Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1444 (Rosettes and Labels), Craftables: CR1336 (Punch die-Autumn leaves), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1011 (Hugs – EN), Ink pad: VersaMark, Embossing powder: Stampendous White EP100, Design paper pad: PK9127 (Watercolor), PK9159 (Swedish winter), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original pearly white (930), cerise (933) and nut brown (939), Pearls: CA3132 (white), Rhinestones: CA3136, Thin jute rope

General instructions:

For all cards: start by tracing the outline of the stencil onto white card or another matching colour. Cut out the figure and erase any visible pencil lines. The inner lines of the stencil are used for decorating purposes only. Trace these on the reverse side of card or design paper. Don't forget to use the stencil upside down, to avoid getting a figure in mirror image! Cut these parts out and adhere. To make a double card, like the apple and mushrooms cards:

Trace the outline of the stencil once again and cut out. Make a horizontal score line and fold over at 4 cm from the top of the figure. Glue the folded top part to the reverse side of the first card. Now the card can stand upright on its own.

Tip:

Does the card not stand up straight properly?

Cut off a small piece of the bottom of the back card to give the card a horizontal part to lean on.



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0360 (Tiny's Grass), LR0555 (Scandinavian Houses – set of 3), LR0556 (Forest trees – set of 3), Stencil by Marleen: PS8015 (Mushroom), Distress ink: walnut stain, Papicolor card Original: taupe (961), Hole punch

Die cut the trees from taupe and adhere to the card.

Die cut the grass from yellow design paper, adhere to the bottom of the card, but keep a small piece aside to use near one of the houses later on. Die cut three houses from nut brown card and recycled grey kraft. Work the houses with ink and adhere to yellow design paper using foam tape. Cut the houses out again. Die cut three roofs from red design paper, cut out and adhere to the brown houses. Adhere the houses as shown.

Die cut the banner from grey, stamp a text, work with white embossing powder and a heat tool. Cut off the left-hand side, punch a hole and tie a bow of thin rope through it. Adhere to the card using foam tape. Finish off with autumn leaves, pearls and silver-coloured adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1422 (Spiderweb), Craft stencil by Marleen: PS8013 (Apple and Leaves), Decoupage sheet Hetty: HK1703 (Tomte Gnomes), Vellum Die cut the spiderweb from vellum and adhere, making sure to only apply glue where it will be covered by autumn leaves later on.

Cut out the gnome with wheelbarrow and the hedgehog from the decoupage sheet and adhere to the apple using foam tape. Die cut the banner from grey, stamp a text, work with white embossing powder and a heat tool and adhere with a bow of thin rope behind.

Finish off with autumn leaves, pearls and silver-coloured adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1408 (Card stand), CR1422 (Spiderweb), Creatables: LR0554 (Tomte Gnome), Stencil by Marleen: PS8014 (Autumn leaves), Papicolor card Original: salmon pink (925), taupe (961), Vellum, Hole punch Die cut the spiderweb from vellum and adhere to the large leaf, making sure to only apply glue where it will be covered by an autumn leaf later on. Die cut the banner from grey, stamp a text, work with white embossing powder and a heat tool. Cut off the left-hand side, punch a hole and tie a bow of thin rope through it. Adhere to the card using foam tape. Die cut the gnomes, assemble and adhere. Die cut the card stand from pearly white card. Trace the inside of the Craftable onto the reverse side of design paper, cut out and adhere the design paper to the card stand. Finish off with autumn leaves, pearls and silver-coloured adhesive stones.

Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: Anja's Beautiful Flowers set (LR0546), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: walnut stain, Ink pad: Versamagic, Papicolor card Brilliant: gravel (161)



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: Anja's Folding die-Circle (LR0552), Scandinavian Houses (LR0555), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: Winter (MB0177), Papicolor card Kraft: brown (323) Die cut/emboss the motifs needed from brown Kraft and Brilliant gravel and ink all the edges with distress ink walnut stain.
Cut out the picture and adhere to the die cut gravel circle.
Apply snow to the rooftops of the houses and adhere as shown.
Die cut the flower from printing papier, highlight with
Versamagic. Crease the flower a little and add a pearl to its heart. Adhere the flower and leaves with a glue gun.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: Anja's Folding die-Square (LR0553), Anja's Beautiful Flowers (LR0546), Forest Trees (LR0556), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: Winter (MB0178), Papicolor card Original: pinetree green (950), Brad, Lace, Seambinding, Stamens Die cut/emboss the motifs needed from pinetree green and gravel and ink all the edges. Cut out the picture, adhere to the die cut square and adhere as shown. Adhere the trees to the card as shown and work with a little snow. Die cut the flower from printing paper and highlight with Versamagic. Crease the flower a little, punch a hole in the centre and thread stamens through. Fix the flower and leaves with a heat gun. Finish off the card with a bow of lace and seambinding and fix with a brad.

