Materials:

Craftables: CR1483 (Trees by Marleen), CR1507 (Card stand extra), CR1510 (Long tags), CR1513 (Alphabet Journal), Creatables: LR0631 (Tiny's Frosty snowman), LR0679 (Dutch ice skates), LR0684 (Wood slices), Die cut and embossing machine, Craft stencil: PS8076 (Sweater), Text stamps: CS1067 (Handgeschreven Kerst), Stamping pad Archival: jet black, Distress ink: walnut


stain, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double sided: PK9172 (Frozen Winter), Papicolor card Original: raven black (901), orange (911), red (918), pearly white (930), navy blue (909), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Kraft, Gel pen: white, Gesso, White corrugated paper (rusk packaging) Cut 14.5 x 18 cm design paper. Cut off the top corners slanting $(5 \times 3 \text{ cm})$ and work the edges with a paper distresser. Mat on dark blue and white card.

Punch a hole, add a die cut reinforcement ring and thread rope through. Tear 11×16 cm white corrugated paper and adhere slanting. Cut 6×15 cm design paper (reverse side of PK9172), work the edges with a paper distresser and mat on white card. Adhere the label but do not apply glue where the label will be put. Die cut a white tag, stamp a text, add a blue reinforcement ring, and tie rope through.

Draw the outline of the sweater onto white card and cut out. Draw the inner lines onto design paper, cut out and adhere. Draw the bottom half of the sweater onto a scrap of white card, tear off the top and use as a snow border. Die cut green Christmas trees. Die cut the snowman and assemble. Die cut white letters. Create a wintery scenery on the sweater. Draw snowflakes with a white gel pen. Die cut and emboss three wood slices from kraft and work with distress ink and gesso. Die cut the skates, assemble, and tie with a bow of double hemp cord. Die cut a card stand and adhere to the reverse side of the card.

(939), Christmas red (943), vanilla (963), light blue (964), Card: light orange, Gel pen: black, Kraft wrapping paper, Mini ink blending tool, Adhesive stone: red Adhere 14×9 cm design paper to the pay envelope. Put the present inside and seal the envelope. Decorate with a strip of red design paper, tear off the ends.

Die cut a dark blue label, draw the inside of the label onto design paper and cut out. Die cut the top of the label from design paper with bricks as well, tear off and adhere. Fix the label with 3D-foam tape.

Thread ribbon and lace through the hole and tie together with a bow of hemp cord.

Die cut the other parts needed. Adhere to the card and finish as per example given.

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white top-fold card and adhere 13 x 13 cm dark blue design paper. Cut design paper with bricks into 13.5 x 3 cm. Emboss houses onto a 12.5 x 10 cm pearly white card. Die cut a dark brown tree. Adhere the layers together with the tree in between. Cut a 9.4 cm \emptyset yellow circle and adhere the picture with 3D-foam tape.

Die cut the bicycle from different colours of design paper and assemble. Adhere all parts to the card and finish as per example given.

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white top-fold card and adhere a 14.5 x 10 cm Christmas red card and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper. Cut design paper with bricks into 15 x 4 cm.

Die cut the wood stove, presents bag, presents, mitre, staff and sweets. Adhere to the card and finish as per example given.

Materials used for both cards:

Clear stamps: CS1072 (Crafting sentiments), CS1073 (Needle work), Velvet card: white, Card: black



Extra needed for this card:

Stamping pads Memento: grape jelly, gray flannel, ladybug, lilac posies, lulu lavender, rhubarb stalk, rose bud, Stamping pad Versafine: onyx black, Versamark transparent ink, Embossing powder: white, Heat tool Cut white velvet card into a 21 \times 10 cm blank card and adhere a 20.5 \times 9.5 cm black card.

Cut a 20×9 cm white velvet card, stamp the images using different colours of Memento ink and adhere.

Use Versamark transparent ink to stamp a text, crochet needle and balls of wool onto a 5.5×9.5 cm black rectangle. Sprinkle white embossing powder on top and melt with a heat tool. Adhere to the blank card with 3D-tape.



Extra needed for this card: Stamping pads Memento: bamboo leaves, dandelion, Danube blue, grape jelly, ladybug, rose bud, tangelo Cut white velvet card into a 13 \times 13 cm blank card and adhere a 12.5 \times 12.5 cm black card.

Stamp the images with different colours of Memento ink onto a 11.5 x 11.5 cm white velvet card and adhere.

