Materials for the cover card:

Collectables: COL1223 (Flower set), Craftables: CR1464 (Marleen's Greenery), Creatables: LR0526 (Van Harte & Ballon-Special 25), LR0569 (Party box), LR0581 (Bunting Banners), LR0582 (Pins-Numbers), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty

Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 13 x 13 cm design paper. Die cut the party box from kraft and design paper. Cut off the bottom of design paper and adhere to the front of the box (see photo). Assemble the box. Die cut heart-shaped balloons from design paper and snow paper and put into the box. Fill the box with strips of wrapping paper. Die cut the pin numbers, cut off the pins and adhere to a balloon. Die cut bunting banners from snow paper and die cut flowers and leaves. Finish with a text and a balloon.

Papers design paper pad: PK9163 (Sea sparkle by Marleen), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930), Recycled kraft grey (322), Snow paper: CA3104, Scrap of green vellum (for the leaves)

Materials used for the cards and bunting banner:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp pad: black, Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930)



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower set), COL1398 (Banners-XL), Craftables: CR1460 (Basic shapes with stitches-Circles), Creatables: LR0626 (Congrats & Balloon), LR0582 (Pins-Numbers), LR0546 (Anja's Beautiful flowers set), LR0526 (Anja's Flower ornament,

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card from kraft, 12.5 x 12.5 cm from pearly white card and 12 x 12 cm from design paper. Round off the corners and adhere the layers together.

Die cut a circle from 12 x 9.5 cm design paper and layer different design paper behind the centre and the sides.

Die cut and emboss a pie, work with distress ink, adhere to design paper and trim leaving a narrow border. Die cut number pins from gold card and adhere at the top. Die cut a banner from pearly white and a text from gold card. Die cut the balloons from blue and decorate with stamps. Adhere rope behind the balloons.

Finish off the card with flowers and flower ornaments.

LR0341 (Mini-cupcake and Cupcake), Distress ink: various colours, Pretty Papers design paper pads: (Eline's Summer Picnic), PK0119 (Kraft), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Papicolor card Original: petrol (962), light pink (923), Enamel dots: PL4512 (yellow)

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower set), Craftables: CR1433 (Card box-leaves used, Creatables: LR0625 (Van Harte & Ballon), LR0582 (Pins-Numbers), LR0581 (Bunting Banners), LR0342 (Confetti), Craft stencil: PS8043 (Party Pocket), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7056 (Eline's Summer Picnic), Decoration paper:

Cut two 12 x 15.5 cm pearly white cards. Score one card at 1.5 cm down from the top, fold over this small piece and adhere to the other card, creating a blank card. Adhere 10.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and 8.5 x 14 cm pearly white card and design paper.

Cut 8.5 x 14 cm design paper and tear off a slanting corner along a ruler.

Copy the outer lines of the party pocket stencil onto vellum, score lines, cut out and fold the pocket together. Die cut the confetti and put in the pocket. Tie rope around.

Die cut balloons, leaves and flowers. Die cut the number pins from gold card.

Finish off the card with an enamel dot.

CA3126 (gold), Papicolor card: Original raven black (901) and Recycled kraft green (328), Enamel dots: PL4512 (yellow), Wax cord



Extra needed for this card:

Decoration paper: CA3121 (glitter gold), Watercolour paper, Ecoline markers

Cut a 10 x 14 cm pearly white top-fold card and layer 9.5 x 13.5 cm glitter card on top.

Make a background on 9 x 13 cm watercolour paper, using Ecoline brush markers. Apply different colours to a craft sheet, next to each other and below each other. Spray a little water over it. Place the watercolour paper onto the paint face down, press down and then carefully remove. Set aside to dry. Stamp the images. Die cut the letters from black card.

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower set), Craftables: CR1464 (Marleen's Greenery), CR1417 (ABC), LR0625 (Van Harte & Ballon), LR0626 (Congrats & Balloon), Silhouette stamps: CS1038 (Party), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7056 (Eline's Summer Picnic), Enamel dots: PL4512 (yellow), Wax cord

Cut five pieces of 10 x 8 cm design paper. Mark the centre of the bottom with a dot and draw a line to the top corners. Cut off, creating flags. Score a line at 1 cm in from the top, fold over and cut off the extra paper.

