Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pad: black, Wax cord



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0560 (Christmas bauble-L), LR0563 (Anja's Antlers), Design folder: DF3439 (Celestials), Clear stamps: CS1009 Happy Holidays, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0117, Pretty Papers design paper pads: PK9139 (Country Christmas), PK9114 (Kraft), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), Christmas

red (943), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold)

Cut a 13 \times 15 cm pearly white top-fold card and mount 12.5 \times 14.5 cm green card and 12 \times 14 cm design paper on top. Emboss 8 \times 13 cm pearly white card, round off the corners and mat on green.

Die cut the Christmas bauble from red card. Cut out the image roughly and then die cut it with the Christmas bauble, it will fit perfectly on the circle.

Die cut the hook and stars from gold-coloured paper.

Die cut and emboss the antlers from kraft and work with distress ink

Stamp the text on to a pearly white label and tie wax cord through.


Tie wax cord to the Christmas bauble too.

Collectables: COL1462 (Mug), Craftables: CR1252 (Skis and snowflake), CR1330 (Anja's Flower border), Design folder: DF3440 (Snow and Ice crystalssnowflake used), Clear stamps: HK1705 (Hetty's Snowmen), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9147 (Aquacolour), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930), Recycled kraft

brown (323), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Adhesive pearls: CA3131 (off white)



Tear strips of white 'snow'. Die cut the mug from design paper and the whipping cream from pearly white card.

Use the die of the mug also to die cut an image. Cut off the background and stick on to the mug.

Die cut the labels from pearly white and kraft and stamp a text. Tie to the mug with wax cord.

Die cut and emboss the skis from silver-coloured decoration paper and the icicles from pearly white card.

Add pearls to the icicles and whipping cream.

Christmas red (943), olive green (945), Recycled kraft brown (323), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold)

Cut two 12 x 15.5 cm red cards. Score one of the cards at 1.5 cm in from the top and stick the small strip on to the reverse of the other card, creating a double card that can stand. Cut 11.5 x 15 cm pearly white, 11 x 14.5 cm design paper, 9 x 12.5 cm Christmas red and 8.5 x 12 cm design paper. Die cut the Christmas bauble from pearly white. Cut out the image roughly and then die cut it with the Christmas bauble, it

Die cut the Christmas trees and hook from gold-coloured paper. Die cut green leaves, red berries and a twig from craft. Stamp a text on to pearly white, cut out and stick on to Christmas red overlapping, tie together with wax cord. Tie wax cord to the bauble as well.

Craftables by Tiny: CR1290 (Birdhouse 1), CR1291 (Birdhouse 2), Creatables by Tiny: LR0558 (Peanut garland and Branch), LR0557 (Pinecone), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: vintage photo



Extra needed for this card: Creatables by Anja: LR0552 (Lacy folding die-Circle), Decoupage sheet Tiny: IT605 (Birds in Winter), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9139 (Country Christmas), Card: pale brown, yellow, dark blue, Glitter glue

Die cut the outermost die from blue design paper and die cut the decorative ones in to the front and back panel.

Die cut the branch twice from dark brown design paper and the pinecones, peanuts and birdhouses from light brown card. Work them with distress ink.

Die cut the birds from yellow card and work the wings and eyes with ink.

Die cut the picture with the round die and mount on to dark blue card. Trim leaving a narrow border. Position all on the card as shown.

Apply glue randomly, sprinkle glitter on top and leave to dry.

Die cut the outermost die from green design paper and die cut the decorative ones in to the front and back panel.

Cut out the picture. Die cut the rectangle from green card and cut in half. Stick the two halves behind the picture as shown. Die cut the birdhouses from grey card and work with ink.

Die cut the branch from dark brown and the peanuts and pinecones from light brown. Work the pinecones with ink.

Position all on the card as shown.

Stick on the pinecones with 3D-glue or foamtape.

Materials used for all cards:

Blending tool or finger daubers, Stamp master: LR0009, Silhouette stamps



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps Silhouette: CS1013 (Fairy Forest), CS1014 (Woodland), Ink pad: Archival jet black, Distress ink: dusty concord, milled lavender, seedless preserves, Victorian velvet, Stamping paper, Papicolor Original: raven black (901), lilac (914), Mask paper Cut a 13 \times 14.5 cm lilac single-fold card and mount a 12.5 \times 14 cm black card on top.

Cut a 12 x 13.5 cm piece of stamping paper.

Die cut an approximately 10 x 10 cm piece of paper and cut out a 5.5 cm Ø from the centre, creating a mask to colour in the moon. Use a blending tool or dauber to apply distress ink, splash a few water droplets on to it and leave to dry. Cut a circle from mask paper, lay it over the moon and colour in the background. Start on the outer edge with the darkest colour and work towards the moon using lighter colours.

Remove the mask and using black ink first stamp the fairy and then the trees, grass, flowers and mushroom. Stamp the flight of ducks over the moon.

Stamp leaves along the top and stroke distress ink black soot around the edges of the card.

Stick the decorated card on to the single-fold card.