Stamp a text onto a 3.5 x 3.5 cm white velvet card and adhere to a 5.5 x 5.5 cm black card.

Materials used for both cards:

Creatables: LR0685 (Gate folding Tiny's Forest), LR0686 (Mittens and scarf set), Design folder: DF3440 (Snow and ice crystals), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps: CS1069 (Kerstpost), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9170 (Wood & Stone), Distress inks: forest moss, gathered twigs, pine needles, Papicolor card: Original pearly white (930) and light green (970), Kraft grey (322), Paper distresser, Bandage gauze: white, Gesso: white, Pompons: white, Rhinestones: CA3136

General instructions:

Work the edges of the paper with a paper distresser and apply gesso. Die cut the trees from light green and work with distress inks forest moss, gathered twigs, pine needles and gesso.



Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0631 (Tiny's Snowman), Decoupage sheet: IT613 (Tiny's Snowmen), Papicolor card Original: black (901), red (918) Cut a 21 x 15 cm pearly white card and score folds at 9 and 10 cm, die cut the trees and fold the card. Cut design paper into 3 x 14 cm and 10 x 14 cm. Adhere to kraft and trim leaving a 2.5 cm border. Adhere the picture to kraft and trim leaving a narrow border. Layer a piece of bandage gauze behind. Tear pearly white strips and create a snow landscape on the card. Die out three light green trees, and truply from kraft. Work

card. Die cut three light green trees, and trunks from kraft. Work as described and adhere with 3D-glue. Complete the card as per example given.





Extra needed for this card: Creatables: LR0615 (Tiny's Deer family), Decoupage sheet: IT607 (Tiny's Winter village), Papicolor card Original: blue (955), Corrugated cardboard Cut a 27 x 13.5 cm pearly white strip and score folds at 6.5 - 7.5 - 20 and 21 cm. Die cut trees onto the side flaps. Fold the card. Cut design paper into a 11.5 x 12.5 cm rectangle and two 0.25 x 12.5 cm strips. Adhere to blue card and trim leaving a 2.5 cm border. Die cut trees from light green card and trunks from brown design paper. Work them as described. Tear corrugated cardboard into 8 x 8 cm and design paper into 4.5 x 12.5 cm. Cut out the picture, adhere to kraft and trim leaving a 2.5 cm border. Layer a piece of bandage gauze behind. Adhere to the card with 3D-glue. Complete the card as per example given.

spun sugar, Stamping pad Memento: white, Decoupage sheet Mattie's Mooiste: MB0172 (Needlework), Papicolor card Original: mocha (953), cerise (933), pale pink (923), night blue (941), Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver) Cut a 12 x 15 cm pearly white blank card and adhere 11.5 x 14.5 cm and 4 x 15 cm design paper.

Die cut two squares of consecutive sizes at the same time, creating a square frame. Die cut the image and adhere. Die cut the top part of the label from design paper and thread wax cord through. Die cut the long zipper and runners from design paper. Die cut two labels from design paper, stamp a text, adhere overlapping.

Die cut flower stems and buttons from design paper and scissors from gold-coloured paper.

Complete the card.

Cut a 12 x 16 cm pearly white blank card and adhere 11×15 cm and 10.5×14.5 cm design paper.

Die cut two circles of consecutive sizes at the same time from design paper and adhere a picture behind the circular frame. Die cut a brown chair and work with distress ink.

Die cut two buttons from a kraft leftover and adhere to the armrests. Die cut and emboss the other parts from kraft, light pink and cerise and work with distress ink.

Die cut the knitting needles and scissors from silver-coloured paper. Die cut a label from design paper, stamp a text, punch a hole and tie wax cord through.

Die cut a blue cushion and a pearly white cat, colour in with markers.

Materials:

Collectables: COL1476 (Eline's Christmas & Reindeer), Creatables: LR0675 (Holly leaves), Die cut and embossing machine, Clear stamps+dies set: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Text stamps: CS1069 (Kerstpost by Marleen), Stamping pad Archival: jet black, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9171 (Brocante

Christmas), Papicolor card Original: raven black (901), red (918), pearly white (930), nut brown (929), dark brown (928), olive green (945), Kraft paper, Corrugated cardboard (packaging), Gesso, Rope, Cotton pad, Pompons: white Cut white card into a 15×15 cm blank card, a 13×13 cm square and a 5×15 cm strip. Die cut design paper into 14.5 x 14.5 cm, 12.5 x 12.5 cm, and a 4.5×15 cm strip. Work the edges with a sponge and gesso. Adhere the smallest squares together, and the strips together as well. Then adhere them to the largest sheet of design paper. Wrap a double thread around the card and adhere at the back. Then adhere to the blank card. Tear corrugated cardboard of 12.5 x 12.5 cm, work with gesso and adhere slanting. Draw the outline of the sweater onto white card and cut out. Draw the inner lines onto design paper, cut out and position on the white sweater.

