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General instructions stamping the border with candles

Stamp the candles with Versamark ink onto metallic paper. Sprinkle embossing powder on top, shake off the excess powder. Heat the embossing powder with a heat tool till it melts.

Cut out the candles and work the flames with a black Sharpie pen and yellow glitter glue.

Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), Die cut and embossing machine, Border stamp: TC0878 (Candles by Tiny), Versamark ink, Embossing powder: white (Wow), Heat tool, Velvet card: white, Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Vellum, Foam die cut sheets: LR0023 (2 mm), Glitter glue: yellow (Stickles), Rhinestones: platinum, Sharpie pen: black



paper: CA3104, Organza ribbon, Rhinestones: CA3132 (white)

Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0632 (Folding die-Star), Text stamps: CS0979 (Christmas sentiments), Stamping pad Versafine: onyx black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9165 (Brocante Winter), Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink), Snow

Cut a 13.5 x 30 cm basic card from white velvet card and score lines at 16.5 cm and 16 cm. Position the stencil of the star on the score line of the short part and die cut.

Die cut the star from snow paper too and adhere it to the other star with vellum in between. Cut off the excess vellum.

Make an incision into the fold of the 1 cm strip of the card and thread organza ribbon through. Adhere at the reverse side.

Adhere 16 x 13 cm design paper on the front and back panel of the card. Stamp the text onto a banner of design paper and adhere to slightly larger snow paper.

Die cut the poinsettia from vellum and the leaves from glitter paper. Stamp the candles 2x onto pink metallic paper and cut out. Take the second border, cut out the candles in front and adhere with 3D tape to the other border.

Finish the card off with white pearls and ribbon.



design paper pad: PK9164 (Winter Days by Marleen), PK9155 (Weathered Wood), PK9154 (Eternity), Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint), Soft glitter paper: CA3143 (gold), CA3147 (mint)

Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1392 (Chain of dots and hearts), CR1476 (Punch die-Holly), Design folder Extra: DF3454 (Karin Joan's Letter), Craft stencil by Marleen: PS8048 (Fire place), Distress ink: hickory smoke, Blending tool, Pretty Papers

Fold an A4-size sheet of velvet paper in half to create an A5-size blank card. Layer 19 x 13 cm design paper on top.

Draw all parts of the craft stencil onto design paper and velvet card. Colour them with distress ink and a blending tool and adhere with glue and 3D tape/foam die cutting sheets.

Die cut the alphabet, garland and holly leaves from gold-coloured and mint glitter paper. Adhere all parts to the card.

Make a text garland and position on the fireplace. Stamp the candles onto mint metallic paper according the general instructions and adhere the border with 3D-foamtape.

Die cut the poinsettias from vellum and velvet card and the leaves from platinum glitter paper. Adhere to the card and finish off with rhinestones.

Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1478 (Poinsettia by Marleen), Creatables: L0633 (Doily Snowflakes), LR0634 (Christmas green), Text stamps: CS1037 (Hello Winter by Marleen), Stamping pad: black, Distress ink: forest moss, gathered twigs, pine needles, Decoupage sheets: PA4098 (Christmas Assorti), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7057 (Eline's Snowflake kisses), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Paper distresser, Gesso: white, Ribbon: white

General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser and gesso and the die cut green leaves with distress ink. Complete the card with Christmas lights, poinsettias, snowflakes, a bow and a text.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1486 (Christmas lights by Marleen), Creatables: LR0632 (Folding die-Star), Decoupage sheet: EWK1252 (Winter Dreams-pink), Metallic paper: CA3138 (copper), CA3139 (light pink), Gauze bandage

Die cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white blank card. Lay the stencil centrally on the card front at 4 cm in from the fold and die cut the star. Cut design paper into two squares measuring 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 7 x 7 cm and two strips measuring 13.5 x 6.5 cm and two strips of 3.5 x 13.5 cm. Cut out the picture and adhere to 8 x 9.8 cm metallic paper. Glue gauze bandage behind. Adhere all layers to the blank card.



The whole star in the centre: Die cut the star from 14 x 14 cm design paper. Position the stencil in mirror image onto the same design paper and die cut it again, creating a whole star. Repeat this with other card colours, cutting each star down a little as per example given. Adhere the star centrally on the card.



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0635 (Classic Border), Decoupage sheet: EWK1253 (Winter Dreams-blue), Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint)

Cut design paper into two squares measuring 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 12.5 x 12.5 cm and two strips measuring 13.5 x 7 cm and 13.5 x 2 cm. Die cut the border 2x from pearly white card and adhere behind the 13.5 x 7 cm strip. Cut out the picture and adhere to 9.2 x 9.2 cm metallic paper. Adhere the layers onto a 14 x 14 pearly white blank card.

