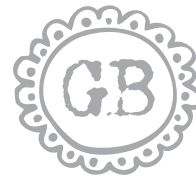


# The Collection #100

## Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1437 (Eline's Mice family), COL1493 (Eline's Kitchen accessories), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1015 (Menu), Stamping ink: VersaMark transparent, Embossing powder: Stampendous white EP100, Decoration paper: CA3126 (gold), Snow paper: CA3104 (glitter), Papicolor card: Recycled kraft grey (322), Metallic pearl white (330), Original: raven black (901), carnation white (903), light pink (923), pearly white (930), blossom (934), nut brown (939), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9175 (Rainbow), Acrylic stamping block, Heat tool, Gel pen: white, Coloured pencil: pink

## General instructions:

Colour the cheeks of the mice with a pink coloured pencil and place a white dot in their eyes and on their nose.



### Extra needed for this cover card:

Collectables: COL1347 (Party numbers), Craft stencil: PS8057 (Party cake by Marleen), Papicolor card: Metallic pearl white (330)

Draw the outline of the cake onto pearly white card. Do this twice, once the normal way and once in mirror image. Cut both out.

Take the cake in mirror image, score a line at 4.5 cm down from the top and fold over.

Glue this part on the back of the other cake. The cake card can stand now.

Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing in mirror image. Cut out and adhere.

Die cut the number, mice and accessories, assemble and adhere. Cut a green 3.5 x 1.5 cm and a pink 4 x 1.5 cm strip. Stamp a text with VersaMark, work with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool.



### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1481 (Cupcake by Marleen), Craftables: CR1544 (Square backgrounds by Marleen), Creatables: LR0707 (Oven mitt & spoon)

Cut a 13.5 x 13.5 cm top-fold card. Cut a square background (CR1544) from design paper and adhere.

Die cut the figures needed as per example given and assemble.

Cut orange strips of 3.5 x 2 cm and 4.5 x 2 cm. Stamp a text with VersaMark ink, work with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool.

Adhere all parts to the card.



### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1322 (Cake), COL1481 (Cupcake by Marleen, candles used), Creatables: LR0411 (Labels hearts), LR0581 (Bunting banners), LR0708 (Cutting boards), Papicolor card: Metallic pearl white (330), Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9170 (Wood & Stone), Hemp cord: white, Round cutting die: 5 cm Ø

Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white single-fold card and adhere 14.5 x 10 cm light blue and 14 x 9.5 cm design paper with confetti print.

Die cut an orange circle, stamp a text with transparent VersaMark ink, work with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool.

Die cut the cutting board and label from design paper and tie hemp cord through both. Adhere all three.

Cut/tear a 15 x approx. 2.5 cm green strip and adhere as shown.

Die cut the mice and cake, assemble and adhere.

Complete the card with colourful bunting banners.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1347 (Party numbers), COL1444 (Rosettes & labels), Creatables: LR0708 (Cutting boards), Craft stencil: PS8085 (Apron by Marleen), Hemp cord: white

Draw the outline of the apron onto pearly white card. Do this twice, once the normal way and once in mirror image without the ribbons. Cut both out.

Take the apron in mirror image and score a line at 7 cm down from the top and fold over. Glue this part on the back of the other apron. The apron card can stand now.

Use the inner lines of the stencil to decorate. Draw them onto the reverse side of design paper. Do not forget to turn the stencil over to avoid drawing in mirror image. Cut out and adhere. Use 3D tape to adhere only three sides of the pocket so that something can be put inside.

Die cut the mice and accessories, assemble and adhere.

Die cut a green circle, stamp a text with transparent VersaMark ink, work with embossing powder and melt with a heat tool.

#### Materials used for all cards:

Collectables: COL1493 (Eline's Kitchen accessories), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping ink: Versafine onyx black, Pretty Papers design paper A4-bloc, double-sided: PK9175 (Rainbow), Card: brown, grey, kraft, light brown, light grey, white, black, Decoration paper CA3126 (gold), CA3127 (silver)

#### General instructions:

For many plain colours the back of the design paper has been used.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1422 (Eline's Baby animals), COL1454 (Eline's Kitten), Creatables: LR0705 (Cooking pots), LR0706 (Vegetables), LR0707 (Oven mitt & Spoon), LR0708 (Cutting boards), Text stamps: CS1015 (Menu), Craft stencil: PS8086 (Chef's hat & Spoons), Clipboard: LR0034

Cut a white A4-card down to 20 x 28.5 cm. Cut an 18 x 19.5 cm and a 10.5 x 19.5 cm rectangle from design paper and a 1.5 x 19.5 cm strip from white card. Adhere to the white base.

