#### Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0550 (Tiny's Larch), LR0551 (Nature star), LR0546 (Anja's Beautiful flower set), LR0547 (Anja's Leaves set), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1008 (Kerst- en nieuwjaarswensen), Ink pad Versafine: onyx black, Distress ink: picket fence, Design paper pad: PK9158 (Forest Dream), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), cerise (933), dark brown (938), olive green (945), Paper distresser

## General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. Blend the larch and mistletoe after embossing with distress ink picket fence.



Extra needed for his card: Craftables: CR1439 (Basic shapes-Arch), Creatables: LR0549 Tiny: (Holly), Decoupage sheet: EWK1263 (Forest Dream), Papicolor card Metallic red lacquer (337), botanic (336), Adhesive stones: JU0932 (clear), Tulle, Wax cord



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1446 (Twine Oval), Creatables: LR0458 Tiny: (Robin), Decoupage sheet: EWK1262 (Forest Dream), Papicolor card: Original: Christmas red (943), nut brown (939), light grey (957) and baby blue (956), Recycled kraft brown (323), Pearls: CA3133

(off-white), Adhesive stones: JU0932 (clear)



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1446 (Twine Oval), Creatables Tiny: LR0458 (Robin), LR0549 (Holly), Decoupage sheet: EWK1245 (Country Christmas 1), Papicolor card: Original: Christmas red (943), nut brown (939) and light grey (957), Metallic: red lacquer (337) and

botanic (336), Pearls: CA3133 (off-white)

Cut a 15 x 15 cm olive green top-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card,  $14 \times 14$  cm design paper,  $12 \times 12$  cm olive green card and  $11.5 \times 11.5$  cm design paper. Die cut the basic arch from pearly white, die cut the image and mat on Christmas red. Die cut the flowers from cerise and pearly white and finish off with a pearl. Die cut the holly from green design paper, the berries from red lacquer, the mistletoe from olive green, the leaves from botanic and the larch from dark brown. Stamp the text onto a scrap of design paper. Finish off the card with a bow of tulle and wax cord.

Cut a 14 x 16 cm night blue top-fold card and adhere 13.4 x 15.4 cm pearly white and 13 x 15 cm, 11 x 13 cm and 6 x 16 cm design paper. Die cut the oval from pearly white, position the picture behind and mat on Christmas red. Die cut the star from dark brown and recycled brown kraft and position behind the oval. Die cut the flowers from baby blue and Christmas red and finish off with a pearl. Die cut the leaves from olive green and the larch from dark brown. Die cut the robin from nut brown, light grey and cerise and assemble. Finish off the card with a text, stamped onto design paper.

Cut a 16 x 15 cm Christmas red top-fold card and adhere 15.5 x 14.5 cm white card and 15 x 14 cm and 16 x 8.5 cm design paper. Die cut the oval from pearly white, position a picture behind and mat on Christmas red card. Die cut the flowers from pearly white and red lacquer and finish off with a pearl. Die cut the holly from green design paper, the berries from red lacquer, the mistletoe from olive green, the leaves from botanic and the larch from dark brown. Die cut the robin from nut brown, light grey and cerise and assemble. Stamp the text onto a scrap of design paper. Adhere pearls to the oval.

## Materials used for both cards:

Collectables: COL1458 (Arrow Sentiments), Creatables: LR0009 (Stamp Master), Die cut and embossing machine, Mask stencils Tiny: PS8009 (Leaves), PS8010 (Pinecones), Layering stamps Tiny: TC0865 (Sunflower), TC0866 (Robin), Amsterdam acrylic paint: Azo light yellow, Azo orange, sap green, Archival ink: leaf green, shadow grey, Stazon ink: timber brown, Distress ink: mowed lawn, salty ocean, tumbled glass, vintage photo, walnut stain, Gelatos: blood orange, Design paper pad: PK9146 (Côte d'Azur), Gelli plate, Post-it notes, Scrapper's floss, Sisal grass

## Tip layering stamps:

The order in which to use the colours is stated on the packaging. Select the ink colours or use paint and a blending foam sponge to ink the stamp. The stamp master is a practical tool to help stamping the layers exactly on top of each other.