Materials used for both cards:

Collectables: COL1362 (Snow Globe, circle 8.5 cm Ø used), Creatables: LR0635 (Classic Border), Decoupage sheet: VK9583 (Eternity), Text stamps: CS1041 (Condolence-NL), Stamping pad: black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9154 (Eternity), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930)



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1432 (Herbs and Leaves), Creatables: LR0610 (Lily), Distress ink, Papicolor card Original: green (954), Corner punch

Round off the corners of the card and the design paper as per example given. Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white card. Cut 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper, cut it at 10 cm; the 3.5 cm strip will also be used. Die cut the circle from the 10 x 13.5 cm (A) part and layer the picture behind. Die cut the corner stencil from design paper and adhere at the side behind the design paper (A). Then adhere the layers onto the 3.5 x 13.5 cm (B) strip. Make sure the pattern of the design paper continues nicely. Stamp a text onto a scrap of design paper. Die cut the lily from pearly white card and work the flower a little with distress ink. Die cut the leaves from green card.



Extra needed for this card:
Papicolor Recycled kraft grey (322), Vellum

Cut a 2.5 x 14.5 cm top-fold card from recycled grey kraft. Cut 12 x 14 cm white card and layer 11.5 x 13.5 cm design paper on top. Die cut the classic border on two sides of a strip of design paper. Stamp a text onto 5 x 16 cm vellum, fold the ends around the card and adhere on the reverse side. Die cut the picture and a semi-circle. Adhere together overlapping.

Extra needed for this card:
Craftables: CR1417 (Punch die-ABC), CR1464 (Marleen's Greenery), Creatables: LR0581 (Bunting Banners), Craft stencil: PS8048 (Fireplace by Marleen), Pretty Papers design paper pads: PK9152 (Herbs & Leaves), PK9164 (Winter Days by Marleen), Papicolor card:

Recycled kraft orange (325) and green (328), Original raven black (901), Soft glitter paper: CA3145 (bronze), Green card, Vellum

Draw the fireplace onto pearly white card along the outline of the stencil. Draw the fireplace 2x, 1x as shown on the stencil with the opening for the fire and 1x in mirror image without the opening. Cut both out. Take the fireplace without the opening and score a line at 2.5 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this part to the reverse side of the other fireplace. The card can now stand by itself. Adhere vellum across the opening of the fireplace. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn over the stencil, to avoid drawing a mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Draw/cut fireplace logs and flames from kraft and glitter paper and adhere to the vellum. Die cut the bunting banners and letters, the moon, the houses, the shoes with straw, the carrots, the note paper and the plants, assemble and adhere. Finish the card off with a text.



Extra needed for this card:
Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circles), CR1487 (Presents bag by Marleen), CR1488 (Presents by Marleen), Design folder: DF3453 (Linen), Craft stencil: PS8047 (Presents bag by Marleen), Distress ink: walnut stain, Black felt tip

Draw the presents bag onto pearly white card along the outline of the stencil. Draw the presents bag 2x, 1x as shown on the stencil and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out. Take the bag in mirror image and score a line at 5.5 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this part to the reverse side of the other fireplace. The card can now stand by itself. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn over the stencil, to avoid drawing a mirror image. Emboss the major part of the bag with the designfolder with linen structure and then work the relief with brown distress ink. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card, the opening of the bag with 3D-tape and leave just below a small area free of tape so that a present can be tucked in between. Die cut the circle from design paper and one from pearly white paper, adhere together and then with 3D-tape on the card. Die cut the jute bag, the presents and the sweets, assemble and adhere. Finish the card off with a text on a yellow banner and stamp the date on the jute bag.

Craftables: CR1488 (Presents by Marleen), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping pad: VersaMark, Embossing powder: white EP100 (Stampendous), Heat tool, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9164 (Winter Days by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft: grey (322) and brown (323), Original: pearly white (930), baby blue (956) and soft blue (964), Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint), CA3141 (light blue), Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Black felt tip



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1415 (Eline's Sleigh and Flow), Craftables: CR1486 (Christmas lights by Marleen), Craft stencil: PS8046 (Christmas tree by Marleen), Clear stamps: CS1036 (Hallo winter by Marleen), Enamel dots: PL4515 (snow & ice), Wax cord blue

Draw the presents bag onto pearly white card along the outline of the stencil. Draw the presents bag 2x, 1x as shown on the stencil and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out. Take the bag in mirror image and score a line at 5.5 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this part to the reverse side of the other bag. The card can now stand by itself. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn over the stencil, to avoid drawing a mirror image. Position each next part of the tree with the top next to the previous top, they will fit like jigsaw piece, without a white line in between. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Die cut the Christmas lights from pearly white and the lights from glitter paper. Assemble and position on the tree. Cut off the excess paper. Die cut the sleigh, jute bag and presents, assemble and adhere. Finish off the tree with a star in top, enamel dots as baubles and a text.