Make also five flags (without the score line) from 9.5 x 7.5 cm design paper. Adhere behind the larger flags and adhere wax cord behind the 1 cm folded strip to make a festoon.

Decorate the flags with flowers, leaves and balloons. Die cut the letters from white card and adhere to the balloons. Stamp different images onto the balloons. Die cut white balloons too and adhere overlapping behind the coloured ones. Adhere a black string behind. Complete the flags with enamel dots.

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper.

Emboss triangles onto 11.5 x 11.5 cm pearly white card. Die cut triangles from two colours of design paper and adhere to the raised triangles. Adhere to the basic card.

Die cut a white circle and a doily from vellum and design paper. Adhere the layers together and then to the card.

Complete the card with a snow border, cyclamen, a text and rhinestones.

Craftables: CR1444 (Hexagons), CR1478 (Poinsettia by Marleen), Design folder Extra: DF3428 (Triangles), Clear stamps: CS1036 (Hallo Winter Sentiments by Marleen-NL), Papicolor card Original: baby blue (956), Pearl pen: white

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and 14.5 x 10 cm light blue card. Use the smallest hexagonal die to cut out 17 hexagons from different colours of design paper. Adhere to the light blue card in the pattern shown and cut off the extra paper. Cut a 19 x 5 cm strip of vellum and place over the pattern, glue the ends to the back. Then adhere to the card.

Die cut a pearly white hexagon, emboss triangles and adhere with 3D tape. Mount a smaller hexagon of design paper on top. Complete the card with poinsettias, rhinestones and a text.

Cut a 30 x 15 cm pearly white strip, score folds at 7.5 cm and 22.5 cm.

Cut two 14.5 x 7 cm baby blue strips and two 14.5 x 6.5 cm strips of design paper. Layer together on the card.

Cut 10.5 x 10.5 cm pearly white card and 10 x 10 cm design paper.

Die cut the hexagon from pearly white card and vellum and a smaller one from design paper.

Stamp a text on the latter, adhere the layers together and then onto the card with ribbon behind. Wrap the ribbon around the card and tie in a bow.

Complete the card with poinsettias and rhinestones.

 Craftables: CR1335 (Punch die-Snowflakes), CR1479 (Cyclamen by Marleen), Design folder Extra: DF3439 (Celestial Stars), Craft stencil: PS8039 (Lantern by Marleen), Clear stamps: CS1037 (Hello Winter Sentiments by Marleen-GB), Papicolor card Original: light grey (957), vanilla (963), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Project NL: PL1515 (December-square used), Jute rope

Copy the outline of the lantern onto pearly white card. Copy the lantern 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image without the openings in the windows. Cut both out.

Take the lantern in mirror image, the one without the openings, and score a horizontal line at 6 cm down from the top and fold over, adhere this part to the other lantern. The lantern/card can now stand up straight. Layer vellum behind the openings in the windows.

Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Copy them onto the back of paper and/or design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over, to avoid getting a mirror image. Adhere the cut-outs to the lantern/card.

Cut two wavy strips of snow paper and adhere along the bottom of the lantern and along the roof.

Finish with flowers, snowflakes, a text with a piece of rope and rhinestones.

Creatables: LR0623 (Tiny's Mushroom), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: gathered twigs, walnut stain, Pretty Papers design papier pad: PK9158 (Forest Dream), Papicolor card: Original: pearly white (930), dark brown (938), army green (954), light grey (957), cream (927) and Recycled kraft brown (323) and orange (325)

General instructions

Colour the light grey mushrooms with distress ink gathered twigs and walnut stain and the deer and sunflower with distress ink walnut stain only.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm dark brown top-fold card and adhere

14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 14 x 14 cm design paper.

Cut the picture into a 9 cm Ø circle and adhere under the branch wreath. Assemble the sunflower and decorate with green leaves.

Place the deer family in the grass. Add autumn leaves to the mushrooms and complete the card with spiders and a web.

daffodil yellow (928), nut brown (939), moss green (951) and Recycled kraft black (324)

Cut two 15 cm Ø dark brown circles, score a horizontal line on one circle at 3.5 cm down from the top. Fold this piece over and adhere to the other circle. Cut off a small horizontal piece at the bottom of the circle at the back. Now the card can stand more easily.