Collectables: COL1398 (Banners), Craftables: CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitches-Squares), Clear stamps: CS1008 (Kerst- en Nieuwjaarswensen), MM1626 (Tiny's Ice Crystals), Ink pads: Versamark

transparent, Versafine deep lagoon, Distress ink: mermaid lagoon, Embossing powder: white (Wow), DCP paper: 250 gsm, Craft tape LR0010, Thin wax cord: white, Heat tool

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card and mount a 14 x 14 cm black card on top. Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm piece of stamping paper and using a blending tool or dauber apply distress ink peacock feathers, picked raspberry and seedless preserves. Make a wider border along the bottom with distress ink black soot: tear a strip of paper and place it on to the card as a mask. Lay the torn paper also a bit higher and apply a little less black soot to get a lighter shade.

Using black ink first stamp the deer, then the trees, and finally the leaves with birds along the top.

Then stamp a few trees in grey ink.

Sprinkle chunky white embossing powder on the card and heat from beneath (to avoid the granules being blown away). Stamp the text in transparent ink, sprinkle white embossing powder and heat with a heat tool.

Stroke distress ink black soot around the edges of the card and stick the decorated card on to the single-fold card.

Cut a 14×14.5 cm blue single-fold card and mount a 13.5×14 cm black card on top. Cut a 13×13.5 cm piece of stamping paper and stamp the border just above the centre and the deer below. Stamp the border also on to mask paper. Cut out and lay the mask over the stamped image.

Die cut or hand cut a 5.5 cm Ø circle from mask paper and stick it on to the card so that only half of the moon is visible behind the houses. Colour in the background: start on the outer edges with the darkest colour and work towards the centre using lighter colours. Leave a rather big 'moonlit' area in the centre uncoloured. A few layers can be made along the bottom using a strip of torn paper as a mask.

Stamp the trees and grass in black ink along the bottom of the card and the leaves along the top. Use grey ink to stamp a few extra trees. Colour in the images with Copic markers. Stroke distress ink black soot around the edges of the card. Lay a double length of thin rope on the left-hand side of the card, secure the ends on the reverse and stick a bow on top. Stick the decorated card on to the single-fold card.

Cut from DCP paper a 10.5×15 cm single-fold card and use craft tape to mask the top and bottom borders: till 4 cm down from the top and 2.5 cm up from the bottom. In the centre a 4 cm wide strip will remain.

Use Versafine deep lagoon to stamp one thick, solid ice crystal in the centre of the card, and with the ink that is still left on the stamp, two more ice crystals that will then have a lighter shade. Leave to dry, then colour in the white spaces using a dauber with distress ink mermaid lagoon.

Die cut from DCP paper the one but smallest Craftables square. Repeat the process of stamping on to the strip and stamp ice crystals on to the square with a thick solid one in the centre. Leave to dry, then use transparent Versamark ink to stamp the decorated ice crystal, sprinkle embossing powder over it and work with the heat tool. Mat the square on plain white DCP paper.

Die cut a white banner, stamp a text and cut to size. Use a length of thin wax cord to make a bow and stick it, together with the square card, on to the single-fold card with 3D glue or foam tape.

Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), MM1625 (Tiny's Christmas Tree), Ink pad: Versafine Spanish moss, Distress ink: shabby shutters, Craft tape (LR0010), Cut from DCP paper a 10.5×15 cm single-fold card and draw a rectangle on to it at 2.5 cm in from all edges. Mask the borders with craft tape.

Use Versafine Spanish moss to stamp a solid tree in the rectangle, and stamp with the ink still left on the stamp a few more trees, that will then have a lighter shade. Leave to dry, then colour in the white spaces using a dauber with distress ink shabby shutters.

Remove the craft tape and stamp in the centre and beyond the bottom edge another solid tree. Leave to dry and then stamp with transparent Versamark the decorated tree on top, sprinkle white embossing powder on the tree and work with a heat tool. Stamp the text in black ink.

folder: DF3427 (Little stars), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Ink pad Archival: library green, Distress ink: vintage photo, tumbled glass, stormy sky, chipped sapphire, scattered straw, black soot, tumbled glass, tattered rose, peeled paint, antique linen, pumice stone, Pretty Paper design paper pad: PK9157 (Soft Pastels), Papicolor card: pearly white (930), moss green (951), Mirror paper: CA3134, Rhinestones: CA3136, Scrapper's floss: cream

Cut a 15 x 11.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and mount 13.25×9 cm design paper on top.

Die cut the ticket and nativity set from watercolour paper and work with distress ink.

Die cut the trees from moss green card and the stars from qold-coloured paper.

Stamp the text on to pearly white scrap and cut in to a banner. Cut a similar one from red card and tie together with a length of rope.

Finish off with rhinestones.

Craftables: CR1422 (Spiderweb), CR1439 (Basic shapes-Arch), CR1451 (Punch die-Cats), Creatables: LR0562 (Pumpkin Border), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9138 (Canadian Fall), Decoupage sheet: VK9571 (Happy Halloween), Card: orange and black Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm orange single-fold card and die cut the pumpkin border along the top of the front flap. Adhere 13 x 13 cm black card on to the back panel of the card. Cut a second 13 x 13 cm piece of black card and 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper, cut in shape and adhere.

Die cut the figures needed and finish off as shown.
