


Mirror image die cutting

What do you need:

- Creatables: LRo344 (or another similar die)
- White cardstock: 28 x 14 cm
- bone folder
- butterfly, flowers, gems or pearls



Cut a 14 cm high and 28 cm long strip of cardstock and score folds at 7 and 21 cm. Place the die onto the right-hand side of the strip, cut and emboss in the normal way. Only the paper on the right-hand side will be cut off.



Turn the cardstock over (so front of strip is face down). The die-cut/embossed side of the strip is on the left-hand side now. Place the die in the same position on the right-hand side of the strip and only cut out (do not emboss!).



Remove the die and clean it well.



Place the die with the cutting side face down onto the top plate of the cutting and embossing machine.



Place the strip onto the die in such a way that the holes correspond. Fix the die with masking tape. Fix the strip with tape too so that it cannot move.



Place the embossing mat on top.



Place the embossing plate on top.



Only run the die and strip through the cutting and embossing machine as far as needed, to avoid unwanted marks in the cardstock. This is what you will see after embossing. Identical shapes on each side.



Turn the strip over and make the folds using a bone folder. Use a Design Folder to emboss a 13.5 x 13.5 cm white card and adhere it to the centre of the card. The card can be decorated with butterflies or flowers and adhesive stones or flat-backed pearls.
