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Materials used for both cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps&dies-set: CS1053 (Tegeltjeswijsheden-texts NL), Perfect colouring paper (PCP): white, Stamp master advanced: LR0029, Stamping ink: Archival jet black, Memento nautical blue, Distress ink: tumbled glass, Pretty Papers design paper pad (A4, double-sided): PK9168 (I love Holland), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Copic markers or other colouring material

General instructions:

Stamp the images and figures with stamping ink Archival jet black onto PCP and colour them in. Then die cut the figures with their solid background dies. Die cut the tile from design paper, work the edges with stamping ink Memento nautical blue and stamp the text with the same ink. Dab clouds onto the image using the mask stencil and distress ink tumbled glass.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1389 (Pocket Card & Marks, Card with tab used), COL1383 (Village Decoration set 2, Tree and Fence used), Craftables: CR1361 (Stitched Clouds and Waves, Wavy border used), Creatables: LR0581 (Bunting Banners), Stamps&dies-sets by Hetty: HT1652 (Dutch girl),

HT1653 (Dutch farmer), Craft stencil: PS8058 (Windmill), Mask stencil: PS8024 (Clouds and Sunburst), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft: grey (322) and brown (323), Original: nut brown (939), moss green (951) and baby blue (956), Metallic thread: blue

Cut a pearly white 16.5 x 10.75 cm rectangle and score a fold at 5.75 cm from the left.

Cut a pearly white 10 x 10 cm and 5 x 10 cm card and mat on baby blue.

Die cut a wavy edge along a moss green strip of 10 x 3.5 cm and of 5 x 3.5 cm.

Draw the outline of the windmill onto grey kraft and cut out.

Use the inner lines for decoration purposes, draw them onto design paper and cut out.

Stamp and die cut the figures and tiles.

Die cut the small card with tab from design paper, cut to size and adhere behind the tile, together with a rolled-up length of thread.

Die cut the tree and fence from nut brown, moss green and brown kraft.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1442 (Giftwrapping Karin's Deer, Star & Tag), Craftables: CR1390 (Basic Shapes with Stitches-Rectangles), Stamps&dies-sets by Hetty: HT1632 (On the Farm), HT1633 (In the Meadow), HR1652 (Dutch Girl, Chickens used), HT1654 (Tractor), Mask stencil: PS8024

(Clouds and Sunburst), Scrapper's thread

Cut pearly white card into a 14.75 x 10.75 cm top-fold card and a 14 x 10 cm rectangle, mat the latter on design paper. Cut 13 x 8.75 cm and 8.5 x 4.5 cm from design paper. Die cut two tags from design paper and thread a length of rope through one of them. Die cut a rectangle with stitches from PCP, stamp the border of the meadow and trees and colour in.

Stamp and die cut the chickens, tractor and tile.

Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps&dies-set: CS1053 (Tegeltjeswijsheden-texts NL), Stamping ink: blue, Distress ink: pine needles, forest moss, Pretty Papers design paper pad (A4, double-sided): PK9168 (I Love Holland), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), soft green (970), Paper distresser, Ribbon: red-white-blue, 1 cm, adhesive pearls: dark blue, 3 mm

General instructions:

Work the edges of the design paper with a paper distresser. Die cut the tulip border and bouquet from soft green card. Work them with distress ink. Die cut the flowers from different colours of design paper and card. Finish the card with adhesive pearls and a bow.



Extra needed for this card:
Creatables: LR00603 (Flags), LR0653 (Tulip Border), LR0654 (Tulip Doily and Bouquet), LR0655 (Wooden Shoes), Craft stencil: PS8059 (Nederland), Decoupage sheet: EWK1274 (I Love Holland-Bicycles)

Cut a pearly white 27 x 16.5 cm strip and score folds at 6 and 12 cm. Cut 4.5 x 15 cm design paper and adhere to 5 x 15.5 cm blue card. Cut a 1 x 16.5 cm strip from design paper. Adhere the layers to the left-hand side of the card. Cut out the picture, adhere to blue design paper and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border, then adhere it to lighter blue design paper and trim leaving a similar border. Adhere to the card on the left-hand side. Die cut a pearly white wooden shoe, work the edges and embossed parts with blue stamping ink. Die cut the bouquet. Cut 13.5 x 15 cm design paper and adhere to 14 x 15.5 cm blue card. Adhere to the right-hand side of the card. Cut design paper measuring 9 x 9 cm and two strips: 3 x 15 cm and 13.5 x 5 cm. Adhere as per example given. Draw the outline of the craft stencil onto pearly white card and cut out the map of Holland. Draw the Dutch provinces onto design paper, cut out and adhere. Die cut the tulip border and flowers. Die cut the Dutch flag with pole and adhere to the card.



