# The Collection #71

### **General instructions:**

The dimensions are indicated like this: first you will see the height and then the width. So when it says 10 x 5 cm, this means the paper is 10 cm high and 5 cm wide. Lace is stuck with double-sided tape.



#### **Materials:**

Creatables by Petra: LR0438 (Larch), LR0512 (Apple blossom), LR0539 (Amaryllis), LR0564 (Triangle), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: peeled paint, aged mahogany, pumice stone, Decoupage sheet: VK9572 (Birds in Winter), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9158 (Forest Dream), Papicolor card: Original: silver grey (902), fiesta red (918), pearly white (930), dark brown (938), olive green (945), army green (954), Metallic: ivory (331), red lacquer (337), Snow paper: CA3104, Mirror paper: CA3137 (red), Vellum: white, Shiny pearls: mother-of-pearl white D109, red D110, Lace: LB1017 nylon gathering lace elastic 15 mm olive green





**1a and 1b.** Die cut/emboss the triangular frame 1x from pearly white and 2x from ivory, and the outline stencil from snow paper.

Stick the picture centrally behind pearly white and stick to the snow paper using 3D glue. Set aside to dry. Lay the two ivory frames onto a cutting mat, see photo. Secure them with tape, to avoid them slipping away. Then stick them in place behind the snow paper.



- **2.** Die cut/emboss: -the amaryllis from army green and the flower from red lacquer and fiesta red.
- -the twig from dark brown and the larch from silver grey, vellum and snow paper. Stick in place as shown.

**Tip:** for the long twig and larch, only apply glue behind the part that will be attached behind the amaryllis, allowing the central part to take a more natural shape. Set aside to dry. This part will later be stuck to the dark brown strip. See photo 4.



**3. Folding the card:** Take an olive green A4-sheet. Fold and open up again. The fold will be on top.

Make a 2.5 cm incision into both sides of the top-fold. Fold both side of the front flap inside at 2.5 cm in from the edge. Glue on both side.

Leave the centre open (the front is on the left-hand side in photo).

On both sides cut off 0.5 cm of the back of the card. Cut two 14.7  $\times$  3 cm strips of red mirror card and a 19.3  $\times$  12.2 cm dark brown one.

Place the card in front of you straight up, so that the right-hand side in this photo is at the bottom.

Start by gluing the mirror paper onto olive green, at 1 cm in from the side.

Then the dark green strip and finally the mirror paper again. Fold the bottom of the protruding dark brown card forward. This part will allow the card to stand up straight. Finish off the sides with lace.



The corner of Creatable LR0564 consists of two stencils: an inner and an outer corner. Die cut/emboss the outer corner from olive green and the inner one from dark brown. Secure the outer corner with non-permanent tape, so that it cannot slip. Die cut the corner with the machine and cut into a triangle as shown. Glue the tip of the dark brown card to olive green. Slide the dark brown bottom between the corner as shown and adhere.





**4.** Cut 14.3  $\times$  15.5 cm mirror paper and 13.8  $\times$  15 cm design paper with flower design. Layer together.

Die cut two outer corners from olive green. Cut in shape as shown and glue in position behind the red top corners.

Cut a dark brown strip of 29.7 (= whole width A4) x 5 cm. Fold in half.

Slide the strip in the centre across the flower design, fold the top over the red mirror paper and adhere at the back.

Adhere this set onto the front of the olive green card.

Finally glue the frame (see photo 2) with the picture onto the dark brown strip.

### Materials:

Craftables: CR1332 (Basic shapes-Square), Creatables: LR0556 (Trees-set of 3), LR0567 (Car and Christmas tree), LR0550 (Larch), Ink pad: white, Decoupage sheet Tiny: IT606, Pretty Papers design paper-bloc: PK9158 (Forest dreams), Papicolor card:

Original: olive green (945) and night blue (941), Recycled brown kraft (323), Enamel stickers: PL4510 (gold/silver), Wax cord

Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm single-fold card from kraft and layer 12 x 12 cm white card,  $11.5 \times 11.5 \text{ cm}$  design paper and two die cut white squares on top.

