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Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7059 (Eline's Autumn Whispers), Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930) and Recycled brown kraft (323), Snow-tex



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), LR0438 (Petra's Larix), LR0563 (Anja's Antlers), LR0634 (Christmas green), LR0679 (Dutch ice skates), LR0677 (Circle layout), Clear stamps: CS1067 (Handgeschreven kerst), Stamping ink: Inkon3 - blackout hybrid detail ink,

Distress ink: tattered rose, walnut stain, Decoupage sheets Mattie's Mooiste: MB0187 (Windmills), MB0188 (Birdhouses), Papicolor card Original: salmon pink (925), olive green (945), taupe (961), Soft glitter paper: CA3127 (silver), Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint), Circle cutter, Enamel dots: PL4515 (snow & ice), Gesso: white, Wax cord

Cut a 15 x 30 cm taupe strip and score at 15 cm. Place the largest circle just over the edge of the fold and die cut. The two circles are attached now. Fold the top circle in half.

Die cut a single taupe circle and adhere to the folded card, to create an easel card. Die cut the circle layout from pearly white card and the fields from decoupage sheets and design paper. Adhere to the top circle. Use a circle cutter to cut 14.5 cm Ø pearly white and 14 cm Ø design paper. Apply gesso to the edge of the design paper.

Die cut the poinsettia from salmon card, work with distress ink tattered rose and complete with an enamel dot.

Die cut the larix from olive green and work with snow-tex.

Die cut the mistletoe from metallic mint and the antlers from brown kraft, work with distress ink walnut stain. The circle in front rests behind the poinsettia.

Stamp the texts onto design paper, cut out and work with gesso.

Die cut the skates from silver paper and kraft and attach to the card with wax cord.

hinge, walnut stain, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0187 (Windmills), Papicolor card: Original dark brown (938), olive green (945), salmon pink (925), Soft glitter paper: CA3127 (silver), Foam ball clay: white, Gesso: white, Adhesive pearls, Pens: white and black, Wax cord

Cut a 25.5 x 15 cm dark brown strip and score at 15 and 16 cm. Die cut the tree on the right-hand side of the card. Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm card and 14 x 14 cm design paper.

For the narrow strip next to the tree cut 2.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and 2 x 14 cm design paper. Apply gesso along the edges of the design paper and adhere the layers together.

Die cut the birds, deer, and peanut garlands from brown kraft and work them with distress ink rusty hinge and a black and white pen. Work the tree and peanut garlands with snow-tex and apply foam ball clay near the deer.

Die cut the skates from brown kraft and silver paper, adhere together and attach to the card with wax cord.

Die cut the oval from pearly white card and design paper, adhere the picture. Die cut the amaryllis from salmon pink and work with distress ink tattered rose. Die cut the larix from olive green and work with snow-tex.

Die cut the green twigs from metallic mint and the antlers from brown kraft, work them with distress ink walnut stain.

Complete the card with adhesive pearls and amaryllises.

LR0623 (Tiny's Mushrooms), LR0678 (Gate folding-Tree), LR0680 (Tree log), Distress ink: picket fence, walnut stain, rusty hinge, Papicolor card: Original dark brown (938), chocolate brown (919), nut brown (939), Christmas red (943) and light grey (957), Recycled orange kraft (325), Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0188 (Birdhouses), Foam ball clay: white, Paper distresser, Pen: black

Cut a 15 x 15 cm chocolate brown top-fold card and adhere a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card. Cut design paper into 14 x 14 cm, 11.5 x 11.5 cm and 4.5 x 14 cm. Work the edges with a paper distresser. Die cut the tree from dark brown card and adhere behind the chocolate brown card as shown in the example.

Die cut the birdhouse and birds, peanut garland and pinecone from brown kraft. Die cut the mushrooms from Christmas red and pearly white card and assemble.

Die cut a pearly white circle and adhere the picture.