Draw the outline of the chef's hat onto white card. Draw the inner lines onto white card as well. Cut out and adhere together. Draw the outline of the spoons onto kraft and cut out. Die cut the other shapes needed from different card colours and design paper. Stamp a text onto the cutting board.

Cut a 1.5 x 6.5 cm strip from design paper, stamp a text and adhere to 1.9 x 6.9 cm design paper.

Complete the clipboard as per example given.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1464 (Eline's Puppy), Craftables: CR1507 (Card stand extra), CR1538 (Slimline banners), Creatables: LR0341 (Mini-cake & Cupcake), Text stamps: CS1015 (Menu), Craft stencil: PS8061 (Cookbook)

Draw the outline of the pages of the cookbook onto white card and plain design paper. Draw the inner lines of the pages onto design paper. Bend all pages a little. Adhere the design paper pages to the white pages. Adhere the four pages together in the centre only. Adhere a strip of foam tape between each page, this way they keep the curved shape.

Cut a 0.4 x 2.5 cm strip from kraft for the shelf. Die cut the other shapes needed from different card colours and design paper.

Adhere a card stand to the back of the cookbook.

Cut a 2 x 7 cm strip from design paper, stamp a text and adhere to 2.4 x 7.4 cm design paper.

Complete the cookbook as per example given.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1422 (Eline's Baby animals), COL1463 (Eline's Baby bunny), Creatables: LR0677 (Circle layout), Distress ink: scattered straw

Die cut the circle layout from design paper and white card. Die cut the shapes needed from different card colours and design paper. Apply a little distress ink scattered straw to the piping bag.

Adhere a card stand to the back of the card. Complete the card as per example given.



#### Extra needed for this creation:

Collectables: COL1454 (Eline's Kitten), Craftables: CR1462 (Cake wedge), CR1474 (Shaker doily), Creatables: LR0582 (Pins-Numbers), LR0697 (Blossom), Text stamps: CS1015 (Menu), Paper piercer

Die cut the base of the cake wedge from white card and assemble. Die cut the complete lid from design paper and 1x the triangular top only. Cut two 1 x 11.7 cm strips (pastry cream) from plain design paper and die cut a yellow blossom. Adhere these parts to the cake wedge.

Die cut the shapes needed from different card colours and design paper. Use a paper piercer and pierce three holes in the top of the cake to place the number pins.

Stamp the text onto the circle.

Complete the cake wedge as per example given.

#### Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1246 (Apron by Marleen), Creatables: LR0566 (Dinner set), LR0706 (Vegetables), Die cut and embossing machine, Text stamps: CS1505 (Menu), Stamping ink: black, Distress ink: various colours, Pretty Papers design paper A4-bloc, double-sided: PK9175 (Rainbow), Papicolor card Original: pearly white (930), Card: kraft, Decoration paper: CA3127 (silver)

#### General instructions:

Die cut the vegetables from pearly white card and work with distress inks.

*Bell peppers:* candied apple, forest moss, mustard seed, ripe persimmon, rustic wilderness.

*Tomatoes:* candied apple, forest moss, mustard seed, ripe persimmon, rustic wilderness.

*Carrots:* forest moss, ripe persimmon, rustic wilderness, spiced marmalade.

*Leeks:* forest moss, rustic wilderness, vintage photo.

Die cut the cutlery from silver-coloured paper.

Complete the card with cutting boards, aprons, decorative edges, plates and cutlery, spoons, vegetables and a text.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0705 (Cooking pots), LR0707 (Oven mitt & Spoon), LR0708 (Cutting boards), Card: caramel, Distress ink: speckled egg, Ribbon: caramel, 3 mm

Cut design paper into three 8.5 x 13.5 cm and three 8.5 x 7 cm rectangles and three 8.5 x 1 cm strips. Adhere them to three 9 x 14 cm caramel rectangles.

Cut a 30 x 15 cm pearly white strip and score folds at 10 and 20 cm.

Make the handles of the cooking pot and the lid cap a little darker with distress ink speckled egg.

Adhere all parts to the card as per example given.

Cut design paper into a 13.5 x 13.5 cm square and a 13.5 x 7 cm and a 13.5 x 1.5 cm strip. Adhere to a 14 x 15 cm May green card and then to a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card.

