QUILLING BASIC SHAPES

Quilling

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1. Tight coil

Roll a strip of paper tight, hold in place, glue it on the roll.

2. Loose coil or scroll

Roll a strip of paper tight, allow rounds to relax and glue the end.

3. Teardrop

Take a teardrop between thumb and fore finger and pinch the tip, to make a point. Curve the tip.

4. Oval

Take a teardrop between thumb and fore finger and pinch both tips, to make two points.

5. Leaf

Make an oval and bend one point to the left and one to the right.

6. Petal

Press with the nails of both thumbs one side of the coil inside to make a dent.

7. Double vine

Fold a 1/4 or a 1/2 strip in uneven parts and roll the ends to one side. Apply a dab of glue in the fold.

8. Heart scroll

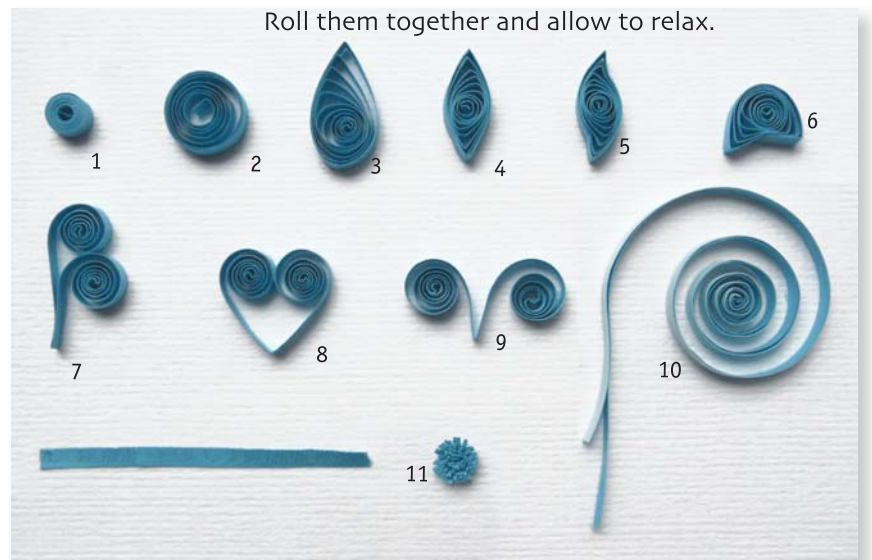
Fold a 1/4 or a 1/2 strip in half and roll the ends towards the inside of the folded crease.

9. V-scroll

Fold a 1/4 or a 1/2 strip in half and roll the ends towards the outside of the folded crease.

10. Two colours double scroll

Take two 1/2 strips and glue the ends together.



11. Fringed flower

Make small and even cuts about 2/3 across the width of the strip. Roll the fringed paper into a coil. Apply a dab of glue at the end and wait for the glue to dry, then press the fringe down.

Teardrop with eccentric centre.

Use a quilling board. Roll a coil of one strip and place in quilling board. Use a pin to pull the centre of the coil to the side and push the pin into the board to hold in place. Carefully apply a dab of glue between the pin and the coil. Leave to dry and remove the pin. Take the coil between thumb and fore finger; pinch on one side to make a point. The quilling board can also be used to make coils or scrolls of the same size, then only glue the ends and not in between the coils. Hearts and V-scrolls of the same size are also made with the quilling board.