Cut a 14 cm Ø pearly white circle and from design paper a 13.5 cm Ø one. Die cut the folding circle XL from baby blue card and copy the inner lines onto design paper. Cut out the image with a doily die and mat on pearly white card.

Place the deer in the grass. Assemble the robin and place it on the larch and autumn leaves.

Decorate the side panels with mushrooms, spiders and spider webs.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm Christmas red top-fold card. Cut 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 14 x 14 cm and 11.5 x 11.5 cm design paper. Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser and then adhere.

Decorate the wreath with extra leaves, twigs and pinecones and adhere around the picture.

Position mushrooms at the foot of the birdhouse and place autumn leaves with pinecones in the grass.

Finish with a sunflower, autumn leaves and a twig with alder cones.

VK9581 (Ilse's Funny Fall), Papicolor card Original: daffodil yellow (928), moss green (951), olive green (945), Christmas red (943)

Craftables: CR1336 (Punch die-Autumn leaves), CR1420 (Punch die-Autumn), CR1450 (Punch die-Halloween), Creatables: LR0434 (Barrel), LR0545 (Sunflower), LR0593 (Petra's Magnificent die), LR0621 (Tiny's Leaves set), Distress ink: hickory smoke, picket fence, Decoupage sheet:

Die cut the largest die (LR0593) from pearly white card and apply distress ink hickory smoke after embossing. Place the die onto design paper, copy the inner lines and cut out. Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. Adhere the pearly white shape to a red top-fold card. Trim the sides and bottom leaving a narrow border.

Die cut the smallest shape from taupe card and apply distress ink picket fence after embossing. Layer the picture behind the opening and adhere white card/paper behind the taupe border. Add a sunflower, autumn leaves and a larch twig with cones.

Place mushrooms in the grass, add a spider. Complete the card with a barrel, mushrooms, autumn leaves and a spiderweb.

VK9581 (Ilse's Funny Fall), Papicolor card: Original: daffodil yellow (928), moss green (951), olive green (945), mouse grey (944), Christmas red (943), taupe (961) and Recycled kraft black (324)

Materials used for all cards:

Clear stamps: TC0876 (Tiny's Leaves set), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Stamping paper: white, Blending tools, Craft sheet, Copy/masking paper



(934), army green (954), Embossing powder: clear, Heat gun, Rope

Extra needed for this card:

Mask stencils by Tiny: PS8040 (Sliced wood), PS8042 (Foam), Clear stamp: TC0877 (Tiny's Leaf with grain), Text stamps: CS1019 (Dream-NL), Distress ink: forest moss, ground espresso, peeled paint, rusty hinge, shabby shutters, Victorian velvet, vintage photo, wild honey, Stamp pads: black, Ranger coffee, VersaMark, Papicolor card Original: blossom

Cut 9 x 13 cm stamping paper. Stamp large leaves using watermark-ink. Sprinkle embossing powder over the images created and heat with a heat gun. Colour in the paper with distress ink rusty hinge, Victorian velvet and vintage photo. Spray with water and let the colours run and blend. Leave to dry. Press the Victorian velvet and rusty hinge stamps pads multiple times onto a craft sheet. Spray a little to water down the ink and press the stamping paper into the ink multiple times. Leave to dry. Place a mask over the stamping paper and work with distress ink rusty hinge to create smudges. Make the border a little darker using distress ink ground espresso. Add more pressure for darker colours or use varying pressure to change the look, if needed. Adhere the card to 9.5 x 13.5 cm army green. Wrap a rope around. Colour a 2 x 13.5 cm strip of stamping paper with pink distress ink. Use a mask to create darker spots with the same distress ink. Make the borders darker using distress ink ground espresso. Layer the stamping paper onto 10 x 14 cm blossom-coloured card and then to an 11 x 15 cm pearly white blank card. Stamp the leaves onto stamping paper using brown ink, cut out and colour in with distress ink. Adhere to the card with 3D glue. Finish with a bow of rope and a text.