Die cut the larix and log from dark brown and the bird from nut brown, light grey and orange kraft and assemble. Work the log with distress ink picket fence.

Apply snow-tex to the birdhouse, tree, peanut garland, larix, mushrooms, pinecones and log.

Work the birds with distress ink rusty hinge and a black pen.

Apply foam ball clay as shown.

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Materials:

Creatables: LR0676 (Trifolds), LR0670 (Anja plus set-Oval), LR0571 (Anja's Vertical folding die-twist used), LR0435 (Petra's Poinsettia), Craftables: CR1510 (Long tags), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps+dies set: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Text stamps: CS0991 (Kerst), Stamping ink: Memento MD-602 teal zeal, Decoupage sheets: VK9590 (Spirit of Winter), VK9591 (Winter Wonderland), Bazzil card: bahama, Velvet card: white, Soft glitter paper: CA3144 (platinum), Vellum, Cadence Finger wax: 6152 (pearl), Chrystal drops: 676N (pale gold), Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Coconut hair, Vintage drops: 1310N (worn navy)

General instructions:

- Die cut and emboss the trifolds and fold the 'hinges'.
- Die cut and emboss the ornaments 2x, including one for the reverse side of the card.
- Die cut the poinsettia from vellum and work with finger wax.



Die cut the trifold from soft glitter paper. Die cut the die with stitches from blue card and the pictures with a long die in the centre. Assemble and adhere together. Decorate the reverse side of the card with a stamped Christmas text.



Die cut and emboss the trifolds from blue card. Die cut an opening on the left and right. Use the long tag with stitches and the die with the open pattern and die cut them together from glitter paper and adhere. Die cut a banner and stamp a text. Adhere with

3D-glue.



Die cut and emboss the trifolds from blue card. Use the long die with stitches for the centre, die cut it from glitter paper and use the plain one for the decoupage sheet. Then die cut two long dies of different sizes at the same time from glitter paper and adhere the narrow frame around the pictures. Stamp a text onto a label. Complete the card and make sure the label can be tucked behind the poinsettia.

Cut a 21 x 13.5 cm blue strip and score at 7 and 14 cm, creating three flaps, fold as a zigzag strip. Die cut an opening into the front flap. Use the long die with stitches and place the smaller long die in the centre to cut out pictures. Die cut them at the same time. Adhere a picture behind the front flap and one on the reverse side. Adhere the bottom and side of the 2nd and 3rd flap, to create a pocket for a label to be tucked in. Die cut a label and stamp a text. Complete the label pocket as shown.

Craftables: CR1514 (Frogs by Marleen), CR1518 (Envelope set by Marleen), CR1519 (Mailbox by Marleen), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamps+dies set: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Clear stamps: CS1065 (Opkikkerteksten by Marleen), Stamping ink: Archival jet

black, VersaMagic red magic GD-12, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7059 (Eline's Autumn Whispers), Papicolor card Original: raven black (901), aprikot (924), pearly white (930), blossom (934), Christmas red (943), Card: green (2 shades), light red, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white), Adhesive stones: orange, Rhinestones: CA3136 (silver), Enamel dots: PL4515 (snow & ice), Gel pen: white, Hemp cord: white, Lace: white

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white top-fold card, an apricot 13 x 13 cm square and 12.5 x 12.5 cm design paper. Adhere together and to the card.

Cut a 13.5 x 5 cm strip from design paper and adhere with lace behind one side.

Die cut the pillar box from Christmas red, work with red ink and adhere to light red card.

Cut off the excess light red card neatly along the pillar box.

Die cut two frogs, envelopes and stamps, adhere together and stick in place.

Complete the card with a banner with text and a piece of hemp cord. Add several adhesive stones.