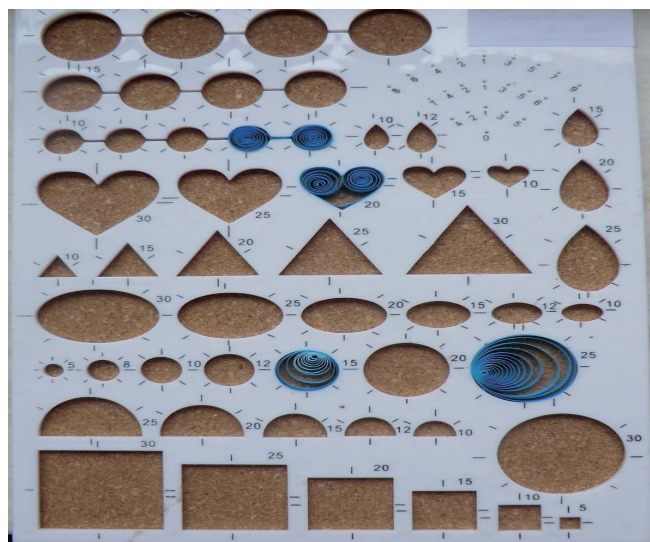
Different flowers

Flower of teardrops

Make seven teardrops of a $\frac{1}{2}$ strip and glue a $\frac{1}{2}$ pink and a full length of lilac together for a tight coil. Glue the rounded sides of the teardrops against the coil to make a flower.

Flowers of petals

Roll five petals of a $\frac{1}{2}$ strip and glue a $\frac{1}{4}$ red strip and a $\frac{1}{2}$ pink strip together for a coil. Glue the rounded sides against the coil to create a flower.



Flower of ovals

Roll six ovals of a $\frac{1}{2}$ strip and glue the points together to create a flower. Add stamen in the heart of the flower.

Roll five coils of a $\frac{1}{4}$ strip and glue together. Adhere a fringed flower of a $\frac{1}{4}$ strip to the centre. Determine the size of the flowers yourself. Easy to remember: full length, $\frac{1}{2}$ strip and $\frac{1}{4}$ strip. Fringed flowers are made from a $\frac{1}{4}$ strip or a $\frac{1}{8}$ strip. Always use a clear-drying glue.

Butterflies

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Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 11.5 x 14.5 cm cornflower blue and 7 x 14.5 cm light blue on top as per example. Die-cut COL1320 twice from pearly white. Trace in pencil the outline of COL1320 twice onto cornflower blue and trim with a border. Emboss the white

circles with a Design Folder and adhere them to the cornflower blue ones. Stamp the text. Finish off the card by adding quilled flowers and flat-backed pearls.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white single-fold card and layer 14 x 14 cm lilac on top. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm lilac and 12 x 12 cm pearly white. Emboss the pearly white square with the Design Folder and adhere onto the lilac square. Cut 5 x 5 cm

pearly white and stamp the text. Cut 5.5 x 5.5 cm lilac and adhere the squares together slantwise. Finish off the card with quilled flowers.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and layer 14 x 14 cm Christmas red on top. Cut 12 x 12 cm pearly white and emboss with the Design Folder. Die-cut LR0318 from pearly white and work with distress ink. Trace in pencil the outline of LR1320

onto Christmas red and trim with a border. Adhere together. Stamp the text. Add the quilled flowers to complete.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white card and layer 14 x 14 cm blossom on top. Cut 12 x 12 cm pearly white and emboss with the Design Folder. Cut it into a square and then into four equal parts of 6 x 6 cm. Layer onto Christmas red and trim with a

border. Stamp the text onto pearly white. Adhere to Christmas red and trim with a border. Finish off the card with quilled flowers and hearts.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white single-fold card and layer 14 x 14 cm light blue on top. Cut 12.5 x 12.5 cm cornflower blue and 12 x 12 cm pearly white card. Swipe the Design Folder with distress ink, place the white square in it and emboss it. First layer the square onto the cornflower blue one and then add to the card at a slant. Die-cut

COL1320 from pearly white. Trace in pencil the outline of COL1320 onto cornflower blue and trim with a border. Adhere the circles together. Stamp the text. Finish the card off with quilled butterflies and flat-backed pearls.



Cut a 14.5 x 14.5 cm pearly white single-fold card and layer 14 x 14 cm lilac on top. Cut 12 x 12 cm blossom and emboss it with the Design Folder. Die-cut LR0318 from pearly white and work with

distress ink. Stamp the text. Finish off the card with the quilled butterfly and flat-backed pearls.

Stamping

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Cut a 15 x 15 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 14.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and 13 x 13 cm shiny white card on top. Cut a 5 x 17 cm strip from design paper; use foamtape to layer it across the card, protruding 1 cm on each side. Add a 5 x 13 cm strip of pink striped design paper along the bottom. Die-cut CR1272 from 12.5 x 12.5 cm white card. Stamp the vase with flowers and colour in.

