

# The Collection #85

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## Materials used for all cards:

Creatables by Anja: LR0637 (Mix & Match Edge), LR0619 (Warm Winter Wishes/scalloped circle), LR0607 (Vertical folding die-Oval), LR0546 (Beautiful Flower set), LR0547 (Leaves set), LR0608 (Vertical Folding die-Rectangle, twigs used) and LR0509 (Tiny's Butterfly set-3), Clear stamps: CS1028 (Mini-labels + texts), Decoupage sheet: VK9585 (Birdcages), Pretty Papers design paper-bloc: PK9166 (Brocante Summer), Card: soft yellow, pink, white, Metallic paper: CA3199 (light pink), Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Vellum, Diamond gems: JU0937, Enamel dots: PL4515, Pearls: CA3133, Finger wax: 6152 (Inci Pearl Cadence), 6147 (Inci Antique pink Cadence)

## General instructions:

Die cut the flowers from vellum, work them with wax. Set aside to dry. Dab a little ink to tint the hearts of the flowers and the edges a little. Allow the glue to dry a little first before adhering the vellum layers together.



Cut a 14.3 x 14.3 cm pink blank card. Die cut the open border on the right-hand side and the big scallops at the back, making sure the scallops are exactly behind the open border. Cut metallic card to size and die cut the big scallops. Adhere on the left inside. Cut design paper to size and die cut the small scallops on both sides, adhere. Use the oval die to die cut metallic card and the picture. Finish off the card.



Cut a 14.3 x 14.3 cm soft yellow blank card. Die cut the open pattern at the right-hand side and die cut the reverse side with the cutting edge, approximately 2 mm wider. Cut a 14.3 cm strip from design paper and die cut the small wavy border on the right and the big wavy border on the left. Score at 10.5 cm and fold the paper around the card, adhering it at the front only. Die cut the picture with the circle with scalloped edge (LR619) and make the narrow glitter border using two round dies at the same time. Finish the card off.



Cut a 14.3 x 14.3 cm white top-fold card. Die cut big scallops along the bottoms. Cut 14.3 x 14.3 cm from design paper, die cut the open border along the front and the big scallops along the back. Fold it around the card and adhere at the front only; leave the ends at the back hanging loose. Die cut the top and bottom of the picture using the small scallops. Adhere to larger white card, trim in shape leaving a narrow border. Finish the card off.



**Materials used for both cards:**

Craftables: CR1331 (Basic shapes-Circles), CR1493 (Open Flower), CR1494 (Natural Twigs), CR1495 (Sprigs), Creatables: LR0509 (Tiny's Butterflies set), LR0638 (Gate folding die-Butterfly), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1018 (Dream), Stamping pad: VersaMark, Embossing powder: white (EP100 Stampendous) and heat tool, Decoupage sheet: VK9584 (Daydreaming), Pretty Papers design paper-bloc: PK9166 (Brocante Summer), Papicolor card Original: light pink (923), pearly white (930), moss green (951), soft green (970), Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink), Snow paper: CA3104, Soft glitter paper, Craft tape: LR0010, Enamel dots: PL4512 (baby pink), Hemp cord: green, Lace: white, Pearls: CA3132 (white), Rhinestones: CA3136 (silver)



**Extra needed for this card:**

Craftables: CR1371 (Laurel with heart), CR1496 (Forget-me-not)

Cut 30 x 13.5 cm pearly white card.

Adhere the first butterfly to one end with craft tape and cut out. Measure 13.5 cm further and adhere the next butterfly to the other end with craft tape and cut out too.

Cut 13 x 13 cm design paper and adhere.

Cut 13.5 x 7.5 cm design paper and adhere with ribbon along one side.

Die cut the largest circle from design paper and cut out the picture. Adhere together and onto the card using 3D-tape.

Die cut the laurel from white and adhere.

Die cut the flower, twigs and sprigs and a butterfly to decorate the card with.

Finish the card off as shown.



**Extra needed for this card:**

Collectables: COL1444 (Rosettes & Labels), Craftables: CR1353 (Label XL & Labels XS), Creatables: LR0592 (Doily duo), Hemp cord: white, Ribbon: green

Cut a 30 x 13.5 cm pearly white strip.

Adhere the first butterfly to one end with craft tape and cut out. Measure 13.5 cm further and adhere the next butterfly to the other end with craft tape and cut out too.

Cut 13 x 13 cm light pink card and 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper, adhere together. Cut a small semi-circle from the top and glue it inside the card with tape along the sides and bottom only.

Close the two halves of the butterfly with a length of lace. Add a text.

Die cut a white label. Draw the inside of the die onto design paper using a pencil, cut out and adhere.

Cut a 15 x 3 cm strip from design paper, die cut as shown and adhere to the label with lace along one side. Die cut the largest doily from design paper.

Cut a 9.5 cm Ø circle from vellum and cut the picture out.

Adhere the layers together and onto the label using 3D-tape.

Die cut the flower, twigs and sprigs and a butterfly to decorate the label with.

Finish the card off as shown.



**Materials used for both cards:**

Craftables: CR1474 (Shaker doily), CR1493 (Open Flower), CR1494 (Natural Twigs), CR1495 (Sprigs), CR1496 (Forget-me-not),  
Creatables: LR0639 (Birdcage-L), LR0640 (Birdcage set), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft stencil: PS8034 (Postcard), Clear  
stamps: CS1022, Decoupage sheet: VK9586 (Birds & Birdcages), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9166 (Brocante Summer)



**Extra needed for this card:**

Papicolor cards: Original raven black (901), Recycled Kraft grey (322), Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink), Ribbon: pink, Sequins: pink

Draw the centre of the craft stencil onto kraft, move the stencil a little and draw the shape a little longer. Where the stencil was extended there will be holes. Cut out creating a ticket.