(954), Embossing powder: clear, Heat gun, Copy/masking paper, Ribbon: 0.5 mm

Extra needed for this card:

Clear stamp: TC0877 (Tiny's Leaf with grain), Text stamps: CS1019 (Droom-NL), Stamp pads: Memento London fog, Ranger coffee, VersaMark, Distress ink: forest moss, peeled paint, shabby shutters, Markers, Papicolor card Original: red (941), army green

Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm stamping paper. Attach masking paper, a narrow strip along the left and a wider one along the right. Stamp the larger leaves with watermark ink. Sprinkle embossing powder over the stamped location and heat with a heat gun. Colour in the paper with green distress ink; work your way in from the edge with a dark shade and a lighter one towards the centre. Add more pressure for darker colours or use varying pressure to change the look, if needed. Remove the masking paper and adhere the stamping paper to a 13 x 13 cm red card. Stamp the text in brown and attach the ribbon. Adhere the stamping paper to a 13.5 x 13.5 cm army green card and then to a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white blank card. Stamp with Memento ink 3x the same leaf onto stamping paper. Cut out and colour in with markers of different colours. Adhere the leaves with 3D glue.



wild honey, Papicolor card Original: orange (911), red (941), Gel pen: white, Paper distresser, Water brush pen

Extra needed for this card:

Mask stencils by Tiny: PS8041 (Leaf with grain), PS8042 (Foam), Text stamps: CS1018 (Dream-GB), Stamp pads: black, Ranger coffee, Distress ink: black soot, carved pumpkin, fired brick, fossilized amber, rusty hinge, spun sugar, Victorian velvet, vintage photo,

Colour 12 x 13.5 cm stamping paper with distress ink black soot to achieve grey shades. Add more pressure for darker colours if needed. Work your way in from the edge with a dark colour and a lighter one towards the centre. Spray with a little water to achieve smudges, leave to dry. Press down the stamp pad onto the craft sheet multiple times and spray to water it down. Press the stamping paper into the ink a few times to create smudges. Place the masks over the paper and work with distress ink black soot and/or rusty hinge to create darker spots. Use brown ink to stamp texts on the borders of the stamping paper. Stamp leaves in black ink and colour in with a water brush pen and distress ink black soot. Work the edges of the stamping paper with a paper distresser. Draw a decorative line with a white gel pen. Layer the stamping paper onto 12.5 x 14 cm orange, then 13 x 14.5 cm red, before adhering all to a 14 x 15.5 cm pearly white blank card.

Materials used for the cards and wreath:

Collectables: COL1472 (Eline's Raccoon), Creatables by Tiny: LR0621 (Leaves), LR0622 (Blackberries), LR0623 (Mushrooms), LR0624 (Wreath), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp pad: Versafine onyx black, Decoupage sheet: AK0073 (Eline's Background-Autumn), Card: brown, red, black, white, orange, kraft, different shades of green and grey, corrugated cardboard, Foam tape: white, Gel pen



Extra needed for this card:
Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circles), CR1355 (Grass), CR1468 (Doodle-Circles), Clear stamps: TC0876 (Tiny's Leaves set), Distress ink: antique linen, vintage photo and walnut stain, Distress oxide ink: bundled sage, candied apple and spiced

marmalade, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9152 (Herbs and Leaves), Button



Extra needed for this card:
Clear stamp: CS1022 (Spring), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9152 (Herbs and Leaves), Ribbon

Colour a 12 x 2 cm strip of stamping paper with distress ink black soot. Stamp the text in black onto a 9 x 1.5 cm strip of stamping paper. Work the edges with a paper distresser. Then colour the edges with brown distress ink. Stamp the leaves onto stamping paper, using brown ink. Cut out and colour in with different colours of distress ink. Add black dots. Adhere to the card using 3D glue. Finish with white dots made with a gel pen.

Press the Memento stamp pads multiple times onto a craft plate, spread out the ink evenly over the craft plate with a brayer. Place the mask on top and roll the brayer over the craft plate several times. Use the craft plate to print an image onto 12.5 x 12.5 cm stamping paper. Stamp the text in black. Stamp the leaves with Memento London fog. Use masking paper to be able to stamp the leaves on top of each other. Colour in the leaves with markers. Layer the stamping paper onto 13 x 13 cm buttercup yellow, then a further layer of 13.5 x 13.5 cm orange, before adhering all to a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white blank card. Draw a decorative line with a fine liner.