General instructions:

Creating the sky: Place the mask stencil with the ice crystals at the top of the image. Use a sponge with Versamark and wipe over the stencil carefully. Remove the stencil and apply a little Pan Pastel onto the image. Fix the image. Work the edges of the trees and the rooftop with snowtex. Die cut a stitched rectangle from PCP, stamp the image using the masking technique and Archival jet black ink. Colour in with Copics or another colouring medium. Stamp the candles, colour in and cut out.

Craftables: CR1390 (Basic shapes with stitches-Rectangle), CR1448 (Punch die-Stars), Creatables: LR0556 (Forest trees), Die cut and embossing machine, Mask stencil Tiny: PS8011 (Ice Crystals), Distress ink: vintage photo, Copics of other colouring medium, Clear stamps: CS1010 (Knuffels/Hugs), HT1639 (Tomte Gnomes), Ink pads: Archival jet black, Versamark, Design paper pad: PK9159 (Swedish Winter), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original: pearly white (930), olive green (945) and moss green (951), Perfect Colouring Paper (PCP), Mirror card: CA3134 (gold), Fixing spray, Pan Pastel: ultra-marine blue tint (520,8), Adhesive stones: JU0952 (light and dark gold), Rope, Snowtex



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1361 (Stitched Waves & Clouds), CR1431 (Succulent-pointed), CR1432 (Herbs & Leaves), Creatables: LR0555 (Scandinavian Houses)

Cut a 11.5 x 15 cm single-fold card from grey kraft. Cut a 11 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and two 10.75 x 7.1 cm rectangles from design paper. Cut a 10.75 x 8.5 cm pearly white card and die cut the clouds border along one side. Die cut a decorative border from design paper and cut to size.

Die cut a stitched rectangle from design paper and PCP. Stamp the image. Create the sky. Die cut four trees from moss green and olive green card. Die cut the house from grey kraft. Leave the shape in the die and highlight with distress ink vintage. Layer design paper behind the house. Die cut a clouds border from pearly white and cut to size. Stamp the girl, colour in and cut out. Adhere to the card using 3D glue/foamtape. Die cut the stars from gold-coloured mirror card. Die cut the succulent 2x from design paper. Die cut the herbs and leaves from moss green and olive green card. Position a piece of rope behind the flower. Stamp the text and cut into a banner. Cut a banner of the same size from design paper. Add a pearl to the hearts of the flower.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1442 (Giftwrapping, Karin's Deer, Stars & Tag), COL1443 (Karin's Bird, Hearts & Tag), Craftables: CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitches-Square), Clear stamps Hetty: HT1640 (Lantern

border), Mask stencil Tiny: PS8012 (Snowflakes), Gesso

Cut a 15 x 11 .5 cm top-fold card from kraft. Cut 14.25 x 10.75 cm design paper and mat on pearly white card. Die cut a stitched square from red/white design paper. Cut 13.25 x 9.50 cm design paper. Place the mask stencil with the snowflakes near the top and dab onto the stencil with gesso. Die cut the label 2x from design paper. Die cut a stitched rectangle from PCP and stamp the image. Die cut the trees 2x from kraft and 1x from moss green and olive green card. Work the kraft trees with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut the banner 2x from design paper, stamp the text with

Archival jet black. Tie them together with a piece of rope. Finish off with stars, die cut from gold-coloured card.