Cut design paper into 11 x 7.5 cm and two 3,5 x 7,5 cm strips, ink the edges.

Die cut the large birdcage and small cages from black card.

Cut a picture from the paper pad and adhere to the large cage overlapping.

Adhere all layers to the card.

Die cut twigs/sprigs from metallic paper and design paper and adhere making the small bird cage look like a vase.

Die cut twigs/sprigs from design paper and adhere to top of the large cage. Die cut a large bird from metallic paper and small birds from black card.

Finish the card off with bows and sequins.



**Extra needed for this card:**

Papicolor card: Original: raven black (901) and carnation white (903), Recycled kraft grey (322)  
Scraps: green card and vellum,  
Soft glitter card: CA3148 (light pink)

Draw nine arcs of the large pattern of the craft stencil on kraft, extend this piece with three more arcs. Where the stencil was extended there will be holes. Cut out creating a ticket.

Draw the largest part of the craft stencil onto pearly white card.

Draw eight arc this time. Cut out and adhere to the kraft, but leave the top open for a label to be put in.

Cut design paper into 10 x 10 cm and 3 x 12 cm.

Die cut the shaker doily from design paper and the large birdcage and small ones from black card.

Cut a picture out. Adhere the layers to the card as shown.

Die cut the open flower from vellum and glitter card and the leaves from green and kraft. Adhere.

Die cut twigs/sprigs and adhere.

Cut an 8 x 12 cm label from kraft and adhere scraps of design paper.

Draw the smallest part of the craft stencil on carnation white card, fold in half and wrap ribbon around, tie ends in a bow. Adhere to the label.

Add a text and a bird die cut from glitter paper

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### Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Distress oxide inks: Tim Holtz, Card: solar white (216 grs Neenah classic crest), Glue: roller/ multi medium matte, Misti



CB5501, Glossy accent

### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1456 (Baby), CR1491 (Puzzle piece), Stamping sets: EC0176 (Eline's Babies), KJ1721 (Karin Joan-Gefeliciteerd), Stamping pad: grey (Stazon), Distress oxide inks: tattered rose, pine needles, dried marigold, worn lipstick, Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver), Sheets chipboard:

Cut a 15 x 15 cm white top-fold card. Die cut the puzzle pieces 4x from whit card and work them with distress oxide ink pine needles. Die cut two puzzle pieces from chip board. Die cut the bay items and work with distress oxide inks.

Die cut two safety pins from mirror paper.

Stamp the text and the baby or use petty baby pictures and/or texts. Stamp the text with grey ink onto white card.

Position two puzzle pieces on the chip board puzzle pieces.

Adhere them four puzzle pieces on the blank card.

Use glossy accent for the bubbles.

Finish the card off as shown.



needles, pumice stone, Card: black, Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink)

### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1477 (Flowers), CR1460 (Hearts), Creatables: LR0641 (Truck), Stamping set Karin Joan: KJ1721 (Gefeliciteerd), Stamping pad: Memento tuxedo black, Distress oxide inks: worn lipstick, spun sugar, dried marigold, pine

Cut a 14 x 10.5 cm white top-fold card. Apply distress ink pumice stone along the bottom of the blank card. Die cut white flowers and work them with three colours of distress oxide inks.

Die cut the truck 3x from white card. Work one with distress oxide ink pine needles. Adhere together with the black wheels of the truck on top. Adhere double-sided tape to the back of the truck but leave the cargo tray free from tape.

Position the truck on the card and place flowers in the cargo tray and behind. Die cut two hearts from metallic paper.

Stamp and die cut the texts.



Distress oxide ink: worn lipstick, Craft tape: LR0014 (double-sided), Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink), Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver)

### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1460 (Hearts), CR1492 (Punch die-Puzzle pieces), CR1351 (Basic shapes-Hearts), Stamping sets Karin Joan: KJ1728 (Feestje), KJ1721 (Gefeliciteerd), Stamping pad: grey (Stazon),

Cut a 14 x 10.5 cm white top-fold card.

Apply craft tape to a white sheet and die cut five strips of puzzle pieces. Adhere to white card, but first check whether the die of the heart fits completely. The strip in the centre can be pulled down a little if needed.

Die cut the heart, work with distress oxide ink worn lipstick and adhere to the blank card. Decorate with two puzzle pieces and small hearts from white card and metallic paper and adhere.

Die cut the word from white card and silver-coloured mirror card. Adhere together creating a shadow effect.

Stamp the text onto white strips.



oxide inks: pine needles, DC vintage blue, Brilliance pearlescent poppy, Card: black, Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver), Coloured pencil, Folding bone

### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1402 (Clouds), CR1471 (Airplanes), CR1492 (Punch die-Puzzle pieces), Creatables: LR0641 (Truck), Craft stencil: PS8052 (Puzzle piece), Sheets chipboard: CB5501 (Puzzle pieces), Stamping set Karin Joan: KJ1728 (Feestje), Distress

Draw the puzzle piece onto white card along the outline of the craft stencil. Repeat this in mirror image, making sure the borders near the folding line will overlap. Erase the pencil lines. Cut out and fold. Using a folding bone will help to make sharp creases. Stamp and die cut the texts. Die cut three clouds.

Die cut the planes from white card and colour a few.

Die cut the puzzle pieces from chip board.

Die cut the truck 3x, work one of them with Brilliance pearlescent poppy. Adhere together with the black wheels of the truck on top. Adhere double-sided tape to the back of the truck but leave the cargo tray free from tape. Position the truck on the card and fill the cargo tray with puzzle pieces and planes. Finish the card off with clouds and a few extra planes. Draw the line between the word and the plane.