Cut from kraft a 15 x 15 cm top-fold card. Cut a 14 x 14 cm ochre card and a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white one. Cut a 3 x 10 cm strip from design paper with wood grain.

Stamp autumn leaves onto white card using distress oxide ink. Stamp autumn leaves onto green, orange and red card using black ink.

Die cut from different card colours: circle (solid and open), doodle-circle and grass. Die cut the raccoon from white and work with distress ink. Finish off the card as per example given.

Cut a 12.2 x 19.8 cm top-fold card from kraft, 11.2 x 18.8 cm design paper with wood grain and 9.8 x 17 cm green card.

Cut the background into 9.2 x 16,5 cm and cut a 3 x 4 cm strip of corrugated cardboard.

Cut a 3 x 4 cm banner from kraft, stamp a text and layer two short ribbons, folded in half, behind.

Die cut from different card colours: leaves (3x), wreath (2x), pumpkin and raccoon. Use the light green wreath as a base to decorate. Cut off a few dark green leaves and stick to the light green wreath.

Finish off the card as per example given.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1402 (Bendy card), Distress ink: peeled paint, vintage photo, Rope

Cut from kraft a 14 x 14 cm single card and from orange a 11 x 13.5 cm one. Cut the background into 10.5 x 13 cm and cut 2 x 3.5 cm corrugated cardboard. Die cut the large flap from dark green and the small one from light green. Die cut from different card colours: grass (3x), leaves (3x), raccoon. (2x), pumpkin (2x), mushrooms and a blackberries branch. Work the grass and leaves with distress ink. Make a bow of rope and adhere behind the chestnut leaf. Finish off the card as per example given.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1422 (Spiderweb), CR1467 (Basic shapes with stitches-Ovals), Craft stencil: PS8014 (Autumn Leaf), Distress ink: vintage photo, peeled paint, Stamp pad: white (Versacraft), Pretty Papers design paper pads: PB7056 (Summer Picnic), PK9145 (Beary cute), Ribbon, Rope

Trace the outer lines of the autumn leaf onto kraft and the inner lines onto orange design paper. Work the design paper with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut from different card colours and design paper with wood grain: oval (8x), small oval, leaves (8x), raccoon, pumpkin, spiderweb (2x), blackberries branch (2x) and mushrooms (3x). Work the leaves, blackberries branch and mushrooms with distress ink peeled paint and vintage photo and with white Versacraft. Finish off the wreath as per example given.

Materials used or all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Paper design paper pad: PB7053 (Eline's Berry Christmas), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft brown (323), Embroidery needle, Craft tape: LR0014 (double-sided, 10 cm wide)

General

Die cut the heart or Christmas tree from a scrap of recycled kraft. Embroider according to the pattern with 6 strands of embroidery thread and then die cut the shape to size. Use a larger die to cut a heart or tree from another card colour.

Making letter stickers

Adhere wide double-sided craft tape behind the card/paper before die cutting the letters/stars. Then remove the backing paper and the stickers are easy to arrange on the card.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1481 (Embroidery die-Christmas tree), CR1480 (Punch die-Buttons), Design folder: DF3454 (Karin's Letter board), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Embroidery thread: white, brown and 2 shades of green

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm blank card from kraft. Die cut the letters from snow paper. Cut two 5.5 x 12.5 cm strips from different sheets of design paper and adhere across the card as shown and adhere the letters. Die cut the tree from kraft and embroider the pattern. Die cut buttons from snow paper and adhere to the tree using small pieces of foam tape. Die cut the larger tree from snow paper.



Extra needed for this card:
 Craftables: CR1482 (Embroidery die-Heart), Mirror paper: CA3137 (rood), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), red (918), Christmas red (943), Embroidery thread: red, white, brown and 2 shades of green, Rope

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white blank card and adhere 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper. Cut four 5.5 x 5.5 cm squares from different sheets of design paper and adhere next to each other with sellotape at the back. If needed cut off the sides neatly. Die cut a heart from kraft and embroider the pattern. Die cut a larger heart from red card and adhere together. Position the heart centrally on the design paper and an 11.5 x 11.5 cm red card, pierce a hole through the layers as shown, thread a length of rope through and tie into a bow. Then adhere to the card.

General instruction:

Die cut the long basic card first. Lengthwise it does not completely fit into an A5-machine.