COL1459 (Eline's Christmas Tree), COL1460 (Eline's Sleigh), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS0991 (Fijne Kerstdagen), Ink pad: Versafine onyx black, Design paper pad: PB7035 (Eline's Berry Christmas), Papicolor card pearly white (930), Christmas red, Recycled Kraft: brown



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1442 (Karin's Deer, Stars & Tag), Design folder: DF3450 (Pine), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Buttons, Ribbon, Rope Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white top-fold card. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and adhere to 13 x 13 cm red card. Emboss a white 10 x 10 cm card and then adhere to 10.5 x 10.5 cm green design paper. Cut a 4 x 13.5 cm strip from design paper and a 2 x 13.5 cm one from red card. Tear off a strip from the red one along the long side. Stamp the text onto a 3 x 4 cm strip from kraft. Die cut the figures needed from various card colours and design paper. Finish off the card as shown.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables Eline: COL1438 (Christmas Outfits), COL1455 (Lion), COL1461 (Reindeer), Craftables: CR1229 (Eline's Christmas Star), Mirror card: CA3134 (gold), Foam clay: white Cut a 12 x 21 cm top-fold card from kraft. Adhere 11 x 20 cm light red design paper to 11.5 x 20.5 cm dark red design paper. Cut a 5 x 21 cm white strip and tear off along one long side. Cut a 2 x 6 cm strip from red design paper.

Cut a 1.5 x 5 cm strip from kraft, cut out a corner on one end and stamp a text. Die cut the figures needed from various card colours and design paper. Apply foam clay under the sleigh and reindeer. Finish off the card as shown.

Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1447 (Circle and Stars), Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pad: black, Design paper pad: PB7035 (Eline's Berry Christmas), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930), Recycled kraft brown (923), Copic markers, Scrapper's floss



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps Eline: EC0173 (Christmas-Hedgehogs), Ink pads: green and red Cut an 11 x 15 cm top-fold card from kraft and adhere 10.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 10 x 14 cm and 9.5 x 13.5 cm design paper. Tear from pearly white card a strip for the snow border and from design paper a narrow green one. Stamp the hedgehogs and colour in with markers. Cut out and adhere. Stamp different hedgehogs with a Christmas baubles, only colour in and cut out the bauble. Adhere as shown. Stamp a text onto a label and tie scrapper's floss through the hole. Finish off the card with a few stars. Place a star on the cap of the toadstool too.



CA3126 (gold), Gel pen: white

Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1439 (Eline's Christmas Decorations), COL1443 (Giftwrapping Karin's Bird, Heart & Tagtag gebruikt), Clear stamps: ECO174 (Eline's Christmas Mice), Decoration paper:

Cut a 11 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card. Cut 10.5 x 14.5 cm and 9.5 x 13 cm design paper. Cut a 5 x 10 cm strip from design paper and adhere to 5.5 x 10 cm design paper. Die cut the circle with stars from gold-coloured paper. Die cut the Christmas trees from pearly white and green and adhere overlapping. Stamp mice, colour them in and cut out. Die cut a label from pearly white card and design paper, stamp a text and tie them together with scrapper's floss. Die cut the holly twigs from pearly white and design paper and adhere together overlapping. Die cut the berries from red card and highlight with a white gel pen. Position the holly twigs behind the label. Stamp a few musical notes. Finish the card off with die cut gold-coloured stars.

Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1448 (Punch die-Stars), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1010 (Knuffels/Hugs-NL), Ink pad: black, Distress ink: gathered twigs, Decoupage sheet: VK9570 (Ilse's Funny's), Design paper pad: PK9159 (Swedish Winter), Papicolor card: Original Christmas red (943), pearly white (930), Recycled kraft grey (322), Gesso: white, Paper distresser, Rhinestones: CA3136

General instructions:

Work the edges of the paper with a paper distresser and white gesso.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1449 (Nordic Star), White glitter paper

Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper and adhere 3 x 15 cm red-white design paper across the front slantwise. Cut off the protruding ends. Cut 5 x 13.5 cm and 6.5 x 6.5 cm design paper and adhere. First adhere the square to a 14 x 14 cm Christmas red card and then to the front of a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Cut out the picture, adhere to pearly white card, trim leaving a 3 mm white border all around. Then adhere it to the card. Die cut stars from design paper, pearly white card and white glitter paper and adhere using 3D-glue or foam tape. Finish off with a text and rhinestones.



Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1447 (Circle and Stars) Adhere 13,5 x 13,5 cm design paper to a 14 x 14 cm Christmas red card. Then mount on top design paper measuring: 8.5×6 cm, 4×10 cm, 9×5 cm, 9×2.5 cm and a 1.5×14 cm strip. Adhere to a 15×15 cm single-fold kraft card. Finish off the card with a circle with stars, a picture, rhinestones, stars and a text.