Draw the chef's hat onto pearly white card and cut out. Work the edges with distress ink and adhere with 3D-glue.

Complete the card as per example given.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0705 (Cooking pots), Craft stencil: PS8086 (Chef's hat and spoons), Distress ink: speckled egg, Card: May green





Creatables: LR0705 (Cooking pots), LR0708 (Cutting boards), Craft stencil: PS8086 (Chef's hat and spoons), Card: caramel, Ribbon: white, 3 mm

Cut design paper into a 4.5 x 14.5 cm and a 1.5 x 14.5 cm strip. Adhere to 11 x 14.5 cm design paper and an 11.5 x 15 cm caramel card. Then adhere them to a 12.5 x 16 cm single-fold kraft card.

Complete the card as shown.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0708 (Cutting boards), Craft stencil: PS8061 (Cookbook), Ribbon: white, 2 cm

Draw the parts of the cookbook onto kraft, various colours/prints of design paper and pearly white card.

Draw the two top pages once more from design paper and trim 2.5 mm on all sides.

Cut design paper into two 7.2 x 3 cm strips and two 1.5 x 10.5 cm strips. Adhere to the cookbook and cut off the sides in line with the book's pages.

Adhere the book together, curl a few corners and complete with a bow.

#### Materials used for all cards:

Craftables: CR1545 (Art texture-Swiss cross), CR1547 (Band aid & Pills), Die cut and embossing machine, Stamping ink Archival: manganese blue, jet black, Perfect colouring paper (PCP), Copic markers or other colouring medium, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9175 (Rainbow), Papicolor card Original: raven black (901), red (918), pearly white (930), Craft tape, double-sided: LR0014 (10 cm wide)

#### General instructions:

- Stamp the background with CS1080 (Beterschapsteksten/mantelzorg) and Archival stamping ink manganese blue.
- Stamp the doctor and nurse with stamping ink Archival jet black onto PCP-stamping paper. Colour in the images and cut out with the die belonging to the set.
- Die cut the pills jar (CR1547-Band aid & Pills) from pearly white card and vellum. Adhere the vellum before cutting onto double-sided craft tape (LR0014). Die cut the pills from different colours of design paper and pearly white card. Work the elongated pills with distress ink tea dye. Lay the pills on the pot and adhere the vellum with double-sided tape.
- Die cut the Swiss cross (CR1545 Art texture) from design paper or red card and adhere the cross onto the pills jar.
- Work the fruit (COL1469) after die cutting with distress ink in the colours used for the fruit.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1461 (Nest die-Hearts), CR1510 (Long tags), CR1533 (Art texture-Squares), CR1551 (Big tag), CR1546 (Heart beat), Text stamps: CS1080 (Beterschapsteksten/mantelzorg), Stamp+die sets by Hetty: HT1660 (Doctor), HT1661 (Nurse), Scrapper's thread: green

Cut a 10.5 x 13.5 cm pearly white single-fold card and two 8.5 x 10 cm rectangles from design paper.

Die cut the Art texture square from pearly white card. Die cut the small rectangle of the big tag, a heart, band aid and heartbeat from design paper. Die cut the heart of the heartbeat from pink design paper. Die cut the Swiss cross from design paper and adhere the cross to the band aid.

Stamp and die cut the doctor and nurse, see general instructions.

Die cut the long tag from pearly white card and design paper. Stamp a black text.

Tie green thread through the tag.

Marleen), Stamp+die by Hetty: HT1661 (Nurse), Distress ink: mustard seed, barn door, spiced marmalade, Papicolor card Original: orange (911), red (918), cream (927), nut brown (939), army green (954), Scrapper's thread: blue



#### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1360 (Basic passe-partouts-Circles), CR1461 (Nest die-Hearts), CR1510 (Long tags), CR1546 (Heart beat), Stamp+die by Hetty: HT1660 (Doctor), Text stamps: CS1080 (Beterschapsteksten/mantelzorg), Distress ink: tea dye, Scrapper's thread: green, Vellum



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1469 (Fruit by Marleen), Craftables: CR1533 (Art texture-Squares), Creatables: LR0702 (Wicker basket), Text stamps: CS1065 (Opkickers by Marleen), Stamps+dies set: CS1058 (Banners by Marleen), Craft stencil: PS8013 (Apple by Marleen), Distress ink: vintage photo, mustard seed, barn door, spiced marmalade, peeled paint, Pretty Papers

design paper A4-bloc, double-sided: PK9170 (Wood & Stone), Papicolor card Original: orange (911), red (918), cream (927), nut brown (939), moss green (951), army green (954), Enamel dots: PL4514 (dew drops), Push pins: CA3151 (gold), Scrapper's thread: white

Cut a 14.25 x 9.25 cm pearly white card, adhere to slightly larger design paper and then to a 15 x 10 pearly white single-fold card. Die cut the Swiss cross and long tag from pearly white card and design paper.

