Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1476 (Punch die-Holly), Die cut and embossing machine, Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), moss green (951) and Christmas red (943), Double-sided tape

Creating a shaker window:

Die cut the frame (circle or square) for the clear shaker window. Adhere double-sided tape around the opening at the back. Flip over and adhere double-sided tape around the entire border of the opening, making sure there are no gaps where bits of the filler could work their way out after the card is assembled. Add some shaker snow in the window and then remove the backing from the tape. Cut out the picture a little larger than the window. Centre it (face down) over the back of the window and adhere.

Craftables: CR1474 (Shaker doily-Round), Creatables: LR0612 (Folding die-Christmas tree), LR0613 (Folding die-Gate), LR0392 (Icicles), Decoupage sheet: EWK1270 (Cozy Christmas), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9158 (Floral Dream), Snow paper: CA3104, Shaker window: LR0025 (round), Shaker snow: LR0028

Cut a 17 x 15 cm pearly white strip. Score on each side a mountain fold at 2.5 cm and a valley fold at 5 cm. The centre will be 12 cm wide. Adhere design paper. Fold the card. Assemble a shaker window and adhere to the card. Cut out the robin and adhere to the outside of the window with a very small piece of foam tape or a droplet of 3D-glue under its tail. Die cut a pearly white gate and adhere to the folded parts of the card. Die cut the icicles from snow paper and adhere along the top. Adhere a moss green tree behind each side of the card. Finish off the card with holly leaves and red berries.

Craftables: CR1475 (Shaker doily-Round), Creatables: LR0612 (Folding die-Christmas tree), LR0615 (Deer Family), LR0444 (Horizon-Trees), Decoupage sheet: EWK1271 (Cozy Christmas), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9158 (Floral Dream), Papicolor card: nut brown (939), Shaker window: LR0024 (square), Shaker snow: LR0028, Gesso, Felt tip: red

Cut a 24 x 14.7 cm pearly white strip. Score a valley fold at 6 cm in from both ends. The centre will be 12 cm wide. Adhere design paper and fold the card. Adhere a moss green tree behind each side of the card.

Assemble a shaker window and adhere to the card.

Die cut two moss green rows of trees and a brown deer family. Adhere to the card and apply a little gesso. Die cut white holly leaves and berries; colour the berries with a red pen.

Finish the card off by adhering a pretty piece of design paper to the reverse side.

(939), Gesso, Shaker window: LR0024 (square), Shaker snow: LR0028

Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white single card. Adhere a smaller square of design paper. Die cut a pearly white frame. Layer moss green and a picture behind. Die cut a pearly white frame and adhere. Now the card can stand when the gate is opened. Finish off the card with holly leaves and brown seed boxes (LR0437).

General instructions:

Adhere double-sided tape to both sides of the brim of the shaker window. Adhere an image to a piece of card slightly bigger than the shaker window. Lay the shaker window with the convex side down and sprinkle shaker snow or snowflakes into the concave side. Glue the image (face down) onto the window to close it. Use the window as per examples given. Die cut the parts of the amaryllis from white card, the nature star from moss green and the holly from pine green and red card. Place a length of rope behind the flower tuft and add a flat-backed adhesive pearl to the heart. Stamp the text in black ink onto white card, cut into a banner and mat on design paper.

Creatables: LR0551 (Nature Star), Craftables: CR1476 (Punch die-Holly), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1009 (Happy Holidays), Decoupage sheet: VK9580 (Christmas Forest), Ink pad Archival: jet black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9159 (Swedish Winter), Papicolor card Original: red (918), pearly white (930), pine green (950), moss green (951) and Recycled kraft grey (322), Shaker snow: LR0028, Rope



Glitter paper: CA3122 (silver)

Extra needed for this card:
 Craftables: CR1335 (Punch die-Snowflakes), CR1361 (Border with stitches-Clouds and Waves), CR1475 (Shaker doily-Square), Creatables: LR0556 (Forest trees), Design Folder: DF3420 (Icicles), Shaker window: LR0024 (square),

Cut a 14 x 14 cm top-fold card from grey kraft. Cut 13.25 x 13.25 cm design paper and mat on white. Emboss a 12.75 x 12.75 cm white card with the design folder. Die cut a decorative border from design paper. Assemble the shaker window. Die cut the border with clouds 2x from white card; cut an aperture the size of the square window. Attach the other border overlapping. Die cut the trees 2x from white and 1x from moss green card. Stamp the text and tie rope around. Die cut the nature star from moss green and the holly from red and pine green. Finish the card off with die cut stars.

 Craftables: CR1321 (Punch die-Stars), CR1474 (Shaker doily-Circle), Creatables: LR0539 (Petra's Amaryllis), Shaker window: LR0025 (Circle), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Enamel dots: PL4509 (Christmas)

Cut a 14 x 14 cm top-fold card from grey kraft. Cut design paper in to 13 x 13 cm and 3x 12.5 x 12.5 cm, mat the large square on to white card. Adhere two squares overlapping. Cut a circular aperture into one of them. Die cut the round doily from white card. Die cut the flower tuft 2x. Stamp the text and finish the card off with die cut stars.