Extra needed for this card:
Creatables: LR0652 (Build-a-Windmill), LR0654 (Tulip Doily and Bouquet), Decoupage sheet: EWK1275 (I Love Holland-Tulips), Kraft

Adhere 19 x 9 cm design paper to 19.5 x 9.5 cm dark blue design paper. Cut a 19 x 3.5 cm strip from design paper and three 1 x 10.5 cm strips. Adhere to a 20.5 x 10.5 cm blank kraft card. Die cut a pearly white doily and cut out the centre too, creating a circular frame. Cut out a picture and adhere behind. Die cut the tile and stamp a text in blue ink. Work the edges with the same ink. Then adhere to 4.5 x 4.5 cm red design paper. Die cut the windmill from different colours of design paper and card. Using the stencil draw the outline of the solid blades onto pearly white card and cut out. Die cut the bouquet and flowers. Adhere to the card as per example given.



Extra needed for this card:
Craftables: CR1504 (Bicycle-Ladies), CR1505 (Bicycle-Gentlemen), Creatables: LR0653 (Tulip Border), Design folder: DF3458 (Canal Houses), Decoupage sheet: EWK1275 (I Love Holland-Tulips), Papicolor card Original: black (901), red (918), Decoration paper: silver

Adhere 13.5 x 13.5 cm dotted design paper to 14 x 14 cm light blue design paper. Cut design paper measuring 6 x 14 cm, an 8 x 8 cm square, a 9 x 7 cm rectangle and a 13.5 x 3 cm strip. Adhere to a red 15 x 15 cm blank card. Emboss a pearly white 5 x 14 cm strip with the design folder. Cut off two houses along the roof. Adhere all layers to the blank card. Cut out the picture, adhere to light blue design paper and trim leaving a 2.5 mm border. Adhere to the card. Die cut the tile from white card. Stamp the text with blue stamping ink. Stroke the same ink along the edges. Adhere to a light blue 4.5 x 4.5 cm card. Die cut the tulip border and flowers and adhere to the card. Die cut the bicycles from silver-coloured, pearly white and black card. Use the silver-coloured bicycle as the basic bike and adhere the other parts. Die cut the basket from design paper. Adhere all layers as per example given.

Materials used for both cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps&dies-set: CS1053 (Tegeltjeswijsheden-texts NL), Distress ink: faded jeans, Card: red, white and blue



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1499 (Flower Jug by Marleen), Creatables: LR0382 (Dutch Village), LR0654 (Tulip Doily and Bouquet), LR0655 (Wooden Shoes), Pretty Papers design paper pad (A4, double-sided): PK9168 (I Love Holland), Felt tips: red and black, Rope

Cut a red 14 x 14 cm blank card and a 11.5 x 11.5 cm square. Cut design paper into 13.5 x 13.5 cm and 11 x 11 cm. Adhere the layers together.

Die cut and emboss the motifs needed. Adhere the circle to design paper and a slightly larger red circle.

Ink the embossed parts of the flower jug with distress ink and those of the wooden shoes with a red and black felt tip. Adhere all parts to the card.



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0652 (Build-a-Windmill), LR0653 (Tulip Border), Design folder: DF3457 (Dutch Tile), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0185 (Dutch)

Cut a blue 15 x 15 cm blank card and mount 14.5 x 14.5 cm red card on top. Emboss a 14 x 14 cm white square with the design folder. Ink the embossed parts and edges of the tile with distress ink and adhere.

Die cut and emboss the other motifs needed.

Cut out a picture and adhere to a red and a blue slightly larger circle.

Stamp the text onto a white rectangle and mat on blue card. Adhere all parts to the card.

Materials used for all cards:

Clear stamps: CS1052 (Handwritten-Congratulations), CS1054 (Tulips), Velvet paper: white



Extra needed for this card:

Craft stencil: PS8060 (Tulip), Stamping ink Memento: bamboo leaves, Danube blue, new sprout, summer sky, Card: blue

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm blank card from white velvet paper. Stamp small flowers onto a white 13.5 x 13.5 cm card. Adhere together. Draw the outline of the tulip onto blue card and the inner lines onto velvet paper. Cut them out.