Craftables: CR1476 (Punch die-Holly), CR1478 (Poinsettia by Marleen), CR1485 (Deer by Marleen), CR1518 (Envelope set by Marleen), CR1519 (Mailbox by Marleen), Creatables: LR0370 (Pinetree set), LR0551 (Nature Star), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps:

CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), CS1070 (Christmas mail by Marleen), Stamping ink: Archival jet black, VersaMagic red magic GD-12, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9164 (Winter days by Marleen), Papicolor card: Recycled grey kraft (322), Original raven black (901), carnation white (903), light pink (923), pearly white (930), nut brown (939), Christmas red (943), baby blue (956), Card: light red, Metallic paper: CA3140 (mint), Snow paper: CA3104, Gel pen: white, Hemp cord: white, Adhesive pearls: CA3132 (white)

Copy the pattern onto pearly white card and cut out. Cut 14 x 9.5 cm baby blue card and 13.5 x 9 cm design paper. Cut a 11.5 x 3.5 cm strip of coordinating design paper. Adhere together.

Cut/tear a 14 x approx. 2.5 cm strip from snow paper and adhere with 3D-tape.

Die cut the tree from design paper.

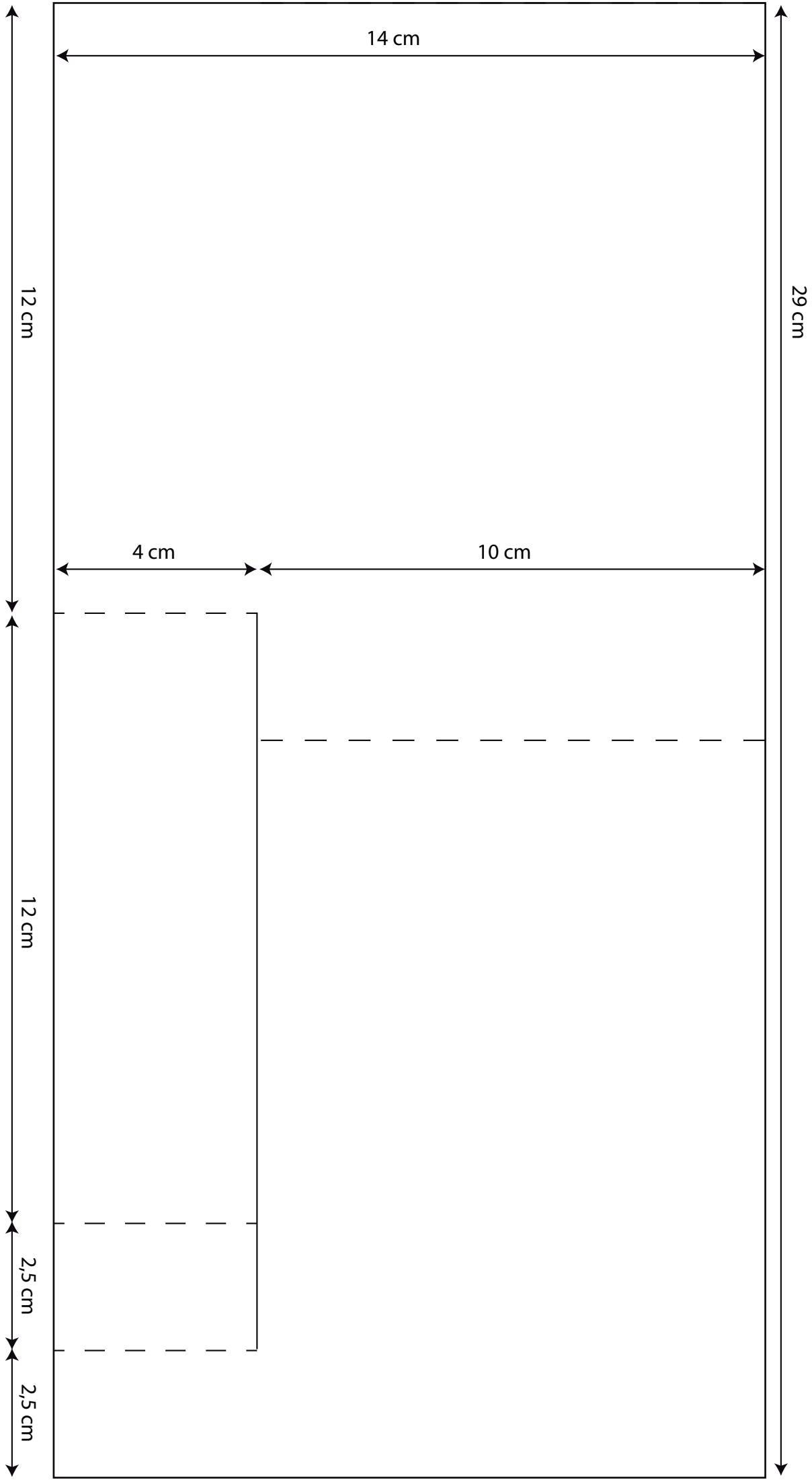
Die cut the pillar box from Christmas red, work with red ink and adhere to soft red card, leave the door free of glue/tape.