Die cut the parts of the reindeer (use a cotton pad for the white parts), cut out and assemble.

Adhere together with the pompons.

Die cut two holly leaves, a branch with berries (work with gesso) and a label. Stamp a text.

Adhere all parts to the card and add a bow from double hemp cord.

(Lantern Border), Stamps+dies set: HT1658 (Christmas Bear), Stamping pad Archival: jet black, Distress inks: black soot, candid apple, fossilized amber, frayed burlap, stormy sky, tattered rose, walnut stain, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9171 (Brocante Christmas), Watercolour paper, Gesso, Glitter: ice white (Nuvo Pure Sheen), Rope, Tulle

Craftables: CR1360 (Basic stitched passe-partouts-Circles), CR1527 (Cross stitch-Sweater), Die cut and embossing machine, Embroidery thread: different colours, Clear stamps: CS1066 (Jij bent Mega), CS1068

(Gezegende Kerst), Stamping pad VersaMark transparent, Embossing powder: white and Heat tool, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9171 (Brocante Christmas), Papicolor card Original: red (918), pearly white (930), pine green (950), Hemp cord: white



Materials:

Craftables: CR1335 (Punch die-Snowflakes), CR1510 (Long tags), Creatables: LR0687 (Hot drink), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping pad Archival: jet black, Distress inks: black soot, candid apple, fossilized amber, frayed burlap, gathered

twigs, hickory smoke, stormy sky, tattered rose, Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK9171 (Brocante Christmas), Clear stamps: CS1067 (Handgeschreven Kerst), HT1620 (Border Polar ice), Clear stamps+dies set: HT1669 (Winter bear), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Watercolour paper, Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver), Velvet paper: white, Vellum, Gesso, Glitter: ice white (Nuvo Pure Sheen), Rope Cut a 13.5 x 28 cm white strip and die cut trees on both sides. Score folds at 5 cm (is next to the trees) and at 7.5 cm - 20 cm and 22.5 cm.

Cut design paper into 12 \times 13 cm and two 2 \times 13 cm strips. Work with gesso and adhere.

Die cut a circle from watercolour card, stamp the border image and colour in with distress ink.

Stamp the bear, present and four musical notes onto watercolour paper. Colour in the bear and box with distress ink and die cut the images with the coordinating dies. Adhere to the card. Tear a small strip of white card, stamp a text, apply glue, and sprinkle glitter on top. Position along the bottom of the card. Apply ink to the branches of the trees and sprinkle with glitter. Add a bow of tulle and hemp cord. Set aside to dry.

Cut a 15 x 15 cm red card and adhere a 14.5 x 14.5 cm green card. Cut 14 x 14 cm red design paper, an 8.5×15 cm green strip, and an 8×15 cm red one and 7.5×15 cm green dotted design paper. Arrange the sheets and decide where the texts should come.

Stamp the texts with transparent ink, sprinkle embossing powder on top and melt it with a heat tool.

Die cut the consecutive circles together to create circular frames.

Die cut and emboss a white sweater and embroider the crossstitch pattern with four strands of embroidery thread. Adhere the layers to the card and add a bow of double hemp cord.

Cut a 14.5 x 15.5 cm white top-fold card. Cut design paper into 14×15 cm and 13×14 cm and work the edges with gesso.

Die cut a white tag, stamp a text, add a reinforcement ring, and tie a bow of double hemp cord through.

Adhere the design papers together, but do not apply glue where the label will be put.

Wrap a double rope around the sheets of design paper and adhere at the back.

Die cut two mugs from watercolour paper, stamp the border image onto one of them and the bear onto the other one. Colour in with distress ink. Die cut and emboss two silver-coloured teaspoons. Die cut the steam clouds from vellum and the marshmallows from velvet card.

Adhere to the card as per example given.

Add a few snowflakes, apply a little glue and sprinkle glitter on top. Add a bow of double hemp card.