Materials used for both cards:

Craftables: CR1477 (Punch die-Sakura/Cherry Blossoms), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp Master: LR0009, Ink pad: black, Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Stamping paper: white, Black 3D-tape: LR0027 (2 mm thick)



Extra needed for this card:

Silhouette stamps: CS1033 (Sakura/Cherry Blossoms-Japan), Distress ink: aged mahogany, festive berries, fired brick, gathered twigs, Papicolor card: black (901), red (918), Masking paper/copy paper, Fine liner: black

Cut a 12.5 x 12.5 cm card from stamping paper.

Tear two strips of masking paper and place along top and bottom of the stamping paper. Colour in the centre with red distress ink. Remove the masking paper and stamp the image in black ink. Use a fine liner to draw a line from gate to tree. Then stamp a few more lanterns.

Cut a 3.5 cm Ø circle from masking paper. Place on top of the bridge and make the border a little darker with distress ink gathered twigs.

Layer the stamping paper onto a 13 x 13 black card, a 14 x 14 red card and then onto a 15 x 15 cm white card blank.

Finish the card off with die cut black flowers and attach with black 3D-tape.

Design Folder Extra: DF3446 (Flowers), Silhouette stamps: CS1032 (Summer Romance), Mask stencil: PS8033 (Splashes), Distress ink: blueprint sketch, mermaid lagoon, twisted citron, squeezed lemonade, Papicolor card Original: grass green (907), apple green (967), White 3D-tape (2 mm), Die cutting foam sheets (2 mm): LR0023 (white 5x A5), Water and brush

Cut stamping paper into rectangles of 8 x 13.5 cm and 8 x 3 cm. Colour in with distress ink.

Emboss the small rectangle with the design folder and stamp the images onto the large one in black ink. Create a few smudges in the sky using the mask and distress ink mermaid lagoon. Use a wet brush and splash water droplets on to the card. Set aside to dry. Adhere the rectangles to apple green card and trim leaving a 2.5 mm wide border. Then adhere to grass green and trim leaving a 5 mm wide border. Finally adhere to a 10.5 x 21 cm white card blank. Stamp another moon onto stamping paper, cut out and adhere with black 3D-tape.

Finish the card off with die cut apple green cherry blossoms and adhere with white 3D-tape.

Collectables: COL1443 (Karin's Bird, Hearts & Tag), Creatables: LR547 (Anja's Leaves set), Die cut and embossing machine, Mask stencil: PS8031 (Tiny's Ropes), Ink pad Archival: jet black, Faber Castell Gelatos: green tea, Posca pen: black, Adhesive stones



Extra needed for this label:

Creatables: LR0546 (Anja's Beautiful Flower set), Clear stamps: CS0992 (Background-Alphabets), CS1018 (Texts-Dream), CS1035 (Mandala-Delhi), MM1621 (Texture), Amsterdam acrylic paint: pale sky blue (551), olive green (621), primary yellow (275), turquoise (522), Coloured pencils: Caran d'Ache Fluo, Faber Castell Gelatos: blueberry, Gelmedium, Gesso: white, Ribbon, Posca-pens:

white, Napkin Ikea, Sisal grass, Stabilo Woody 3-in-1, Studio Light Tags, Washi tape

Apply small blobs of paint to the label, spread out with a small spatula or a credit card. Blend the colours together with gesso, spread out with your fingers. Apply Gelatos green to a baby tissue and rub it on the label through the apertures of the mask stencil. Intensify the colours by rubbing more Gelatos on the background with your fingers. Stamp a mandala on white paper. Colour in with Fluo coloured pencil and Stabilo Woodies. Cut out. Cut off a small part of the mandala (see photo) and glue both parts to the card, together with strips of a napkin, using gel medium. Outline with a black Posca pen. Add washi tape. Stamp two images, for example an alphabet, on to the background. Stamp a (screw)cap with black and white ink. Apply gesso to the circle. Use a black Woody to colour the outer edge, spread out with your fingers. Make splashes. Die cut a heart, a flower and leaves and adhere, together with a ribbon, using 3D glue/tape. Stamp the text and finish off with a bow and flat-backed pearls.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: Clear stamps: CS1018 (Texts-Dream), CS1034 (Mandala-Mumbai), Ink pad: Versamark, Alcohol blending solution, Alcohol ink: aqua, citron, red pepper, wild plum, Distress ink: picked raspberry, salty ocean, Embossing powder: white, Heat tool, Water Art watercolour paper, Yupo paper

Work the front of a card blank with distress ink and a blending foam sponge. Apply Gelatos green to a baby tissue and rub it on the label through the apertures of the mask stencil. Stamp the mandala on to Water Art paper using Versamark and work with white embossing powder. Cut out and work with distress ink picked raspberry and salty ocean. Work Yupo paper with droplets of alcohol ink and a blending solution (optional), allow the fluids to run out and set the card aside to dry. Stamp the mandalas on to it and cut out. Adhere the large mandala on the left-hand side, cut off excess paper. Make a pretty arrangement with the cut out mandala flowers and place die cut leaves in between. Stamp the text and finish off with splashes, dots and a heart.

