Materials:

Creatables: LR0675 (Holly leaves), LR0684 (Wood slices), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1068 (Gezegende Kerst), Stamping pad: Versamark transparent, Embossing powder: white, Heattool, Distress ink, Pretty Papers design paper pad A4,

double-sided: PK9170 (Wood & Stone), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), olive green (945), Bazzil kraft paper, Gesso, Needle, Paper distresser, Piercing tool, Sewing thread: white, Satin ribbon: white Draw the outline of the stencil onto pearly white card. Draw the bell jar 2x, 1x the normal way and 1x in mirror image. Cut both out.

Take the bell jar in mirror image and score a horizontal line at 5.5 cm down from the top and fold over. Adhere this glue strip to the other bell jar. The card can now stand up straight. Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw along them onto the reverse side of design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing in mirror image.

Adhere the cut-out parts to the bell jar.

Die cut the church from different colours, assemble and adhere. Die cut the trees and adhere around the church.

Die cut the poinsettias, leaves and deer and assemble. Position one of the flowers at the top with hemp cord behind and two other ones with the deer at the bottom. Decorate both flowers with mistletoe and pearls.

Complete the bell jar card with a text.

Adhere a 13×13 cm white card to a 13.5×13.5 cm kraft blank card. Cut 12.5×12.5 cm design paper, use a ruler and pierce holes along the border and embroider backstitches. Work the edges with a paper distresser and gesso.

Stamp a text in the centre with transparent Versamark ink, sprinkle white embossing powder on top and melt this with a heat tool. Die cut and emboss the wood slices 3x, except the two smallest ones, and work with distress ink.

Assemble the wreath on a separate piece of paper. Place the wood slices in a circle, the largest one at the bottom, the next sizes on top and finally the small ones. Work the wreath with gesso. When satisfied with the result, glue the slices together with foam tape. Adhere white ribbon to the top centre of the design paper and secure the end at the back.

Then adhere the design paper to the card and the wreath. Die cut two holly leaves, work with gesso and adhere as shown. Complete the wreath with a white bow.

Marleen), Text stamps: CS1067 (Handgeschreven Kerst), Stamping pad: black, Papicolor card Original: olive green (945), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Enamel stickers: PL4511, Paper distresser Cut a 10 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere a 8 x 14 cm gold-coloured paper and 7.5 x 13.5 cm and 6 x 12 cm design paper.

Die cut the baubles from different metallic colours and the suspension strips from gold-coloured paper. Die cut mint green pine branches. Adhere all parts to the card and complete with a bow of hemp cord.

Cut a 10 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere 9 x 14 cm olive green. Cut 8.5×13.5 cm design paper and work the edges with a paper distresser. Stamp a text.

Emboss a 3 \times 8.5 cm strip of design paper and tear off one side. Die cut pine branches from white card and design paper.

Die cut the baubles and suspension strips from silver-coloured paper.

Die cut a pearly white label and stamp a text. Tie a bow of hemp cord through.

Adhere all parts to the card and complete with enamel stickers.

Materials used for all cards and labels:

Art stamps: MM1630 (Christmas), Watercolour paper/card, Stamping paper smooth, Stamping pad: black, Watercolour paint, ink or coloured pencils, Black Micron fineliner, White fineliner or gel pen



Extra needed for this card: Art stamps: MM1631 (Kerst) en MM1634 (Christmas tree), Card: pink and black, Watercolour paint or ink in blue, green and pink, Glitter glue Stickles Cut a 23 \times 16 cm pink blank card, a 10.5 \times 15 cm black card and a 10 \times 14.5 cm one from watercolour paper.

Work the watercolour card with paint in blue and green. Stamp, after the paint is dry, MM1634 and complete with small stamps from MM1630 and MM1631. Colour in the stars with yellow paint.

Draw a few ice crystals and colour them in with a white gel pen. Colour the stars in the tree in with pink. Decorate the tree with dots of glitter glue.

Complete the card with a text.



Extra needed for this label:

Art stamps: MM1631 (Kerst), MM1634 (Christmas tree), MM1635 (Santa), Watercolour paint or ink in blue, green and pink/skin colour shades, Ribbon, Self-adhesive reinforcement ring: black Cut a 8 x 16 cm watercolour card. Make a hole in the top centre and adhere a black reinforcement ring. Cut off the top slantwise at 1.5 cm. Work the watercolour label with MM1635.

Stamp and colour in the face of Santa and the holly twig with watercolour paint or coloured pencils. Draw a few extra ice crystals onto the label.

Stamp the text onto a separate piece of watercolour card, draw a line around, cut out and adhere.

