Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0478 (Tropical Leaves), LR0610 (Lily), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1029 (Mini Labels-Eng), Ink pad: Versafine onyx black, Distress ink: vintage photo, Card: blue, yellow, grey, green (diff. shades), light brown, brown kraft, white, black, Pretty Papers design paper pads: PK9148 (Boho Summer), PK9161 (Floral Delight), Gel pen: white



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1470 (Eline's Alpaca), Craftables: CR1355 (Grass), Creatables: LR0411 (Label), Decoupage sheet: AK0071 (Eline's Savanne Background)


Cut from kraft a 10 x 27 basic card and score folds at 7.5 cm and 15 cm. Cut a 3.5 x 27 cm strip too and score folds at 7.5 and 15 cm. Cover the basic card with 7 x 9.5 cm (2x) and 5.5 x 11.5 cm orange design paper and 6.5 x 9 cm (2x) en 9 x 11 cm from the decoupage sheet. Glue the largest background to the basic card with the sides and bottom side only, creating a pocket for a label. Die cut three strips of grass from dark green card. Cut them into pieces of 7.5 cm (2x) and 12.2 cm and adhere to the strip. Then glue the ends of the strips to the basic card. Die cut the shapes needed from different card colours. Work the lily with distress ink vintage photo. Fold and glue a 2 x 2 cm blue card with rounded corners over the top of the grey label. Stamp a text onto the mini label and tie to the label. Finish the card off as per example given.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1471 (Eline's Sloth), Text stamps: CS1022 (Spring), Decoupage sheet: AK0070 (Eline's Tropical Background), Enamel dots: PL4502 (orange & green)

Cut an 18 x 25 cm basic card from grey kraft and score folds at 12 and 13 cm. Trace the pattern onto the card. Cut the picture into 7.5 x 13 cm. Cut 11.5 x 17 cm design paper and cut a 9.5 x 15 cm rectangle from the centre to create a 1 cm wide frame. Layer 7.5 x 13 cm design paper on the reverse side of the front flap. Die cut the shapes needed from different card colours. Work the lily with distress ink vintage photo. Cut 2.8 x 5 cm grey kraft and stamp a text in black ink. Then adhere to 3.6 x 5.5 cm design paper. Finish the card off as per example given.

Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine



design paper pad: PB7056 (Eline's Summer Picnic), Card: kraft, blue, scraps of black and light grey, Gel pen: silver

Extra needed for this card:
 Collectables: COL1323 (Flower Set), Craftables: CR1417 (Punch die-ABC), Craft Stencil: PS8037 (Fiat 500), Distress ink: faded jeans, Pretty Papers

Trace the Fiat 2x onto kraft, using the outer lines of the stencil. Score a horizontal line across the roof of one car, at 1.5 down from the top, and glue the folded part to the other car, so that car/card can stand. Trace the inner lines of the stencil onto blue, black and light grey card. Place the stencil onto the blue car and dab distress ink into the narrow lines using a dabber or sponge (see photo). Colour the door handle and bumpers with a silver coloured gel pen. Stamp a text and finish off with letters and flowers.



(Travelling), Card: ivory, kraft, green, Gel pen: white, Wax cord

Extra needed for this card:
 Craftables: CR1432 (Herbs & Leaves), Creatables: LR0482 (Horizon Tuscany), LR0582 (Pins-Numbers), LR0587 (Poppy), LR0609 (Fiat 500), Design folder Extra: DF3452 (Poppies), Clear stamps: CS1028 (Mini Labels-NL), Decoupage sheet: VK9576

Cut a 15 x 15 cm ivory card blank and layer 14 x 14 cm kraft on top.
 Take 2x light green and 2x dark green cards of 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 13 x 13 cm ivory.
 Die cut and emboss the shapes needed.
 Layer the green horizons together slightly overlapping. Tear the top of the embossed ivory card in the shape of the horizon.
 Stamp a text onto the labels and tie wax cord through them.
 Cut an ivory and red circle and adhere black numbers.
 Use the stencil to trace the number plate on a black scrap and write a number with a white gel pen.
 Finish off the card.