Cut out the picture and glue in place.

Die cut the trees, car and larch twig. Highlight the embossed parts with white ink.

Tie a tree on top of the car and adhere with 3D-tape. Use enamel stickers to make hubcaps.

Finish off with a stamped text and a bow of wax cord.

### Materials used for both cards:

Clear stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Ink pads: Archival black, Versamark transparent, Embossing powder: white, Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white)



### Extra needed for his card:

Clear stamps: TC0868 (Tiny's Christmas bulbs border), CS1008 (Icicle used), Distress oxide ink: twisted citron, peacock feathers, salty ocean, Papicolor card Original: night

blue (941), WaterArt watercolour paper

Cut a 10  $\times$  16 cm white top-fold card and layer 9.5  $\times$  15.5 cm dark blue on top.

Stamp the Christmas bulbs border onto  $9 \times 15$  cm watercolour paper using transparent Versamark ink, sprinkle with white embossing powder and heat/melt with a heat tool.

Work the background with distress oxide ink. Splash water droplets on top.

Stamp a few icicles using black ink.

Attach a wax cord bow to the left-hand top corner. Finish off the card with adhesive pearls.



Gel pen: white, Zig markers

### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0393 (Icicles), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamp: TC0869 (Tiny's Snowmen border), Papicolor card Original: iris blue (931), Watercolour paper, Cut a 10.5 x 15.5 cm iris blue top-fold card and layer 10 x 15 cm pearly white card and a further 9.5 x 14.5 cm blue layer on top. Stamp the snowmen border with transparent Versamark ink onto 9 x 14 cm watercolour paper, then sprinkle with white embossing powder and heat/melt with a heat tool. Work the background with Zig markers. Make vertical stripes in different colours and then apply a little water with a flat brush. Work a small strip with Zig markers too, stamp a text and mat on white card.

Make white dots with a gel pen.

Die cut an icicle from pearly white card, punch a hole and thread wax cord through. Position in the left-hand top corner. Finish off the card with adhesive pearls.

### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1360 (Basic shapes with stitches-Circle), Creatables: LR0556 (Treesset of 3), LR0567 (Car and Christmas tree), Design folder: DF3450 (Pine), Clear stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Ink pad: Versamark transparent, Embossing powder: white,

Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9150 (Swedish Winter), Card: green, Button, Gesso, Heat tool, Wax cord

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white single-fold card and layer 14.5 x 14.5 cm green card and a further 14 x 14 cm embossed white layer on top. Die cut the trees from two green colours and apply a little gesso. Cut a 12 cm  $\emptyset$  chequered circle from design paper and a 3.5 x 14 cm and 4.5 x 14 cm strip. Die cut the green and white smaller circles, emboss the latter one.

Wrap wax cord around the Christmas tree and position on top of the car.

Hand cut a label and stamp a text using transparent Versamark ink. Sprinkle white embossing powder on top and heat/melt with a heat tool.

Tear two white strips of paper to create snow and place in front of the tree trunks. Finish off the card.

(Type Case), Pretty Papers design paper pads: PB7053 (Berry Christmas), PK9155 (Weathered Wood), Card: kraft and gold-coloured scraps, Gel pen: white

Cut a 15  $\times$  15 cm white single-fold card and stick a few layers of smaller design paper squares on top.

Die cut/emboss the shapes needed from various card colours and design paper.

Finish off the deer and bow with white dots. Complete the card.

### Materials used for both cards:

Clear stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Ink pad: Memento tuxedo black, Snow paper: CA3104, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7053 (Eline's Berry Christmas), Papicolor card Original: raven black (901), pearly white (930), Christmas red (943), Diamond gems: PL4515 (snow and ice), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Rhinestones: CA3136, Thin jute rope

General instructions for both cards: start by tracing the outline of the stencil onto white card or another matching colour. Cut out the figure and erase visible pencil lines.