Work the top of a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card with leaves (PS8009) and distress ink. Make a plain green border along the bottom. Adhere a 15 x 5 cm strip of design paper along the top and a 15 x 1 cm one along the bottom.

Use a piece of water colour card and stamp a border of sunflowers using the stamp master. Stamp the same sunflowers onto Post-it notes, cut out and use to mask the sunflower border. Then create the background. Cut off this card at 12 x 8 cm. Work with distress ink and add leaves. Ink the edges and make yellow and white splashes on the background. Mat on white and then adhere to the card. Stamp a sunflower and two leaves, cut out and adhere together with a tuft of sisal grass and a bow of floss. Finish off with a die cut arrow text.

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm ivory single-fold card and three square cards: brown 13.7 x 13.7 cm, ivory 13.1 x 13.1 cm and kraft 12.5 x 12.5 cm. Emboss the alphabet onto the kraft square and ink the letters with distress ink.

Die cut the label and ink the edges with distress ink. Lay the label into the stamp master and stamp the robin layer by layer. Stamp the leaves and acorns in the same way onto scraps of card. Cut out and adhere in front of the robin. Adhere to the single-fold card as shown.

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm ivory single-fold card, a 14 x 14 cm yellow square and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper. Die cut the stencils.

Use the stamp master to stamp the sunflowers and leaves layer

by layer and cut out. Adhere them to the card as shown.



Cut a 11.5 x 15 cm white single-fold card.

Use an 11 x 14.5 cm Gelliplate print and work the background with leaves (PS8009). Ink the edges with distress ink salty ocean and use a blending foam sponge to apply blue ink/ paint onto the background. Use tumbled glass distress ink to make a few pinecones (PS8010). Adhere to the card with a strip of design paper along the top.

Use a piece of water colour card and stamp the robin using the stamp master. Use your fingers to apply a little gelatos-red to create extra depth. Cut the card around the robin, leave its tail intact, into a  $5.5 \times 9.5$  cm rectangle. Stamp an extra image onto a Post-it note, cut out and mask the bird. Create the background using distress ink, a blending foam sponge and the stencil of the leaves. Ink the edges, mat on white and adhere to the card. Complete the card with an arrow text.

## Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: LR0430 (Leaf doily), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps Hetty: HT1636 (Forest border), Distress ink: rusty hinge, tumbled glass, Inkpad Archival: jet black, Copics or other colouring medium, Design paper bloc: PK9158 (Forest Dream), Perfect colouring paper (PCP), Papicolor card: Original raven black (901), Christmas red (943), mustard yellow (948), Recycled kraft grey (322), Rope: brown

## General instructions:

Die cut autumn leaves from moss green, Christmas red and mustard yellow card. Work the edges with distress ink rusty hinge. Draw a bank of clouds and cut out. Use distress ink tumbled glass and dab it along the edge of the clouds onto the stamped images. Replace the clouds several times to create a clouded sky.



# Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitches-Square), CR1422 (Spiderweb), Clear stamps Hetty: HT1637 (Forest animals-Hedgehogs), Clear stamps Karin Joan: (Groetjes) Cut a 14 x 14 cm top-fold card from kraft. Cut 13.25 x 13.25 cm design paper and mat on Christmas red.

Cut  $12.25 \times 12.25$  cm from PCP. Stamp the edge of the wood and the animals in black ink, using the masking technique. Colour in the image. Cut  $13.25 \times 13.25$  cm design paper, cut out a square from its centre creating a frame. Stamp the spider in black ink. Die cut the cobweb from raven black card and adhere in the top left corner of the frame. Adhere the frame to the card using 3D-foamtape or 3D-glue.

Stamp the leaves and the robin, colour in the image. Die cut four leaves from different autumn colours. Tie a piece of rope into a bow. Stamp the text and cut into a banner.