Draw a line around the label with a black Micron fineliner. Tie a pretty ribbon or a rope through the hole.



Extra needed for this label:

Art stamps: MM1631 (Kerst), MM1636 (Ice crystal), Watercolour paint or ink in blue and green shades, Rope, Self-adhesive reinforcement ring: black

Cut an 8 x 16 cm watercolour card. Make a hole in the top centre and adhere a black reinforcement ring. Cut off the top slantwise at 1.5 cm.

Work the label with watercolour paint or ink in blue and green. Stamp MM1636 and a few extra stars and ice crystals. Stamp the word Kerst onto the label and the other text onto a separate piece of stamping paper, draw a line with the black

fineliner, cut out and adhere. Colour in the stars with glitter glue. Draw a line around the label with a black Micron fineliner. Tie rope through the hole.



Extra needed for this card: Art stamp: MM1637 (Deer), Card: yellow and black, Watercolour paint or ink in yellow, orange and blue shades Cut a 21 x 15.5 cm yellow blank card, a 9.5 x 14.5 cm black one and 9 x 14 cm from watercolour card.

Work the watercolour card with watercolour paint or ink in yellow, orange and blue. Stamp MM1637 onto the card and stamp the image onto smooth stamping paper as well. Cut out the letter with reindeer and adhere to the card. Draw a few extra ice crystals with the Micron fineliner and colour in with a gel pen. Colour in the stars with yellow paint. Adhere the card together.

Clear stamps+dies set: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping pad Versafine: onyx black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PB7057 (Eline's Snowflake kisses), Card: grey (diff. shades), kraft, pink, white and black, Soft glitter paper: CA3142 (silver), Circle cutter, Gel pen: white

General instruction:

The stamped images have been coloured in with Faber Castell polychromos.



Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1439 (Basic Arch), Clear stamps: CS1036 (Hallo Winter), EC0184 (Eline's Snowmen), Corner punch, Diamond gems: JU0937 (pink), Wax cord

Cut a 10 x 13.5 cm white top-fold card.

Cut a 9.5 x 13 cm white card and make smudges with distress ink and water. Round off the corners. Stamp the text in black ink. Cut design paper into a strip of 2×10 cm and one of 3×9 cm. Die cut two banners from glitter paper. Cut 5 x 7.3 cm grey design paper for the label. Stamp, and die cut, the snowman onto white card suitable for the colouring medium you are going to use and colour in the images. Die cut a white basic arch and complete as per example given.

Add pink buttons to the card.

Collectables: COL1439 (Eline's Christmas decorations), COL1490 (Eline's Meercats), Clear stamps: CS1037 (Hello Winter), Decoupage sheet: AK0075 (Eline's Backgrounds-Snowflake kisses), Small piece of Velcro





Extra needed for this card: Craftables: CR1510 (Long tags), Clear stamps: CS1037 (Hello Winter), EC0185 (Eline's Penguins), Design folder: DF3456 (Marjoleine's stripes) The basic card is a kind of three-sided tower.

Cut 3x white card measuring 13.5×13.5 cm and fold diagonally. Cut 3x design paper measuring 13×13 cm and cut in half. Adhere the triangles to the basic card (see photo).

Assembling (see drawings):


Turn card 2 a quarter turn to the left, adhere against the mountain fold of card 1.

Turn card 3 a quarter turn to the left and adhere against the mountain fold of card 2.

Adhere one half of the velcro near the mountain fold of card 3 (see drawing) and the other half to the corresponding spot on the reverse side of card 1.

Cut design paper into a 2×12 cm and a 3.5×12 cm strip and tear off one long side creating a narrow white border. Stamp the text in black ink onto a white banner. Die cut the figures needed from different colours of card and

design paper. Complete the card.



Cut a 10 \times 13.5 cm white top-fold card. Emboss stripes onto a white 9.5 \times 13 cm card using the design folder.

Cut design paper into a 2 \times 4 cm strip and stamp the text in black ink.

Stamp, and die cut, the penguin, a heart and a tree onto white card suitable for the colouring medium you are going to use and colour in the images.

Die cut the shapes needed from different colours of card and design paper.

Complete the card as per example given.



Extra needed for this label: Craftables: CR1494 (Natural twigs), CR1495 (Sprigs), CR1500 (Shaker oval), CR1510 (Long tags-reinforcement ring used), CR1512 (Bubbles), Creatables: LR0666 (Frangipani flower), Clear stamps: CS1036 (Hallo Winter), Decoupage sheet: AK0082 (Eline's Snowmen), Buttons: pink Cut a white top-fold card 10.5 cm wide and 13.5 cm high. Mark both sides of the top at 3.5 cm in from the corner and the sides at 3 cm down from the corner. Cut off the slanted corners. The folded piece in the centre will be 3.5 cm wide.