 Distress ink: picked raspberry,
 Decoupage sheet: VK9577 (Summer Holiday), Pretty Papers design paper pad:

PK9160 (Romantic Dreams), Card: green, ivory, pink, Gilding wax: gold, bronze

Cut a 14 x 14 cm green card blank and layer 13.5 x 13.5 cm ivory, 13 x 13 cm pink and 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper on top. Die cut and emboss the shapes needed.

Work the pots and garden statue with gilding wax and ink the lilies with distress ink. Finish off the card.

 Craftables: CR1472 (Border-Around the World), Clear stamps: CS1019 (Dream), CS1028 (Mini Labels-NL),
 Distress ink: vintage photo,
 Decoupage sheets: VK9576 (Travelling), VK9577 (Summer Holiday), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9160 (Romantic

Dreams), Card: kraft, Wax cord

Cut a kraft 14.5 x 14.5 cm card blank and 14 x 14 cm yellow and lilac design paper. Die cut the border with buildings along the top of the front flap of the kraft card. Lay the stencil on the lilac design paper, trace the shape in pencil and cut out.

Ink the edges of the yellow and lilac design paper and the die cut border with distress ink. Stamp the text onto the yellow square and position both on the card. Cut out the pictures, glue onto kraft and trim leaving a narrow border. Attach the picture with the Eiffel tower onto the card with foam tape. Die cut the label from lilac design paper and kraft.

Stamp the text and glue the labels together slightly overlapping. Tie wax cord to it.

Materials used for all cards:

Collectables by Marleen: COL1469 (Fruit), Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pads: Memento: lady bug (300), new sprout (704), peanut brittle (802), tangelo (200), Versa Magic: spring pansy (35), petunia (36) and Versa Mark transparent, Embossing powder Stampendous: white EP100, Heat tool, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9160 (Romantic dreams), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft: grey (322) and green (328), Original: pearly white (930) and mauve (937), Card: light yellow, light red, light orange



Extra needed for this card:
 Clear stamps by Marleen: CS1031 (Fruit Sentiments),
 Design folder: DF3456 (Marjoleine's Stripes), Paper distresser, Lace

Cut a pearly white 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card, 13 x 13 cm kraft, 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper and 11.5 x 11.5 cm pearly white card. Emboss the stripes with the design folder and work the edges of the yellow design paper with a paper distresser. Layer together. Cut 13.5 x 2.5 cm design paper, stamp a text, work with embossing powder and a heat tool and adhere with lace along the bottom. Die cut the fruit, work with distress ink and position on the card.



Extra needed for this card:
 Craftables: CR1352 (Basic shapes-Labels), Text stamps by Marleen: CS1030 (Fruit Sentiments), Craft stencil by Marleen: PS8038 (Fruit Basket), Papicolor card
 Original: nut brown (939),
 Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver),

Trace the outermost lines of the basket onto pearly white card. Trace the basket 2x: 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut out both. Take the basket in mirror image and make a horizontal scoring line across the handle at 6 cm down from the top. Fold the top over and glue to the reverse side of the front card. The card/basket can stand now.

Trace the front (cloth outside and inside) of the basket onto pearly white card and adhere the cloth for the outside onto the basic card using 3D-glue, leaving space for the fruit to be placed behind. Use the inner lines to decorate. Trace them onto the reverse side of card and/or design paper. Don't forget to turn the stencil over to avoid tracing in mirror image. Cut out and glue onto the card.

Die cut the fruit, work with distress ink and place in and in front of the basket. Finish off the basket with a label with text and tie it with wax cord.

Wax cord: white

Materials used for the white cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: MZ1904 (Marjoleine's Text Banners-NL), Ink pad: Archival jet black, Watercolour card (Crafter's Companion), Ecoline brush pens: bronze green (657), ochre (227), dark ultramarine (506), Watercolour card (Crafter's Companion), Water brush

General instructions:

- Use a black ink pad for stamping.
- Cut out the pictures leaving a narrow border.
- Apply a little ink to a sheet of plastic and mix with a droplet of water. Use this ink to colour in the stamped images.
- Make splashes by loading enough ink onto the brush and then tapping on the brush.
- Adhere the parts to the card with 3D-glue or foam tape.