Create small quilled flowers and leaves. Use half of a quilling paper strip, create coils and shape them into petals and green leaves. Use six petals for a flower. Finish off the card with a stamped text and a bow.



Cut a 16 x 16 cm white single-fold card. Layer 14 x 14 cm and 13 x 13 cm design paper on top. Adhere flower ribbon across the card. Die-cut the square with apertures (LR0300) from white card and the plain square from light blue. Die-cut a white circle fitting the square, stamp the image and colour in.

Attach the circle using foam tape. Add the quilled figures. Die-cut Anja's border from white card. Cut out the letters I and U and add on each side of the stamped heart. Finish off the card with a bow of flower ribbon.



Cut a 16 x 16 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 15 x 15 cm design paper on top. Die-cut LR0236 from pearly white card and CR1273 from 14 x 7 cm pearly white. Adhere together with

the rectangle (LR0318). Add the 7 x 8 cm image. Adhere flower ribbon across the card. Add three quilled cupcakes. Finish off with a white satin bow.



Cut a 16 x 16 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 15 x 15 cm on top. Die-cut LR0236 from pearly white card. Stamp the Christmas ornaments onto the oval and colour the leaves/bows

and border with ink. Add the quilled figures. Finish off the card with a white satin bow.



Cut a 7 x 14 cm pearly white single-fold card and layer 6.7 x 13.7 cm dark green on top. Cut 6.2 x 13.3 cm design paper and cut out a circle at 0.5 cm from the top. Layer green behind the left-hand side. Adhere the sheet to the card using foamtape. Stamp the Christmas decorations onto pearly white card, colour in and cut a few out.

Die-cut LR0276 from pearly white card and cut out the figure as per example. Add a white ornament (LR0180) on the left and right-hand side. Arrange the parts on the card and finish off with the quilled figures and a white satin bow.



Cut a 10 x 15 cm pearly white top-fold card. Use the elegant bar (LR0311) to die-cut along the 15 cm wide bottom of the front panel. Cut 9.5 x 14.5 cm design paper and attach with foamtape. Stamp the image of the Christmas tree with text onto light blue card and cut the Christmas into a triangular shape. Mat on pearly white. Die-cut

the fence (LR0278) from pearly white and attach. Create a quilled penguin, Christmas present and star. Finish the card off with a white satin bow with a quilled flower on top.

Inspirations

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Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white top-fold card. Layer 10 x 14 cm gold-coloured card and 9.5 x 14 cm pearly white on top. Create a branch with different curls and make the lady bird with the

quilling board. Create the bee from yellow and black quilled strips glued together. Arrange the shapes on the card to finish.



Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 13.5 x 13.5 cm design paper on top. Die-cut the hearts from pearly white card and

swipe with distress ink. Arrange the quilled hearts, made from red and pale yellow quilling paper and adhere.



Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white single-fold card. Die-cut the rectangle and corners from silver-coloured card. Arrange the die-cut shapes on the

card. Create the flower and the branch. Adorn the rectangle with quilled berries.



Cut a 14 x 14 cm pearly white single-fold card. Layer 13.5 x 13.5 cm raven black and 7 x 13 cm pearly white card on top. Die-cut the letters from

pearly white and the hearts from pearly white and raven black card. Adhere the layers onto the card. Add the shapes to complete.



Cut a 14 x 14 cm raven black single-fold card. Layer 13.5 x 13.5 cm carnation white card on top. Die-cut LR0236 from raven black card; cut the

shape in half and adhere onto the card as per example. Add the quilled shapes.



Cut a 15 x 10.5 cm pearly white single-fold card. Draw in pencil a 6.5 x 6.5 cm square on the inside, at 0.5 cm from the top and 2 cm from the sides. Score all eight pencil lines. Cut diagonal lines into the 6.5 x 6.5 cm, creating four triangles. Layer 14.5 x 10 cm design paper on the card front, but cut it away around the square. Create a 'box': starting on the card front, fold the four outermost fold lines backwards and the innermost ones, visible on the triangles upwards. Cut a 6.5 x 6.5 cm white square, stamp a text and adhere

to the bottom of the 'box'. Adhere the die-cut square frame, decorated with flat-backed pearls around the 'box'. Add a butterfly created with the quilling board.