Punch a hole in the top centre and adhere a blue reinforcement ring. Cut two 7.5×10.5 cm rectangles from design paper and adhere them with a 1 cm overlap onto the bottom of both halves of the label. The label will be 20 cm long.

Cut three strips from design paper: 3 \times 10.5 cm, 10 \times 10.5 cm and 2.2 \times 3 cm.

Cut the picture into 9 x 9 cm and adhere to 9.5×9.5 cm black card. Die cut a white banner and stamp a text.

Die cut the shapes needed from different colours of card and/or design paper. Complete the label as per example given.

(962), moss green (951), olive green (945), Blending tool, Thin hemp cord: black

Cut a 15 x 15 cm blank card from white velvet card.

Cut 14 x 14 cm red design paper and work the edges with a blending tool and distress ink.

Die cut the card display 1x from gold-coloured soft glitter paper and 1x from gold-coloured card. Turn one display one quarter and adhere together as shown.

Die cut two baubles from white velvet card, the small photo frame from gold-coloured card and the clips, plant pots, bauble with text, suspension strips and tree. Colour the baubles and white photo frame in with distress ink.

Die cut the shapes needed and work some with white gesso. Adhere all parts to the blank card.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm blank card from white velvet and adhere a 14.5 x 14.5 cm petrol and 13.5 x 13.5 cm raven black card.

Work 13.3 x 13.3 cm white velvet card with the mask stencil, distress ink and a blending tool.

Die cut from raven black 4x the card display, the plant pots, a few clips and two photo frames. Adhere the four card displays together.

Die cut from platinum glitter card 2x the centres of the photo frame, the mini label and a few of the larger clips. Die cut the smallest part of the photo frame 2x from white velvet card. Die cut the letters from raven black. Adhere all parts of the photo frames together and then form the texts. Die cut the smileys from petrol and the leaves from moss green

and olive green. Thread black hemp cord through the label and adhere.

Materials:

Craftables: CR1422 (Spiderweb), CR1450 (Punch die-Halloween), Creatables: LR0500 (Moon), LR0561 (Witch on broomstick), LR0591 (Tiny's Cats), LR0611 (Balcony), LR0678 (Gate folding-Tree), LR0680 (Tree log), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft

stencil: PS8074 (Haunted house), Distress ink: aged mahogany, bundled sage, forest moss, fossilized amber, gathered twigs, rusty hinge, Decoupage sheet: AK0073 (Eline's backgrounds-Autumn), Papicolor card Original: black (901), orange (911), pearly white (930), pale green (970) and Kraft grey (322), Cadence rusty patina paint: mold green, Craft sheet, Distress paste: rusty brown, Pencil and eraser Cut a 30 x 15 cm pearly white rectangle and draw two guidelines in pencil: front flap on the right-hand side at 7.5 cm and reverse side on the left-hand side at 7.5 cm.

Place the tree die against the top of the card and on the guidelines and die cut the trees. Then score the card on the two guidelines and at both ends at 6.75 cm. Fold the card as per example.

Cut a background into 14×9.4 cm. Adhere to 14.5×14.5 cm kraft and work the edges with distress ink gathered twigs. Tear soft green strips and work with distress ink bundled sage, forest moss and gathered twigs. Arrange a landscape at the bottom centrally.

Die cut trees from black card. Cut a few more branches on the straight side to give the trees a natural shape. Work them with a sponge and mold green rusty patina paint. Adhere to the card. Tear more soft green strips and work with distress ink bundled sage, forest moss and gathered twigs. Adhere to the flaps. Cut off the sides of the flaps in line with the white card.

Die cut a white moon and work with distress ink aged mahogany, fossilized amber and rusty hinge. Make the border a little darker with distress ink gathered twigs. Adhere the moon with 3D-kit. Place the craft stencil onto orange card, draw the outline of the house in pencil and cut out. Work the edges with distress ink gathered twigs.

Draw the smaller house and the windows onto black card and cut out. Work pieces of paper with distress ink aged mahogany, fossilized amber and rusty hinge and adhere behind the windows.

Draw the roof onto black card. Cut out and work the edges with mold green rusty patina paint.

Adhere the parts onto the centre of the card using 3D-glue. Die cut the balcony 2x from kraft and work with rusty brown distress paste and mold green rusty patina paint. Adhere with 3D-glue.

Die cut the witch from different card colours and assemble. Complete the card as per example.