Materials:

Creatables: LR0614 (Mandala-Mumbai), LR0574 (Flower frame-Round), LR0599 (Sweet borders), Die cut and embossing machine, Decoration paper gold-coloured: CA3121 (glitter), CA3136 (mat), Mirror paper: CA3137 (red), Papicolor card Original: raven black

(901), pearly white (930), light green (947), bright pink (912), blossom (934), Craft tape: LR0014 (double-sided, 10 cm wide)

Cut a 11.5 x 11.5 cm square from different card colours and different kinds of paper and layer craft tape behind. Then die cut the mandala. The small parts of one mandala can be used to fill the other mandalas. When die cutting a mandala from red mirror paper, the small parts can be used to fill part of at least five other mandalas. Then use the remaining mandala shape to fill with other colours. For each black mandala base, you will need to die cut a new one. Removing the small bits and pieces carefully from the black mandala takes some time. But once the black mandala is adhered to a white card the fun begins. Fill it with all kinds of coloured paper, use shiny and glittery paper too. Cut white 12 cm Ø circles to adhere the black the mandalas to. Either use the circle of Creatables LR0574 or a circle cutter, but tracing around a saucer works well too. Cut a 15 x 15 cm black card and fold in half. Die cut a decorative border along one side and layer 15 x 7.5 cm gold glitter paper behind the front. Now the card can stand. Adhere the white circle to a slightly larger red one and place the mandala on top.

Materials used for both cards:


Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: EC0171 (Eline's Baby Animals), Ink pad: Versafine onyx black, Distress ink: evergreen bough, Decoupage sheet: AK0074 (Eline's Sunny Picnic), Pretty Paper design paper pad: PB7056 (Summer Picnic), Card: blue, green (diff. shades), coral red, mint, turquoise and white, Gel pen: white



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1461 (Basic shapes-Hearts), CR1474 (Shaker doily-Circle), CR1477 (Punch die-Sakura/Cherry Blossoms), Creatables: LR0581 (Bunting Banners), Shaker window: LR0025 (circle), Buttons, Hole punch, Ribbon, Shaker material

Trace the label pattern 2x onto white card. Score one label at 1/3 from the top and adhere the folded top part to the other label. Now the label can stand up straight. Cut design paper in to: 11 x 15 cm, 5 x 15 cm, 2.5 x 10.5 cm and 2.5 x 6 cm. Fold the last one in half. Cut 2 x 6 cm design paper, round off the corners and fold in half. Punch a hole into it, place around the top of the label. Trace the hole on to the label and punch out. Adhere around the label and tie with a ribbon. Die cut the following shapes from various card colours: doily (2x), one with an aperture, bunting banners garland, flowers and heart (2x). Die cut the image with a circle die. Cut a small piece of design paper with a circle die, tear off the straight line and adhere half under the image. Fill the shaker window with shaker material and glue the doily with the image on top. Then glue the other doily around the window. Stamp a text on to the small heart and the strip using Versafine onyx black ink. Finish off the label as per example given.

Collectables: COL1449 (Alphabet-XXL), Craftables: CR1475 (Shaker doily-Square), Creatables: LR0575 (Baby Bottle), LR0576 (Baby Text), LR0599 (Sweet Border), LR0587 (Poppy), LR0617

(Classic Label), Design folder: DF3437 (ABC), Buttons, Enamel dots: PL4502 (green & orange), PL4504 (pink & mint), Ribbon, Rope

Cut a 13.5 x 27.5 cm white card blank and score folds at: 7.5 – 10.5 – 16.5 and 19.5 cm. Cut design paper in to: (2x) 7 x 13 cm, (2x) 2.5 x 13 cm and (1x) 5.5 x 13 cm. Work the edges of the design paper with distress ink evergreen bough. Die cut two 13.5 cm long borders and adhere along the reverse side of the cards using double-sided tape. Die cut the following shapes from different card colours and design paper: word “baby”, flower, leaves, doily, square, bottle, heart, label and BOY.

Cut 5.5 x 6 cm white card and emboss with the alphabet design folder. Adhere to the label of which the decorative part was cut off. Tie ribbon and rope through the hole. Cut a 2 x 7 cm strip from design paper and a 1 x 9 cm one from white card. Stamp the texts in black ink. Cut out the image and round off the corners. Finish off as per example given.