Collectables: COL1459 (Eline's Christmas tree), Craftables: CR1464 (Marleen's Greenery), CR1487 (Presents bag by Marleen), Craft stencil: PS8048 (Fire place by Marleen), Clear stamps: CS1037 (Hello Winter by Marleen), Distress ink: walnut stain, Soft glitter paper: CA3142 (silver), CA3145 (bronze), Vellum

ink: walnut stain, Soft glitter paper: CA3142 (silver), CA3145 (bronze), Vellum

Draw the fireplace onto pearly white card along the outline of the stencil. Draw the fireplace 2x, 1x as shown on the stencil with the opening for the fire and 1x in mirror image without the opening. Cut both out. Take the fireplace without the opening and score a line at 2.5 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this part to the reverse side of the other fireplace. The card can now stand by itself. Adhere vellum across the opening of the fireplace. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of (design)paper. Do not forget to turn over the stencil, to avoid drawing a mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Draw/cut fireplace logs and flames from kraft and glitter paper and adhere to the vellum. Die cut the Christmas tree and stars, the jute bag, presents and the plants and adhere on the card. Finish the card off with texts.

Die cut and embossing machine, Papicolor card Original: carnation white (903), red (918), raven black (901), Snow paper: CA3104, Soft glitter paper: (gold), Mirror card: CA3137 (red), Embroidery thread: golden yellow, red

Collectables: COL1476 (Kerst), Craftables: CR1473 (Cross-stitch-Border), Papicolor card Original: Christmas red (943), nut brown (939), dark brown (938), moss green (951), Embroidery thread: two shades of green

Cut 14 x 14 cm carnation white card and 15 x 15 cm red mirror card. Die cut the cross-stitch border at 2.5 cm up from the bottom of the white card. Embroider the pattern. Die cut the parts of the reindeer and assemble. An example is given on the packaging of the die. Use the die for the legs also for the dark brown ears and the green leaves. The red berries can be cut using the die for the nose. Die cut the word Kerst from dark red card and gold-coloured soft glitter paper. Adhere together in such a way that the red word gets a gold-coloured shade.

Use an A5-sheet of red mirror paper and cut 13 x 19.5 cm
 carnation white card. Die cut the cross-stitch circle between
 1-1.5 cm up from the bottom of the white card. Embroider the
 pattern. Die cut the parts for Santa and use a cotton wool pad
 for the beard and moustache. Die cut the word Xmas from gold-
 coloured soft glitter.
 Complete the card with green leaves and red berries.

Extra needed for this card:
 Papicolor card: Original: red
 (918) and dark brown (938),

Cut an 11 x 19.5 cm pearly white blank card and round off the
 top right and bottom left corner, using a saucer to draw along.
 Use a corner punch for the other two corners. Cut 10.5 x 19 cm
 and 10 x 18.5 cm design paper, round off the corners in the same
 way and adhere. Draw the Christmas tree onto pearly white card
 along the outline of the stencil and along the inner lines onto
 design paper. Cut out and adhere together.
 Die cut the text, draw the outline onto white card and cut out.
 Die cut the Christmas lights and greenery. Adhere the layers
 together and then onto the card. Complete the card with die cut
 stars.

 black (901), pearly white
 (930), Card salmon/skin colour,
 Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint),
 Soft glitter paper: CA3142
 (silver), Cotton wool pad

Cut a 10 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card and layer 9.5 x 14.5
 cm design paper on top. Draw the Christmas tree onto pearly
 white card along the outline of the stencil. Use the inner lines
 of the stencil to draw the tree onto design paper. Cut out and
 adhere together. Die cut the beard and moustache, border of the
 hat, mittens and pompom from cotton wool pads. Die cut Santa,
 assemble and position him partly behind the tree. Die cut the
 Christmas lights. Die cut the text, draw the outline onto white
 card and cut out. Adhere the layers together and then onto the
 card.
