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Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps by Marleen: CS1057 (Men's Texts-EN), CS1058 (Men's Labels and Border stamps), Stamping ink Archival: black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9169 (Men Only by Marleen), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Hemp cord



Extra needed for this card:
Collectables: COL1362 (Snow globe-circle used), Craftables: CR1359 (Basic shapes with stitches-Squares), Creatables: LR0659 (Sport), LR0658 (Sneakers), Distress ink: black soot, Stamping ink Hero Arts: mulled wine, Decoupage sheet: EWK1277

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and round off the corners. Adhere 12.5 x 12.5 cm and 9 x 13 cm design paper. Die cut a circle from design paper and a 6 x 13 cm strip. Die cut a frame from design paper by using two squares of consecutive sizes at the same time. Adhere a picture behind. Stamp a text onto pearly white card and then die cut with the solid background. Adhere a piece of rope behind. Die cut and emboss the footballs and work with distress ink. Die cut a pearly white sneaker and work with ink. Die cut a second white sneaker and position behind the first, creating the white outsole. Die cut a label from design paper and stamp a text.

Cut a 10.5 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 10 x 14.5 cm and 9.5 x 14 cm design paper. Die cut the ticket from design paper. Adhere two narrow strips of design paper behind two ends of the ticket. Die cut a frame from design paper by using two circles of consecutive sizes at the same time. Adhere a picture behind. Die cut a label from pearly white card and design paper and stamp a text. Tie hemp cord through the hole. Die cut the head of the tennis rackets from silver-coloured paper and the grip and shaft from brick red. Die cut the tennis balls from buttercup yellow and a label from design paper, stamp a text.

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps+dies: CS1058 (Labels & Stamps by Marleen), Stamping ink Archival: jet black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9169 (Men Only by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Original pearly white (930), Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Enamel dots: PL4501 (blue and grey), Rhinestones: CA3136 (silver)

Collectables: COL1482 (Beer by Marleen), Craftables: CR1433 (Card box, curls used), CR1507 (Card stand-Extra), Craft stencil: PS8063 (Beer mug by Marleen), Clear stamps: CS1057 (Cheers by Marleen), Decoupage sheet: EWK1276 (All for Men-Ber), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Soft

Draw the outline of the beer mug onto pearly white card and cut out. Cut the card stand from dark brown card and adhere to the reverse side of the mug, which can stand up straight now. For decoration purposes use the inner lines of the stencil. Draw along them on the back of paper and/or design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to prevent drawing in mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Cut a 9 cm Ø circle from design paper and an 8.5 cm Ø pearly white one. Cut the picture into a 7.7 cm Ø circle. Adhere to the white circle and then with 3D foam tape to the one of design paper and the card. Die cut a few banners and stamp a text. Die cut the opener, the smiley and the beer bottle. Assemble the bottle and adhere to the card, together with the banners, opener and smiley. Place a bow of hemp cord behind. Complete the card with curls, enamel dots and rhinestones.

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 13 x 13 cm kraft and 12.5 x 12,5 cm design paper. Adhere 9.5 x 9.5 cm design paper to 10 x 10 cm pearly white and position on the card using 3D-tape. Die cut the parts for the jacket and watch, assemble and adhere. Complete the card with a text, hemp cord, curls, enamel dots and rhinestones.

Die cut two labels from kraft. Draw the inner lines of the stencil onto the back of two colours of design paper. Cut out and adhere to the labels. Cut and tear two 5.7 x approx. 1.5 cm dark brown strips and adhere. Die cut two banners, stamp a text and adhere using 3D-tape. Die cut the beer mugs and a bottle, assemble and adhere. Complete the labels with curls and rhinestones.