Die cut the long card from taupe. Die cut the two semi-circles from silver, place the semi-circular decorative cutting die on top and cut out again.

Die cut the large circle from design paper and a circle with decorative border (LR0620) from snow paper.

Die cut the image to size and die cut the flower in two shades of grey. Adhere all layers together.

Die cut the long card from taupe and the large circle and the two semi-circles from design paper. Die cut the decorative round element (1x) and the text part (2x) from white. Die cut the circle with decorative border 2x from mouse grey. Unfold the card and adhere the design paper. Die cut the largest flower from mouse grey and use the smallest shape to choose/die cut a pretty part of the image. Adhere the other die cut shape to the other side of the border with circle, so that they fit exactly. Adhere the ribbon in between. Adhere a sentiment on the inside and reverse side of the card. Add small pearls to the stars of the sentiment. Die cut a flower shape from snow paper and add to the round decorative element. The card can be folded now and tied with the ribbon.

Die cut the long card from mauve and the circle and the two semi-circles from design paper. Die cut the decorative round element 2x from white and the flower shape and twigs from scraps of purple and snow paper. Die cut flower hearts from snow paper and add to the large round elements.

Die cut the long card from taupe and the round element from snow paper. Unfold the card and die cut the decorative semi-circles into the flaps. Die cut the two semi-circles from silver and die cut the semi-circular decorative elements into them. Unfold the card and adhere the decorative semi-circles to the open flaps carefully. They fit perfectly. Die cut a circle from design paper, adhere the round decorative element partially behind the centre and decorate the image.

The cutting die of the solid semi-circle fits on an image of the decoupage sheet. To make this card you will need two of the same decoupage sheets. Complete the flower shapes with small pearls.

General instructions:

Stamp the images with the masking technique onto PCP (Perfect Colouring Paper), using the Archival jet black stamp pad. Colour in the images. Use the same black ink for the texts.

Collectables: COL1443 (Giftwrapping-Karin's Bird, Hearts & Tag), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp pad: Archival jet black, Copic Markers or another colouring medium, Perfect colouring paper (PCP), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9165 (Brocante Winter), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930), Recycled kraft grey (322), Scrapper's floss: white

Craftables: CR1352 (Labels), CR1390 (Basic shapes with stitches-Rectangles), CR1439 (Basic shapes-Arches), Design folders Extra: DF3419 (Snowflakes), DF3440 Extra (Snow and Ice Crystals), Clear stamps: CS1056 (Hallo Winter sentiments by Marleen-NL),

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card from grey kraft. Cut 12.75 x 12.75 cm design paper and mat on white card.

Emboss snowflakes onto a 11.75 x 11.75 cm white card. Die cut the arch from PCP, stamp the images and colour them in.

Cut out the gnome, work the sky with pan pastel.

Stamp the snowflakes (HT1648) with VersaMark onto both images, sprinkle embossing powder over the stamped locations and work with a heat gun. The heat will transform the powder into a raised white coating.

Clear stamps by Hetty: HT1642 (Tree House), HT1648 (Gnomes Winter), Stamp pad: VersaMark, Embossing powder: white, Heat gun, Pan Pastel: 520.1 ultra-blue extra dark, Snowtex

Die cut a rectangle from white card and a label from design paper. Die cut two small labels from white and stamp a text. Die cut snowflakes (DF3440) from white card and apply snowtex.

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card from kraft. Cut 13.75 x 13.75 cm design paper and mat on white. Cut an 11.5 x 11.5 cm white card and emboss the polka dots.

Die cut the square 2x from watercolour paper and work with distress oxide ink antique linen and iced spruced. Stamp the leaves with distress oxide ink iced spruce.

Die cut the autumn leaves from a square of watercolour paper.

Die cut a smaller square from white card and work with the mask stencil and distress ink tumbled glass.

Die cut the trees and fairy house from kraft, work with distress ink vintage photo. Layer carnation white paper behind the house.

Die cut white clouds and work the edges with distress ink tumbled glass. Die cut the banners from design paper and cut to size.

Die cut the oval from design paper and PCP. Stamp the image and colour in. Die cut the tag from design paper and white card, stamp the text.

Complete the card with die cut leaves.