Die cut the text out off the tag and adhere design paper behind. Die cut a pearly white band aid and adhere a cross die cut from design paper.

Stamp a black text and die cut the word Beterschap from pearly white card and design paper.

Stamp the nurse (see general instructions).

Die cut the fruit from different colours of design paper.

Tie rope through the label.

Cut a 10.75 x 14 cm pearly white single-fold card and adhere 10.24 x 13.5 cm design paper. Cut a 10 x 13.25 cm pearly white rectangle and die cut a circle on the right-hand side, adhere design paper behind. Stamp band aids onto the card. Die cut the heartbeat from raven black and red card. Cut to size and adhere within the circle.

Die cut the heart and band aid from design paper and a long tag from pearly white card and design paper.

Stamp a text with black ink. Stamp and die cut the doctor and nurse.

Stamp the pills jar as described in the general instructions.

Die cut the heart of the heartbeat from red card and adhere to the band aid.

Draw the outline of the apple onto pearly white card and the inner lines onto design paper. Cut out and adhere.

Die cut the Art texture square from pearly white card and the wicker basket from nut brown card, work it with distress ink vintage photo.

Die cut the pills jar as described in the general instructions.

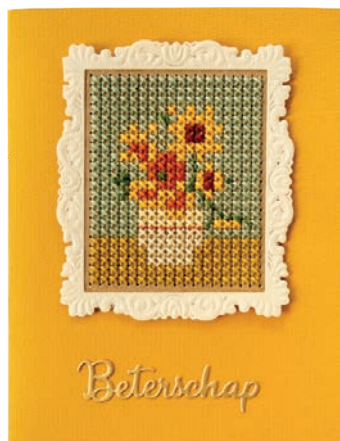
Die cut the fruit from different colours of card and design paper and work with distress ink.

Die cut the band aid from pearly white card and the heart of the heartbeat from red card.

Die cut the banner 2x from design paper, stamp a black text.

Tie the tags to the basket.

Decorate the apple with enamel dots.



**Materials:**

Craftables: CR1530 (Cross stitch XXL), Creatables: LR0709 (Picture frames), Creatables: LR0710 (Beterschap), Die-cut and embossing machine, DMC-embroidery thread: brown, golden brown, warm yellow and golden yellow for the background. For the pot two tints of lighter yellow, green for the leaves and bluish green for the background. Papicolor card Original: nut brown

(939), pearly white (903), mustard yellow (948), Metallic paper: CA3126 (mat gold)

Die cut the embroidery holes into brown card and embroider as per pattern. Cut the embroidery to the size of the frame. Die cut and emboss a white frame.

Let the many online images of Van Gogh's sunflower painting inspire your choice of colours.

Die cut the text from mat gold paper.

The single-fold card is 12.5 x 16.5 cm.

**Materials used for all cards:**

Creatables: LR0703 (Anja's Hydrangea), LR0693, (Anja's Circle XS, twig used), Die cut and embossing machine, Glitter gloss Nuvo: 888N

**General instruction flowers:**

Die cut the flowers and leaves from white card. Work them with a finger dauber, or a small sponge, with ink. Spray with a little water and dab away the excess. Lay them on a foam pad and make "stripes" on the flowers, from the outside in, with an embossing tool. Set aside to dry. They will now be nice and sturdy.



**Extra needed for this card:**

Creatables: LR0709 (Picture frames), LR0553 (Anja's Lacy folding die), LR0710 (Beterschap), Decoupage sheet: EWK1285, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9174 (Springtime), Stamping inks: VersaMagic: GD-60 (tea leaves) and GD-78 (Aegean

blue), Memento MD-607 (nautical blue), Card: soft yellow, Crystal drops: 680N (duck egg blue)

Take a yellow card and die cut and emboss the folding die. Fold the card and adhere design paper behind the front flap.

Die cut and emboss the picture frame from design paper and adhere the picture behind.

Die cut the text 3x from design paper and adhere together. Work the flowers with ink and a touch of glitter. Adhere to the card and add a few crystal drops. Leave to dry.