Draw the outline of the speaker onto pearly white card. Draw the speaker 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut them out. Take the one in mirror image and make a horizontal score line at 3 cm down from the top and fold over. Adhere the folded part to the back of the other card. The card can stand up straight now. For decoration purposes use the inner lines of the stencil. Draw along them on the back of paper and/or design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to prevent drawing in mirror image. Adhere the cut-out parts to the card. Die cut the music staff from gold-coloured paper and adhere. Die cut the parts of the guitar, work the neck with brown ink. Assemble and adhere to the card using 3D-foam tape. Die cut the smileys from decoration paper and black card, assemble and adhere. Complete the card with a text, hemp cord, stars, enamel dots and rhinestones.

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Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1482 (Beer by Marleen), Craftables: CR1509 (Punch die-Playing cards), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1055 (Playing cards), Texture stamp: MM1629 (Tiles), Stamping paper: white, Stamping ink: black, Distress ink: aged mahogany, festive berries, fired brick, gathered twigs, ground espresso, Markers: brown, yellow, dark grey, light grey, red, Papicolor card Original: black (901), red (918), pearly white (930), Kraft, Corrugated cardboard, Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint) and CA3141 (light blue), Soft glitter paper: CA3145 (bronze), Vellum, Paper distresser, Rope

General instructions:

Work the edges of the card with a paper distresser and colour in with distress ink gathered twigs and ground espresso.

Stamp the cards and text onto white stamping paper using black ink.



Make your own design paper by stamping corners of the images as per example given onto white stamping paper. Colour in with markers.

Die cut the punch die from black and red card. Use the remaining card as a mask.

Die cut the mugs and glasses from pearly white card, soft glitter paper and vellum.

Die cut the beer bottles (cap from soft glitter paper) and bottle opener from metallic paper.

Texture stamp: MM1627

(Script), Craft stencil: PS8061

(Open Book)

Draw the parts of the open book in pencil onto different kinds of paper and cut out.

The order in which the layers are being used from bottom to top: kraft, stamping paper (1), pearly white, corrugated card, pearly white (2), pearly white and stamping paper (3).

1. Colour the paper with red distress inks. Stamp figures onto the stamping paper using the texture stamp Tiles and distress ink ground espresso.

2. Make your own design paper using the playing card stamps, as per the instructions given above.

3. Stamp the text using black ink. Make a few tears in the edges. Dab figures onto the paper using the remaining card from which the punch die was cut.

Assemble the booklet by only applying glue in the centre.

Finish off with beer mugs, beer bottles, card, etc. and tie rope around.



Extra needed for this bookmark:

Craftables: CR1510 (Long tags), Ribbon: red, white and black

Die cut the largest label from kraft.

Cut 4.3 x 12.8 cm stamping paper and colour as per the general instructions.

Cut 4.8 x 13.3 cm stamping paper and colour in with red distress inks. Stamp figures onto it use the texture stamp Tiles and distress ink ground espresso. Then adhere to the large label.

Complete the bookmark with a beer mug, beer bottle, etc., cards and ribbon.

Materials used for all cards:

Creatables: LR0531 (Rainbow & Clouds), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping ink Versafine: onyx black, Stamp master: LR0029, Embossing powder: clear, Heat tool, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9163 (Sea Sparkle by Marleen), Watercolour paper: 200 grs, Velvet card: white, Sequins



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1507 (Card stand-Extra), Craft stencil: PS8061 (Open Book), Stamps+dies: CS1059 (Text messages), Stamps+dies: EC0180 (Eline's Unicorns), Die cutting foam sheets: LR0023 (2 mm), Distress ink: diverse colours and blending tool, Embossing powder: clear, Heat tool, Snow paper: CA3104, scraps of coloured card for the rainbow, Vellum, Glitter glue: Stickles

Draw the outer lines of each of the four pages of the book onto velvet card and the inner lines of each page onto design paper. Bend each page a little into the natural shape of an open book. Adhere the design paper to the white pages and then adhere all pages with glue in the centre only.

Attach a strip of 3D foam sheet between each page.