Extra needed for this card: Collectables: COL1442 (Giftwrapping Karin's Deer, star & tag), Craftables: CR1383 (Spiders and bugs), Clear stamps Hetty: HT1637 (Forest animals-Squirrels), Clear stamps Karin Joan: KJ1721 (Gefeliciteerd) Cut a 15 x 12 cm top-fold card from kraft. Cut design paper into 14.25 x 11.25 cm and 13.5 x 10.5 cm, mat the large rectangle on Christmas red card. Die cut the label from design paper. Cut 14.25 x 9.5 cm PCP. Stamp the edge of the wood and the animals in black ink using the masking technique. Colour in the image. Stamp the leaves and the squirrel, colour in and cut out. Tie rope into a bow. Die cut four leaves. Die cut a black spider and adhere on the leaves.

Stamp the text and cut into a banner.

## Materials used for both cards:

Creatables Tiny: LR0548 (Robin), LR0549 (Holly), LR0550 (Larch), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear Stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Ink pads: black, Hero Arts white, Design paper pad: PK 9142 (Après-ski), Rhinestones: CA3136, Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), nut brown (939), Christmas red (943), olive green (945), Wax cord



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1446 (Twine Oval, Design folder: DF3419 (Snowflakes), Distress ink, Decoupage sheet: VK9568 (Snowmen-oval), Papicolor card Original: night blue (941), carnation white (903), Gesso Cut a 16 x 11 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 15.5 x 10.5 cm night blue card and 15 x 10 cm design paper. Emboss 5.5 x 12 cm pearly white card and cut in half. Die cut the twine oval from pearly white card and layer the two embossed strips behind. Tie a bow of wax cord in the top left corner of the oval. Cut out the image and adhere. Die cut/emboss the holly from olive green and the berries from Christmas red. Work with gesso. Die cut/emboss the larch from nut brown and work with white ink. Die cut the bird from nut brown and work with ink. Die cut pieces of bread from carnation white and work with light brown ink. Stamp a text onto pearly white card.

Complete the card with rhinestones.



**Extra needed for this card:** Craftables: CR1414 (Twine Circle), Creatables: LR0379 (Pinetree), Decoupage sheet: VK9569 (Snowmen-circle and square), Papicolor card: moss green (951) Cut a 15 x 7.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere  $14.5 \times 13.5$  cm design paper. Die cut the trees from pearly white and moss green, adhere together overlapping. Die cut/emboss the twine circle from pearly white and thread wax cord through the holes. Cut out an image and adhere.

Adhere the trees in front of and behind the circle. Die cut the holly from olive green and the berries from Christmas red. Work with gesso. Die cut/emboss the larch from nut brown and work with white ink. Die cut a bird from nut brown and work with ink. Stamp a text onto a pearly white strip, mat on white and tie a piece of wax cord to it. Complete the card with rhinestones.

# Materials used for both cards: Die cut and embossing machine



## Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1442 (Karin's Label), COL1458 (Arrow Sentiments), Craftables: CR1444 (Basic shapes-Hexagon), CR1445 (Deer Head), Design paper pad: PK9149 (Do what you love), Mirror card: CA3134 (gold), Sequins: black Cut a 13 x 15 cm black top-fold card. Cut 5 x 13 cm design paper and 2.5 x 13 cm black card.

Die cut from design paper, black card and gold-coloured design paper the following: 3x hexagon, label, deer head, arrow sentiment.

Tie rope to the label.

Assemble the card as per example and add sequins randomly.



## Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circle), CR1353 (Basic shapes-Labels XL and XS), CR1386 (Bow), Creatables: LR0373 (Oak leaf and acorns), LR0545 (Sunflower), LR0550 (Tiny's Pinetree), LR0551 (Nature Star), Design paper pad: PK9138 (Canadian Fall), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Ribbon, Rope Die cut the largest label 2x from kraft and 1x from design paper. Adhere the latter to a kraft label. Set aside to dry and then fold the label in half with the design paper on the outside. Adhere a smaller label from design paper to the other large label.