**Extra needed for this card:**

Creatables: LR0709 (Picture frames), LR0710 (Beterschap), LR0692 (Anja's Square XL), LR0571 (Anja's Vertical folding die-Square), Pretty Papers design paper pad: PK7060 (Honeymoon), Decoupage sheet: EWK1285, Stamping inks: VersaMagic GD-81 (Niagara mist) and GD-76

(malted mauve), Memento: MD-301 (rhubarb stalk) and MD-704 (new sprout), Card: white, Crystal drops: 689N (Moroccan red)

Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm white single-fold card and place the square folding die (LR0571) on the inside on the left with the cutting edge to the right. Die cut and fold the card.

Die cut and emboss the picture frame from the plain side of design paper and adhere the picture behind.

Die cut and work the flowers as described above.

Use the largest die to cut and emboss a square from design paper and adhere inside the card on the right.

Finishing the back of the card: Die cut the picture frame from design paper and the text from white card.

Complete the card by adding a few crystal drops and a touch of glitter.





#### Extra needed for this card:

Creatables: LR0571 (Anja's Vertical folding die-Square), Craftables: CR1539 (Punch die-Lucky, ladybug used), CR1538 (Slimline banners), Stamping ink Memento inks: MD-805 (toffee crunch), MD-707 (bamboo leaves), Decoupage sheet: EWK1284, Pretty Papers design paper A4-pad, double-sided: PK9174 (Springtime), Card: soft green, Crystal drops: 652N (gloss-buttermilk)

Cut a 20.9 x 9.8 cm single-fold card. Place the square folding die inside the card on the left with the cutting edge to the right. Die cut and fold the card. Score the lines a little longer. Cut the long scalloped die 3x from design paper (1x for the back, 1x for the right-hand inside and part of it for the front flap on the left. Die cut and emboss the square and the next size together and adhere the picture of the yellow flower behind. Die cut and work the flowers. Make the ladybug and complete the card with a few crystal drops and a touch of glitter on the petals, leaves and lady bugs.

#### Materials used for all cards:

Die cut and embossing machine, Stamp master advanced: LR0029, Stamping paper: white, Masking tape or Post-it sticky notes



#### Extra needed for this card:

Stamps Colorful Silhouettes: CS1081 (Basic squares), CS1083 (Floral beauty), Art stamps: MM1639 (Summertime), Text stamps: CS1049 (Handgeschreven-Van Harte), Stamping ink Memento dew drops: angel pink, grape jelly, lulu lavender, sweet plum

Stamp three squares in different purple shades partly overlapping onto 12.5 x 12.5 cm stamping paper. Stamp the silhouette flower and text in a darker purple shade. Use the same inks and the Art texture stamp to stamp a few lines onto the squares if you like. Adhere the card to a 13 x 13 cm dark purple card and then to a 14 x 14 cm single-fold card.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Stamps Colourful Silhouette: CS1082 (Basic rectangles), CS1084 (Wildflowers), CS1065 (Opkickers by Marleen), Texture stamps: MM1628 (Crackles), Stamping ink Memento dew drops: desert sand, peanut brittle, toffee crunch, rich cocoa

Stamp three squares in three different shades of brown onto 11.5 x 14 cm stamping paper. First stamp the largest square into the centre and then on the left and right in lighter shades the smaller ones, slightly overlapping. Then stamp the silhouette twigs in the darkest brown shade. If the stamp is too long, mask that part with tape or sticky notes. Stamp the text in the darkest shade too. Use a lighter shade and the texture stamp to add crackles randomly. Wrap thin rope twice around the card and adhere on the back. Adhere a separate bow of rope in the centre. Adhere the card to a 12 x 14.5 dark brown card and then to a 12.5 x 15 cm single-fold kraft card.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Stamps Colorful Silhouettes: CS1082 (Basic rectangles), CS1083 (Floral beauty), Text stamps: CS1052 (Handgeschreven-Congratulations), Texture stamps: MM1627 (Script), Stamping ink Memento dew drops: bamboo leaves, new sprout, pistachio

Cut 10 x 14.5 cm stamping paper and stamp at 1.5 cm in from the left-hand side a long vertical rectangle in three green shades. Dab the darkest green shade onto the bottom of the stamp and, in the centre overlapping, a lighter shade above it and the lightest one at the top. You may need to repeat this a few times to obtain a nice colour gradient.

Adhere masking tape or Post-it sticky notes onto the wide white right-hand side of the card, along the green rectangle.