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: MZ1903
(Marjoleine's Daisies)

Stamp the frame, a daisy and two leaves onto watercolour paper and cut out. Stamp a butterfly and text within the frame. Colour in the images and make splashes within the frame. Adhere to a 10.5 x 15 cm white card blank.



Extra needed for this card:

Design folder: DF3456
(Marjoleine's Stripes), Clear stamps: MZ1901 (Marjoleine's Roses)

Stamp the frame, four roses, five leaves and a banner onto watercolour paper. Stamp a text onto the banner. Cut out the parts and colour in the images. Makes splashes within the frame. Cut a 13.2 x 13.2 cm white top-fold card and emboss the front flap with the design folder.

Materials used for the blue cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pad: Archival cobalt, Watercolour card (Crafter's Companion), Papicolor card Original: blue (955), Craft tape low tack: LR0010 (pink), Scrap paper/copy paper/Post-its, Gel pen: white

General instructions:

- Stamp with cobalt blue ink onto blue card and draw accents with a white gel pen.
- Cut out the pictures leaving a narrow border.

Masking:

- Stamp the flowers onto blue card first. Then stamp them onto thin paper and cut out.
- Place the cut-out flowers onto the stamped flowers and secure with craft tape.
- Stamp the frame or banner (with text) on and over the thin paper. Remove the thin paper, there will be no stamped lines through the flowers.



Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamps: MZ1904
(Marjoleine's Text Banners-NL),
Wax cord: white

Stamp the frame with a flower corner, a banner with flowers and a label onto blue card. Cut out leaving a narrow border. Stamp a flower onto the label and draw white accents. Cut a 15 x 10,5 cm blue card blank. Glue a white 8.5 x 8.5 cm watercolour card and the frame onto the card. Adhere the banner with 3D-glue or foam tape. Wrap cord around the card, thread the label and adhere it with 3D-kit or foam tape.



Extra needed for this card:
 Design folder: DF3455
 (Dots), Clear stamps: MZ1902
 (Marjoleine's Anemones)

Stamp the frame, three anemones, three leaves and a banner onto blue card. Cut out leaving a narrow border. Stamp two butterflies within the frame and draw white accents. Cut a 13.2 x 13.2 cm watercolour card blank and emboss the front flap with the design folder. Glue the frame onto the card and use 3D-glue or foam tape for the anemones, leaves and banner.

Materials:

Creatables, Folding dies by Anja: LR0607 (Oval), LR0608 (Rectangle), LR0571 (Square, twig used) and Creatables: LR0610 (Lily), LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), Designfolders by Marjoleine: DF3455 (Dots), DF3456 (Stripes), Die cut and embossing machine, Ink pads: Versa Magic: GD-53 red brick, GD-81 Niagara Mist and Memento olive grove, Decoupage sheets: VK9577 (Doors), VK9578 (Birds), Pretty Paper design paper pad: PK9160 (Romantic dreams), Card: white, ice blue, Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Scrap of vellum, Enamel dots: PL4514 (Dew drops), PL4515 (Snow & ice), Glitter gloss (Nuvo)

General instructions:

Cut a 14 x 14 cm white single-fold card. Place the basic cutting die inside the card, on the left-hand side. The semi oval or rectangle will be cut out on the right-hand side. Die cut the shape and fold over to the left.



Emboss the stripes inside the card, on the right-hand side. Cut design paper to size using the cutting die and then cut off 2.5 cm all around. Die cut and emboss the small die. Use the cutting die with the stitches to cut out the image. Die cut the lily from vellum and work with ink. Draw lines on the petals with a coloured pencil. Die cut the leaves and work with ink. Adhere the layers to the card and apply a little glitter glue to the flower and petals. Finish the card off.



Cut 14 x 14 cm ice blue card. Emboss the dots and adhere inside the card with a little glue along the fold only. Die cut the large oval, the silver-coloured oval rim and the image with the cutting dies. Layer together. Die cut the poinsettia from vellum and apply a little glitter glue. Finish the card off.
