die cut the picture, mat on design paper and adhere to a pearly white basic circle with decorative border.

Die cut the following parts:

- two palm trees from dark brown, olive green and silver grey card, work the trunks with distress ink picket fence.
- a beach bag from design paper, work with distress ink vintage photo.
- a standing suitcase from design paper and dark brown card and a lying one from dark brown card. Die cut the corners and the handle from brown kraft and the lock from silver card.
- flip flops from design paper.

Complete the card with a stamped text.





Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1360 (Basic shapes with stitches-Circle), CR1377 (Bag topper), CR1443 (Lampions set), Creatables: LR0477 (Flip-flops and Sun glasses), LR0478 (Hibiscus & Tropical leaves), LR0543 (Beach bag), LR0538 (Anja's corners), Design folder: DF3449 (Tropical leaves), Clear stamps: KJ1713 (Zomer), Distress ink: Victorian velvet, vintage photo, Ink pad Versafine: onyx black, Decoupage sheet: EWK1260 (Tropical Dreams), Papicolor card: Original cerise (933),

Christmas red (943), baby pink (959), pink (915), light pink (923), army green (954) and Recycled grey kraft (322), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Wax cord

Die cut a bag topper, cut off the tab. Cut design paper into a 12 cm \emptyset circle and cerise card into 12.5 cm \emptyset , adhere together with the tab in between. Cut out the picture and mat on cerise card. Cut a 15 x 15 cm cerise top-fold card.

Adhere 14 x 14 cm design paper to 14 x 14 cm cerise card and die cut the largest basic circle (10 cm \emptyset) from the centre. Die cut the same circle from the front flap of the top fold card at the same place.

Adhere to the reverse side of the square (design paper and cerise card) strips of 0.5 cm wide foam along the bottom and the two sides. Not along the top! Check to see that the circular card fits. Adhere the square card to the front of the top-fold card, with the open circles neatly on top of each other.

Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 14 x 14 cm green design paper. Emboss the design paper and adhere both squares to the back flap of the card. Stamp a text onto pink design paper, cut out and adhere to the embossed design paper. Die cut tropical leaves from army green and olive green card, work the dark green ones with distress ink picket fence. Die cut the hibiscus from cerise, Christmas red and pink card. Die cut the beach bag from grey kraft, work with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut the sun glasses from cerise card, use the top of the flip flops for the temples and ear pieces. Die cut the lampions and adhere to a line of wax cord.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1432 (Herbs & Leaves), CR1443 (Lampions set), Creatables: LR0478 (Hibiscus & Tropical leaves), LR0537 (Anja's Long borders), LR0538 (Anja's Corners), Distress ink: milled lavender, Decoupage sheet: EWK1261 (Summer Dreams), Papicolor

card Original: cerise (933), baby pink (959), lavender (921), mauve (937), sea green (917), night blue (941), army green (954), Adhesive pearls: JU0932 (clear), Wax cord

Cut a 15 x 15 cm night blue top-fold card. Mount 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and two pieces of 14 x 7 cm design paper on top.

Die cut/emboss the border from pearly white, cut off along the ends, work with distress ink milled lavender and adhere over the centre line.

Cut 12×12 cm design paper. Cut 10.5×10.5 cm white card, die cut/emboss all corners and work with distress ink milled lavender. Layer the picture behind and cut off excess paper along the edges.

Die cut the hibiscus from baby pink and cerise and finish off with a pearl. Die cut the leaves from olive green and army green card; work the olive green ones with distress ink picket fence. Die cut the lampions and adhere to a line of wax cord.

General instructions:

Draw a clouds border and cut out. Use distress ink tumbled glass and dab it along the edge of the clouds border onto the stamped images. Replace the clouds border several times to create a sky with clouds.

Die cut the clouds border (CR1361) from pearly white card and vellum, cut to size. Adhere together overlapping.

Die cut separate clouds 3x from pearly white card and design paper and adhere them overlapping.

Adhere the clouds border and the separate clouds using 3D-glue.

Materialen used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1361 (Stitched Waves & Clouds), CR1402 (Bendy Card-Clouds used), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps Hetty: HT1634 (Sky is the limit) and HT1635 (Sunny days), Distress ink: tumbled glass, Ink pad: Archival jet black, Design paper pad: PK9147 (Aqua Color), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Perfect colouring paper (PCP), Copics or other colouring medium, Vellum or other transparent paper



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1375 (Basic shapes-distressed Square), Design folder: DF3434 (Clouds) Cut a 13 \times 13 pearly white top-fold card and 12.5 \times 12.5 cm design paper.

Emboss clouds onto an 11.5 x 11.5 cm pearly white square. Highlight the embossed clouds with distress ink tumbled glass. Die cut the clouds border from PCP and design paper. Adhere together overlapping.

Stamp the images and colour them in.

Die cut clouds from PCP and design paper and adhere overlapping.

Stamp the kite and plane and stamp the text. Colour the images in and adhere to the card, raised with 3D-qlue.



Extra needed for this card: Ink pad Archival: cornflower

blue

Cut a 15 x 12 cm pearly white top-fold card, 14.5 x 11.5 cm design paper and 14 x 11 cm PCP.

Stamp the images in black Archival ink and colour them in. Die cut the clouds border and stamp the text in cornflower blue ink.

Die cut separate clouds. Stamp the balloon, colour in, cut out and adhere to the card raised with 3D-glue.