Stamp the text and tulips onto the white tulip.

Adhere the tulips together using 3D-foamtape and then adhere them to the basic card.



Extra needed for this card:

Stamping ink Memento: angel pink, bamboo leaves, cantaloupe, new sprout, pearlescent poppy, rhubarb stalk, rose bud, Stamping ink Colorbox: canary, old rose, Card: green

Cut a white 15 x 11 cm blank card from velvet paper and adhere a green 14.5 x 10.5 card.

Stamp a text and tulips onto a white 13.5 x 9.5 cm square and then adhere it to the basic card.

Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original pearly white (930), Pretty Papers design paper pads: PK9163 (Sea Sparkle by Marleen), PB7058 (Eline's Babies-Little Miracle)



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1402 (Bendy Card, clouds used), CR1503 (Dreaming Bear by Marleen), Creatables: LR0576 (Baby Text-Boy & Girl), Craft stencil: PS8057 (Party Cake by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft brown (323), Original: raven black (901), carnation white (903), nut brown (939) and baby blue (956), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Card: pearl, Soft glitter paper: CA3143

(gold), Colouring pencil: pink, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Adhesive stones: gold

Draw the outline of the cake onto pearly white card, but leave the top layer away. Draw the two-layered cake 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out. Take the one in mirror image and make a horizontal score line at 3 cm down from the top and fold over. Lay aside.

Take a separate piece of paper. Die cut the moon and bear. Adhere the moon to the separate piece of paper, assemble the bear and adhere to the moon. Colour the bear's cheeks with the pink colouring pencil and place a white dot in the ears. Cut away the excess paper neatly along the moon and bear and adhere to the glue strip of the second card. Then adhere this card to the one in front. The cake-card can stand now and the moon sits neatly in between. For decoration purposes use the inner lines of the stencil. Draw along them on the back of paper and/or design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to prevent drawing in mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Draw the light blue strips for the cake until the end. Cut out and adhere. Die cut the word 'Baby' from gold and the cloud from white and pearl card. Die cut different stars from gold and glittery snow paper to decorate the cake and finish with adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower Set), COL1481 (Cupcake by Marleen), Craftables: CR1468 (Doodle Circle), Creatables: LR0651 (Gefeliciteerd-text NL), Papicolor card Original: baby blue (956), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Soft glitter paper: CA3143 (gold),

Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver), Circle cutter, Diamond gems: JU0937 (light pink and pink), Hemp cord: white, Lace: white

Cut a pearly white 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card and adhere 13 x 13 cm light blue card and 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper. Adhere 13.5 x 6.5 cm design paper with lace along the bottom, to the card. Cut a 7.8 cm Ø circle from pearly white card and design paper. Adhere to the centre of the card using 3D-tape. Die cut the doodle circle from pink design paper and adhere to the white one. Then mount the one of design paper on top. Die cut the cupcake, assemble and adhere. Die cut the flower and twig and assemble on the card with a hemp cord bow in between. Complete the card with a text and adhesive stones.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1323 (Flower Set), COL1481 (Cupcake by Marleen), Craftables: CR1506 (Music), Creatables: LR0463 (Tiered Tray and Macarons), LR0651 (Gefeliciteerd-text NL), Craft stencil: PS8057 (Party Cake by Marleen), Stamping ink Memento: angel pink (MD404), Papicolor card Original: bright pink (912), purple (913), light pink (923), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Card: pearl, Metallic

paper: CA3139 (light pink), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Mirror paper: CA3135 (silver), Circle cutter, Adhesive stones: JU0937 (light pink and pink), Gel pen: white, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white)

Draw the outline of the cake onto pearly white card. Draw the cake 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out. Take the one in mirror image and make a horizontal score at 3 cm down from the top and fold.

Cut a pearly white 4 cm Ø circle. Adhere to the glue strip in such a way that a little more than a semi circle sticks out at the top. Then adhere the glue strip with the circle to the reverse side of the cake's front. The cake card can now stand up.

For decoration purposes use the inner lines of the stencil. Draw along them on the reverse side of paper and/or design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to prevent drawing in mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card.

Die cut the tuft from snow paper and adhere to the jutting circle. Die cut different macarons from light pink, work with ink and a white gel pen. Die cut different flowers, cherries and small sweets to decorate the cake. Add an adhesive pearl to the flowers. Finally cut the music staff from pearly card and the text from purple.