Adhere the folded label to the lower half of the large label. Die cut a small circular label from kraft. Trace the inside of the label onto design paper and cut out.

Only adhere the bottom of the small label to the flap. Die cut the image with a suitable circular die, mat on a larger circle from design paper.

Die cut the following shapes from various card and design paper colours: 2x sunflower, 4x leaves of sunflower, 2x acorn, nature star, bow, pinetree and a few oak leaves. Highlight the sunflowers and leaves with distress ink walnut stain.

Adhere the sunflower to the top of the label using foamtape so that the tip of small label can be pushed behind.

Thread a ribbon through the top of the label and tie the ends together with rope.

Finish off the card as per example.

## Materials used for all cards:

Background stamps: CS0997 (Musical Notes), Texture stamp Tiny: MM1617 (Stains), Ink pads: black, Watermark ink and embossing powder (gold), Design paper pad: PB7053 (Eline's Berry Christmas), Card: white and kraft, Shadowpaper, Shadowpainting liner, Shadowpaint: carmine red, sienna, light green and olive green, Christmas green, Heat tool, Cord, Brush

## General instructions:

**Stamping:** Stamp the figures in black ink onto Shadowpaper and set aside to dry. Use the Shadowpainting liner, trace the black lines and set aside to dry. Colour in the images with Shadowpaint in the colours indicated per card. Trim leaving a narrow white line all around.


**Labels:** Cut the stamped text into a label and mat on another card colour or make two labels (card 3), punch a hole and tie them together.

**Background:** Moisten one or more sheets of Shadowpaper with a brush and a little water, or spray with water. Use a brush to apply Shadowpaint in the colours light green, olive green, Christmas green and carmine red and blend them well. Set aside to dry. Take a painted sheet of Shadowpaper, sheets from Christmas Berry design paper and other sheets of design paper if you like. Stamp the sheets randomly with watermark ink and the texture stamp with stains. Sprinkle gold-coloured embossing powder on top and work with a heat tool.



**Extra needed for this card:** Powder Pink stamps: PP2807 (Santa Claus and Text), PP2808 (Star and Text) Cut an 11 x 11 cm single-fold card from kraft. Stamp the background with musical notes and set aside to dry. Work the background sheets as per the general instructions and cut them into  $3 \times 3$  cm squares. Adhere them in a block of nine squares to a  $9.5 \times 9.5$  cm white card. Position the white card onto the single-fold card using foam tape. Make the images as per the general instructions. Colour them in with Shadowpaint in the colours carmine red and sienna. Tie a length of cord around the card.

Adhere Santa, stars and a text to the card with foam tape.





Powder Pink stamps: PP2809 (Dove and Text), PP2808 (Star and Text)

Cut a 12 x 12 cm single-fold card from Shadowpaper. Work the background sheets as per the general instructions and cut them into 3 x 3 cm squares. Adhere them in a block of sixteen squares to the front of the card. Stamp a background onto  $9 \times 9$  cm kraft and adhere to  $9.3 \times 9.3$  cm white card. Adhere the white square to the single-fold card with foam tape. Make the images as per the general instructions. Colour them in with Shadowpaint in the colours carmine red and Christmas green. Tie a length of cord around the card.

Adhere the pigeon, stars and a text to the card with foam tape.



Extra needed for this card: Powder Pink stamps: PP2810 (Christmas Bells), PP2810 (Polar bears and Text, text used), Hole punch

Cut a 12 x 12 cm single-fold card from Shadowpaper. Work the background sheets as per the general instructions and cut them into  $3 \times 3$  cm squares. Adhere them in a block of sixteen squares to the front of the card. Stamp a background onto 12 x 5 cm kraft and adhere to 12 x 5.5 cm white card. Position the strip on the card with foam tape. Make the Christmas bells as per the general instructions. Colour them in with Shadowpaint in the colours carmine red, Christmas green and olive green. Tie a length of cord around the card. Adhere the Christmas bells to the card with foam tape.