The inner lines of the stencil are used for decorating purposes only. Trace these on the reverse side of card or design paper. Don't forget to use the stencil upside down, to avoid getting a figure in mirror image! Cut these parts out and stick in place. To make a double card, like the one with the snowman: trace the outline of the stencil once again and cut out. Make a horizontal score line and fold over at 4 cm from the top of the figure. Glue the folded top part to the reverse side of the first card. Now the card can stand upright on its own.

**Tip:** does the card not stand up straight properly? Cut off a small piece of the bottom of the back card to give the card a horizontal part to lean on.

Die cut the pine tree from design paper, wrap thin jute rope around it.

Die cut the label from design paper, stamp a text and tie to the rope.

Then position on the snowman using 3D tape. Die cut the flower and leaves and stick in place. Finish off the card with adhesive stones ands pearls.



### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1343 (Christmas bells), Creatables: LR0567 (Car and Christmas tree), Stencil by Marleen: PS8017 (Christmas Bauble), Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver), Papicolor card: red (918), Gel pen: white Make a background as shown. Die cut the pine trees from design paper and stick to the Christmas bauble.

Die cut the car from red, black and silver.

Die cut the tyres from black and the hubcaps from silver. Stick in place.

Tie the Christmas tree with rope on top of the car, then adhere to the card using 3D tape.

Cut 6.2 x 2.3 cm design paper and stamp a text.

Adhere to the card and decorate with holly leaves and berries. Finish off the card with adhesive stones and pearls.

Trace the inner border of the stencils in pencil on to the reverse side of design paper. Copy the large label onto design paper and the small one onto red card.

Cut out and stick in place.

For the large label cut a  $13 \times 1.5$  cm red strip and for the small one a  $13 \times 1$  cm strip from white and brown design paper. Stick in place and cut in shape.

Die cut the moon from gold and stick in place.

Die cut the houses from kraft, mat on mustard yellow and cut in shape. Position the houses as shown.

Die cut number 5 from black card.

Cut a 4.2 x 1 cm strip from the light yellow part of the decoupage sheet.

Stamp a text and stick to the label using 3D tape.

Cut out Sinterklaas on his horse from the decoupage sheet and position on the label using 3D tape.

Cut an  $8 \times 1.5$  cm strip from design paper with wood design and stick to the small label, cut in shape.

Die cut the gift box from kraft and design paper, assemble and position on the card.

Die cut various presents, a chocolat letter and mitre and put into the box.

Cut out the wooden shoe from the decoupage sheet and adhere. Finish off the label with a 5  $\times$  1 cm light yellow strip.

Stamp the text and adhere.

Tie a length of jute cord through the labels.

Craftables: CR1426 (Candles set), Creatables: LR0496 (Sint & Piet), LR0565 (Sinterklaas & Pieterbaas), LR0568 (Type case), Stempels: CS0981 (Sinterklaas), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft purple (327), Original mocha (953) Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and layer 12.5 x 12.5 cm mocha on top.

Die cut the type case borders from design paper with wood design.

Die cut different pieces of design paper with the inner borders of the type case stencil.

Die cut the steamship and stick in place using 3D tape.

Die cut two small boxes from the decoupage sheet and stamp a text onto them.

Die cut Sinterklaas and Pieterbaas, assemble and stick in place with 3D tape.

Complete the card as shown.

Collectables: COL1442 (Karin's Deer, Stars & Tag), Craftables: CR1353 (Labels XS), CR1452 (Decorative Alphabet-large), CR1453 (Decorative Alphabet-small), Creatables: LR0504 (Champagne), LR0566 (Plate and Cutlery), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft stencil by Marleen: PS8019 (Christmas Bells), Clear

stamp: CS1015 (Menu), Ink pad Versafine: onyx black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9151 (Royal Christmas), Card: red and brown kraft, Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Mirror card: CA3137 (red), Ribbon

# Copy the outline of the Christmas bells onto brown kraft. Select design paper to decorate the bells with. Lay the stencil in the right position to avoid ending up with a mirror image! Copy the inner lines in pencil onto the design paper. Stick in place. Die cut the shapes needed from various card colours. Cut a $1.5 \times 4$ cm strip from red card and one from red mirror card. Cut out a V-shape on one end. Stamp a text onto the red banner using Versafine onyx black.