Then stamp the text of the texture stamp a few times using the darkest green shade. Remove the masking paper and stamp the rose exactly half on the rectangle and half on the white card as per example given. Use the stamp master. Repeat this a few times to get an image in a deep colour. Stamp the text as per example given. Adhere the card to 10.5 x 15 cm green card and then onto an 11 x 15.5 cm white single-fold card.



#### Extra needed for this card:

Craftables: CR1537 (Slimline frames), CR1538 (Slimline banners), Stamps Colorful Silhouettes: CS1081 (Basic Squares), CS1084 (Wildflowers), Text stamps: CS1063 (Handgeschreven-Groetjes), Texture stamps: MM1628 (Crackles), Stamping ink Memento dew drops: cantaloupe, tangelo

Die cut the large rectangle with stitches from stamping paper. Stamp three yellow squares using the stamp master. First stamp the one in the centre and then the other two.

Adhere masking tape or Post it sticky notes around the top square and, using another colour ink stamp crackles with the art texture stamp. Repeat this for the other two squares.

Use the same colour ink and stamp the silhouette flowers and text on top of the squares.

Wrap orange rope around the top of the card twice and adhere on the back. Make a double bow and adhere. (White cord can be coloured with a Copic marker.)

Die cut the large rectangle from yellow card.

Cut off 10 cm from the short size of an orange A4-sheet and fold in half.

Die cut and embossing machine, Velvet paper: white, Blending tool



#### Extra needed for this card:

Collectables: COL1348 (Eline's Hoera), COL1367 (Box of Chocolates), Creatables: LR0341 (Mini Cake & Cupcake), Distress ink: cracked pistachio, festive berries, spun sugar, worn lipstick, Stamping ink: emerald isle (Ink the Stamp Market), Card: green, Brush, Sequins, Washi tape

Cut a 20.5 x 9.5 cm green card and a 20 x 9 cm one from velvet paper.

Die cut the shapes needed from velvet card and colour in with distress ink and a blending tool.

Make a pretty arrangement with the box, cupcakes and the text, but do not adhere them to the card yet.

First decide where the other texts should come and stamp them onto the velvet paper.

Mask the text with washi tape and make splashes with a brush and distress ink diluted with water. Set aside to dry.

Adhere to the velvet card and then to a 10 x 21 cm single-fold velvet card. Complete the card with sequins.

Creatables: LR0341 (Mini Cake & Cupcake), LR0625 (Van Harte & Balloon 25th Anniversary), Craft stencil: PS8024 (Clouds & Sunburst), Distress ink: cracked pistachio, spun sugar, worn lipstick, Glitter paper/snow paper, Holographic paper, Sequins

Cut velvet paper into an 11 x 15 cm single-fold card and a 10.5 x 14.5 cm single card. Adhere together. Cut a 9.5 x 13.5 cm velvet card and work with the craft stencil, various colours of distress ink and a blending tool.

Die cut the cake from velvet card and the balloons and text from glitter card and holographic paper.

Adhere the layers to the card and complete with sequins.

Collectables: COL1349 (Eline's Birthday), Creatables: LR0625 (Van Harte & Balloon 25th Anniversary), Distress ink: festive berries, mustard seed, ripe persimmon, salty ocean, twisted citron, Stamping ink: Versafine onyx black, Card: black, Brush, Mica, Shaker card material

Cut a 15 x 11 cm single-fold card from velvet paper and adhere a 14.5 x 10.5 cm black card.

Cut a 13.5 x 9.5 cm velvet card and work with various colours of distress ink and a blending tool. Make splashes with water and a brush. Set aside to dry.

Die cut the text 3x from black card and adhere together.

Die cut the heart-shaped balloon 3x from the coloured velvet card and stamp the text.

Adhere a strip of mica to the reverse side of the coloured velvet card to cover the hearts. Stick 3D-foam tape to the reverse side leaving the hearts open.

Put shaker material onto the hearts and close with white velvet card. The shaker material will stay in the hearts.

Adhere to the card and complete with a text.

Cut an 11 x 15 cm single-fold card from velvet paper and adhere a 10.5 x 14.5 cm black card.

Cut a 9.5 x 13.5 cm white velvet card and work with a stencil and distress ink. Die cut the balloon from velvet paper and work with various colours of distress ink and a blending tool.

Die cut the text 3x from black card and adhere together.

Make a pretty arrangement with the balloons, but do not adhere them yet.

First stamp the ropes of the balloons with black ink.

Then adhere the balloons and text to the card.