Cut off the excess red paper neatly along the pillar box.

Die cut various envelopes, stamps and Christmas leaves and arrange them nicely behind the door of the pillar box.

Die cut the deer and poinsettia with leaves, assemble and position on the card.

Complete the card with a banner with text and hemp cord. Add diamond gems.



Materials used for all cards:

Stamps+dies set: CS1028 (Mini-labels NL), Die cut and embossing machine, Distress ink: vintage photo, Pretty Paper design paper pad: PB7059 (Eline's Autumn Whispers), Stamping ink: Archival acorn, Papicolor card: Recycled grey kraft (322), Original: raven black (901), carnation white (903), red (918), heather (922), light pink (923), cloud grey (929), pearly white (930), nut brown (939), mouse grey (944), moss green (951), army green (954), dark brown (938), Gel pen: white, Scrapper's floss

General instructions:

Die cut the card stand (CR1507) from pearly white card and adhere it on the back of the card using double-sided tape.

Die cut the leaves, mushrooms, acorns, conkers and sunflower seeds (LR0677) as per example from army green, moss green, nut brown, dark brown, red, pearly white, dark orange, cloud grey and mouse grey card.

Die cut the mini labels from pearly white card and stamp the text with Archival acorn stamping ink.

Collectables: COL1489 (Eline's Hamster), Craftables: CR1507 (Card stand extra), Creatables: LR0650 (Petra's Grass), LR0677 (Circle layout), Decoupage sheet: AK0080 (Eline's Animals Autumn), Papicolor card: Recycled brown kraft (323), Original olive green (945)

Die cut the circle layout from design paper and pearly white and moss green card. Die cut the pictures from the decoupage sheet. Die cut the hamster as per example given from carnation white, raven black and light pink card and grey and brown kraft. Die cut the basket (LR0677) from brown kraft and work with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut the acorns, leaves, mushrooms, conker and sunflower seed. Die cut the grass 3x from olive green and cut to size. Die cut and stamp the mini labels. Adhere the card stand behind the circle.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1488 (Eline's Mole), COL1489 (Eline's Hamster), Craftables: CR1507 (Card stand extra), Craft stencil: PS8073 (Treehouse by Marleen)

Copy the tree house onto pearly white card, grey kraft and design paper. Cut out. Draw the door also onto grey kraft. Cut out the panels, work the edges with distress ink vintage photo and adhere to the card using 3D-glue/tape. Die cut three hamsters as per example from carnation white, raven black, light pink and mouse grey card and grey kraft. Die cut the mole as per example from nut brown, dark brown, light pink, raven black, heather and moss green card. Die cut the spectacles from design paper. Die cut the leaves, mushroom, acorns, conkers and sunflower seeds (LR0677). Die cut and stamp the mini labels and adhere the card stand behind the tree house.



Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1488 (Eline's Mole), COL1489 (Eline's Hamster), Creatables: LR0650 (Petra's Grass), LR0677 (Circle layout), LR0680 (Tree log), Decoupage sheet: AK0081 (Eline's background Fall), Papicolor card: Recycled brown kraft (323), Original olive green (945), Rope

Die cut a 19 x 9.75 cm pearly white strip and score from the right-hand side a valley fold at 6 cm and a mountain fold at 8 cm. Cut out a background and cut it into three parts: 5.25 x 9 cm – 1.5 x 9 cm and 10.25 x 9 cm. Adhere to slightly larger design paper. Die cut moss green grass for the flap on the right-hand side. Die cut the tree log from moss green and nut brown card and work with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut two hamsters as per example from carnation white, raven black, light pink and mouse grey card and grey and brown kraft. Die cut the basket from grey kraft and work with distress ink vintage photo. Die cut the mole from nut brown, dark grey, light pink, raven black, heather and moss green card. Die cut the leaves, mushroom, conker, acorn and sunflower seed. Die cut and stamp the mini labels and tie to the card with rope.

Materials used for both cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp master advanced: LR0029, Texture stamp: MM1628 (Crackles), Papicolor card Original: orange (911), dark brown (938), Blending tool or sponge, Craft sheet or glass plate, Gel pen: white, Heat tool, Post-it paper or masking paper, Rope



Extra needed for this card:

Art stamps: MM1630 (Hallo Herfst), MM1632 (Harvest), Distress oxide ink: mustard seed, spiced marmalade, peeled paint, fired brick, vintage photo, ground espresso, Hole punch

Cut 13 x 14 cm stamping paper and stamp an image using the stamp master. Stamp the images also onto separate pieces of paper to make masks to cover the basket with apples and the large leaves. Cut out the masks and adhere them precisely onto the stamped images on the card.

Work the stamping paper with a blending tool or sponge and distress oxide inks mustard seed, spiced marmalade, peeled paint, fired brick and vintage photo.

Then work the paper with a mask stencil and texture stamps.

Remove the masks and colour in the images with the same inks as used for the background; use ground espresso for the basket.

Work the edges with distress ink vintage photo and draw accents with a white gel pen.

Stamp the text onto a small piece of stamping paper, work with oxide inks, punch two small holes and tie a double rope through. Lay the text across the card and adhere the ropes on the back.

Finally adhere the stamping paper to 13.5 x 14.5 cm orange card and then to a 14 x 15 cm dark brown blank card.



Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0472 (Anja's Flower set), LR0547 (Anja's Leaf set), Texture stamp: MM1627 (Script), Art stamps: MM1631 (Hello Fall), MM1633 (Chrysanthemum), Mask stencil by Tiny: PS8040 (Sliced wood), Distress oxide ink: barn door, peeled paint, walnut stain, fossilized

Cut 14 x 14 cm stamping paper and stamp an image using the stamp master. Stamp the images also onto separate pieces of paper to make masks to cover the flowers and leaves. Cut out the masks and adhere them precisely onto the flowers and leaves.

Use the oxide stamping pads fossilized amber, ripe persimmon, barn door and walnut stain to apply ink to a craft sheet or glass plate. Spray a little water on top and press the stamping paper into the wet ink.

Dry the paper with a heat tool, press the paper back into the ink and dry it again.

Repeat these steps until you reach the colours you like. Then work the stamping paper with stamps and mask stencils.

Remove the masks and colour in the flowers and leaves with the same colours as used for the background.

Work the edges with distress ink walnut stain.

Die cut the large flowers and leaves from stamping paper and work with the same oxide inks. Assemble and adhere to the card with rope behind.

Use buttons with rope tied through them as flowers hearts.

Stamp the texts onto stamping paper and work with oxide inks. Draw accents with a white gel pen.

Finally adhere the stamping paper to a 14.5 x 14.5 cm orange card and then onto a 15 x 15 cm dark brown blank card.