Die cut the rainbow from different scraps of coloured card and the clouds 2x from snow paper and 1x from vellum.

Stamp the unicorns in black ink and sprinkle clear embossing powder on top.

Work with a heat tool. Then die cut the unicorns with the solid silhouette dies and colour them in. Use glitter glue for the clouds and the horns of the unicorns.

Stamp the texts and die cut with the solid background dies.

Adhere as per example given and decorate with sequins.

Die cut the card stand from white velvet card and adhere to the reverse side of the card. The open book can now stand.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1510 (Labels), Stamps+dies: EC0179 (Eline's Pandas), Text stamps+dies: CS1059 (Text messages), Distress ink: hickory smoke, carved pumpkin, shabby shutters, worn lipstick, Metallic paper: CA3139 (light pink), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Corner punch, Ribbon: white

Die cut a 7 x 16 cm label from white velvet card and light pink metallic paper. Die cut the largest label from white velvet card and design paper and the medium one from design paper.

Stamp the pandas in black ink onto watercolour paper, sprinkle clear embossing powder on top and heat with a heat tool.


Colour in and die cut with the solid silhouette dies.

Die cut two clouds from snow paper.

Stamp text messages onto white velvet card and die cut with the solid background dies. Die cut a reinforcement circle from light pink metallic paper and the reinforcement square from white velvet card.

Adhere all layer as per example given and attach the text messages with 3D- foam tape.

Make a pile of the labels and tie a white ribbon through them. Complete with sequins.

Creatables: LR0637 (Anja's Mix & Match Border), Stamps+dies: CS1060 (Text messages), Stamps+dies: EC0179 (Eline's Pandas), Distress ink: hickory smoke, shabby shutters, worn lipstick, mermaid lagoon, Papicolor card: black, Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Vellum, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), 3D-foam

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm blank card from white velvet card.

Cut 13.2 x 13.2 cm black card, 13 x 13 cm design paper, 13 x 5.3 cm white velvet card, 13 x 5 cm black card and 13 x 4.6 cm design paper. Die cut two scalloped borders from soft glitter paper and one cloud from white velvet card and one from vellum. Stamp the texts in black ink and cut out with the solid backgrounds. Stamp two pandas in black ink and sprinkle clear embossing powder on top. Work with the heat tool and die cut with the silhouette background dies.

Colour them in. Adhere the layers to the card, use 3D foam tape for some parts to create a 3D effect and complete with sequins.

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Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1359 (Smartphone), Craftables: CR1508 (Punch die-Smileys), Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9163 (Sea Sparkle), Soft glitter paper: CA3142 (silver), Velvet paper: white, Vellum



Extra needed for this card:
Collectables: COL1449
(Alphabet XL), Clear stamps:
CS1060 (Text Messages),
Stamping ink Memento:
pearlescent purple, Card: lilac

Cut white velvet card into a 13 x 13 cm blank card and adhere design paper measuring 12.5 x 12.5 cm and 11.5 x 11.5 cm. Die cut the bottom of the telephone from design paper and the top from lilac card. Die cut the touch screen from vellum and assemble. Stamp the text messages and die cut them with the solid background dies. Die cut the smileys from glitter card. Arrange the text messages and smileys on the telephone. Die cut the letters from design paper and adhere raised with 3D-tape. Complete the card.

Memento: grape jelly, lulu

material: sequins etc.

Cut a 15 x 11 cm blank card from white velvet and adhere 14.5 x 10.5 cm design paper. Die cut the largest label from design paper and the smallest one from vellum. Die cut the letters from glitter card and adhere to the vellum. Tie the labels together and then onto the card. Die cut the bottom of the telephone from design paper and the top from glitter card. Adhere mica or sheet behind the top of the telephone and adhere 3D-foam tape to the reverse side. Place shaker material on the bottom and adhere the top. Stamp the text messages and die cut with the solid background dies. Die cut smileys from pink and complete the card.