Tie a length of ribbon to the bells and finish off with a star. Complete the card as shown.


### Materials used for both cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp and die set: KJ1727 (ik denk aan jou), Distress ink, Ink pad: Versamark transparent, Embossing powder, Base card: Neenah Cassic Crest Card: solar white 216 gsm, Paper: Neenah Solar white 80 gsm, Bone folder, Glue: roller/multi medium matte, Heat tool, Misti, Sequins



### Extra needed for this card:

Stamp and die set: KJ1726 (Jij), Craftables: CR1444 (Basic shapes-Hexagon), Design folder: DF3424, Ink pads: Memento tuxedo black, VersaMagic pink petunia, Embossing powder: gold, Papicolor card: mint, Foam, Mica sheet, Nuvo Jewel Drops Cut a 10.5 x 14.5 cm top-fold card. Emboss Neenah Solar white 80 gsm with the design folder. Die cut the big word 'jij' from this paper (both sides can be used). Die cut the small word 'jij'. Work with transparent embossing ink, sprinkle embossing powder on top and heat/melt with a heat tool. Die cut the banner and work with VersaMagic. Stamp the text 'bent jarig!'. Stamp and die cut the hearts (KJ1727). Make the shaker box: die cut a hexagon from mint green card and one from mica with the same stencil. Use the same stencil and the smaller size, stick them temporarely together with tape to create a 'stencil' that will cut a narrow hexagonal frame. Then die cut two frames from foam and one from white card. Place the white frame upside down on your work area, stick the complete mica hexagon on top, then the two frames of foam creating a box. Fill the box with sequins. Then stick the mint green hexagon on top sealing off the aperture. Set aside to dry. Then turn the box over and glue the mint green hexagon onto the base card. Finish off the card as shown.



### Extra needed for this card:

Mask stencil: PS8009 (Tiny's Leaves), Ink pad Memento: rich cocoa, Distress oxide ink: worn lipstick, spun sugar, bundled sage, fossilized amber, tea dye, WaterArt watercolour paper: A6, 185 gsm (Kippers), Vellum, Blending tool, Heat tool Cut a  $10.5 \times 13$  cm white top-fold card,  $10 \times 12.5$  cm watercolour paper and  $10.5 \times 13$  cm vellum. Die cut and stamp the text 'ik denk aan jou' in black ink. Stamp the text 'op deze bijzonderfe dag' using transparent ink. Sprinkle with embossing powder and heat/melt with an heat tool. Die cut a banner after working the paper with worn lipstick and spun sugar distress ink. Cut foam in the same size as the banner. Apply distress ink to the back of the mask stencil. Moisten watercolour paper. Turn the mask stencil over and place it on the damp water colour paper. Carefully press it down with a piece of cloth. When satisfied with the result, remove the stencil. Set aside to dry and then stick to the base card. Stick the die cut texts to vellum, and then to the watercolour paper using glue only behind the texts and along the edges to avoid the glue showing through the vellum. Finish off as shown.

### **Materials:**

Craftables: CR1454 (Embroidery holes), CR1352 (Basic shapes-Label), Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pad Versafine: onyx black, Stamp master LR0009, Embroidery thread (DMC) and embroidery needle, Coloured card, Craft tape: LR0010, Fineliner: black



Die cut the labels from card scraps. Use the largest die from the label set.

Secure the square stencil with the embroidery holes to the label using craft tape and die cut by machine. Remove all paper from the stencil.

Use the stamp master and choose a suitable text to stamp on to the label.

Draw a line along the border of the label using a fineliner.

Use six strands of DMC-thread to make the embroidery pattern nice and thick. Leave a length of thread hanging at the back and embroider over it to start your work neatly.
